

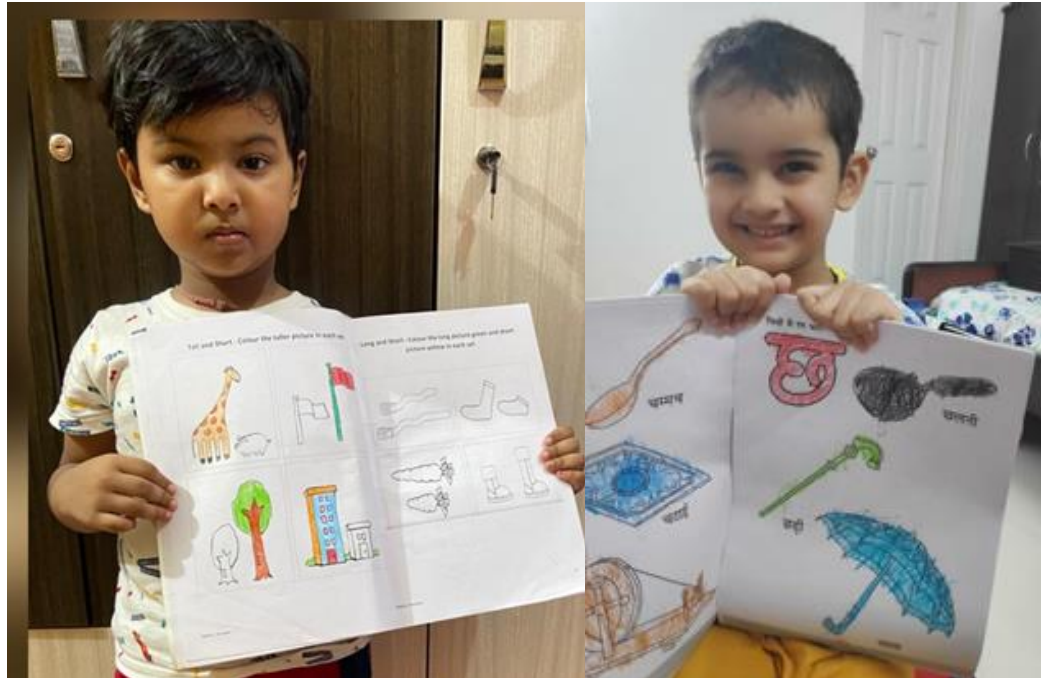

KINDERGARTEN



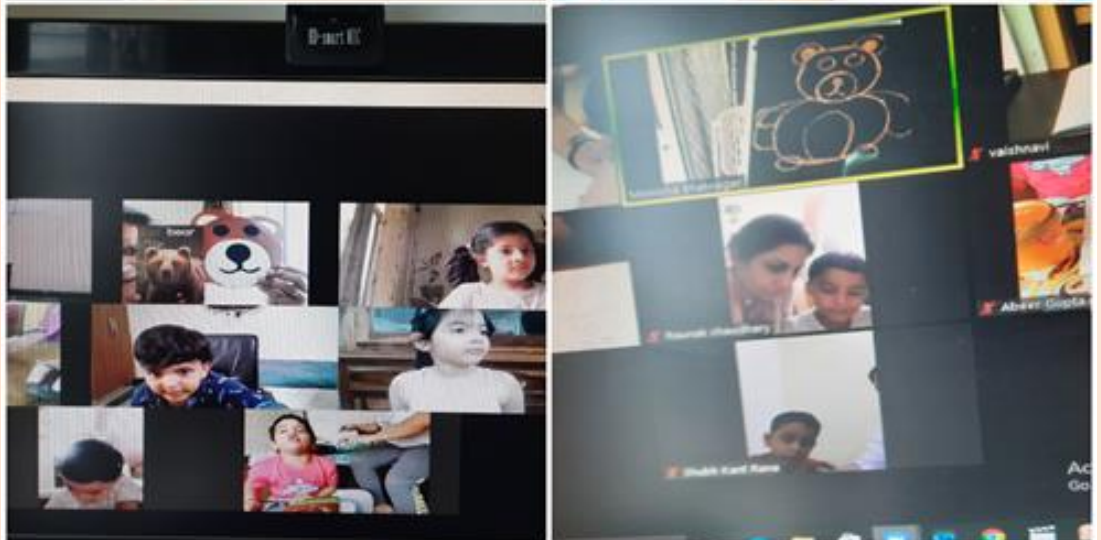

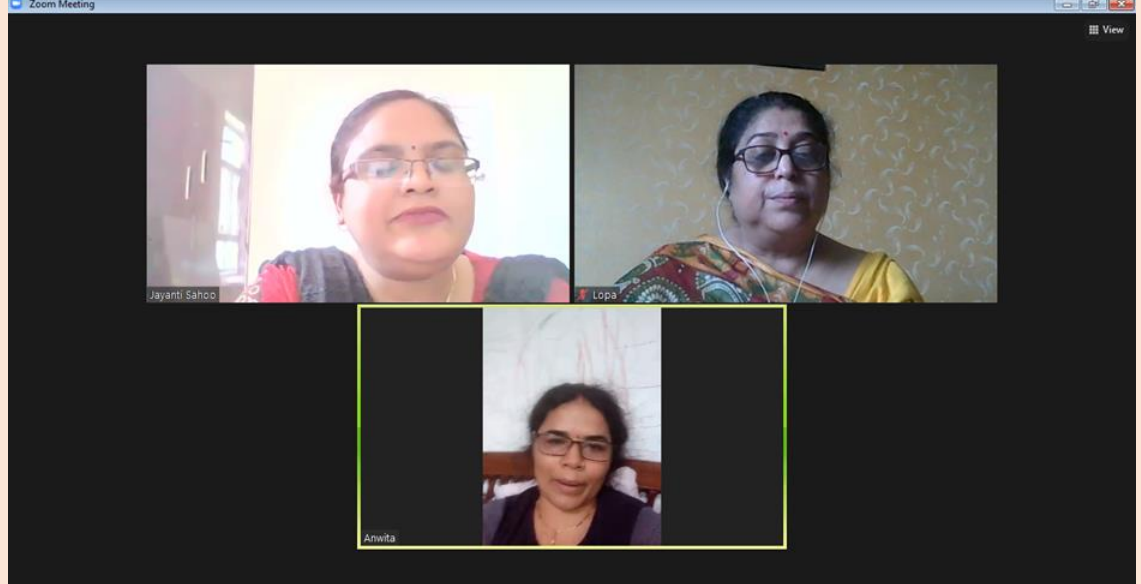
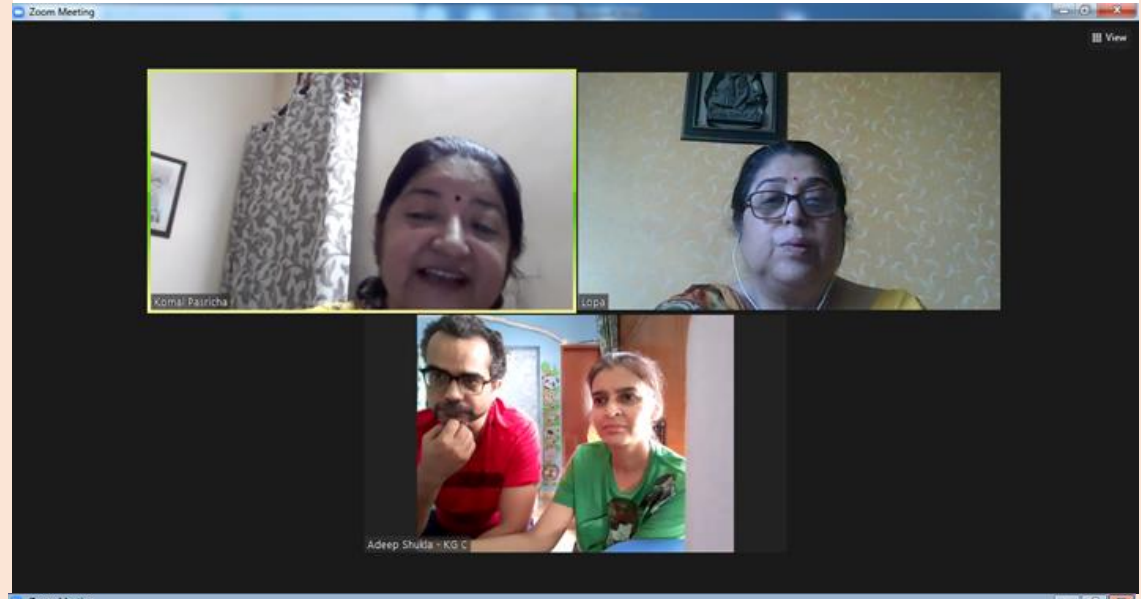

She also likes to chat and to play chess.

