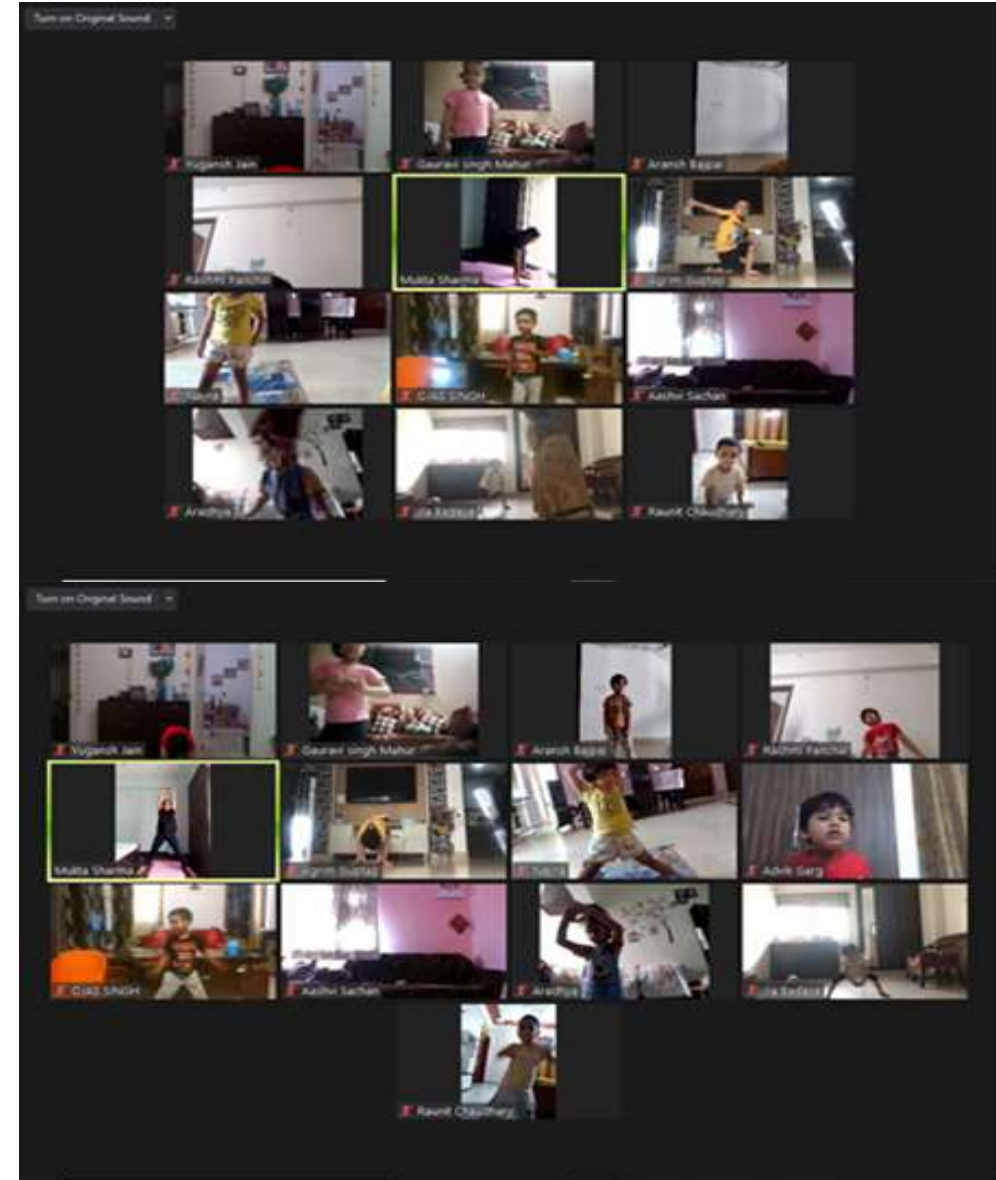
Fitness- Day-1 Uppar body streching exercises.

