NURSERY



ENGLISH

This week nursery children revised writing letters L, T, I and H, E, F in their four lines notebook. Jolly phonics rhymes related to the letters were also revised with them to help them learn the phonic sounds.



MATHS

This week students practiced numbers 1,2,3,4,5 in their small square notebook. Revision of oral counting 1-15 was done with the children and they also tried to match the number with its value through blocks. They enjoyed doing the worksheet related to the same.



HINDI

This week the children of nursery revised vyanjan क, ख, ग, घ and च through pictures and vyanjan rhyme in their online class. They also enjoyed doing the rhyme आम रसीला.



GENERAL AWARENESS

As part of general awareness, during this week discussion on healthy and unhealthy food was done in the class. Students also discussed what they should eat daily and what food they should have once a week. They also enjoyed colouring the worksheets related to the topic.



EASP

Nursery students participated in the Clean My City race practice, collecting different things from the ground. They demonstrated teamwork, enthusiasm, and a sense of responsibility.



KINDERGARTEN



ENGLISH

The letter k was introduced to the students using a flashcard and the Jolly Phonics song. The students actively participated and were able to identify various objects that start with the letter k.

HINDI

The students revised the swars taught so far and were able to recognize pictures related to them. This activity made the recapitulation of swars interesting and learning process enjoyable for the students.



GENERAL AWARENESS

Students were engaged in learning about healthy and junk food. Sorting between the two helped them understand the importance of making healthier choices. Working on a related worksheet and the topic reinforced their learning.



SKILL BASED ACTIVITY

This week, students of kindergarten focused on Wearing and Tying Shoes. Students learned the steps to put on their shoes and tie them. This helped in developing fine motor skills and hand-eye coordination. Students also practiced putting on their socks, enhancing their ability to manage clothing independently. These activities help to gain confidence and independence in their daily routines.



HANDS ON ACTIVITY(KG)

The students learned to identify the biggest number and compare the numbers using the "crocodile mouth" method. They participated in an activity where they placed the crocodile mouth in front of the biggest number.





MATHS

During this week students revised single digit addition and two digit addition was introduced to them. Students were explained the steps of solving the sums and a few board practices were given as well.

GENERAL AWARENESS

During this week, students participated in the discussion related to the neighbourhood. As a part of the activity related to the topic, students visited a nearby bank and the school library. They were briefed about the importance of library and a bank and the work conducted in different neighbourhood places.



HINDI

Students read a paragraph related to two, three and four letter words. They also made an effort to make small sentences with words like कमल, शहद, कलम etc.



JADUI PITARA

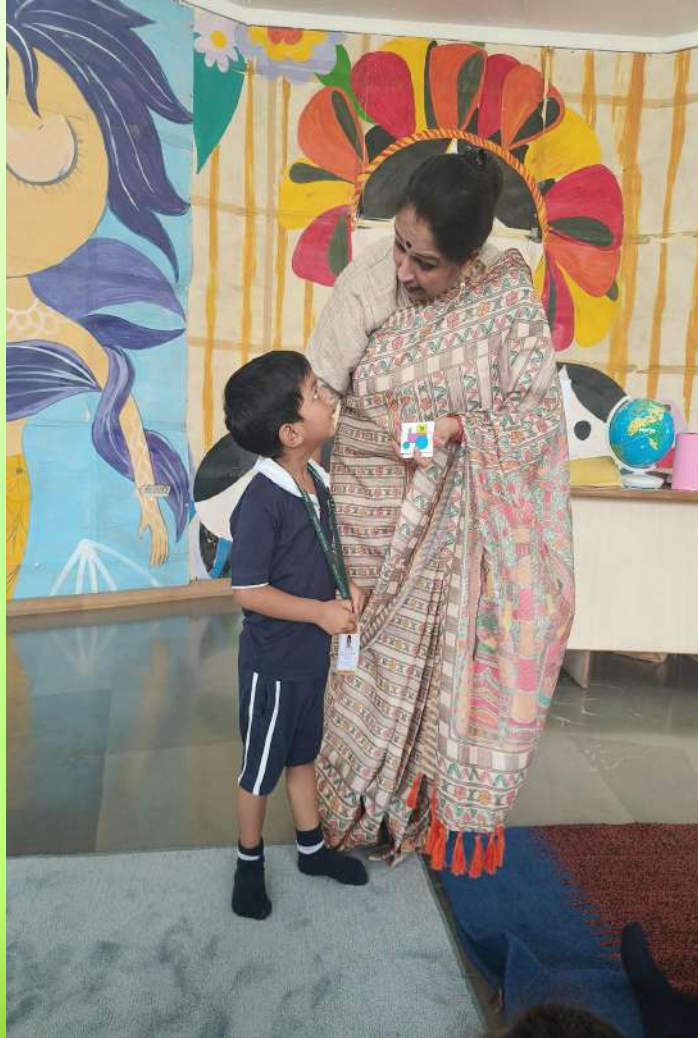

As part of the learning outcome, students also enjoyed making different objects like dinosaurs, cats, castles etc with the help of newspaper cuttings.