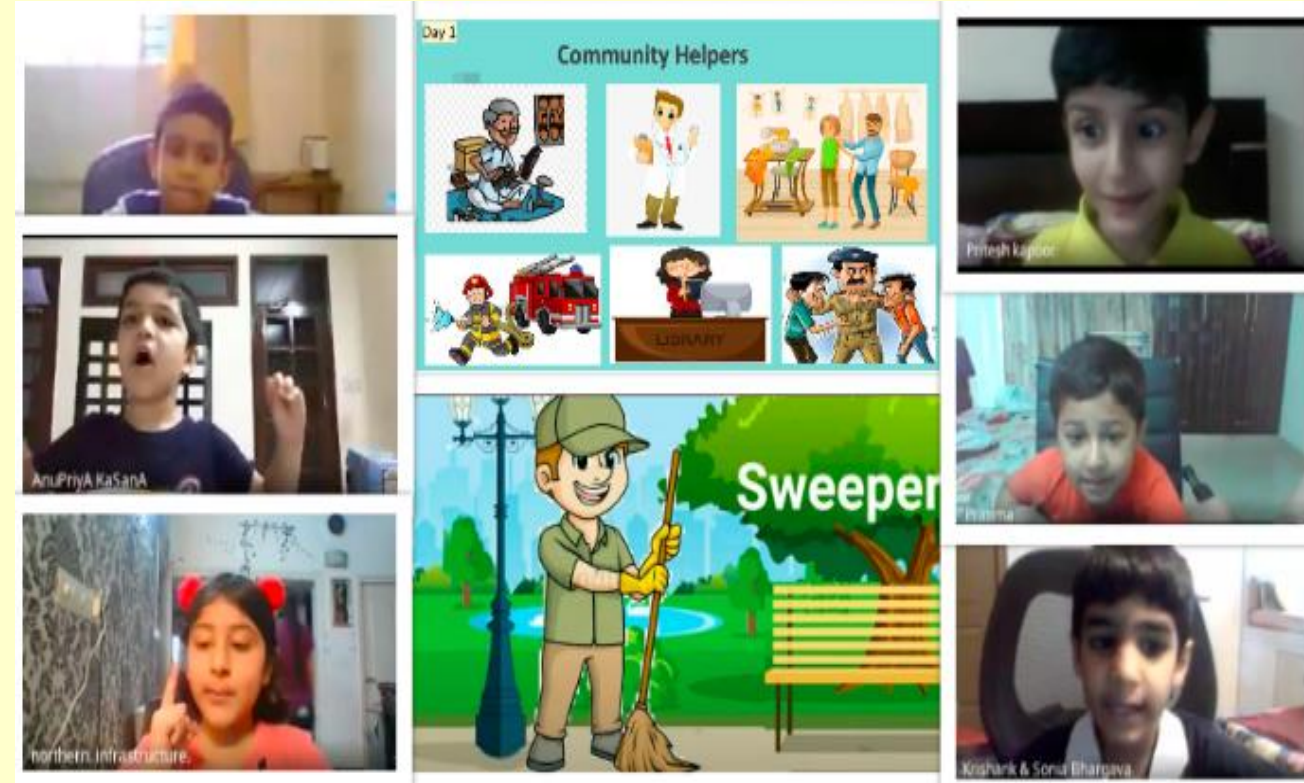

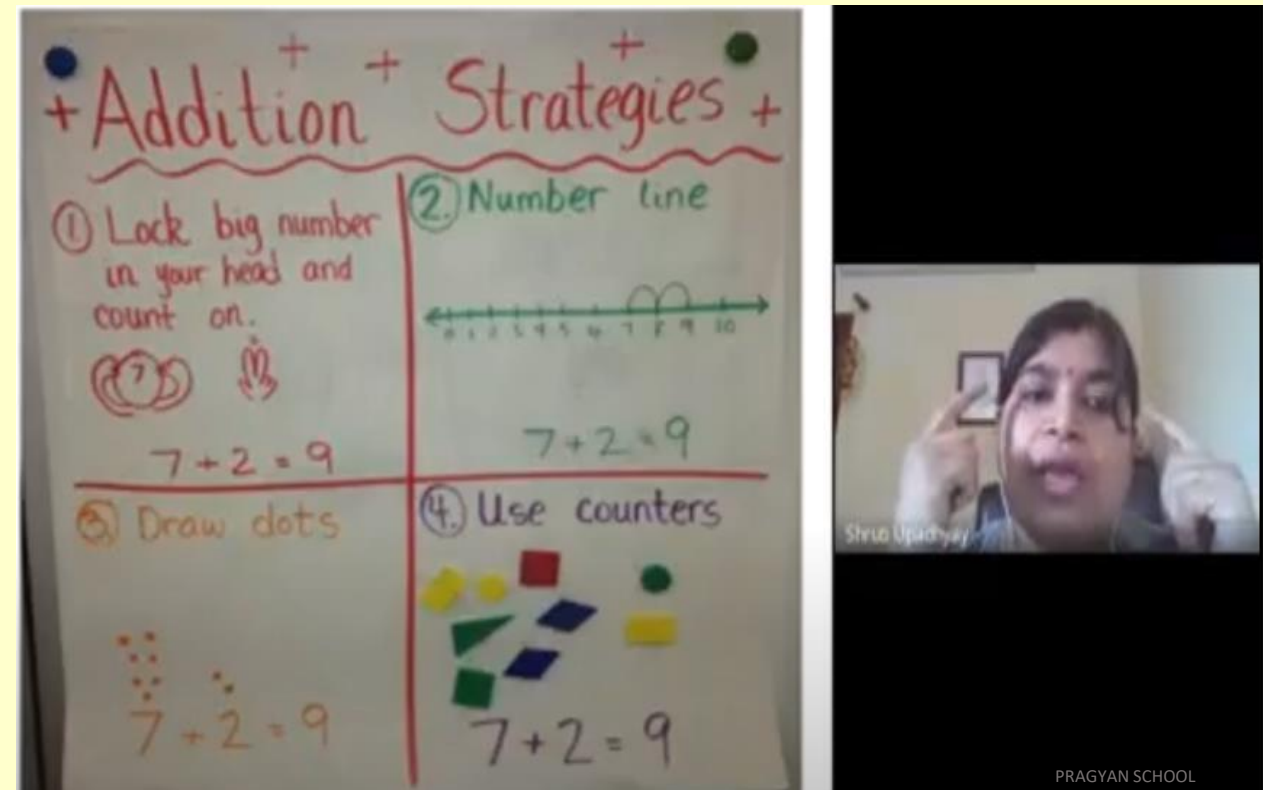
ENVIRONMENTAL SCIENCE

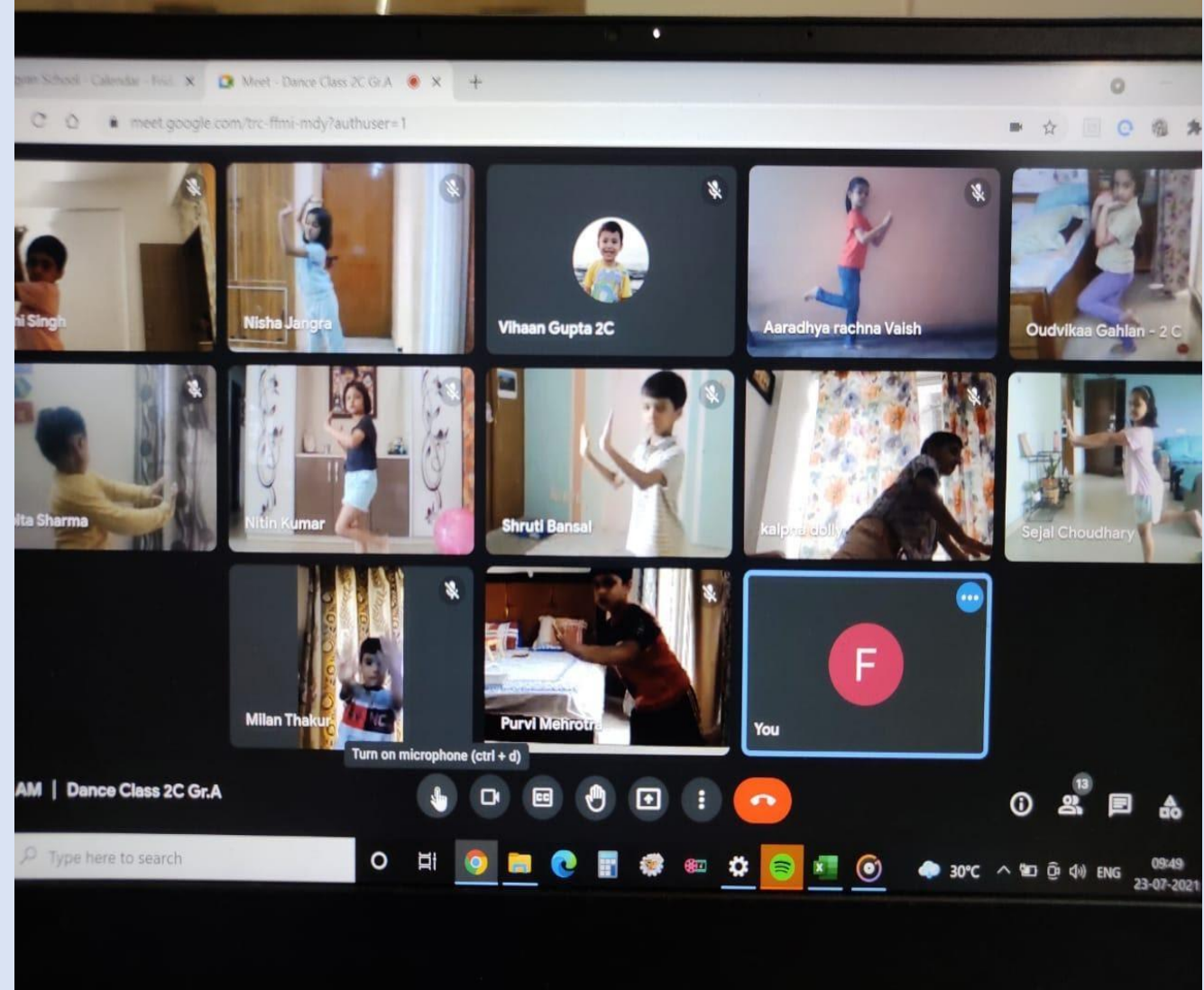

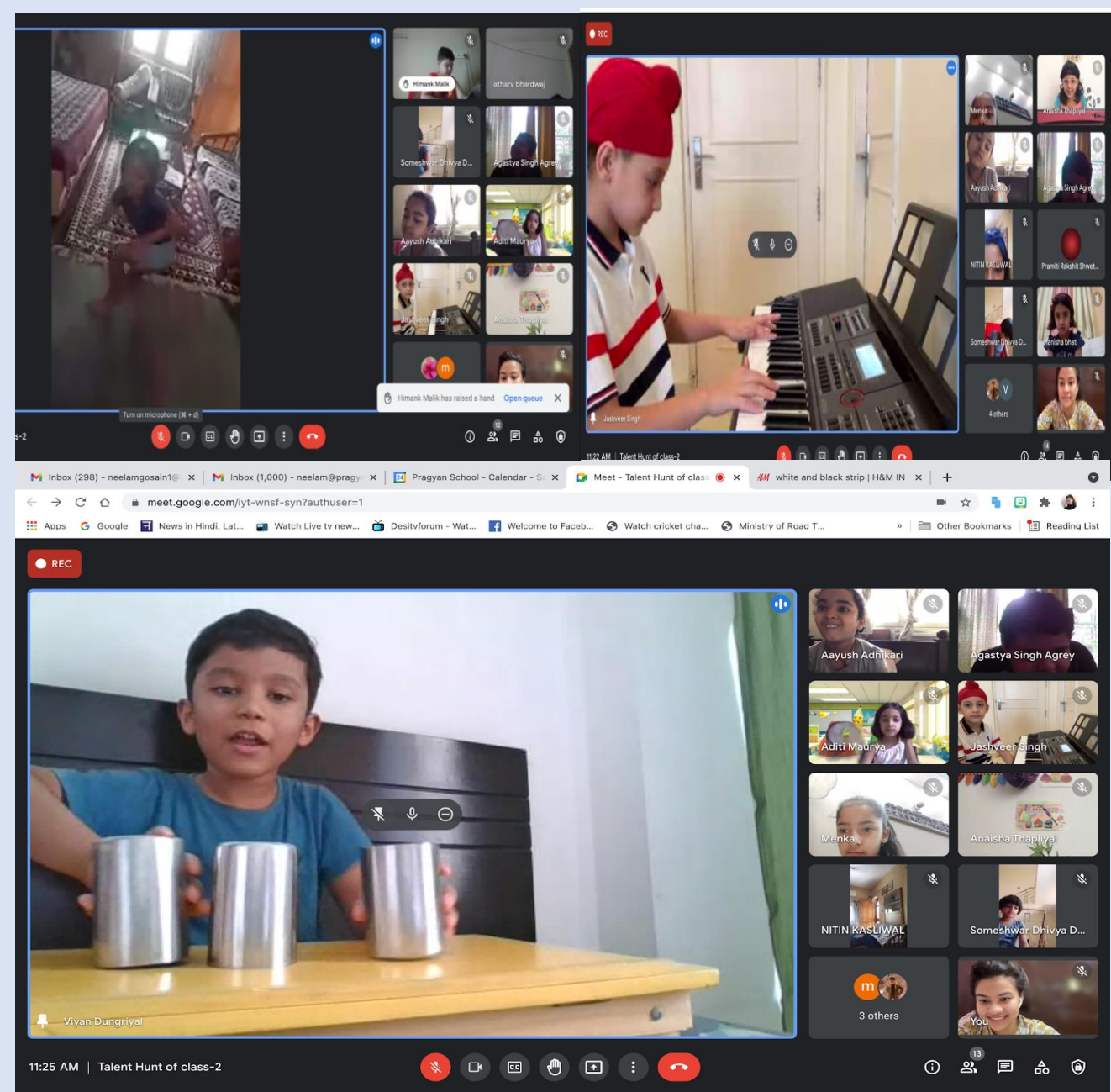


Students of class 2 learnt pirouettes with counts and practiced continuous circles. They also revised dance steps and learnt four more steps of patriotic theme.

Students of class 1 and 2 learned to make paper craft and Cardboard wall hanging with dal and rice during their online Art and craft period.



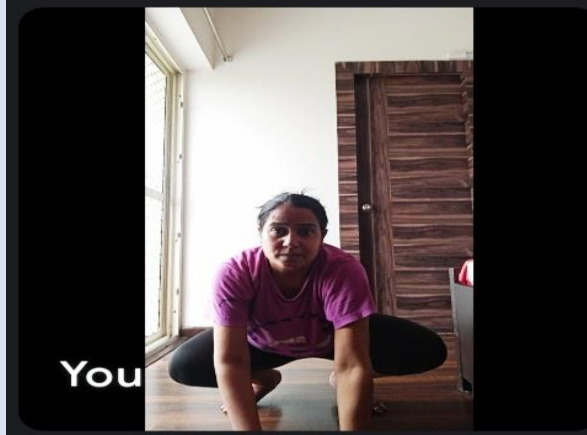
PHYSICAL FITNESS(1&2)

- Footnote**: Make sure your speech is properly punctuated. "Here you are, I said." "Yes, you are a little bit late!" I said.

