NURSERY



ENGLISH

Letter O was introduced to the children with the help of pictures and different objects. They also enjoyed the Jolly phonics song of letter O. Students did worksheets related to the letter in their workbook. They tried identifying things starting with letter O.

MATHS

This week number 19 was introduced to the students through counting different objects and they also did worksheets related to the number. They also practiced writing the number in their notebook.



HINDI

Vyanjan 'प' was introduced to the students with the help of pictures. They also enjoyed colouring 'प' related objects in their Hindi letter book.



GENERAL AWARENESS

As part of general awareness, students were introduced to different seasons in the class. Students participated in class discussion about seasons and things that one can eat and drink and the kind of clothes people wear in different seasons. Students also enjoyed colouring the worksheets related to the topic.



JADUI PITARA

Jadui Pitara helps to promote curiosity and encourage exploration in early childhood education.

As a part of Jadui Pitara, our curious nursery students participated in an engaging activity where students recognised and understood different modes of transportation through colorful pictures and enjoyed discussion on transportation.

Nursery students explored flags and colors through an interactive activity. They colored Indian and Canadian flags, adding maple leaf cutouts, and created multicolored leaves. This integrated exercise developed Art skills, English vocabulary (flag), and Value Education (national symbols). Math concepts (lines) were also revised promoting holistic learning and creativity.

ENGLISH

The students were introduced to the "e-family" words and to a new story "The Red Hen" as part of their reading scheme. Learning these words helped students to reinforce their understanding of the sounds and to strengthen their reading skills.

MATHS

This week, students learnt the numbers 91 to 100. Understanding these higher numbers not only builds a foundation for math but also sparks curiosity and confidence as they head toward three-digit numbers. The students had written practice of the numbers from 51 to 100 that helped reinforce their understanding.



HINDI

Students were introduced to the vyanjan थ. To make learning more engaging, students were encouraged to colour pictures beginning with vyanjan थ and they also did the vyanjan in their notebook. This helped them associate visual creativity with language learning.



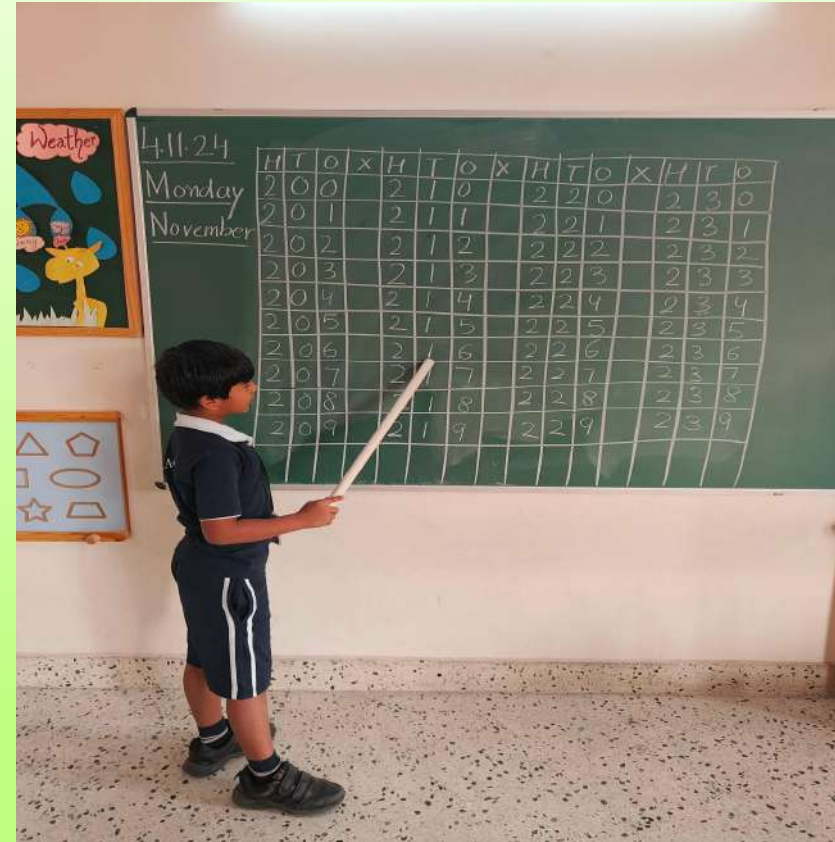


ENGLISH

During this week students practiced 'ay' digraph. Introduction to articles a and an enhances phonemic awareness and builds confidence amongst students to work independently. It helps kids recognize vowel and consonant sounds, an essential part of reading skill.

