

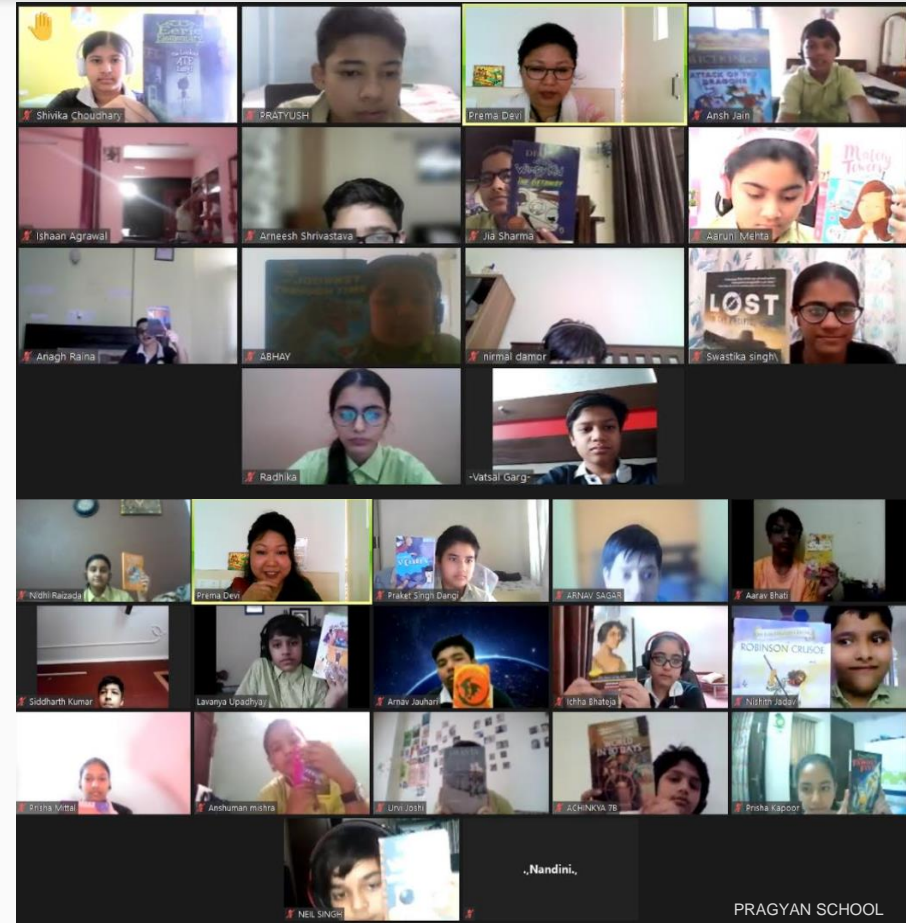

Toycathon 2021 is a unique opportunity for Students, Teachers, Start-ups and Toy experts/professionals in India to submit their innovative toys/games concepts and win large number of prizes. We are proud to share that Hanswarup Talwar, XB of Pragyan School, along with his team won the Toycathon-2021 challenge. The team consisted of following students from different schools, Team leader ,Surat Sahni VIII, Shabd Sahni IX, Hanswarup Talwar X, Saksham Tiwari XI, under the mentorship of Ms Pinky Mathur and Mr Pramod Kumar Talwar, presented a novel idea 'Gam-i-Yog', which integrates the ancient Indian yogic techniques with modern age AI - Computer Vision and Machine Learning. The team proposed an innovative idea that provides a zero-cost, fun play-way and safe method to practice yoga at home. Around 14130 teams submitted 17770 different ideas in Toycathon-2021, out of which 1200 teams were selected for the grand finale. After three vigorous rounds of mentoring and power judging, 117 teams were declared winners on 26th June 2021.


## Instrumental Music

During the instrumental session conducted on 10th July 2021, students of class VI gained information on various kinds of musical instruments and Cromactical patterns. They also practiced on a song 'ae watan' (Patriotic song). Grade VII students gained knowledge of 'staff musical notes'. They also practiced on the song (Sare Jahan se acha). Students of grade VIII tried to perform some beautiful music tones in their instrumental music class. They also gained knowledge of musical staff notes on piano & guitar .In IX-XII, students practiced music notes symbols on piano & guitar .



SESSION 1 4 Starting Of Right

Blues Notes, Worksheets 71  
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There are three main types of guitar: the nylon string or classical guitar, and the electric guitar.




The six strings of a guitar are numbered from first to sixth starting on the thinnest string and counting up to the thickest string. The strings also have letter names that correspond to each string. Memorize them.



**Proper Right Hand Technique**




Hold the pick between your thumb and first finger. The thumb and pick should form a 90 degree angle. The pick should be sticking out from underneath the thumb a 1/4 to 1/2 of an inch.




Bracing your hand gives your hand the needed stability to accurately switch between strings. Although there are many different ways to brace, placing your pinky on the soundboard right below the first string is the most common way. You don't need to press hard.

