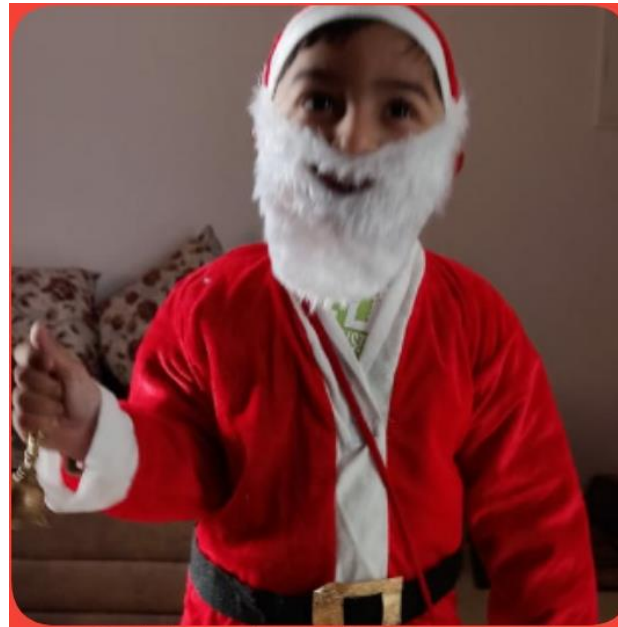

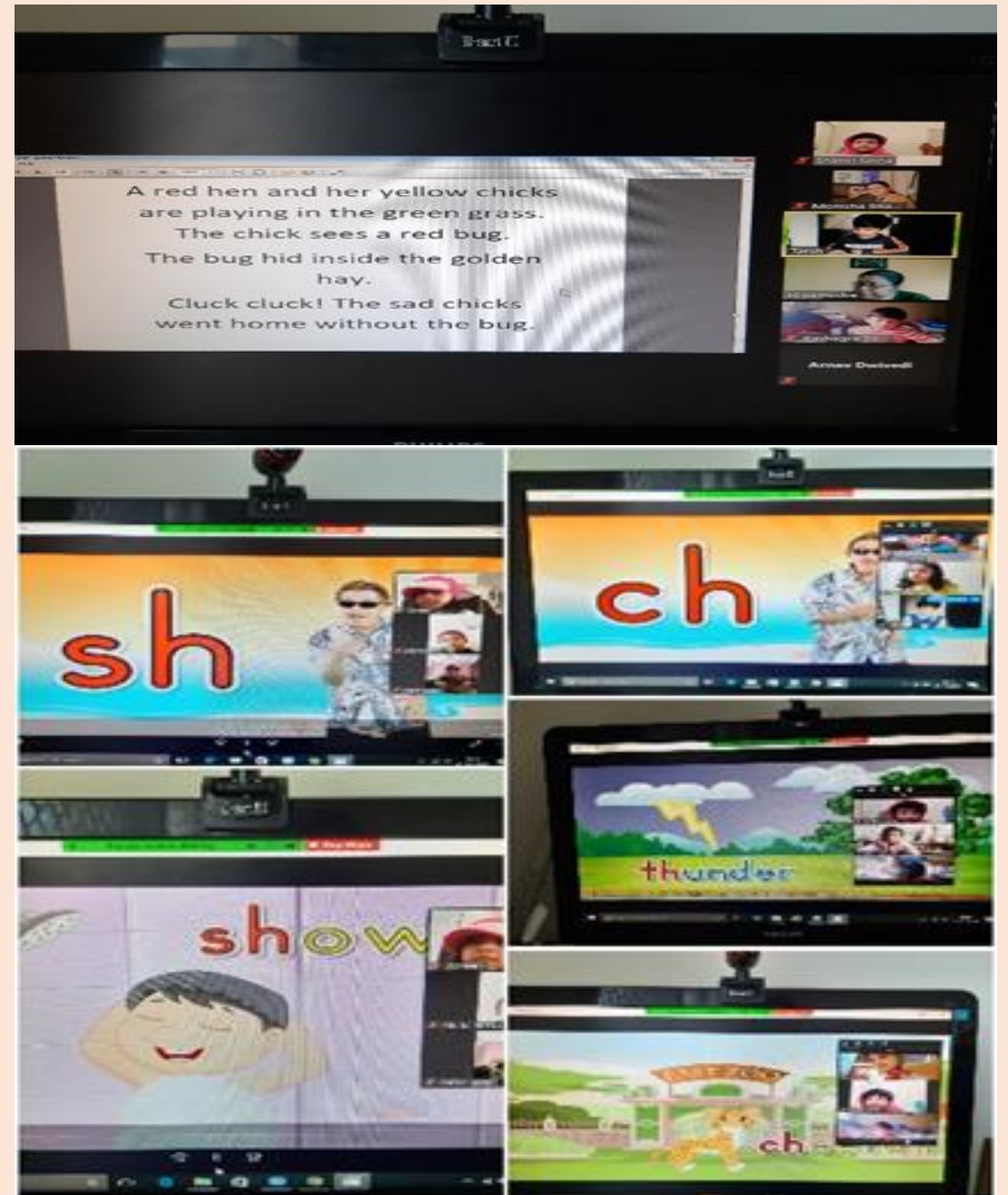


# KINDERGARTEN

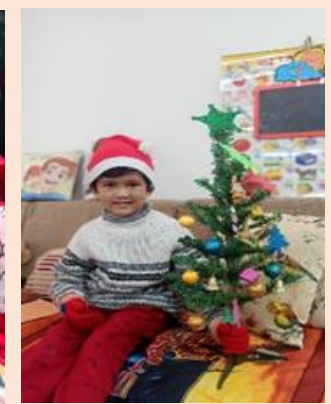
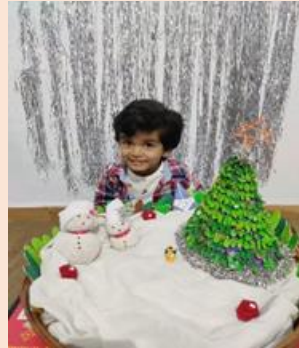
**Art and craft** -Students enjoyed colouring in Santa.

Students of evening class enjoyed making beautiful drawings on Christmas. They learnt to draw Santa and created a background on their own with a Christmas tree and other things.

