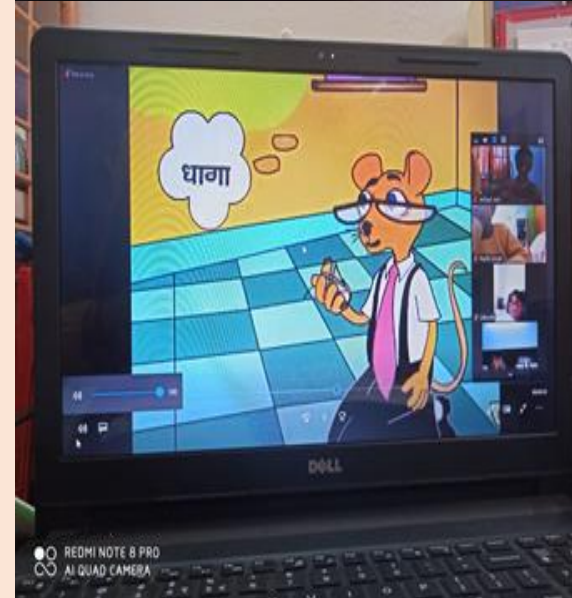
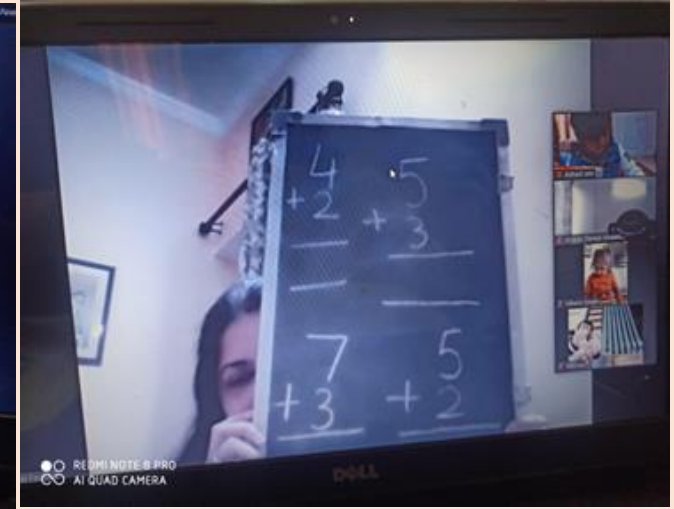
Reading Scheme -Reading practice of sight words of colours and small sentences with the sight words were done. Students enjoyed reading small sentences.



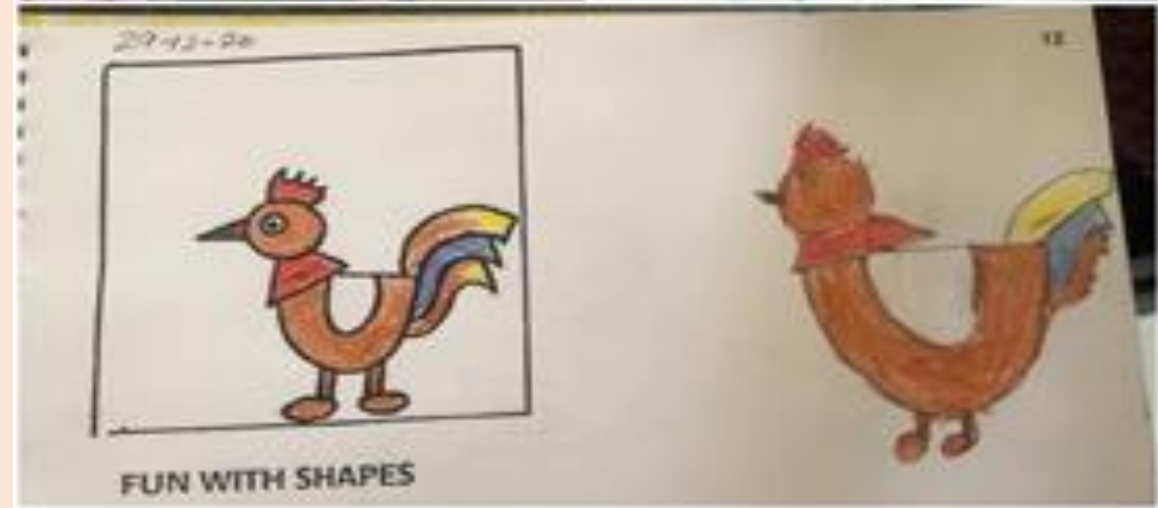


Maths -Revision of simple addition was done in the class. Written practice of 160-170 was also done.