MATHS

Students orally practiced numbers from 200-250. They also did writing practice for counting 200-220 in their workbooks and board practice for ascending and descending order.



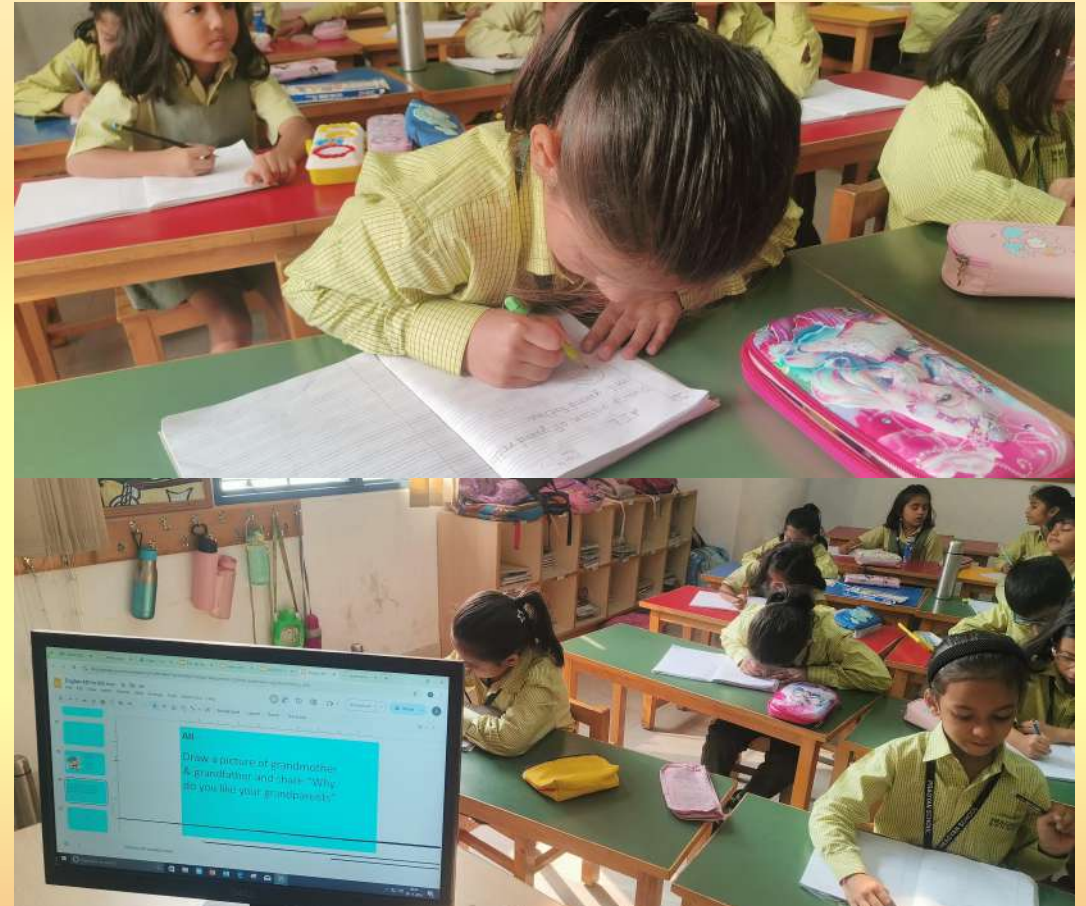
GENERAL AWARENESS

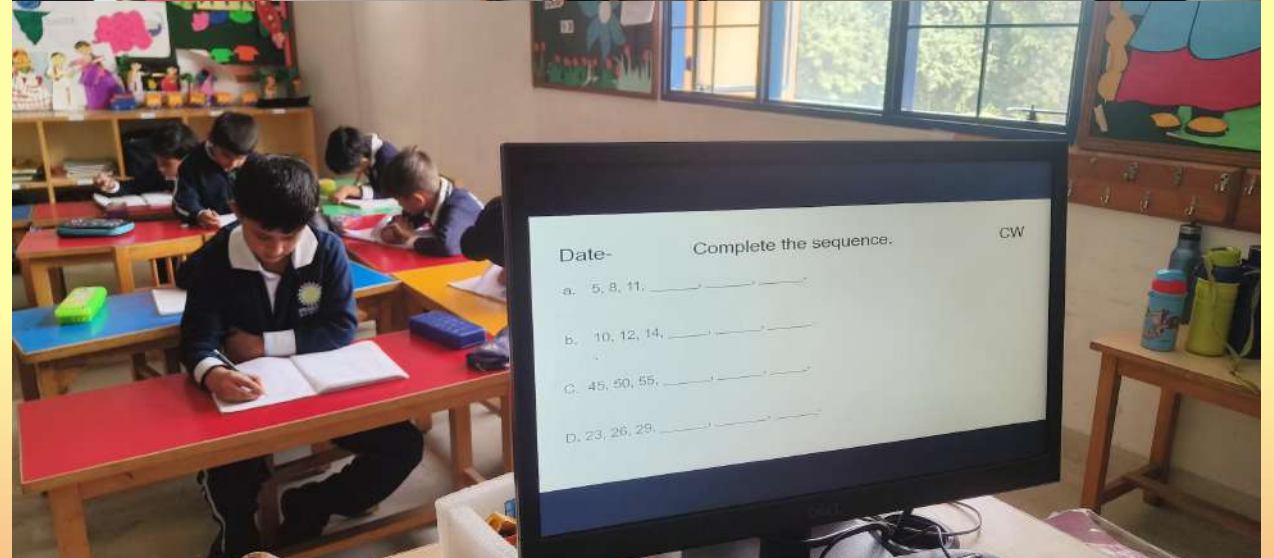
ENVIRONMENTAL SCIENCE

This week students of class 1 read the Chapter: Clothes from their EVS textbook. They had a class discussion on the importance of clothes. Students could do the worksheets based on the same independently. They also practiced the New words of the same chapter and did the notebook work.





Children of class 1 enjoyed learning skip count by 10's and table of 10. Also children practiced carryover addition and sums questions. Relevant PPT and videos were shown. In skip counting by 10s students will notice that the digit in the tens place increases by 1 each time they add 10 to a number. Noticing these patterns in skip counting helps develop number sense.

