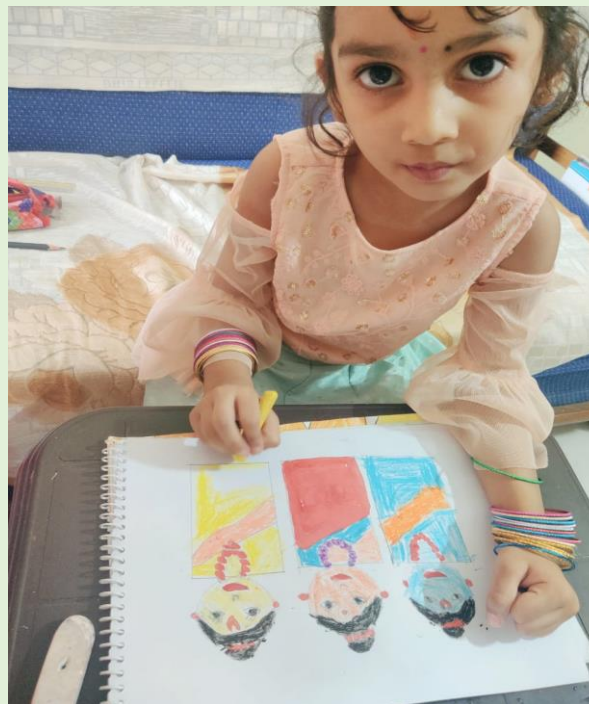
English –Introduction of letter G was done by doing worksheets and picture reading was also done where students can identify the pictures related to the letter G.

Hindi - Introduction of vyanjan ‘ढ’ was done by doing the picture reading.

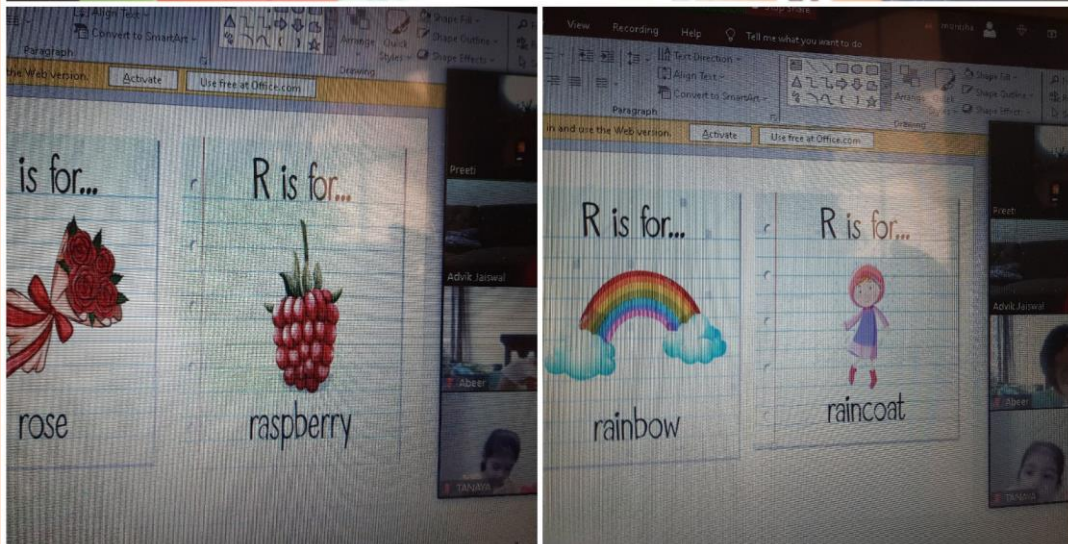
Environmental Science- Students enjoyed the craft work of woodpecker.

They were also made aware of the nine avatars of Devi Durga and the importance of Navratri through a video.

Fifth Day: Goddess Skandmata

Since Goddess Durga is also the mother of Lord Kartikeya, she is known as Skandmata. Goddess Skandmata is the deity of the solar system.

Navratri festival is dedicated to worshipping the nine forms of Goddess Durga.

How it is celebrated in different states

Navratri is celebrated differently in various parts of the Indian cultural sphere.