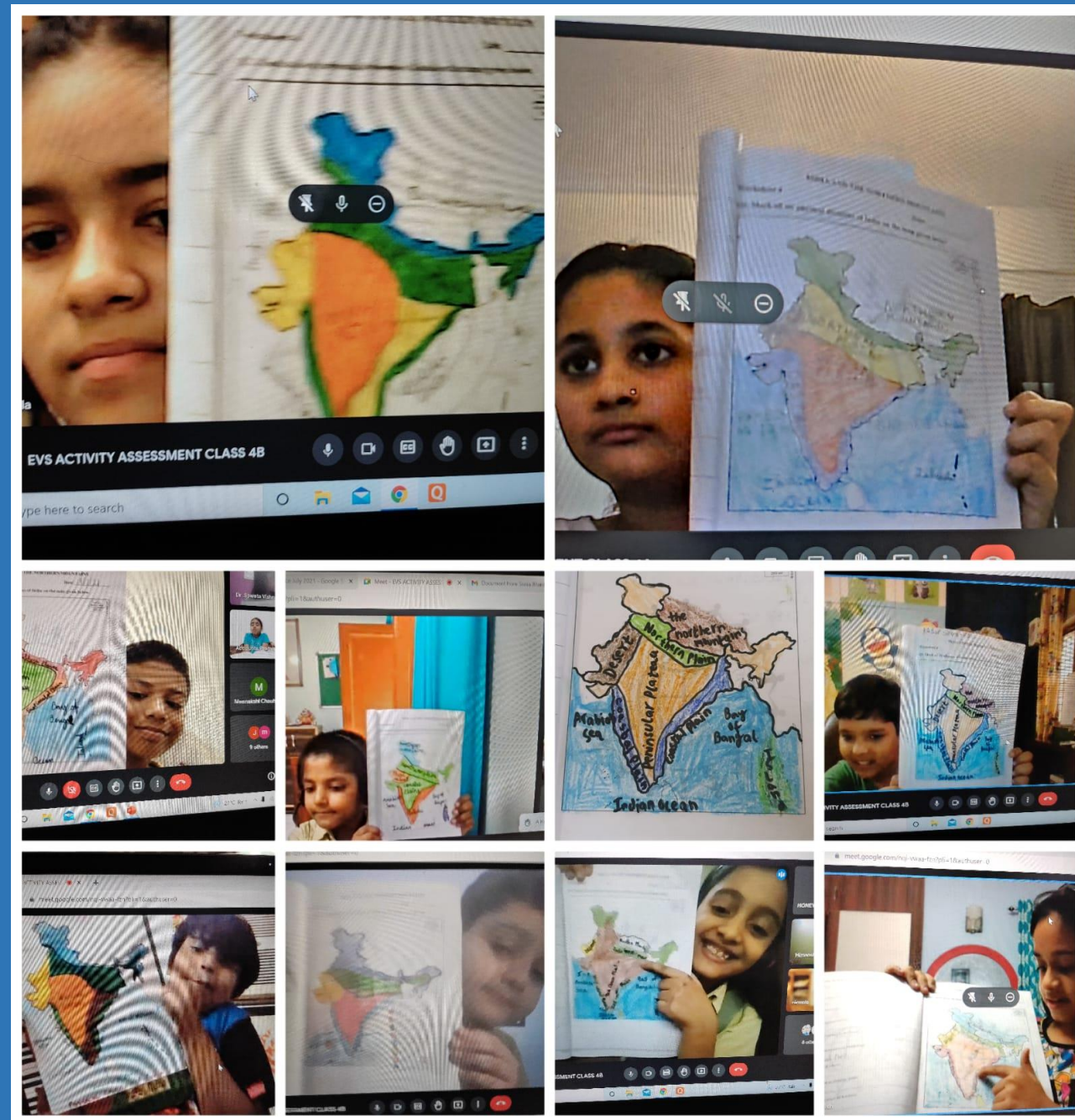

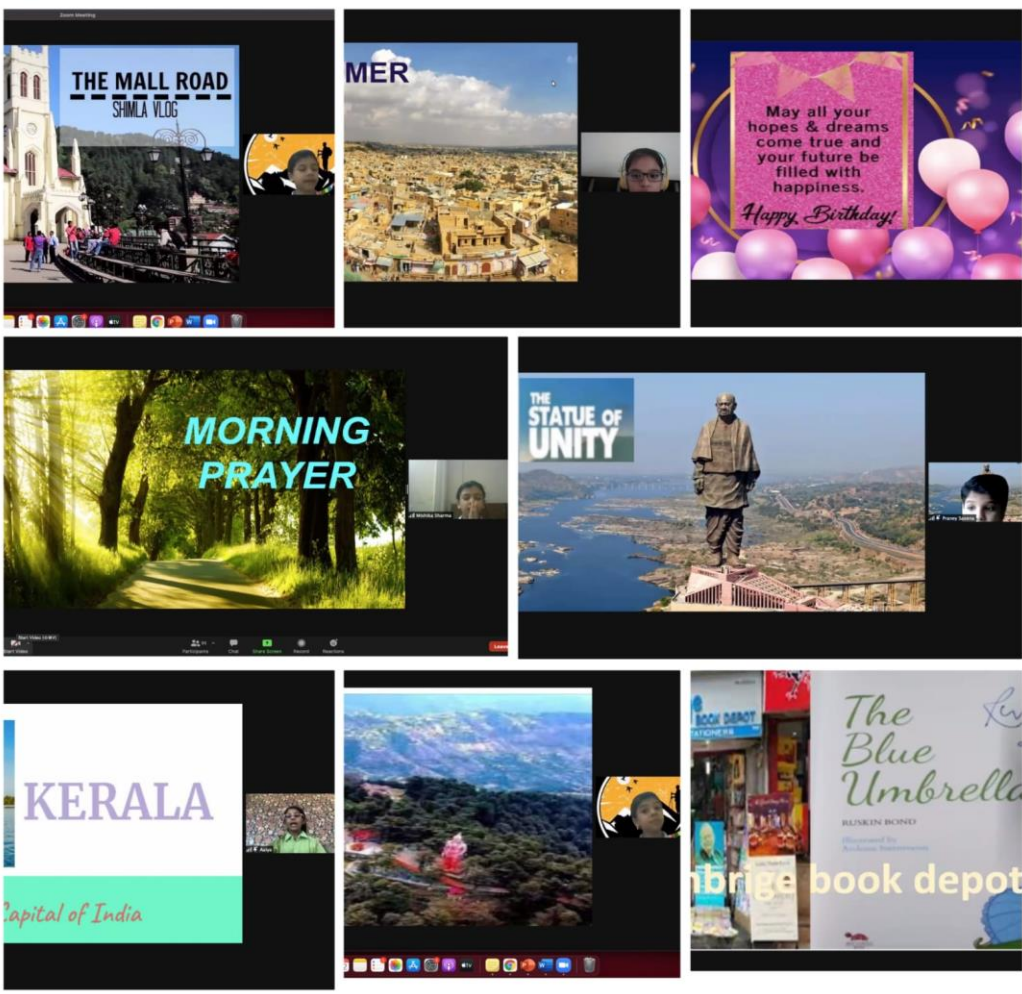