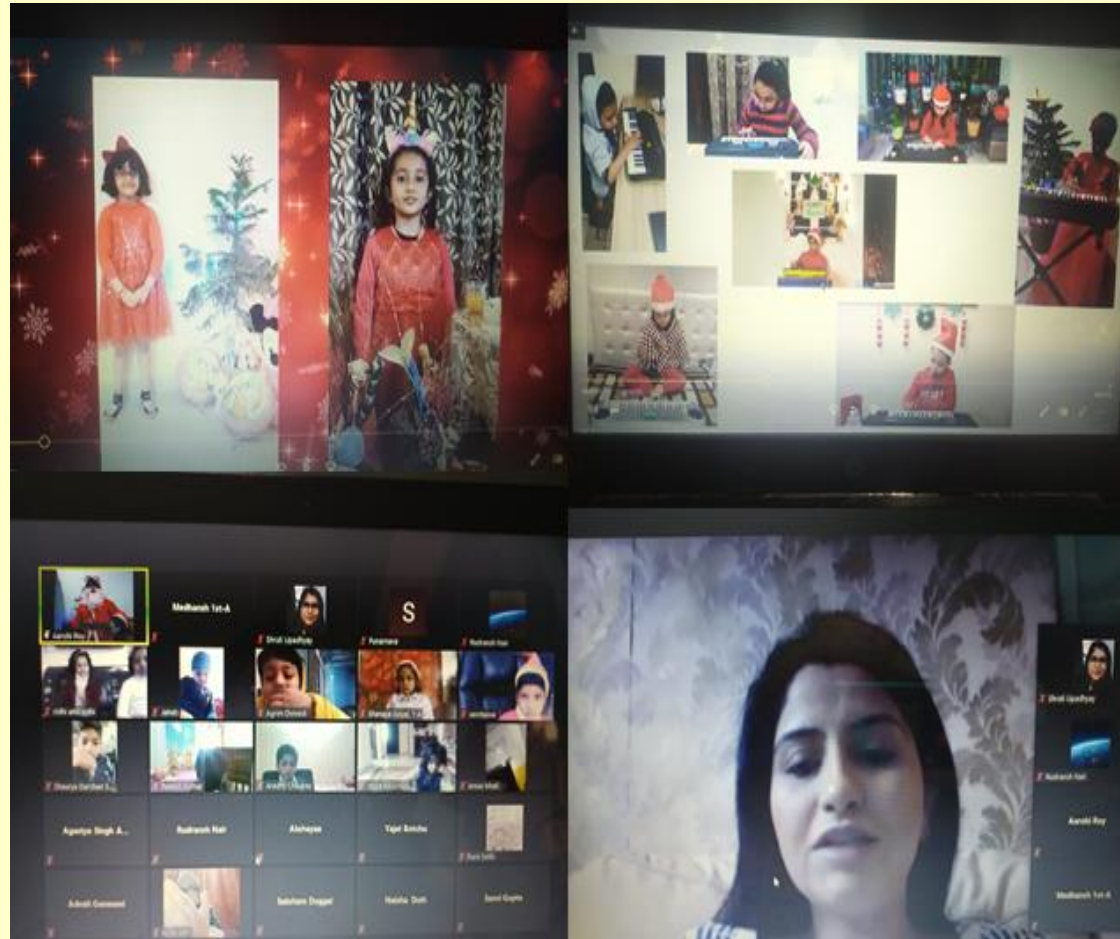


# CHRISTMAS

## ASSEMBLY

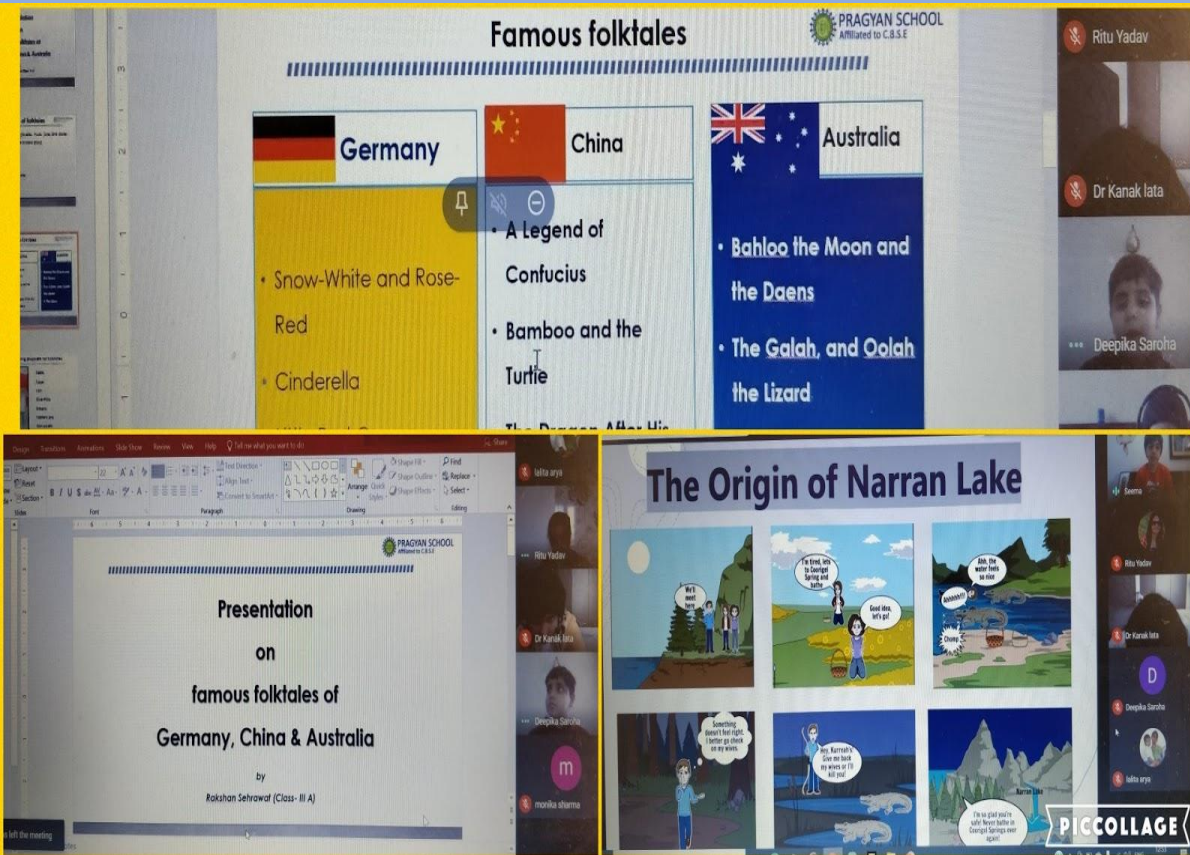