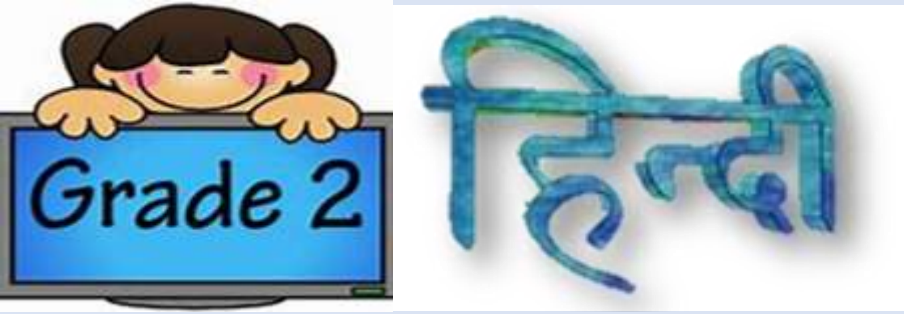

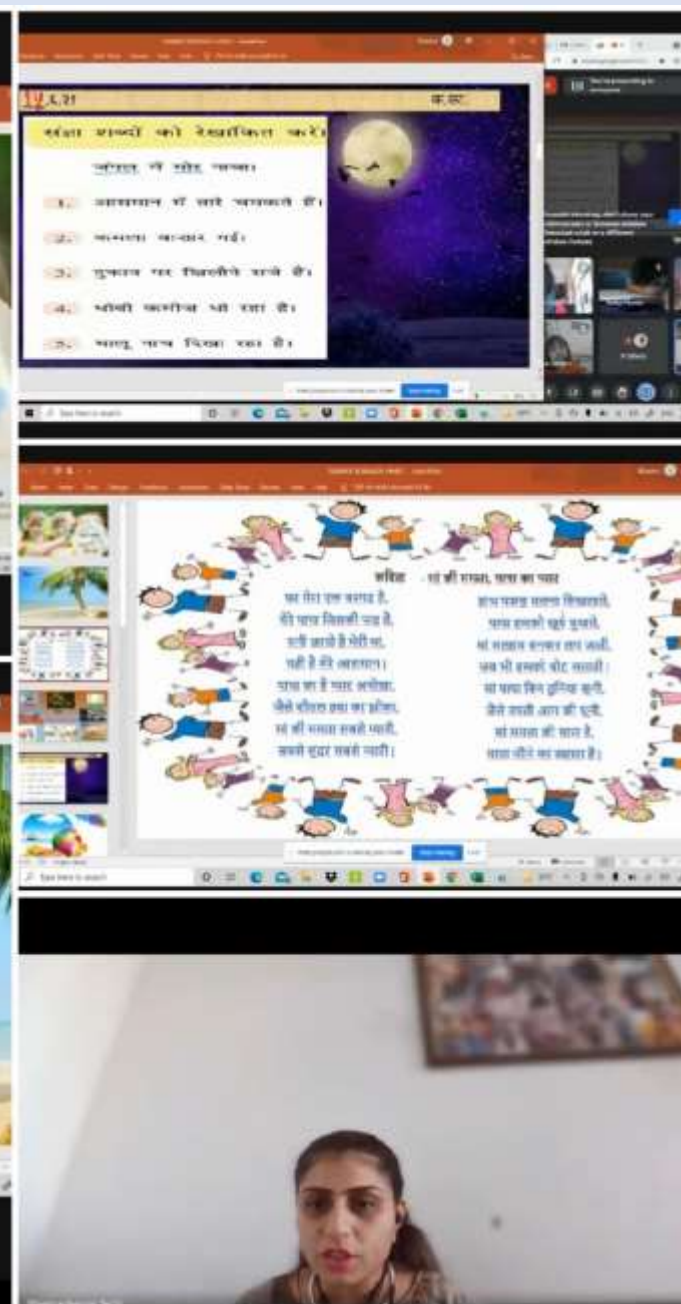

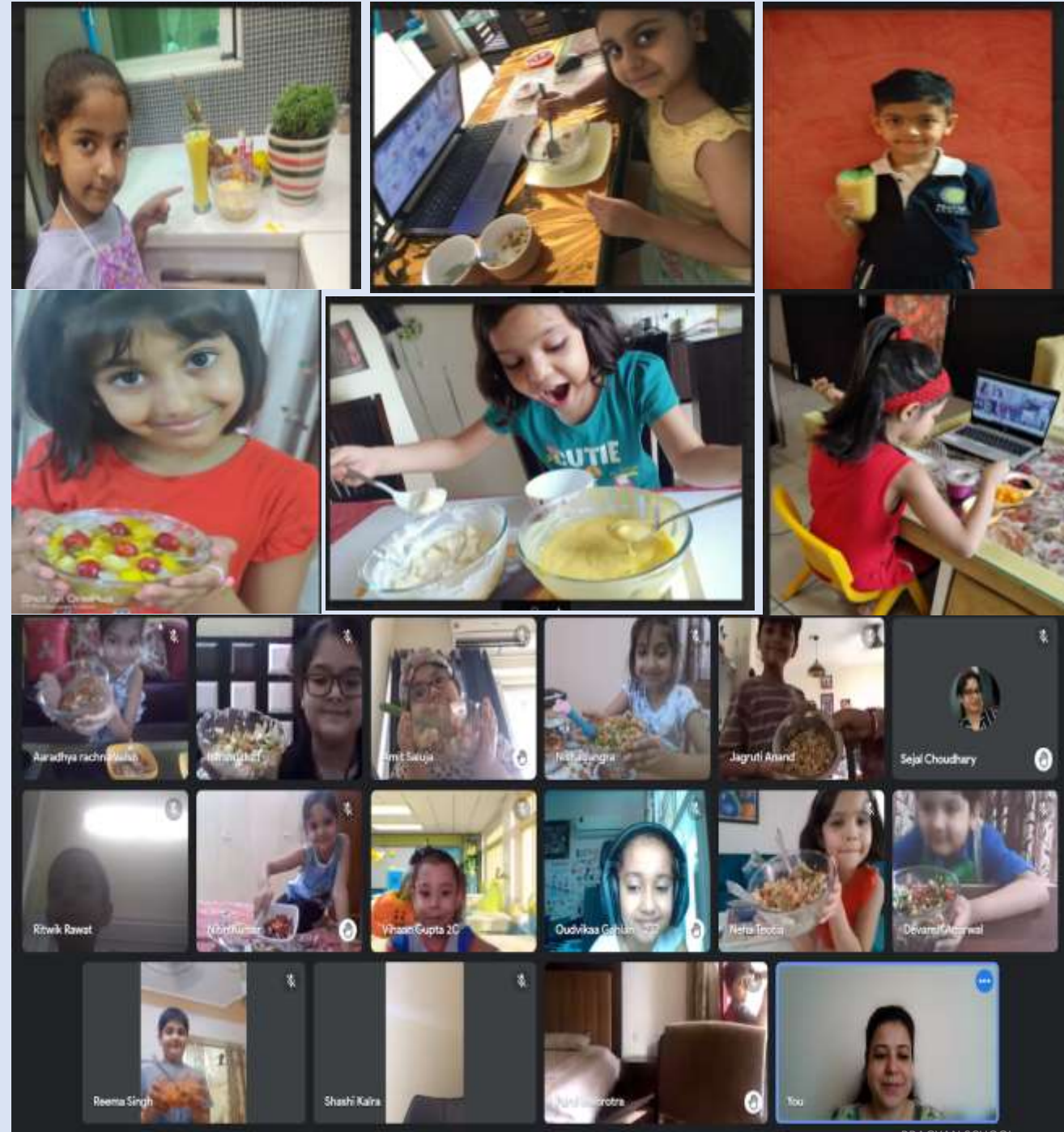

Fact-2, Your potato fries will be healthier if the skin is left on it as all the nutrients are in its skin.