ENVIRONMENTAL SCIENCE

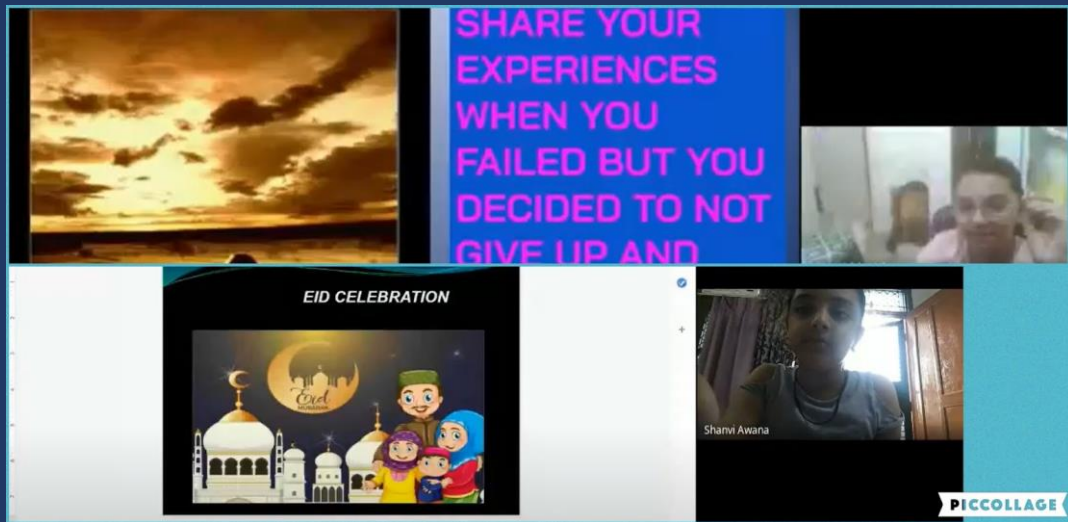
ASSEMBLY- TOURISM(5B)