**Proper Left Hand Technique**



Hold your thumb over the top of the neck of the guitar. Your wrist should be straight. Your thumb should be resting on the palm and the side of the hand.



Your four fingers should be spaced out. No two fingers should be on the same fret. Your first and fourth fingers are curved slightly toward the frets.

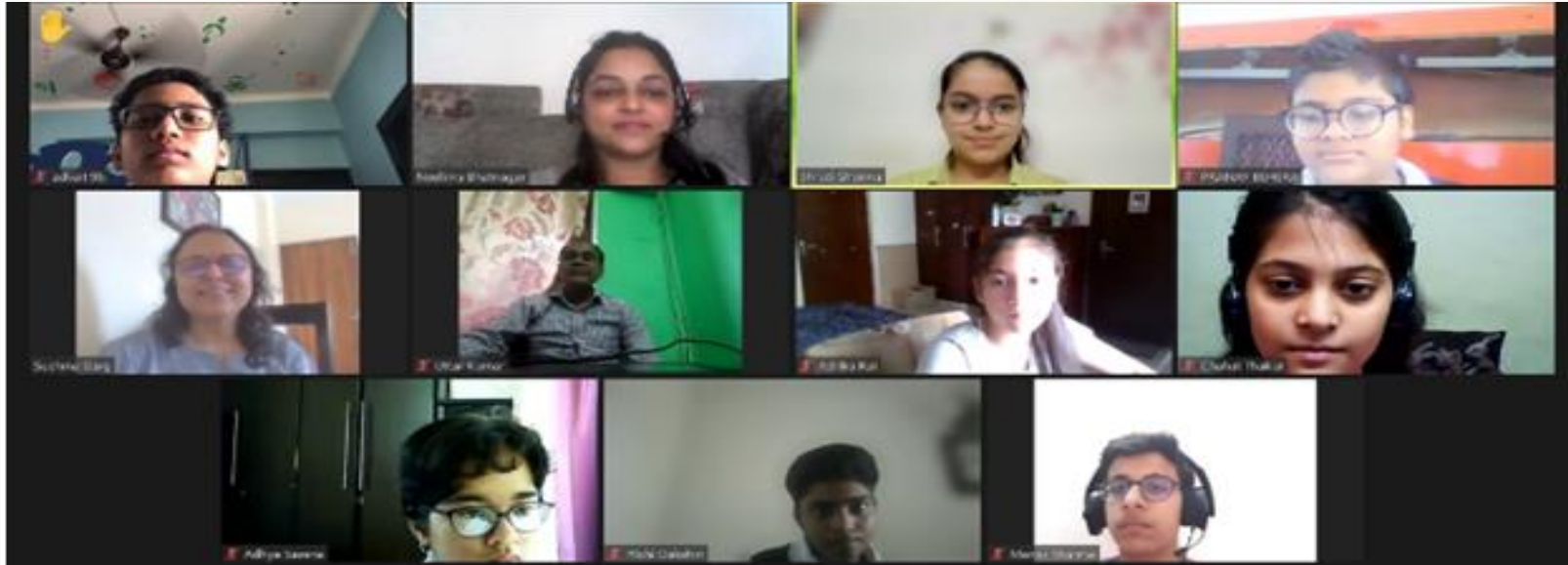

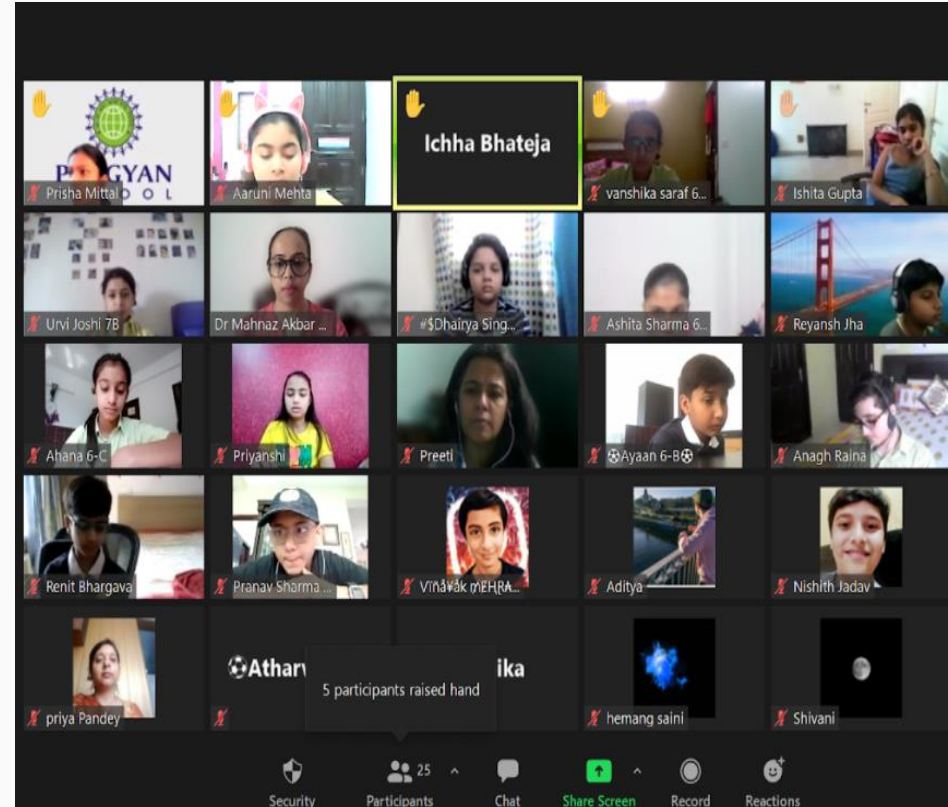
# DEBATING AND JOURNALISM CLUB [IX-XII]