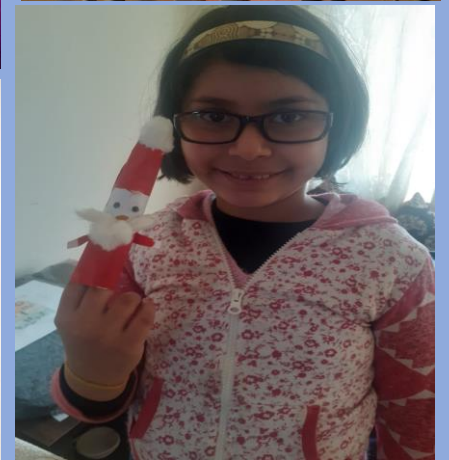




# ART CLASS

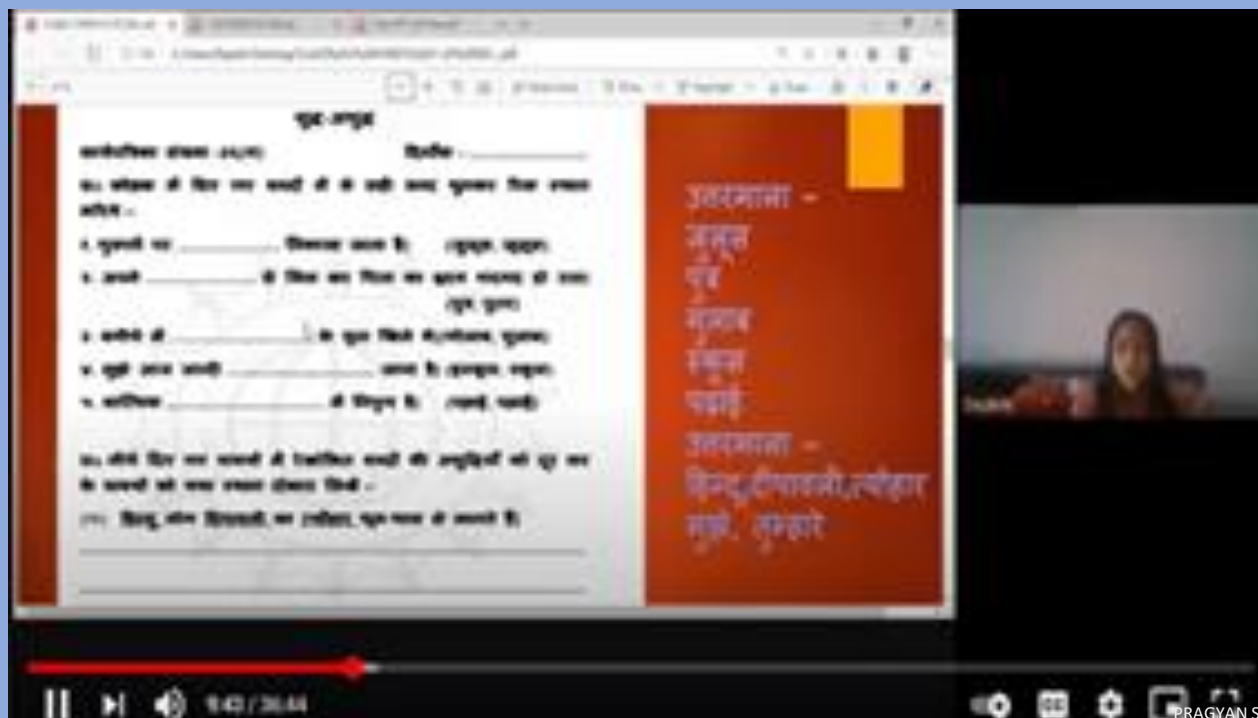

Students of class 3 were introduced to the concept of “SHUDH ASHUDH” through the pictorial presentation. They also revised vilom shabd.