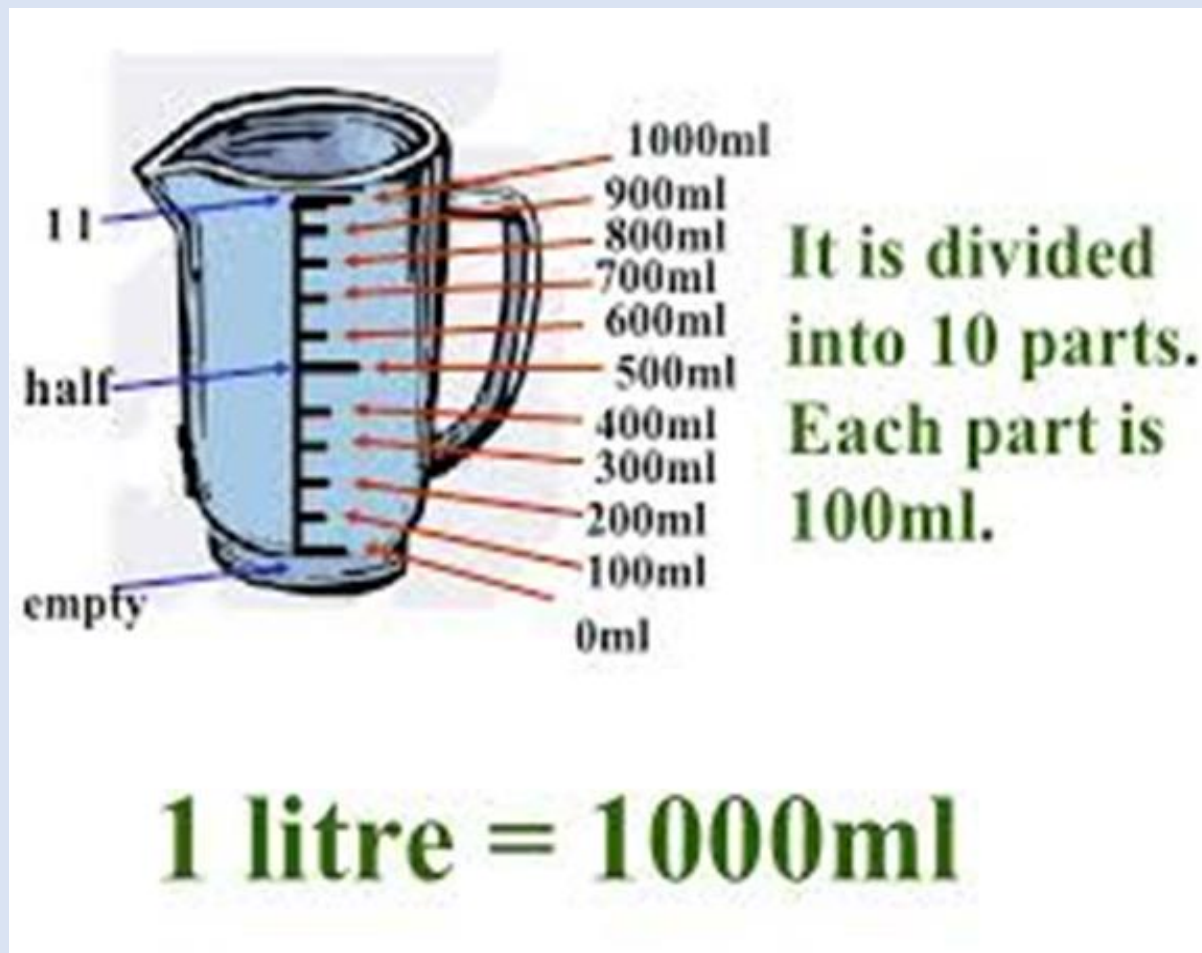
VOCAL MUSIC CLASS

ENVIRONMENTAL SCIENCE

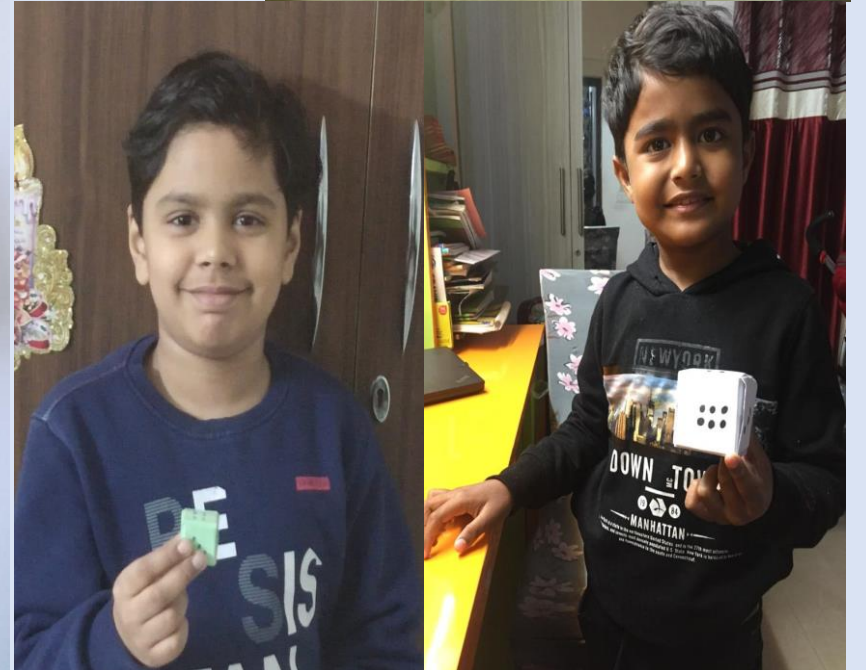
Maps are really useful to us. Direction is the particular way you have to go to get from one place