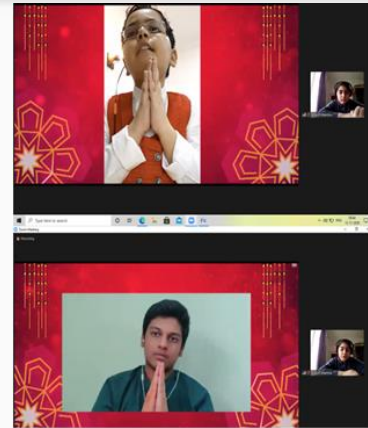

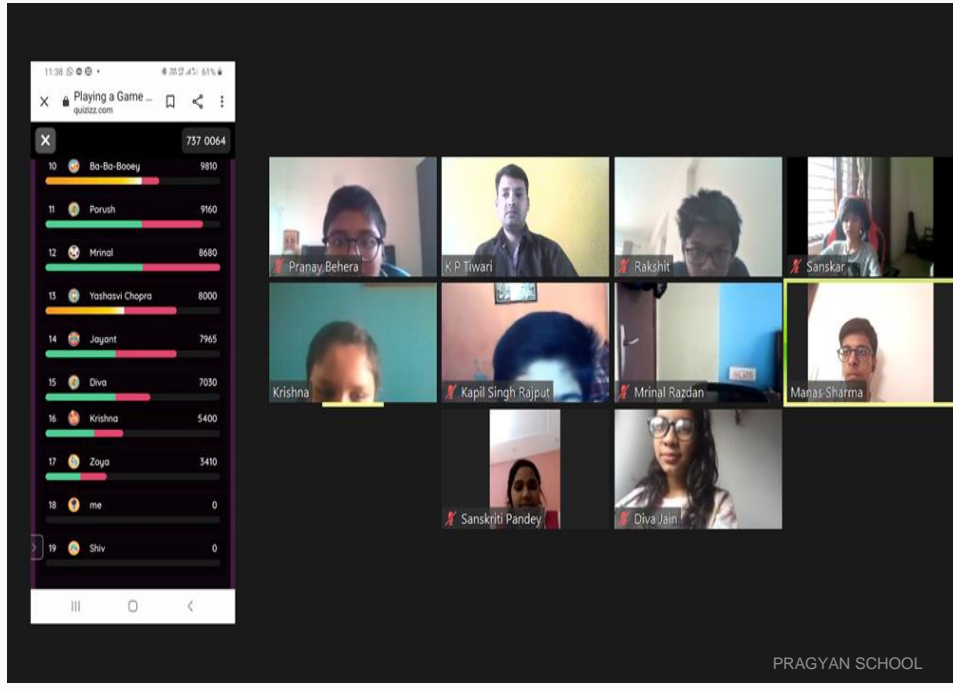
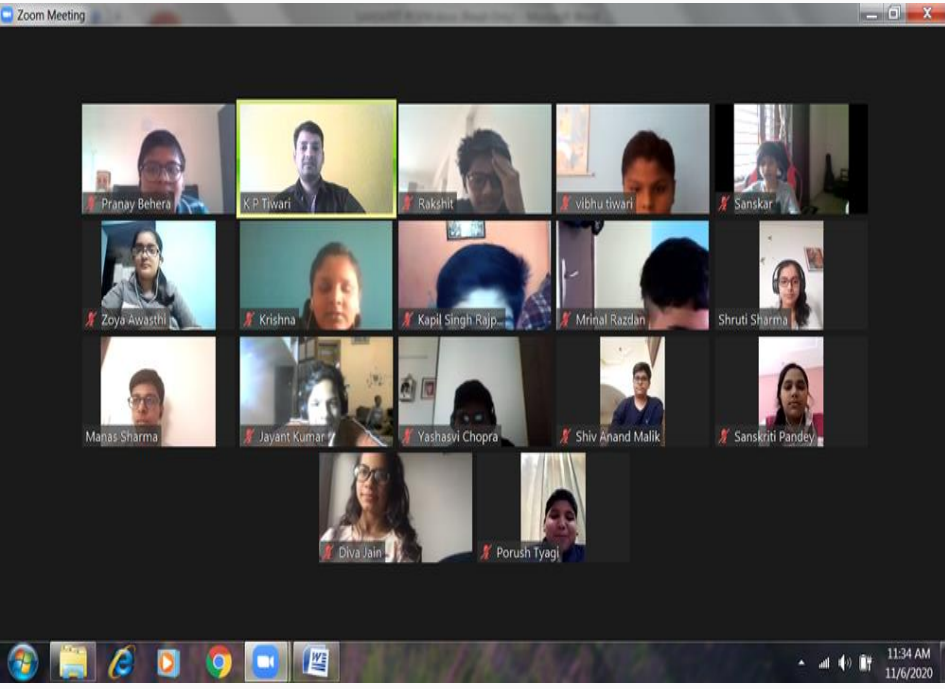
VIRTUAL TOUR-AULI- MINI SWITZERLAND OF INDIA

VIRTUAL TOUR OF AULI- UTTARAKHAND



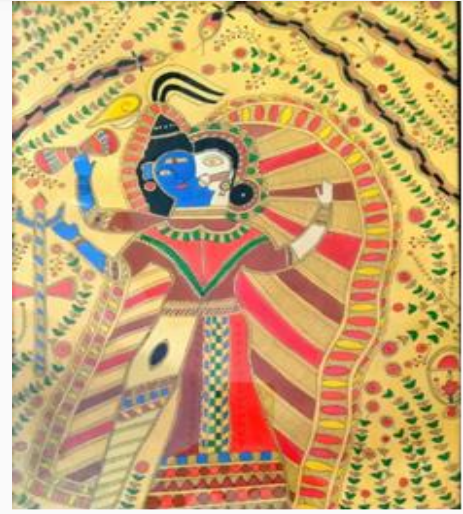