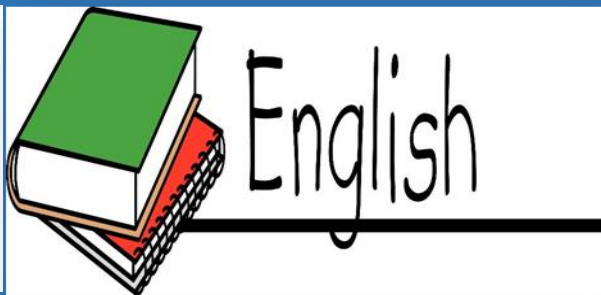


# CHRISTMAS ASSEMBLY









**How the sun was made**



# Grade 4 MATH

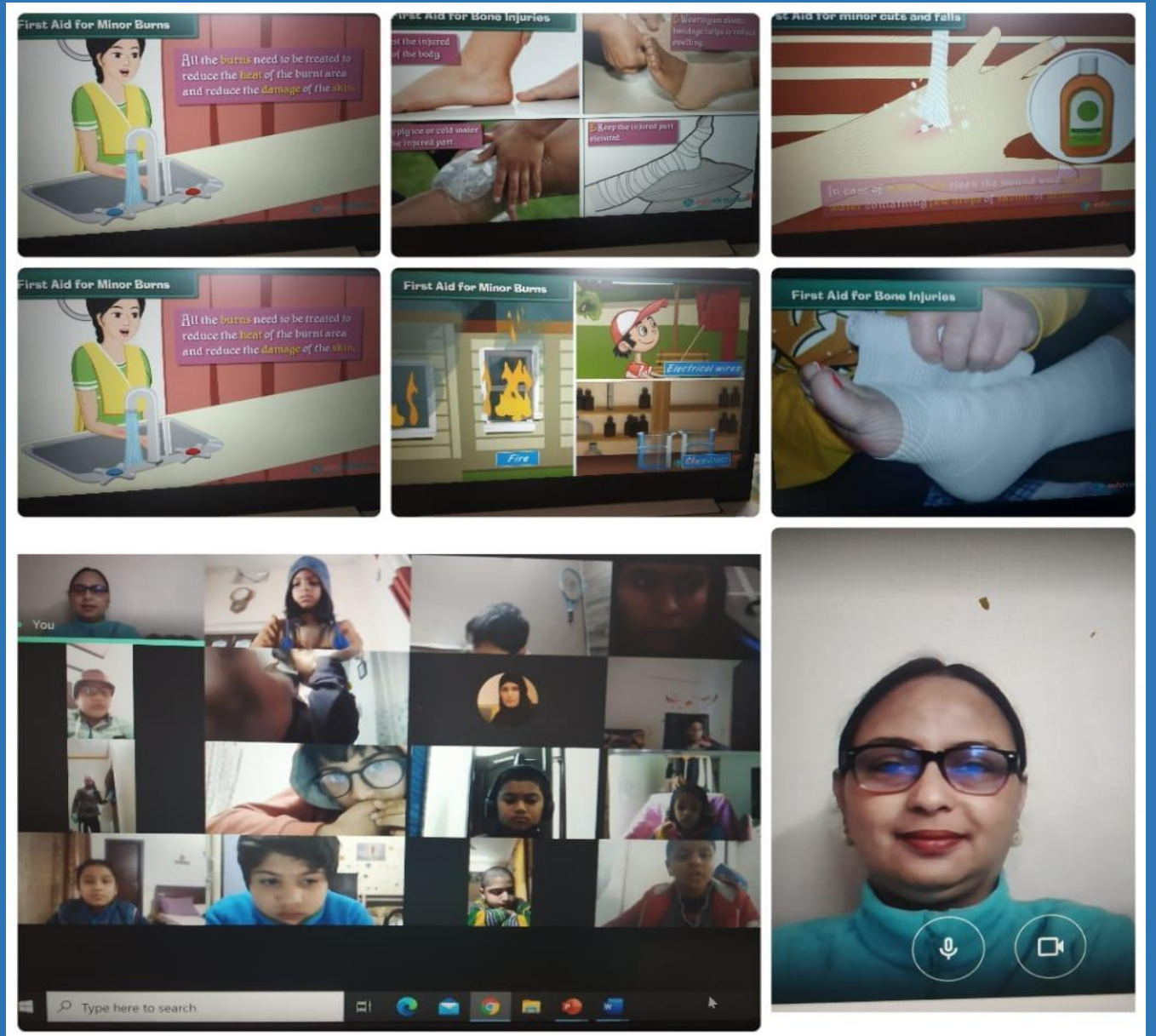
Students of class 4 enjoyed the Math's activity based on the Tiling pattern, "Tessellation." They used different 2D shapes to create their own design.