to another. Students of class 2 had their EVS activity in which they learnt to design a map.





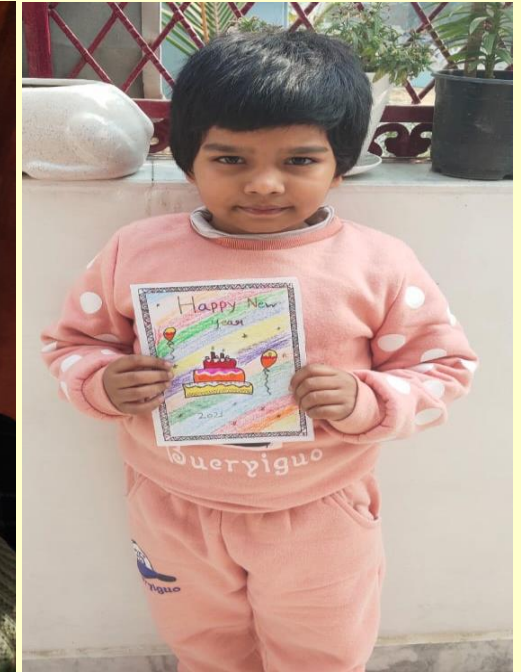
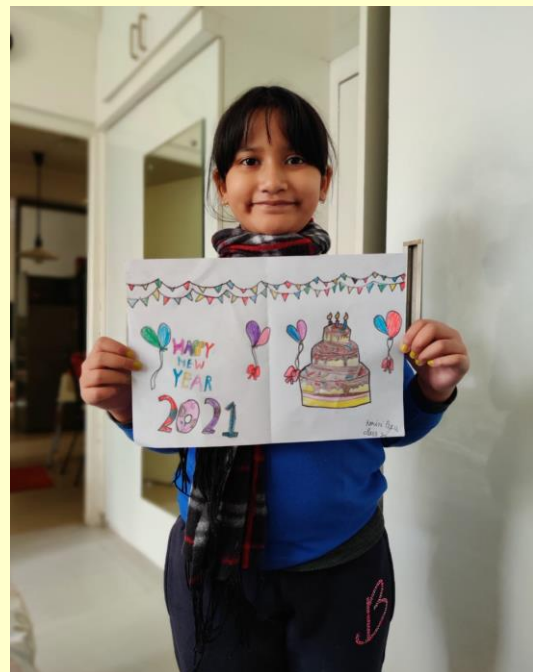
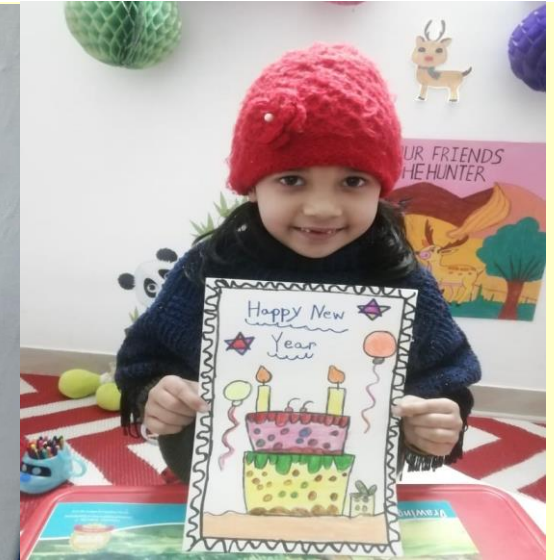