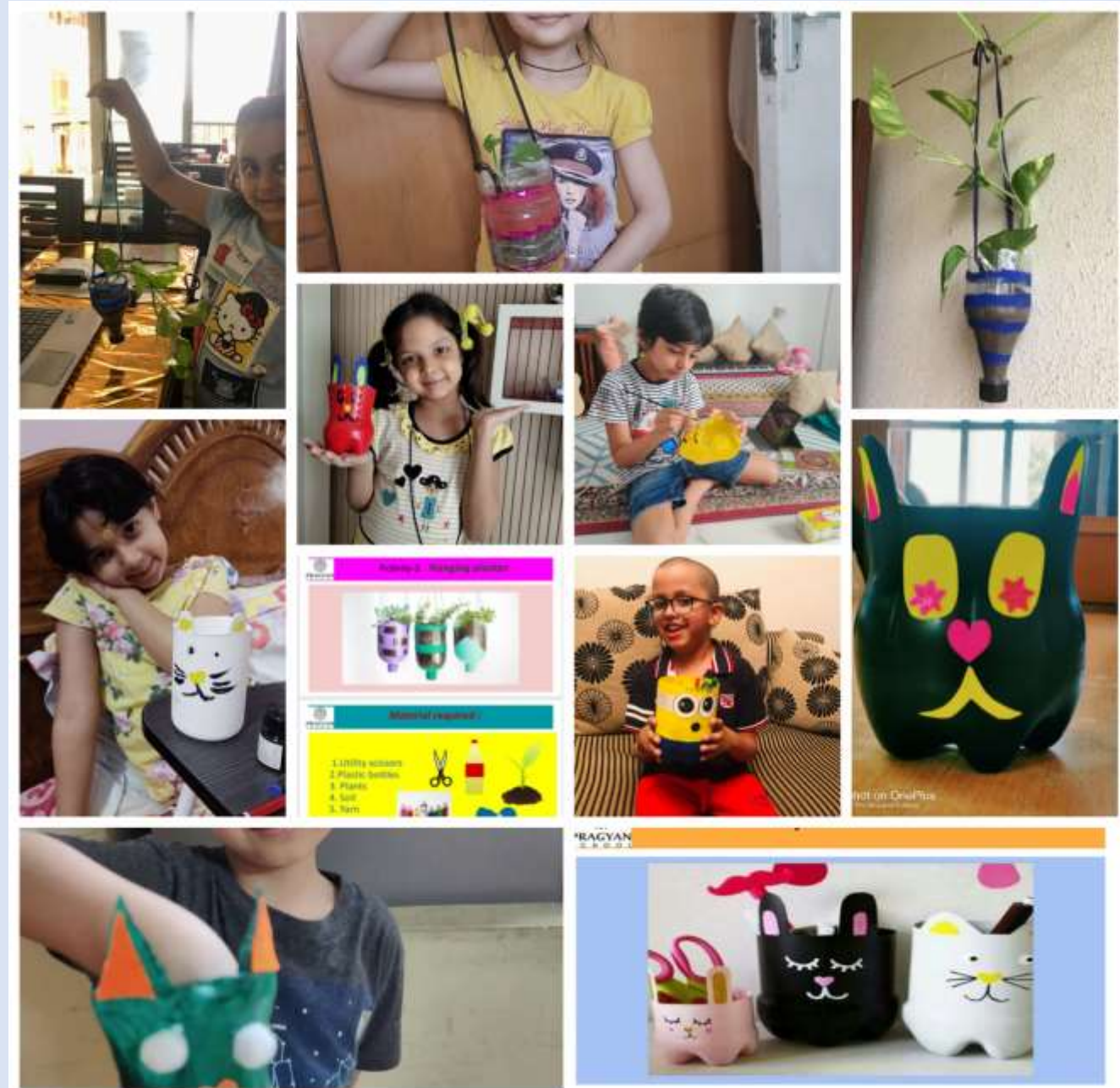

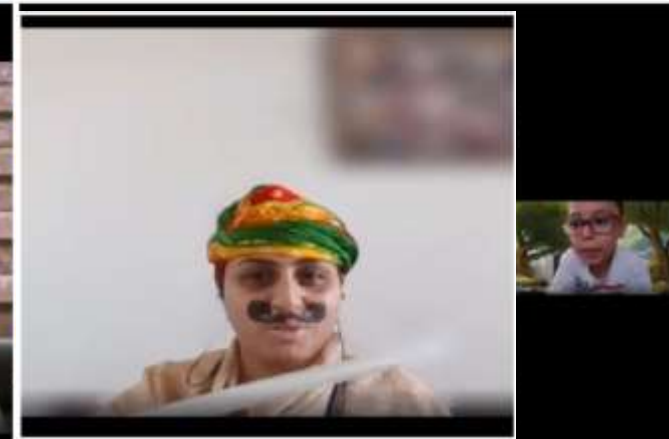
BEST OUT OF WASTE

Children made the cards which were child centered and added their own ideas to the creative zone.