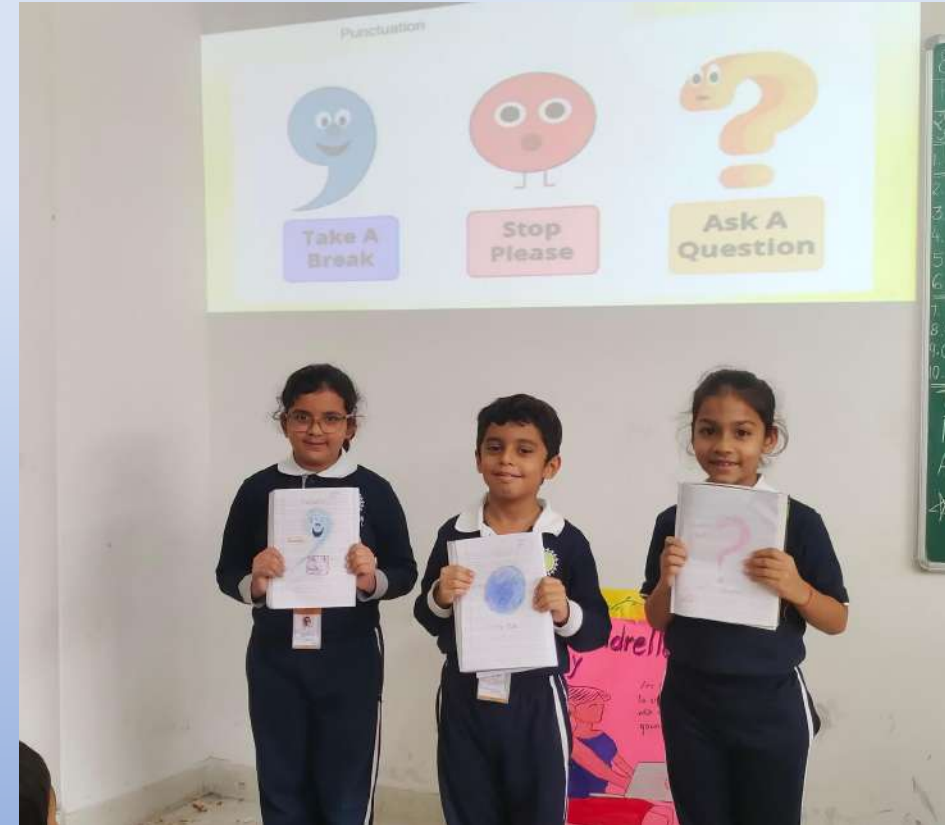
हिन्दी

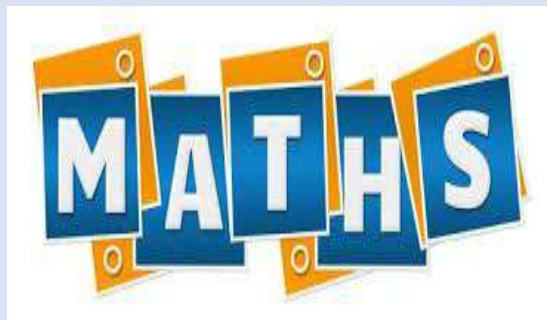




ENVIRONMENTAL SCIENCE

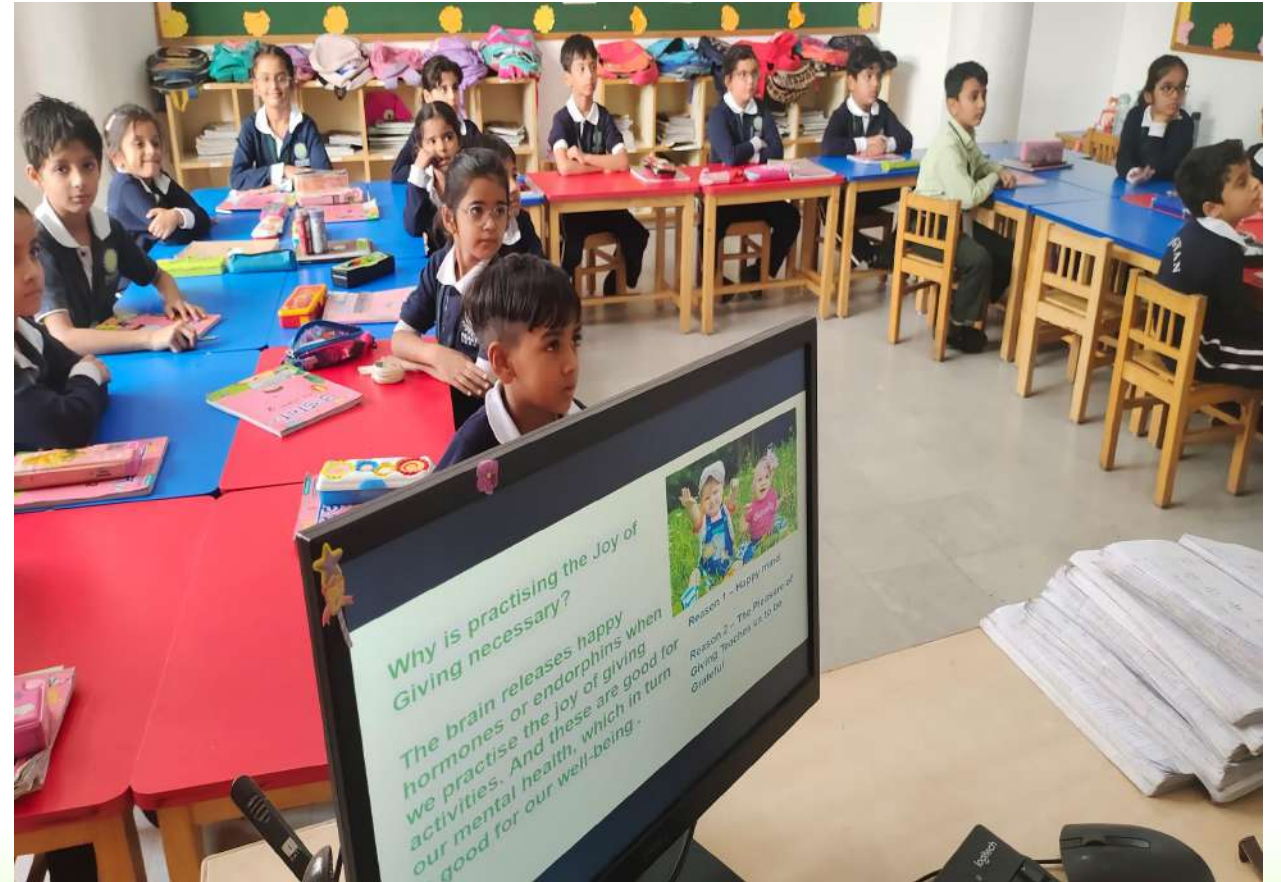
CIRCLE TIME

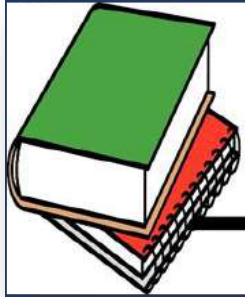

Students of class 5 were introduced to the new words and poem of the month. They did picture composition and revised poems and the spellings of the new words for their assessments.

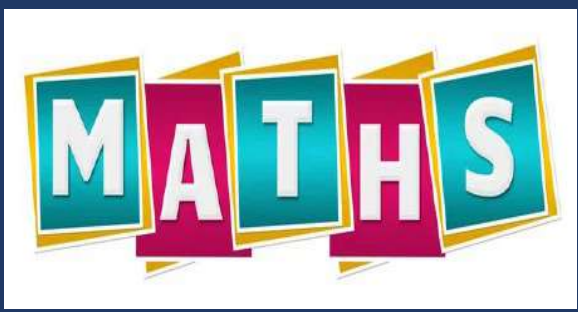

Grade 3-5 students participated in yoga and meditation session, exploring breathing exercises, relaxation techniques, and guided meditation. Students experienced calmness and happiness.