Students of class 2D enjoyed making winter scenes of the hill area. They created beautifully snowman, snow, mountains, snow house, people wearing warm clothes etc.



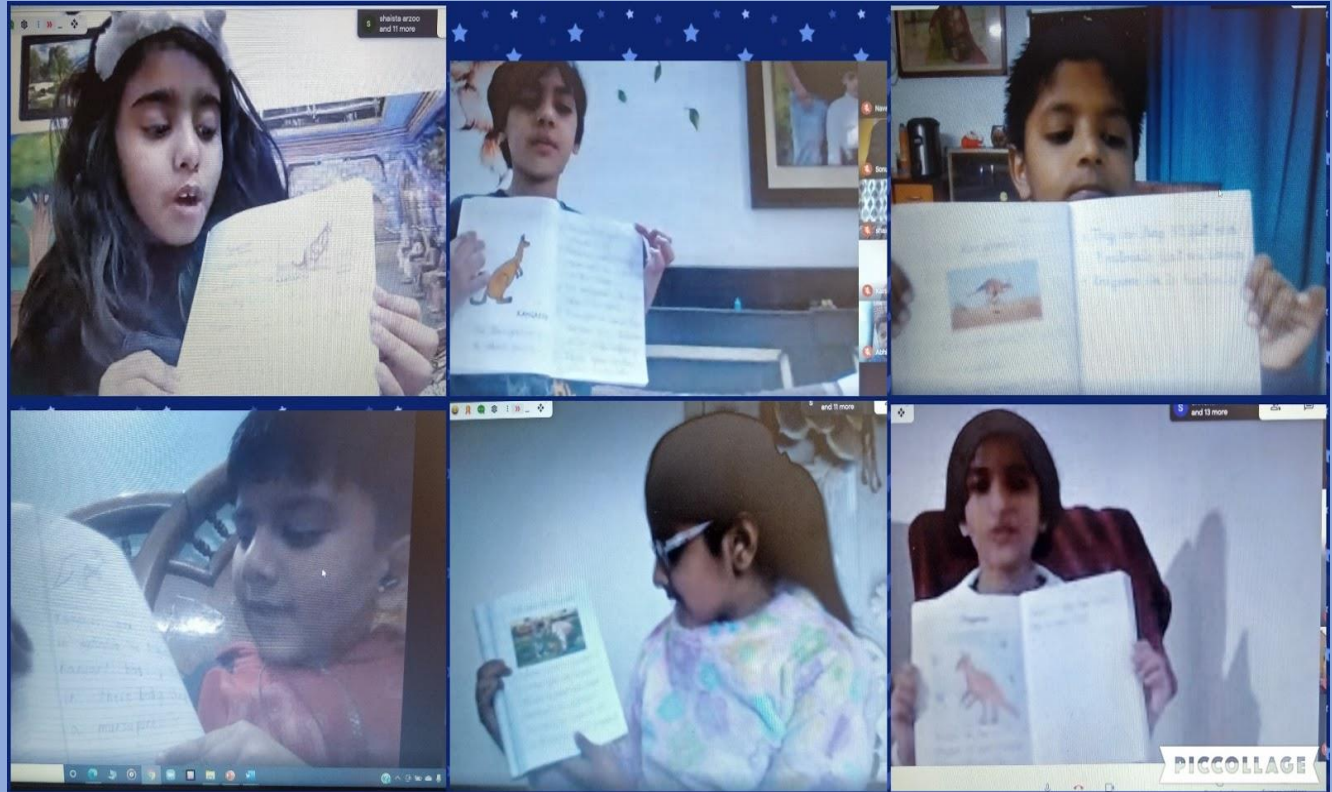
SPECIAL EVENING ART CLASS

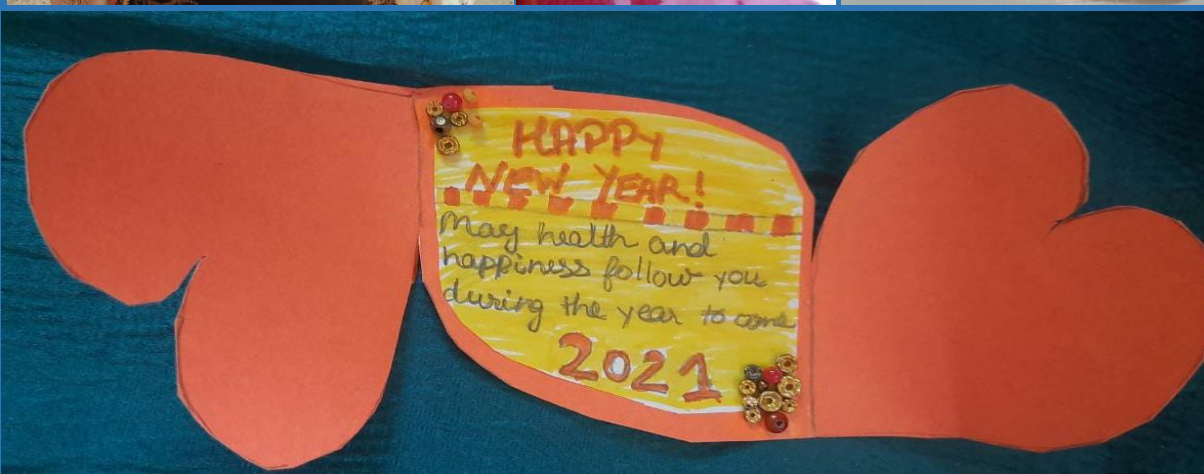
Students of class 4 studied the concept of Shuddh-Ashuddh