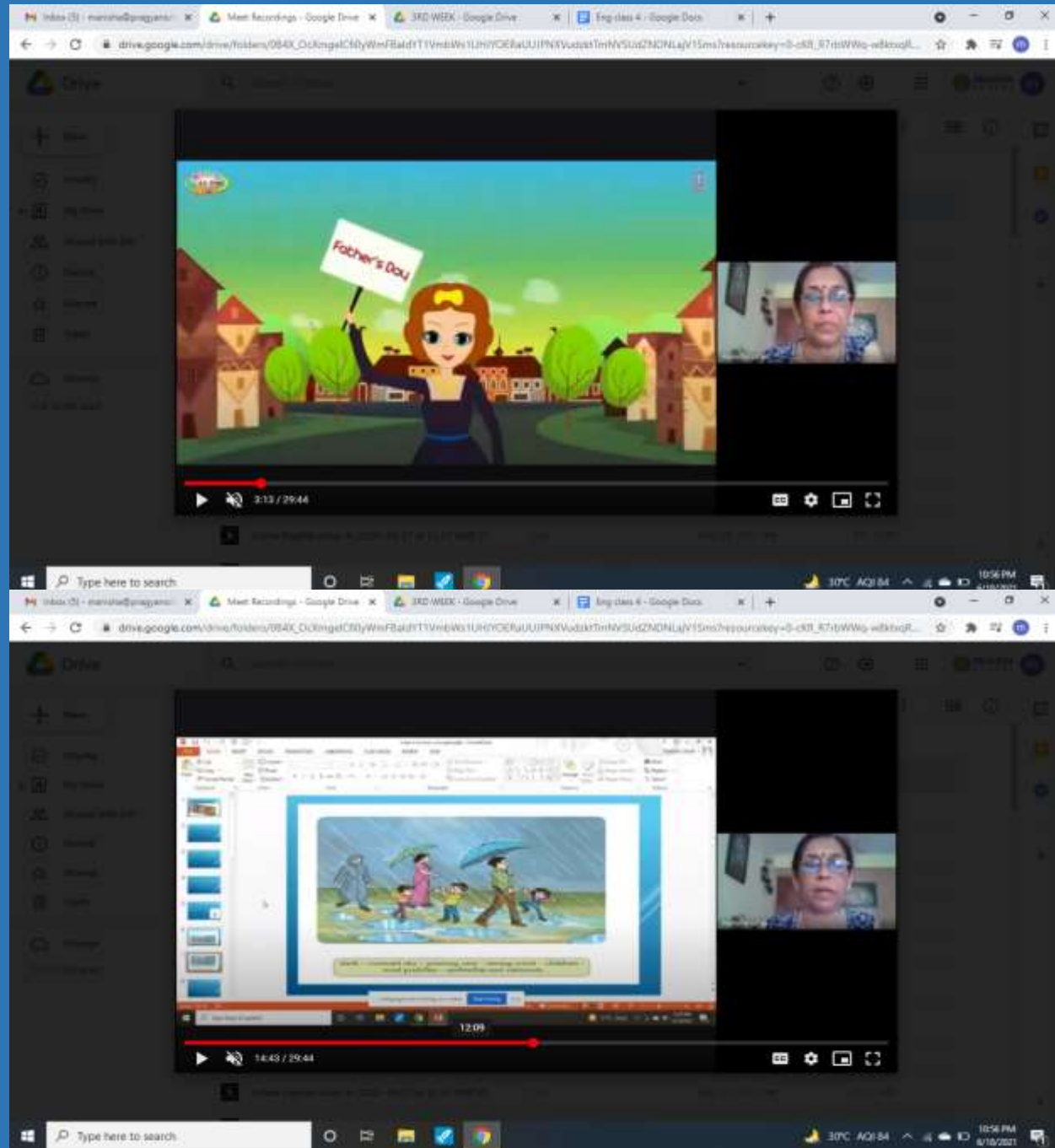
COOKING WITHOUT FIRE

ENVIRONMENTAL SCIENCE