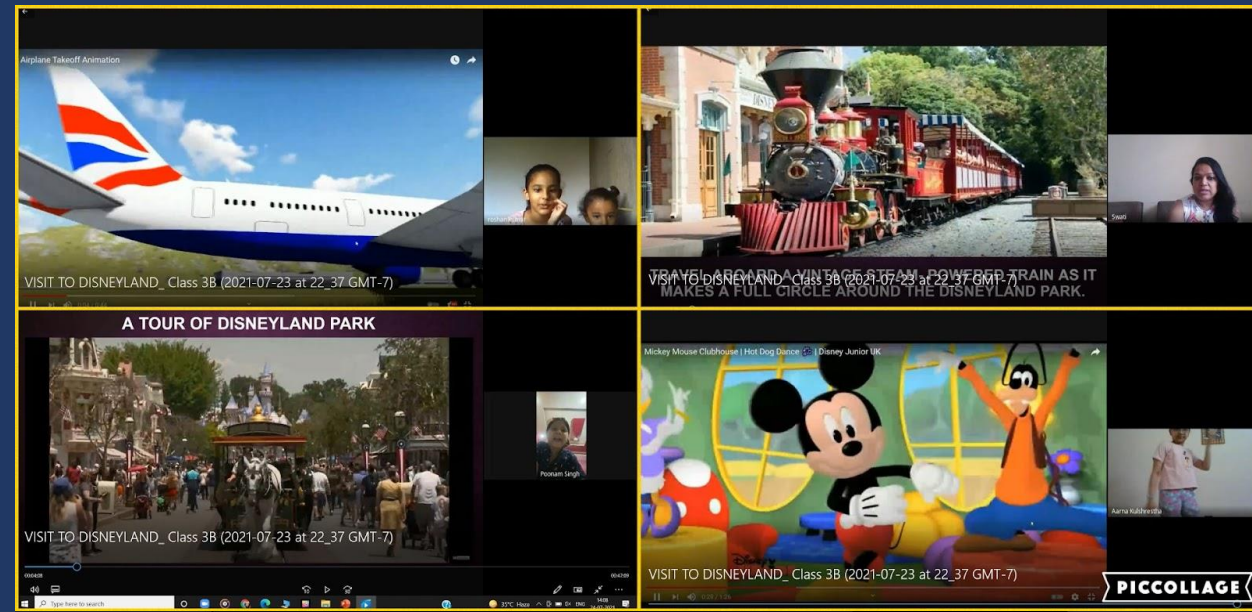
CLASS TEACHER PERIOD

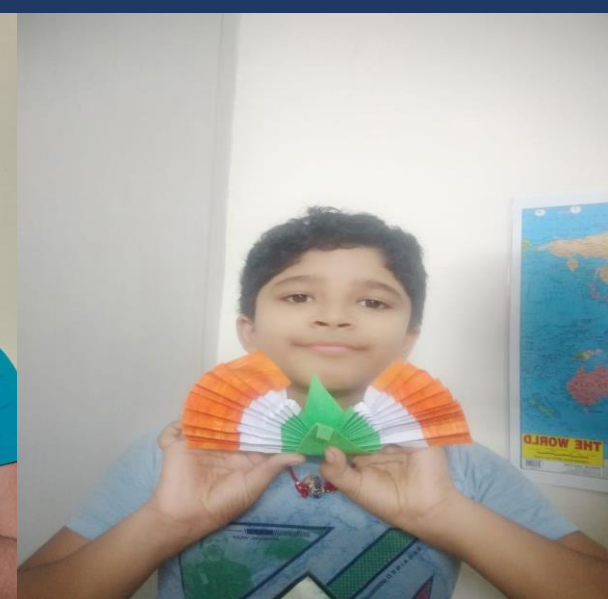
COLLABORATIVE SESSION- VIRTUAL TOUR

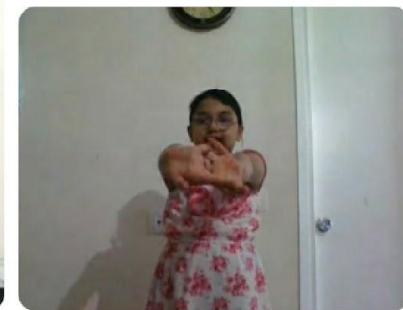
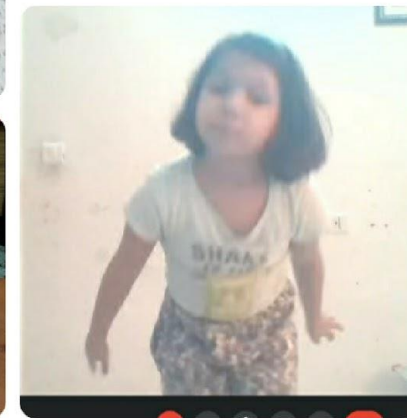
ART AND CRAFT (3- 5)

Students of classes 3 to 5 learnt to make pinwheels and beautiful cards for Independence Day during their art class.



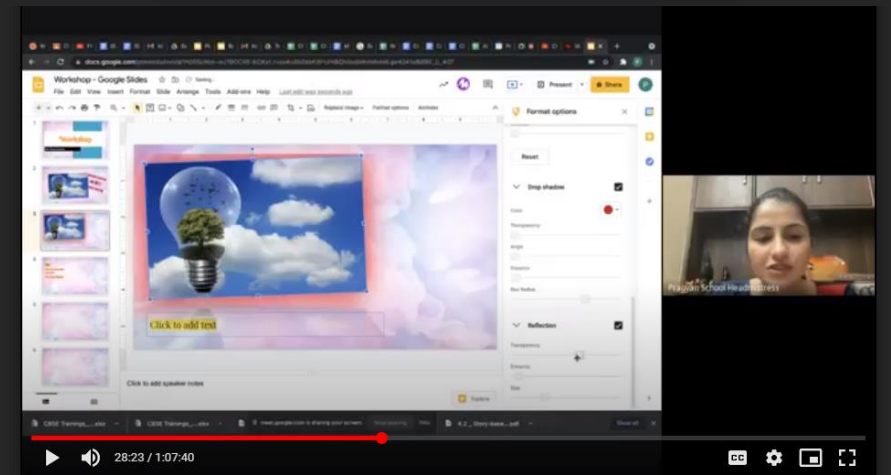
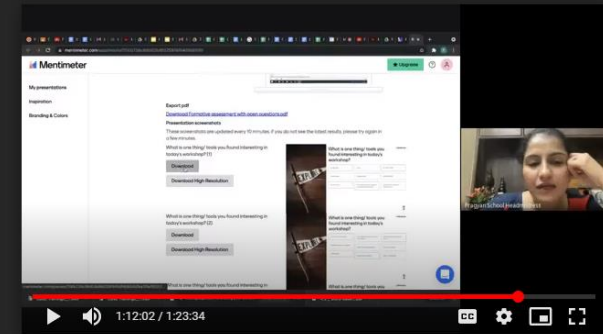
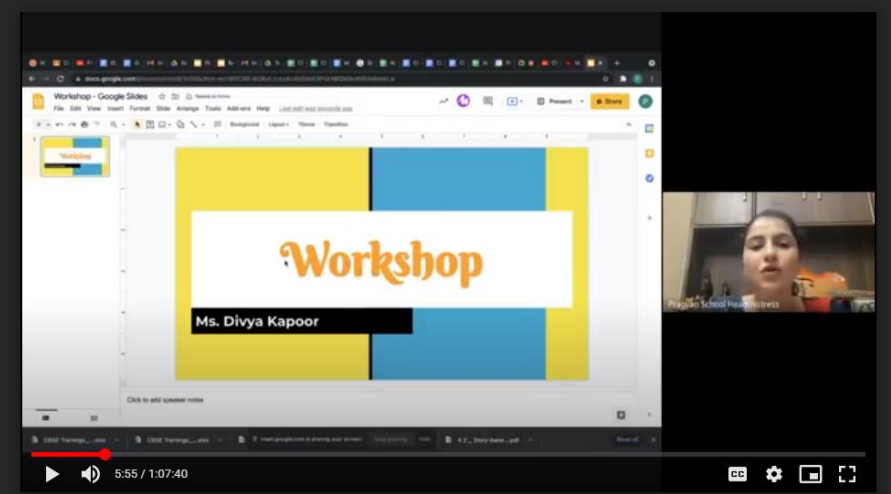