and did few exercises based on this topic in their Hindi Workbook.

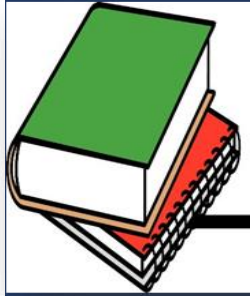




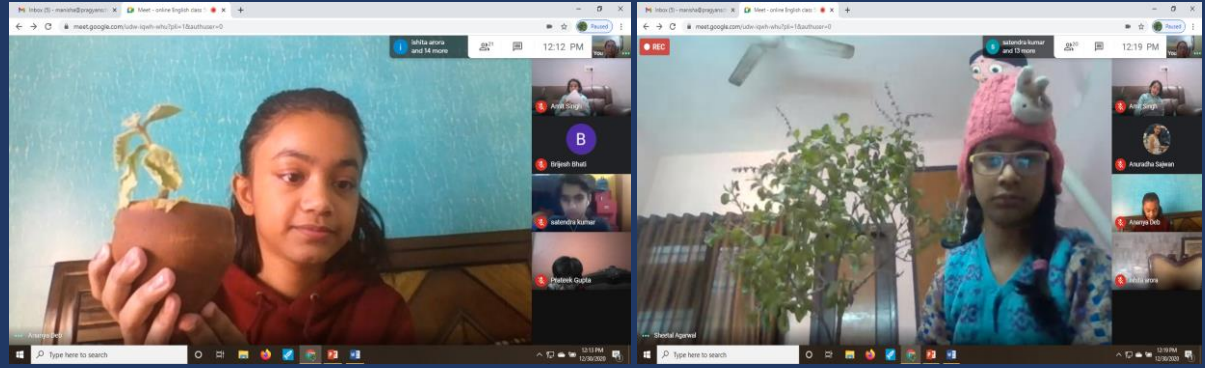
Grade 4 ART CLASS

Students of classes 4 A, B, C made beautiful greeting cards for the new year. They loved doing this activity taught to them through step by step instructions.

