GA: Discussion of different sense organs and its functions was done in the class.

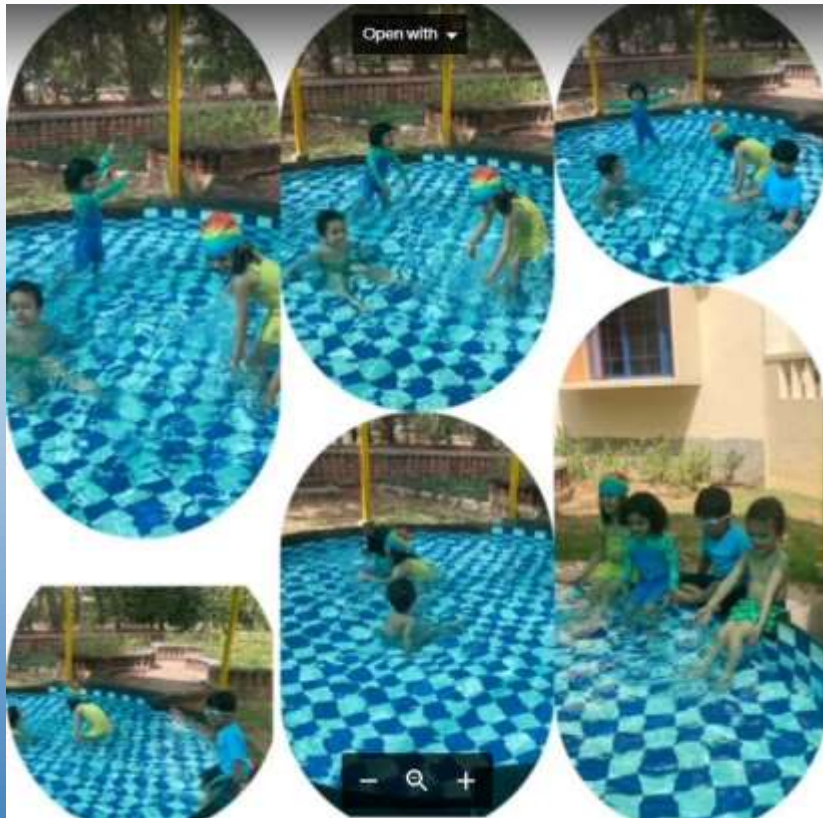


EVS: Revision of pigeon was done in the class.

ENVIRONMENTAL SCIENCE

CLASS TEACHER PERIOD (3-5)

Students of classes 3-5 had theme-based Enrichment periods on Monday, Tuesday and Thursday. The topic for the Circle Time on Monday was Health and Hygiene. It was discussed with the students that better hygiene leads to better health, confidence and overall growth. Important hygiene behaviours are difficult to practice without the right knowledge and skills, adequate community support and the belief that one's own behaviour can actually make a difference. Related ppts and videos were shown too. Tuesday's Value Education session continued on Be Clean, Be Healthy. The session triggered the class discussion on how a joint effort of maintaining cleanliness in school can make a difference. The General Awareness session on Thursday was on Awards and Honours. The students were briefed that India has several 'National Awards' across various categories.