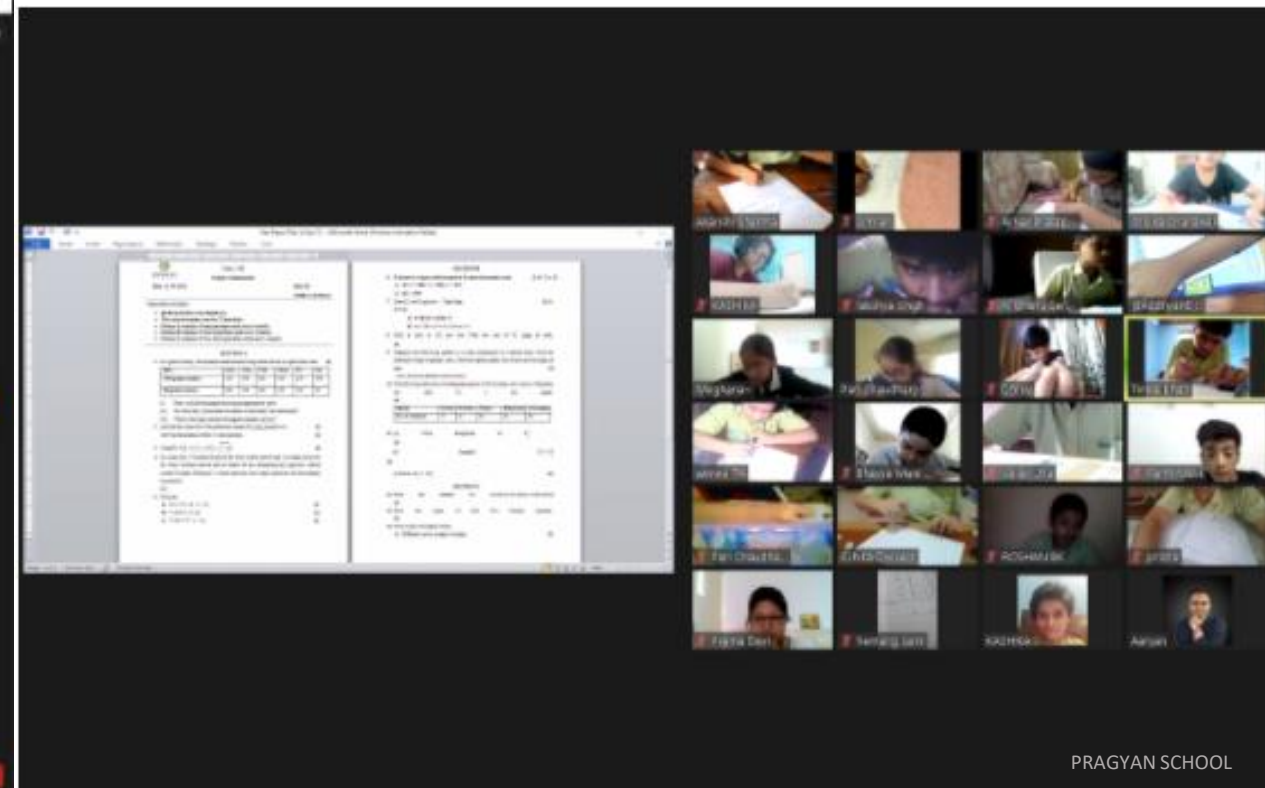
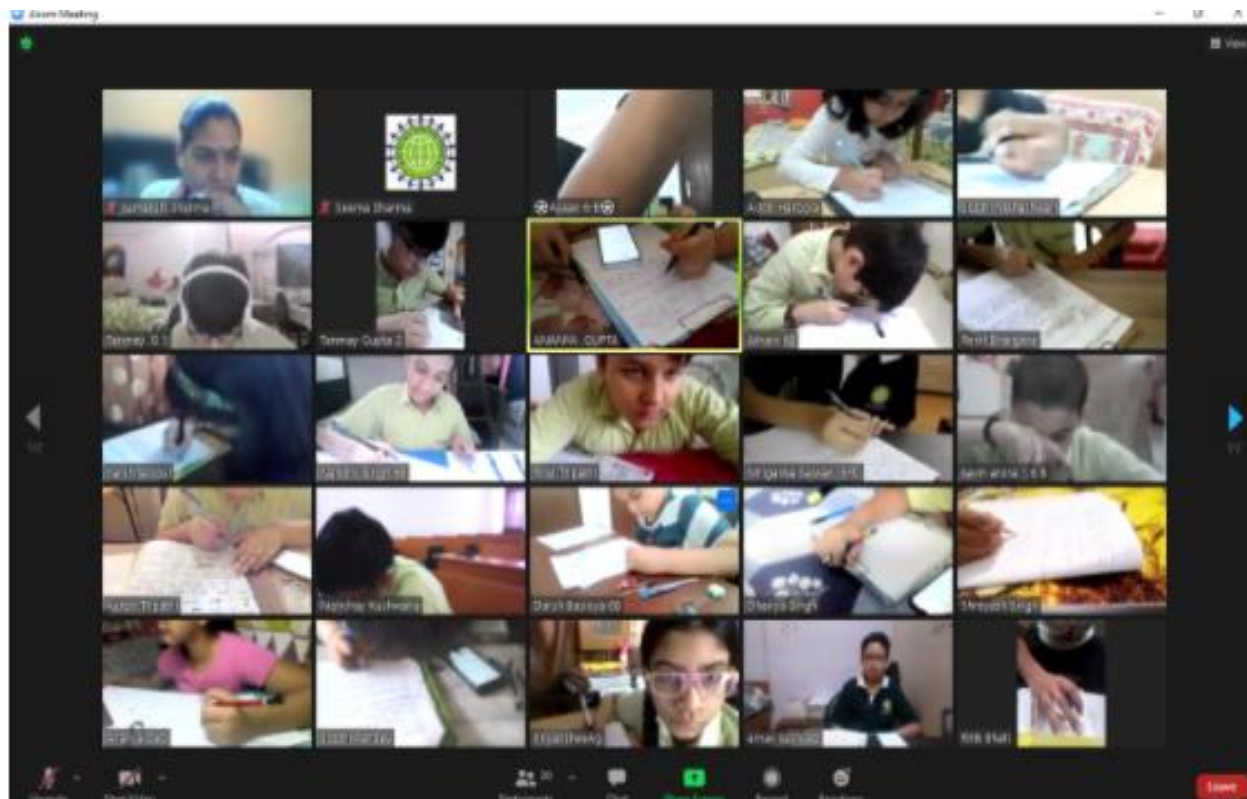
SENIOR WEEKLY CIRCULAR CLASS VI-XII