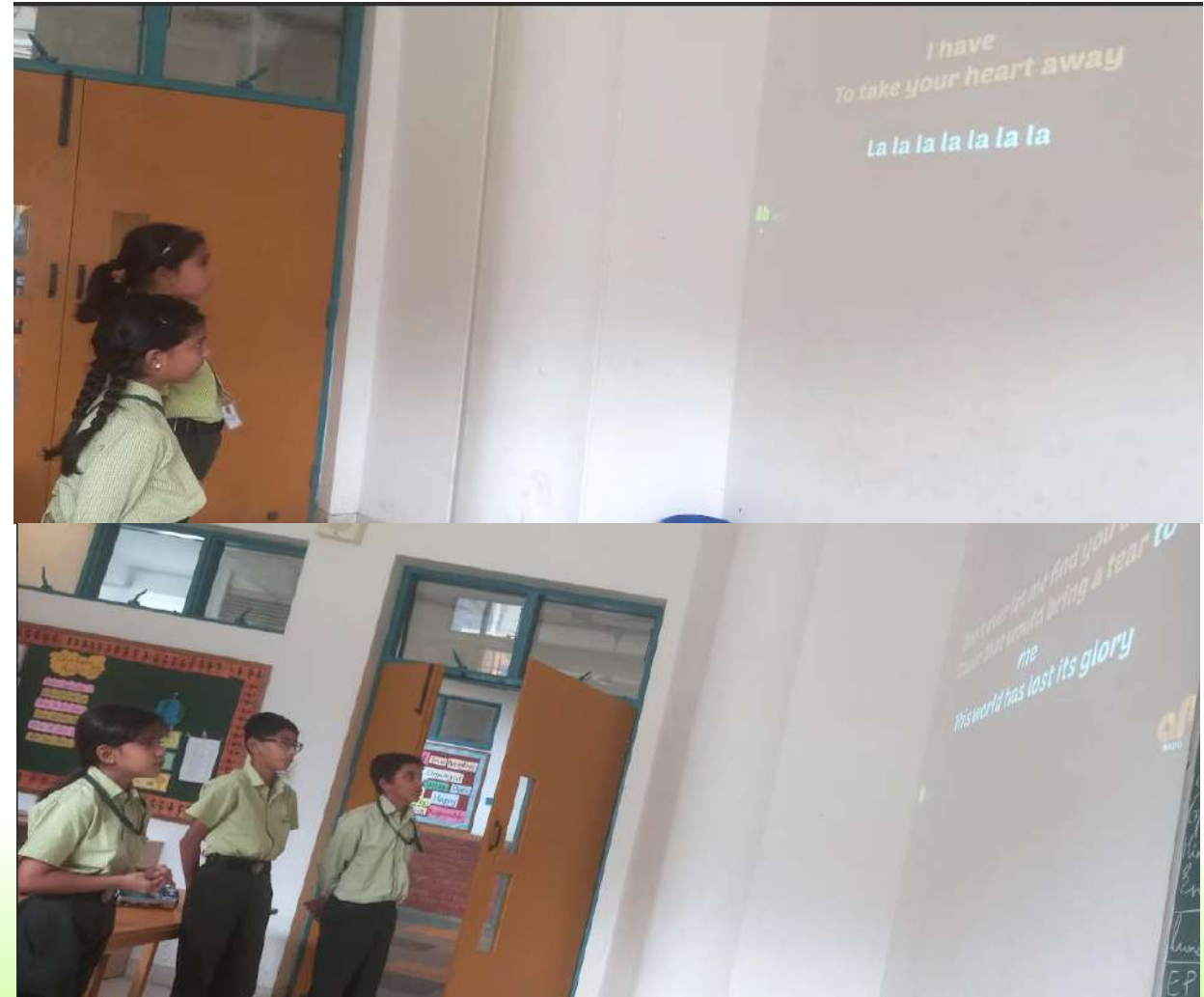
VOCAL MUSIC CLUB



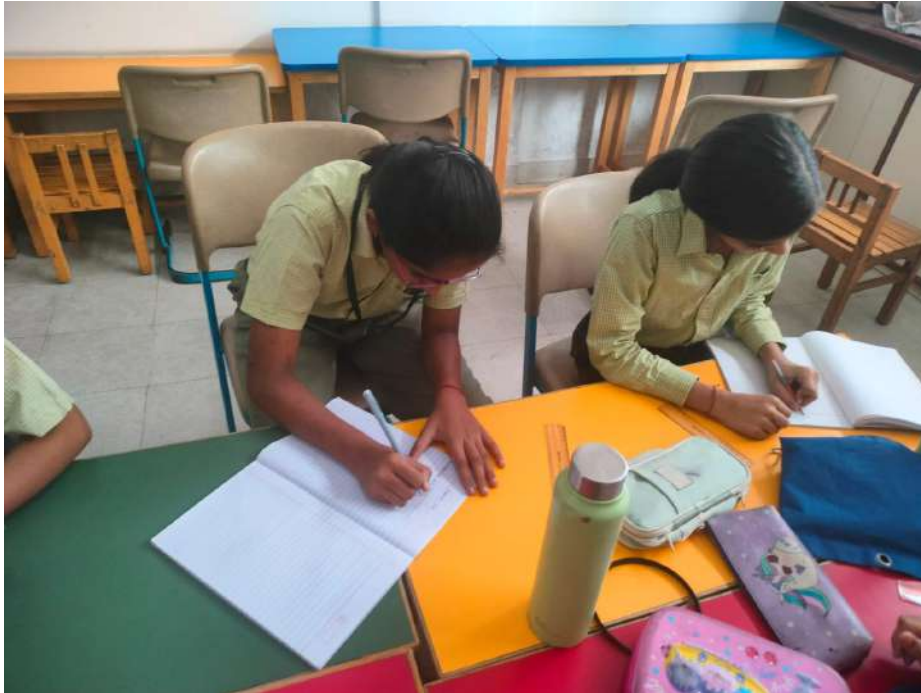