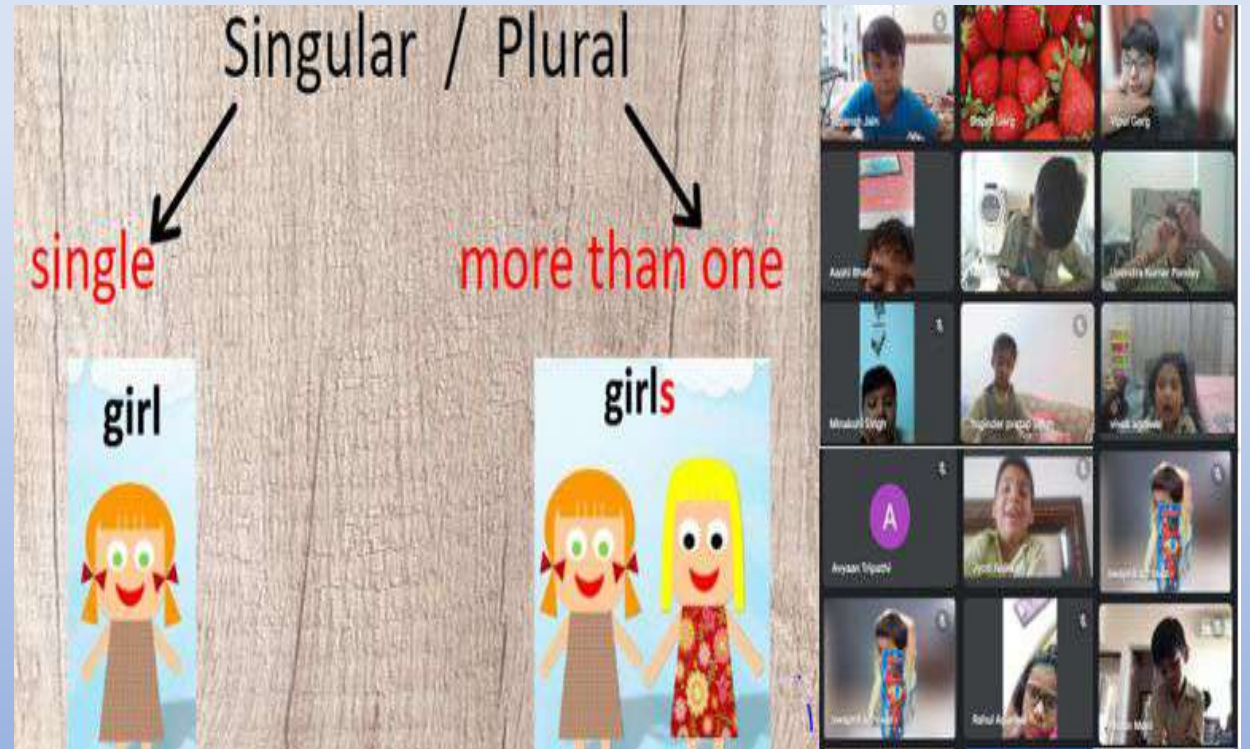
हिन्दी

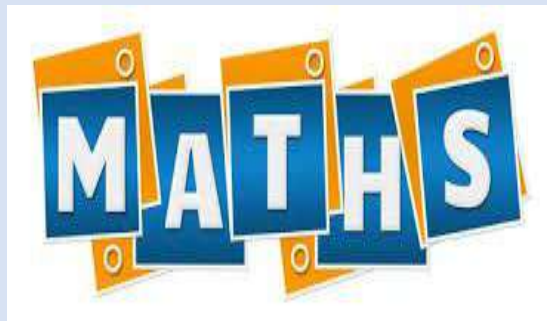

Timely revision is key to retaining knowledge. This week, our Class 2 students revisited the chapters taught in April, May and July, solidifying their grasp of the subject matter.