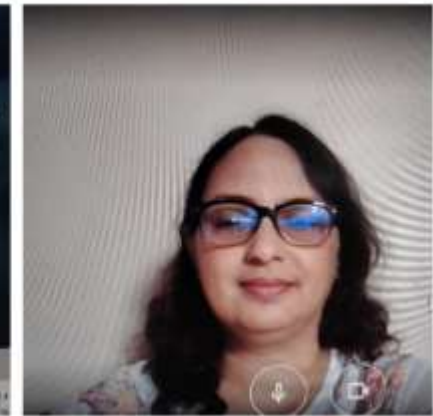

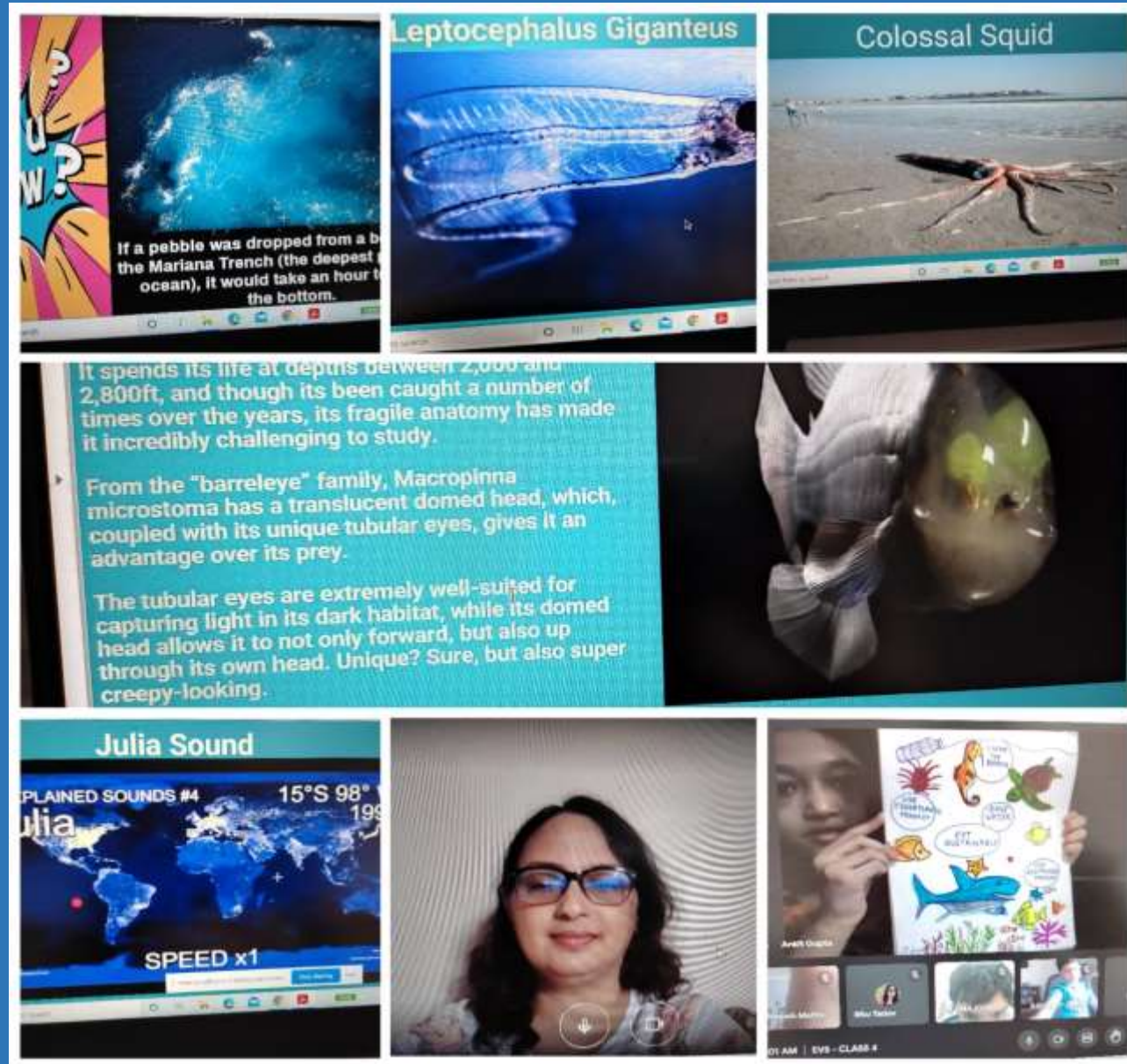




UNDERWATER MYSTERIES

