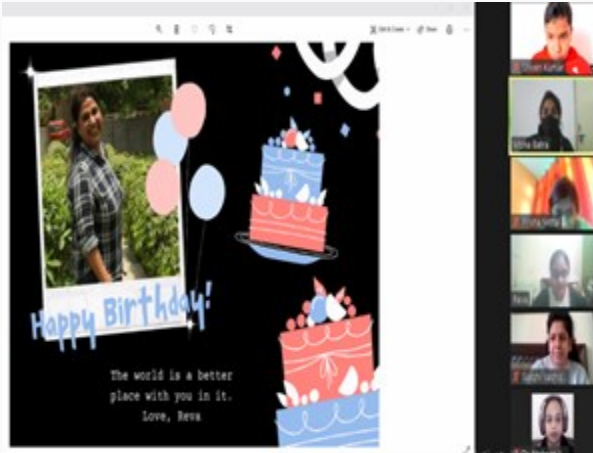

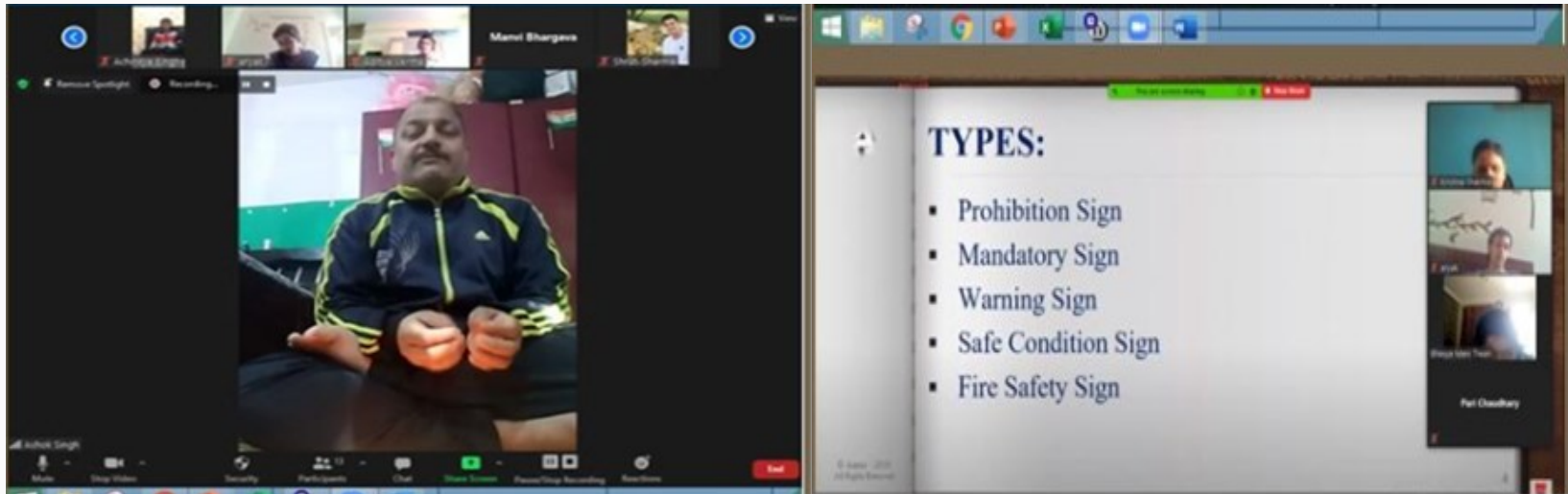
# INTERACT CLUB (VI- VIII)