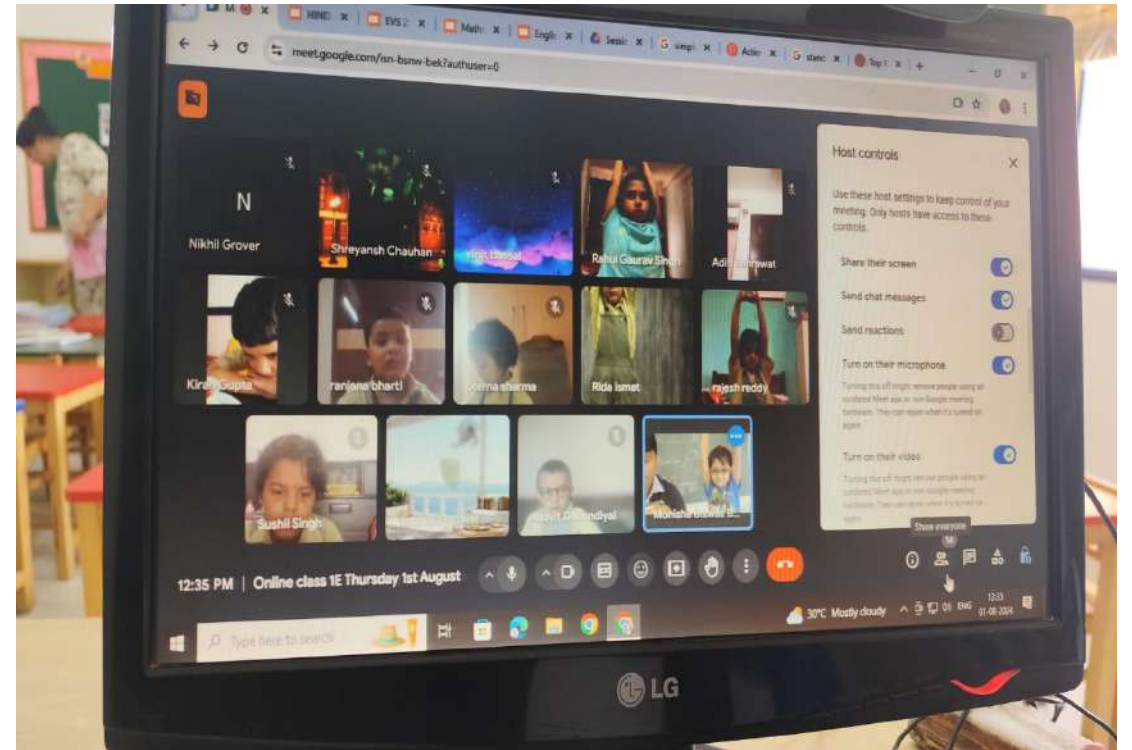

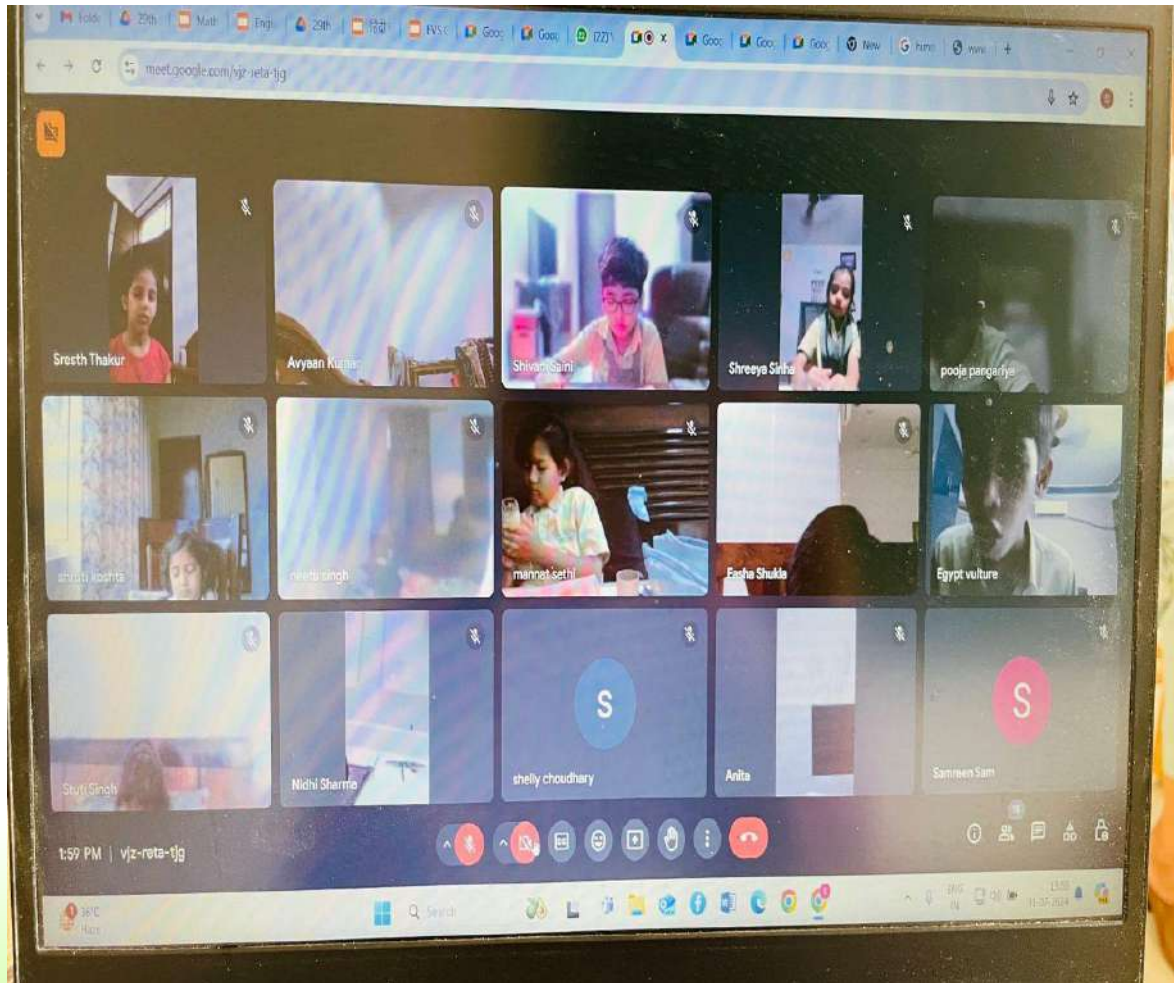