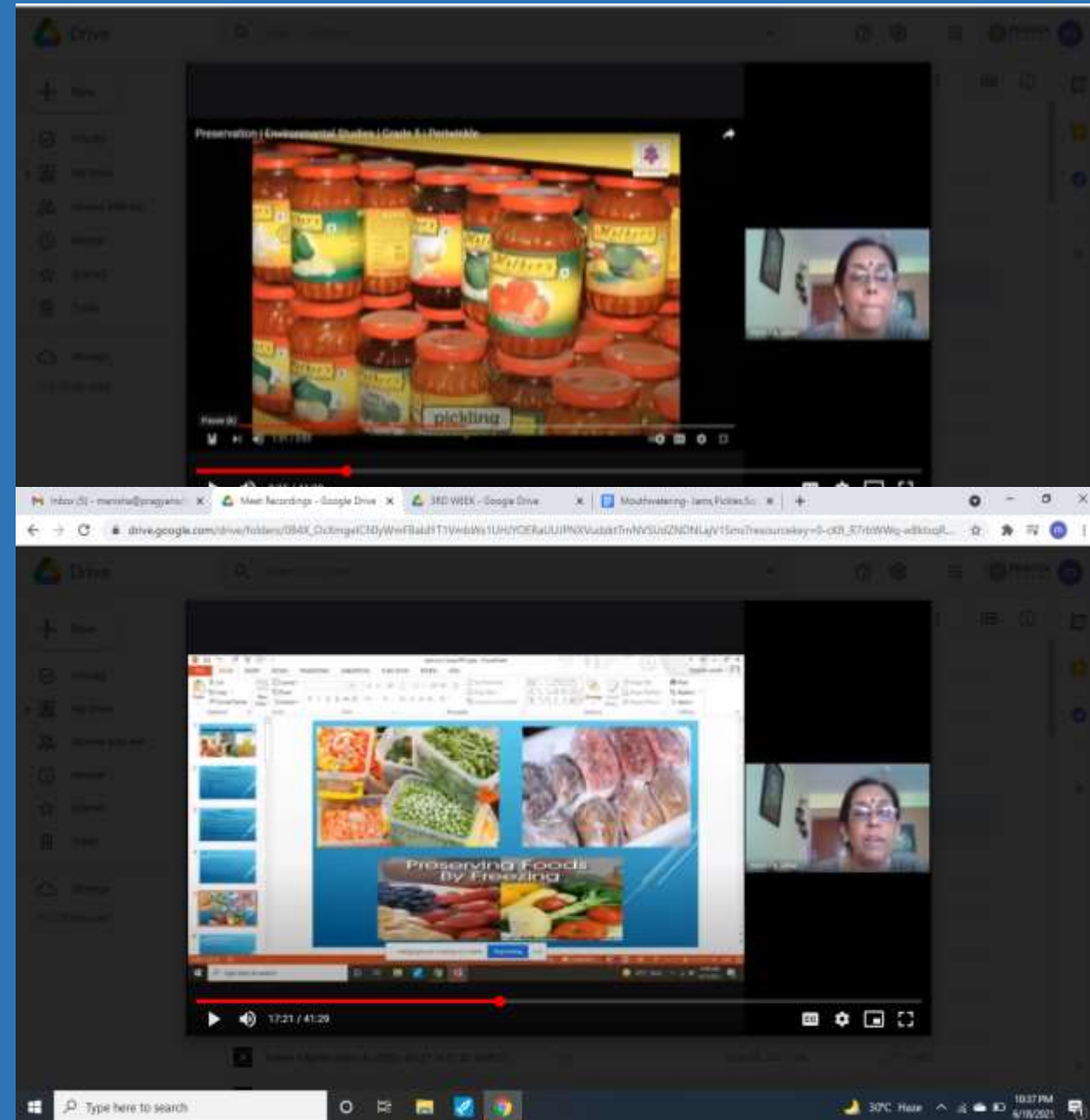
SUMMER Camp

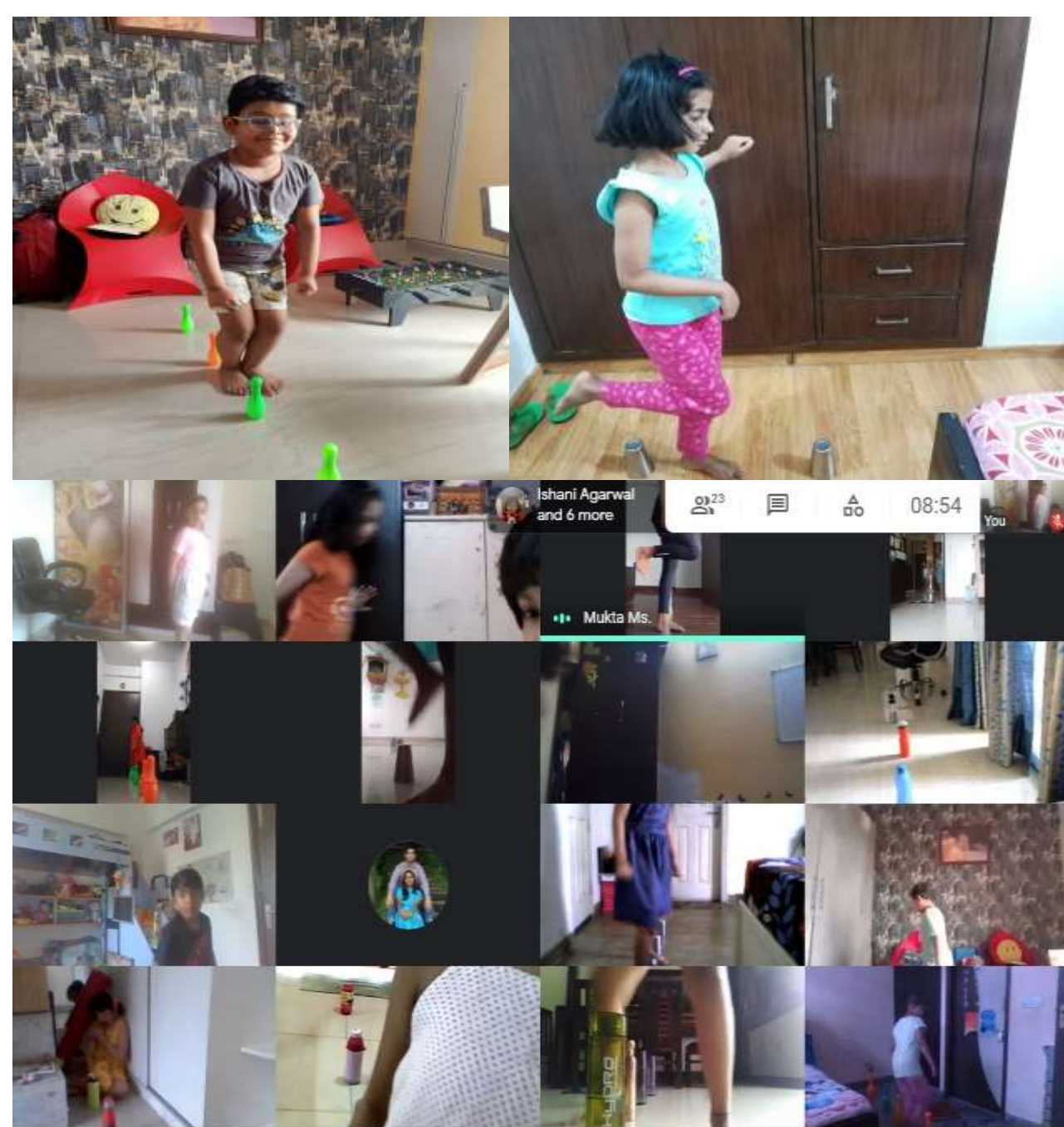
Students of class 5 were excited to learn dance steps on the song “Believer”. They have learnt the first stanza of the song.