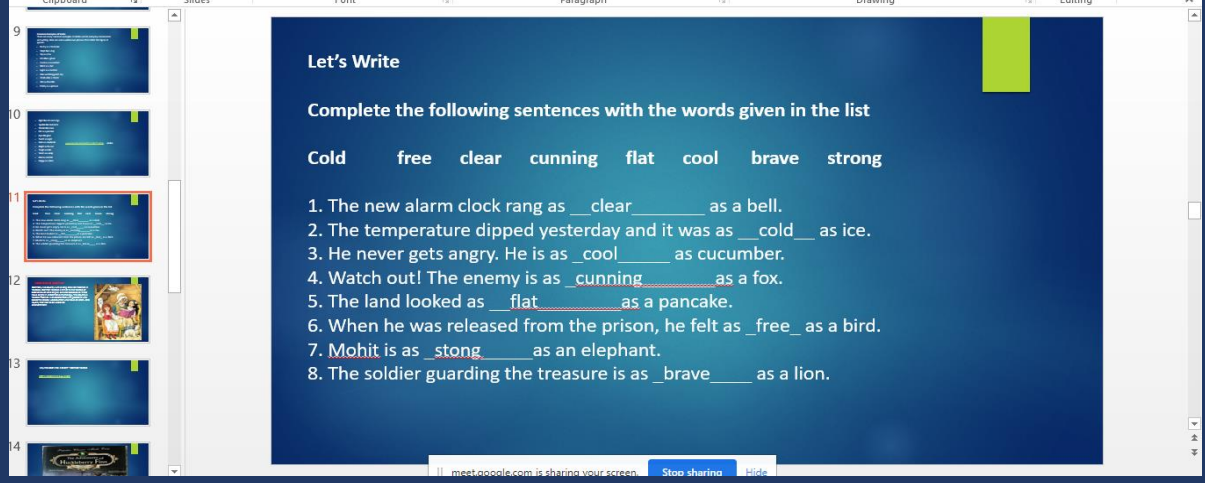
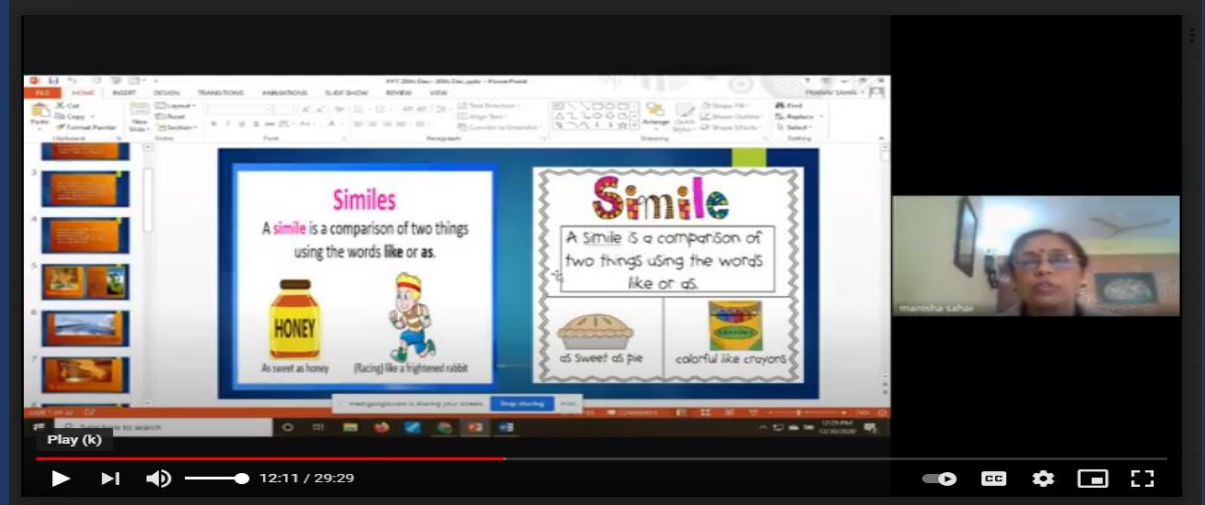