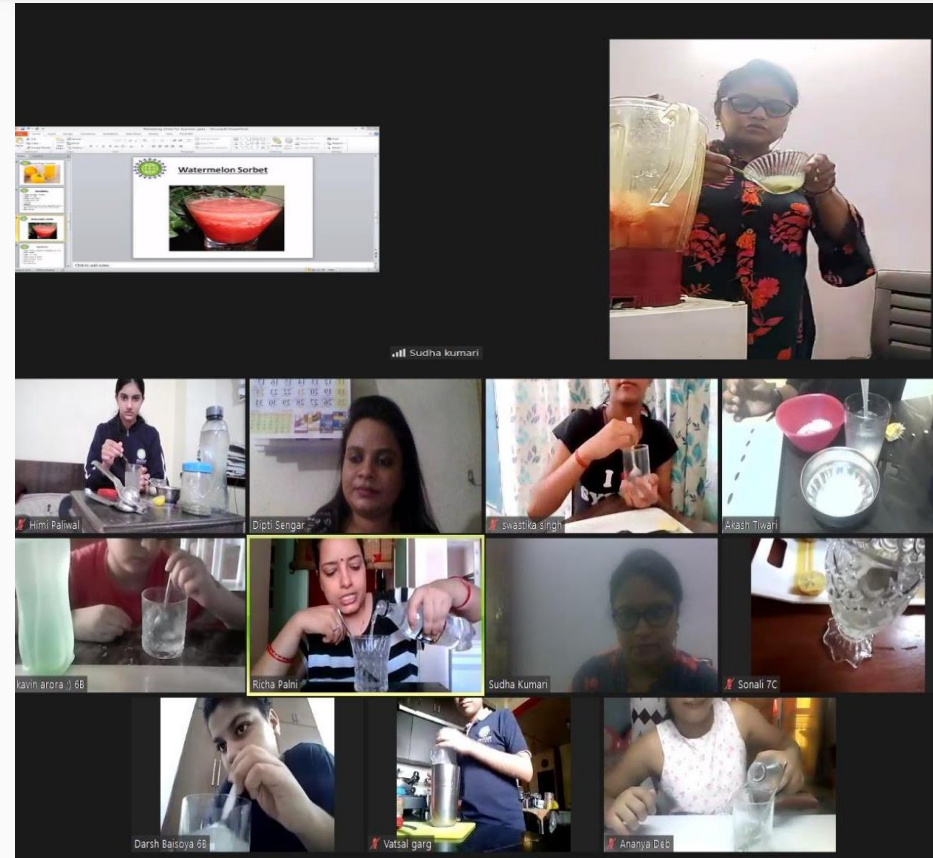
# INTERACT CLUB [IX-XII]

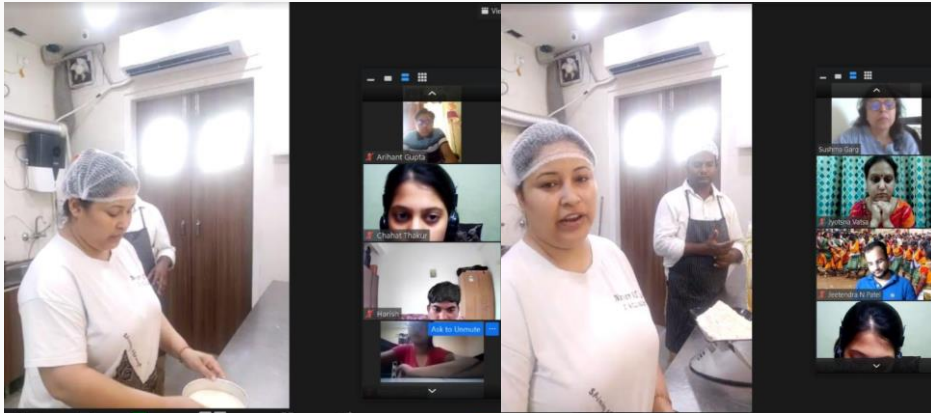
# ECOLOGY CLUB [IX-XII]