# ENVIRONMENTAL SCIENCE

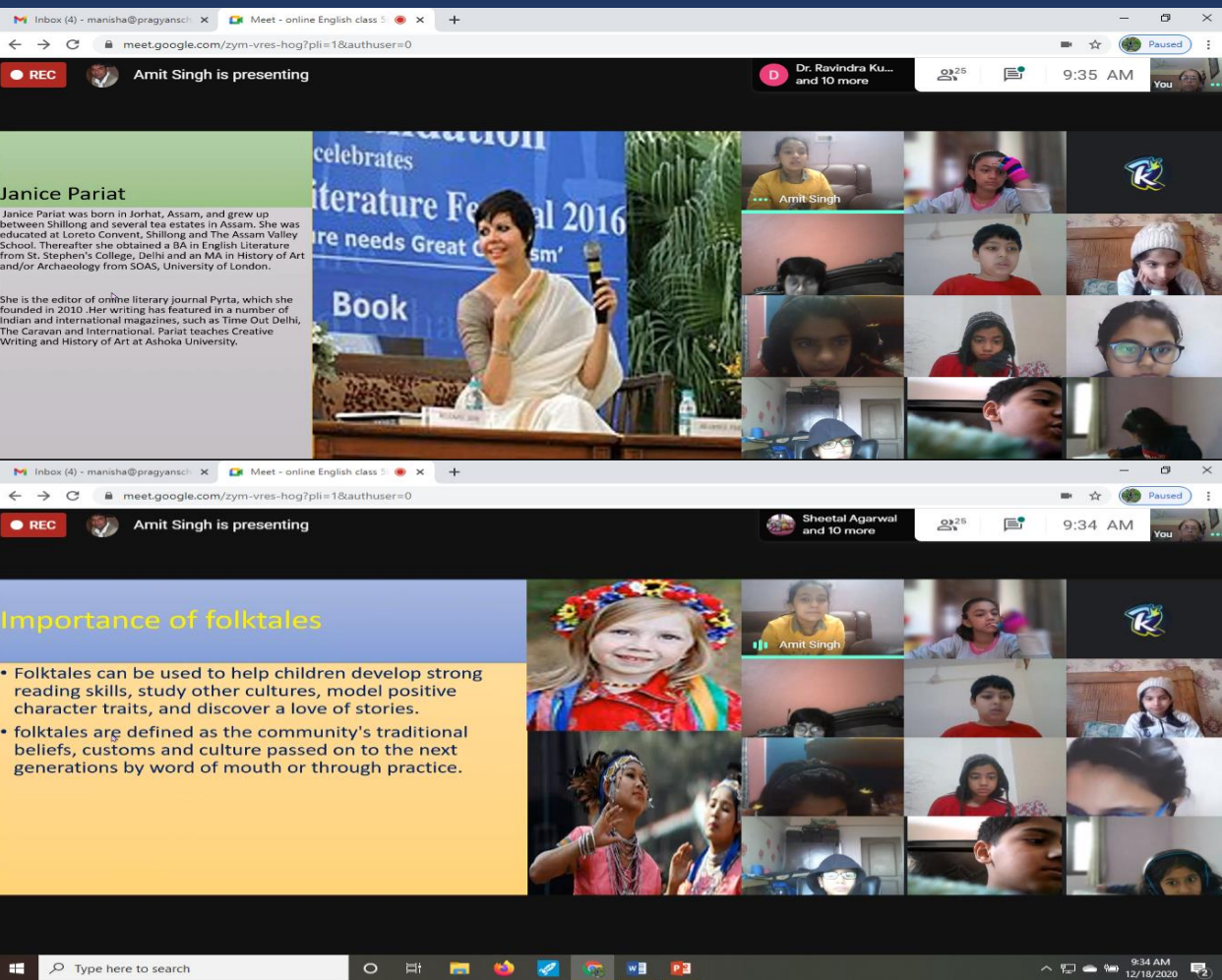