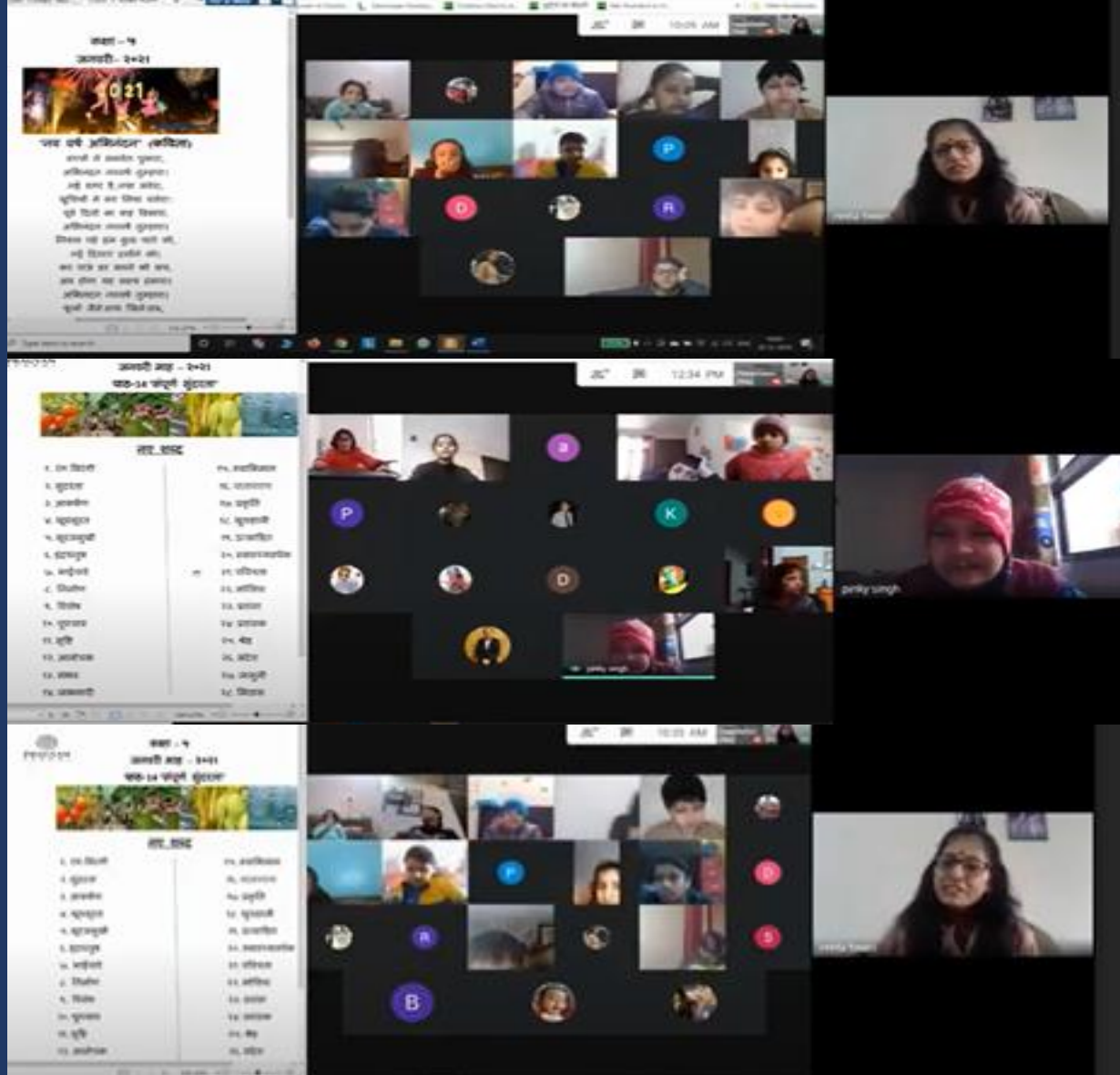

L-14: Religious and Social Reformers

Raja Ram Mohan Roy

- He studied various languages including Persian, Arabic, Sanskrit and English.
- He published his first book Tohfat-ul-Mohiddin in 1803, in which he stated that all religions preached the worship of one god.
- He strongly criticised idol worship and meaningless religious rituals.
- He was against the barriers of caste divisions and social evils, such as sati, and propagated widow remarriage.
- As a result, the British Government passed a law abolishing sati in 1829.

- He was a scholar and believed in the authority of the Vedas.
- He also established gurukuls to impart Vedic education.
- He strongly disapproved rituals such as idol-worship, the caste system, untouchability, child marriages and animal sacrifices.

