Math

Subtraction is useful for many activities of everyday life, like setting the table, making change at the supermarket, and playing some games. Addition and subtraction prepare children for learning about other math topics, including multiplication and division, in school. Class 2 students were introduced to the Chapter: Subtraction, where they learnt subtraction using number line and backward counting. They also revised the tables from 2 to 5.

- Subtraction Explanation:** A box explaining that in the subtraction problem $7 - 3 = 4$, the number 7 is the minuend, the number 3 is the subtrahend, and the number 4 is the difference.

Students of class 3 were introduced to the poem of the month 'Friend'. They revised the poems 'My Hat is Full of Rabbits' and 'My Doggy Ate My Essay'. They even revised the difficult words from the months of April and May. They did the reader Gulliver Stories. The grammatical concept of singular and plural was revised too along with some written exercises. The students wrote a paragraph on 'My favourite Holiday Activity' too.





The Students of Class 3 revised the concepts covered before the vacation. They solved worksheets based on 3-digit addition of numbers. The students were also told to revise and write the multiplication tables from 2 to 10. The concept of addition using expanded form was introduced in the class. Table dodging was done at the beginning of the class everyday of the week to help them learn the tables.





ENVIRONMENTAL SCIENCE

The students of grade 4 revised the chapter **INDO GANGETIC PLAINS** in the class. They were also shown ppt and videos related to the topics that they revised in the class. Lesson- Animals was also introduced in the class. Some interesting videos related to the animals were also shown to the students in the class.

ENVIRONMENTAL SCIENCE

The students of grade 5 were introduced to the various organ systems of the body with special focus to the skeletal and muscular systems with the introduction of L-18: The Human Skeletal System. The functions of the system along with the joints and their types were discussed in the class. Students were excited to learn about the different functions and structure of the skull, rib cage, vertebral column and the limbs. Videos related to the joints and types of muscles were also shown in the class.





Children enjoy dance so students of class 5 learnt basic techniques for taking circles. They also learnt different floor steps on drum beats and music.



ART CLASS (3-4)

Students of class 3 & 4 learned the technique of dot painting that is produced by repeated imprints of a paint covered brush, dotting stick or other implement onto the surface of the painting and that in doing so, there are recognisable 'dot' marks on the art file.



COMPUTER (4-5)

Students of Grade 4 were taught the MS-Word in which they did inserting, Formatting and Editing of table. Students of Grade 5 did MS-PowerPoint in which they learnt to add Gif and screenshot in slides. Students made beautiful presentation on the topic Summer Vacation.



CLASS TEACHER PERIOD (3-5)

The students of classes 3-5 were welcome back after the refreshing summer break with a special assembly conducted by the teachers. Students of classes 3-5 had theme-based Enrichment periods on Monday, Tuesday and Thursday. The topic for the Circle Time on Monday was Gratitude. The importance of showing gratitude to helpers was discussed with the students. Related ppts and videos were shown too. Tuesday's Value Education session was on Responsibilities.