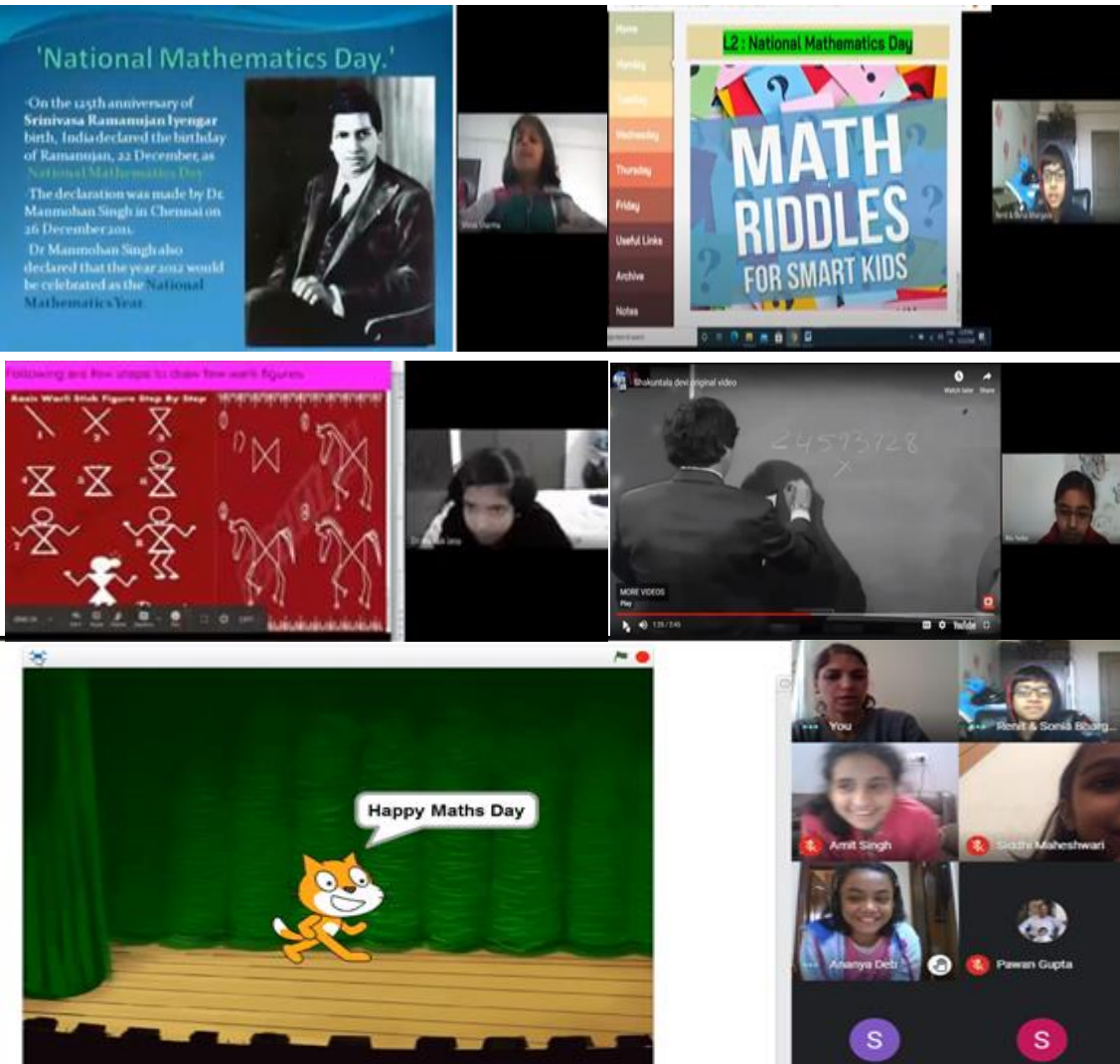