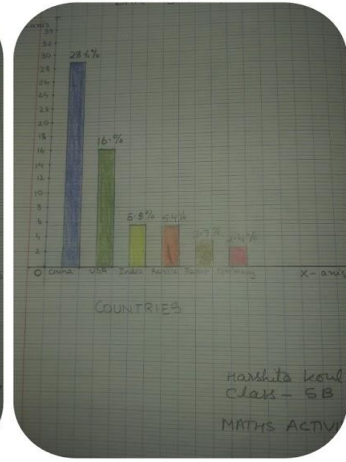

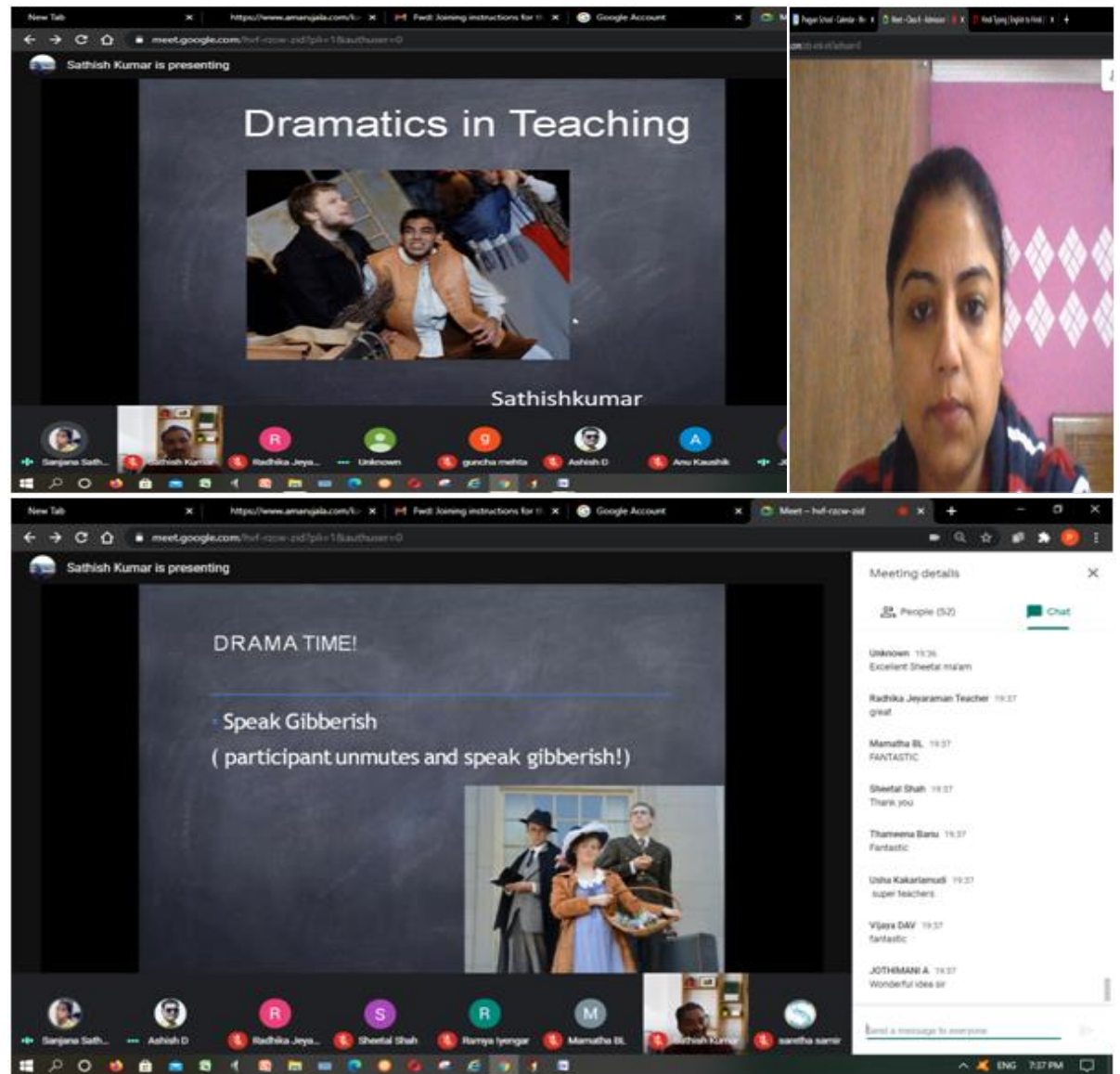
SPECIAL EVENING ART CLASS