- In the eastern part of India, in Kolkata, Navratri is mainly celebrated as Durga Puja. The beautifully decorated idols are brought home.
- The idol is then decorated with flowers, clothes, jewellery, red vermilion and various sweets are kept in front of the Goddess.
- Navratri in Gujarat means a nine-night festival full of dance, music, and a lot of fun! The dance form that is performed during Navratri is Ras Garba.

Dussehra:

Dussehra or Vijaydashami is an important Hindu festival which signifies the victory of good over evil. This annual festival is celebrated

What is Navratri?

Navratri is a Hindu festival which is dedicated to worshipping the nine forms of goddess Durga. The word Navratri is derived from two Sanskrit words—'nava' meaning nine and 'ratri' meaning night.

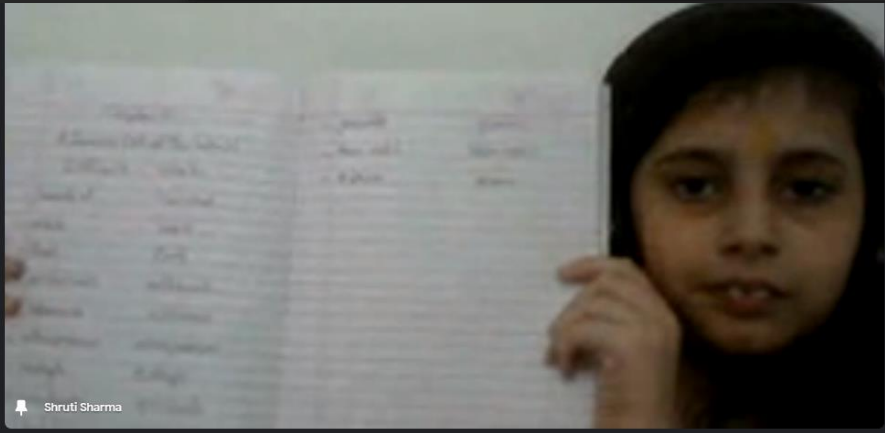

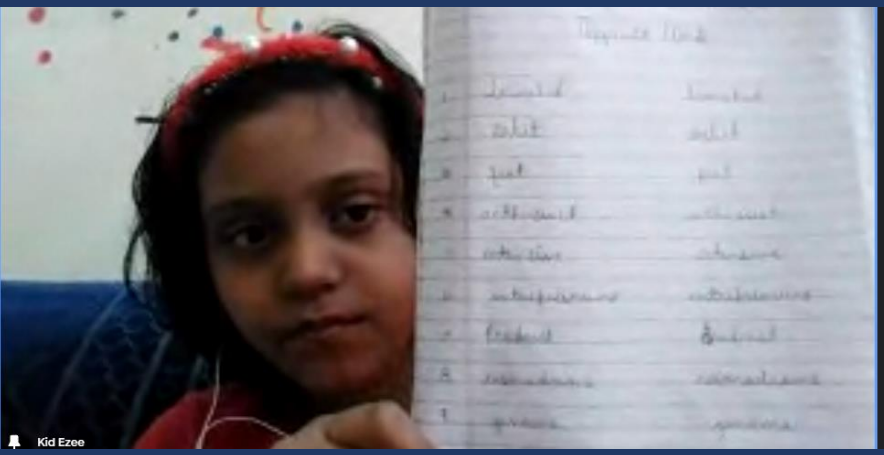

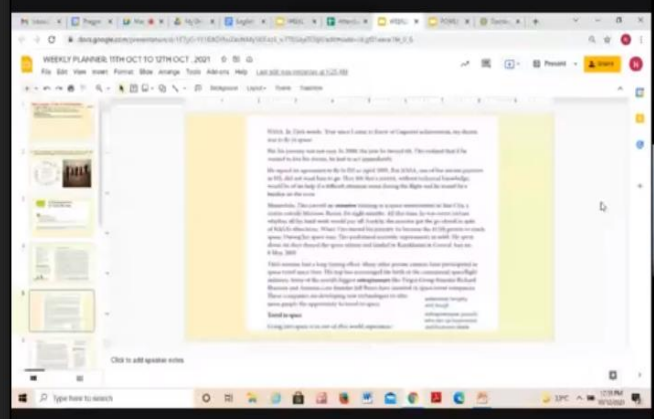
