FUN SPORTS (NUR & KG)

Games play an important role in raising well rounded children. It helps with coordination, balance, motor skills and spending their natural energy. Children enjoyed various fun sports activities like Hurdle race, hula hoop, parachute, hit the ball and ring the cone as part of their summer camp activity.



ALPHABET AND NUMBER ART (NUR & KG)

Learning to draw with numbers and letters is a matter of learning to control the movements of a pencil on paper. In this activity children learnt to draw different animals with the help of the alphabet and numbers.



BEST OUT OF WASTE (NUR & KG)

The objective behind the activity Best Out Of Waste is to encourage students to learn the importance of reuse and recycle. Children enjoyed making flowers, dolls and piggy banks using waste materials.



LEAF PAINTING (NUR & KG)

Children of Nursery and Kindergarten enjoyed learning to make different pictures using leaves of different shapes and colours. They learnt how to colour using the brush.



COLOURING AND DRAWING (NUR & KG)

During their summer camp, the children are not only learning different shapes and patterns but they are also learning to draw various objects using different shapes and patterns.



CLAY MODELLING (NUR & KG)

Students can strengthen sensory skills as they learn to manipulate the material into different objects and shapes .It also helps to improve eye /hand coordination and build both gross and fine motor skills. Children learnt to create various articles in their clay modeling class.



FITNESS AND OUTDOOR GAMES (NUR & KG)

Outdoor games help the young children develop essential motor skills like coordination, agility and balance. Regular physical activity can help them build strong bones and muscles and control weight. Students of nursery and KG enjoyed different outdoor games along with a few fitness exercises in their first week of summer camp.



MEMORY GAME(1&2)

Memory games for kids are fun and challenging. Children of class 1 and 2 enjoyed creating and playing memory games. The classes started with several memory games like matching card games, I went shopping, action game etc. These games and activities require them to focus, think and remember, and these are all great skills that we all need to use every single day.



AEROBICS & ZUMBA (1&2)

Students of class-1 & 2 learnt zumba on the beats of music. The class always began with some warm up exercises and then continued with some zumba. The song & steps of zumba are making these kids move their body and have fun at the same time.



MAGIC WITH COTTON BALLS (1&2)

Cotton craft enhances children's creative abilities, their fine motor skills and strengthens their hand/finger grip. But mostly it's just fun. Children learnt and made bunnies, little chicks and pandas during their 'Magic with cotton balls' activity.

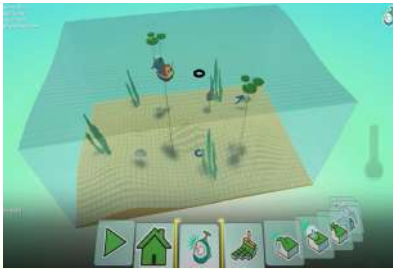
SCIENCE GREEKS (1&2)

Science experiments help the kids to gain knowledge of the tools and materials that are used in daily life and their qualities. Activities that are related to nature and science help the kids to develop correct thinking methods and also help in succeeding in school lessons. Children enjoyed learning about different experiments related to water, air, different forces and surface tension. In this week science geeks did several experiments related to water experiment, air experiment (Rocket Balloon), make a static powered dancing ghost, build a soap powered model boat and some water refraction experiments.



LITTLE TECHIE: KODU (1&2)

Children had a lot of fun in the first week of Computer Summer Camp. They learnt brush , play game, hills, water and object tool of Kodu Game Lab. They made different Terrain and paint the terrain with different objects .

TUPITUBE (3-5)

Calligraphy is the art of beautiful handwriting, often characterized by elegant, decorative, and stylized letterforms. Students enjoyed learning the basic strokes and letter formation of the faux calligraphy and brush pen calligraphy in the first week of Summer Camp. They even tried writing different words gracefully on a sheet of paper.

TIE & DYE(3-5)

Tie and dye, a method of fabric design, is a process where parts of a piece of fabric are pulled into tufts which are tied with strings or elastic bands.

Students enjoyed learning the basic techniques and different types of patterns of tying and dying in the first week of Summer Camp.



CULINARY DELIGHTS (3-5)

Students of Culinary Delights enjoyed making some mouthwatering snacks accompanied with tasty chutney too. They prepared samosa chaat, mexican wrap, kulcha matar and Bombay grilled sandwich. They learnt to chop various vegetables for the dishes and also developed organizational skills to maintain a suitable clean working counter in a kitchen.



THE MEANDERING YARN (3-5)

Embroidery is the craft of decorating fabric or other materials using a needle to apply thread or yarn. During the first week of the Summer Camp, The students of classes 3 to 5 learnt the basics of stitching and embroidery. They learnt to do various kinds of embroidery like running stitch, stem stitch, back stitch, chain stitch and satin stitch.



MAGICAL HANDS (3-5)

The students participating in the magical hands summer camp activity made some beautiful toys using simple machines like a lever, inclined plane and wheel and axle during this week. They learnt about these simple machines that we use in our day to day lives and also enjoyed making them.



NAMASTE YOGA (3-5)

Yoga helps students to develop a healthy body at the physical, mental and spiritual level. When combined with breathing and meditation, yoga acts as the best element to take care of our mind, body and soul. During the first few days of the summer camp, students of classes 3 to 5 learnt vajrasan, bhastika pranayam, bhujangasan, dhanushasan, tadasan and surya namaskar.



LAWN TENNIS CAMP (3-5)

Students of classes 3 to 5 learnt warm-up exercises and flexibility training, fast foot movement training, technical skills of tennis forehand, backhand shot and rally during summer camp.



BADMINTON CAMP (3-5)

Students of classes 3 to 5 learnt general warm-up exercises, agility and foot movement training, technical skills of badminton, forehand service, forehand lift shot and forehand toss during their sports camp.



BASKETBALL CAMP (3-5)

Students of classes 3-5 learnt warm-up exercise, dribbling variation, jump shot, layup shot and they also learnt to play a match during summer camp.



FOOTBALL CAMP (3-5)

Students of classes 3-5 learnt to receive and give the pass, running with football, passing interpassing, bullet shoot, general rules of football game and warm up and cool down, dribbling, ball control drills and to play small sided matches ,during their sports camp.



VOCAL MUSIC (3-5)

Students of classes 3 to 5 enjoyed the vocal music classes during the summer camp. They were taught raag, Bhopali during the first week of the camp.