PHYSICAL EDUCATION (1&2)

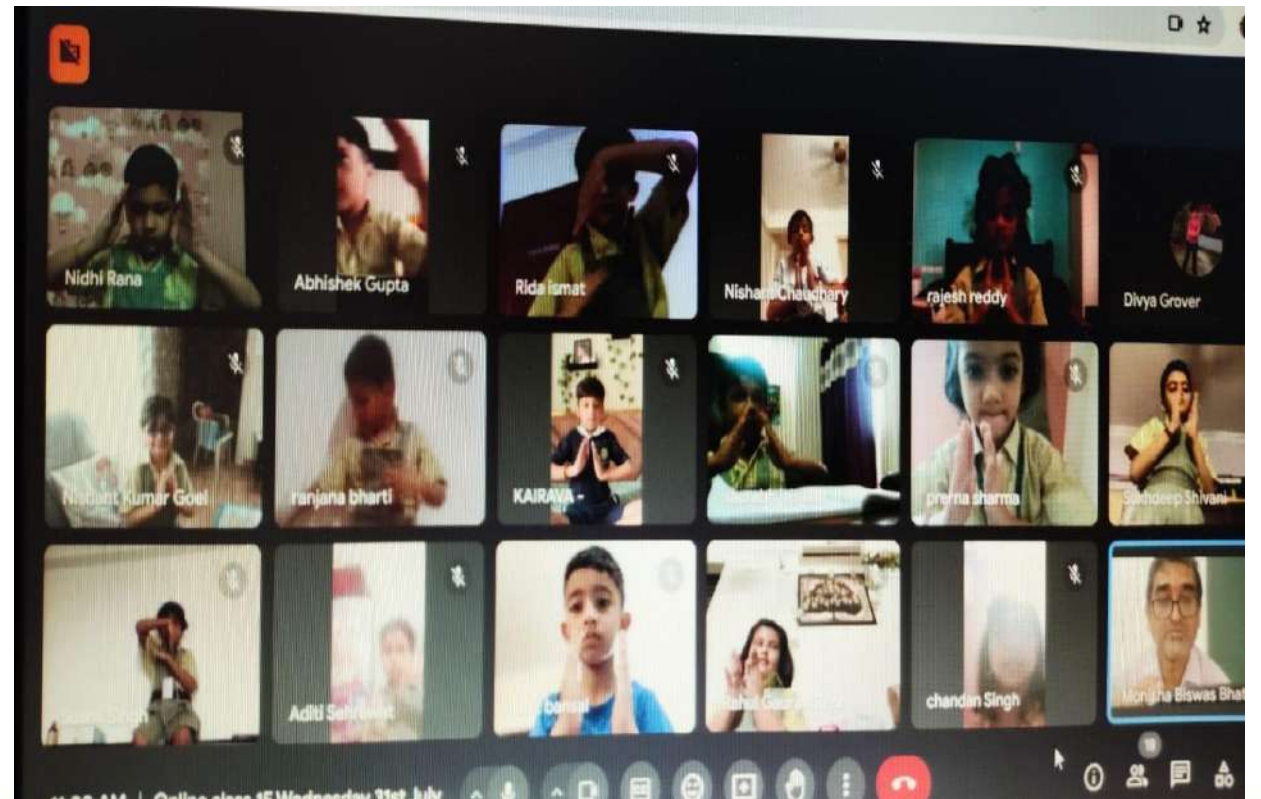
VOCAL MUSIC (1&2)

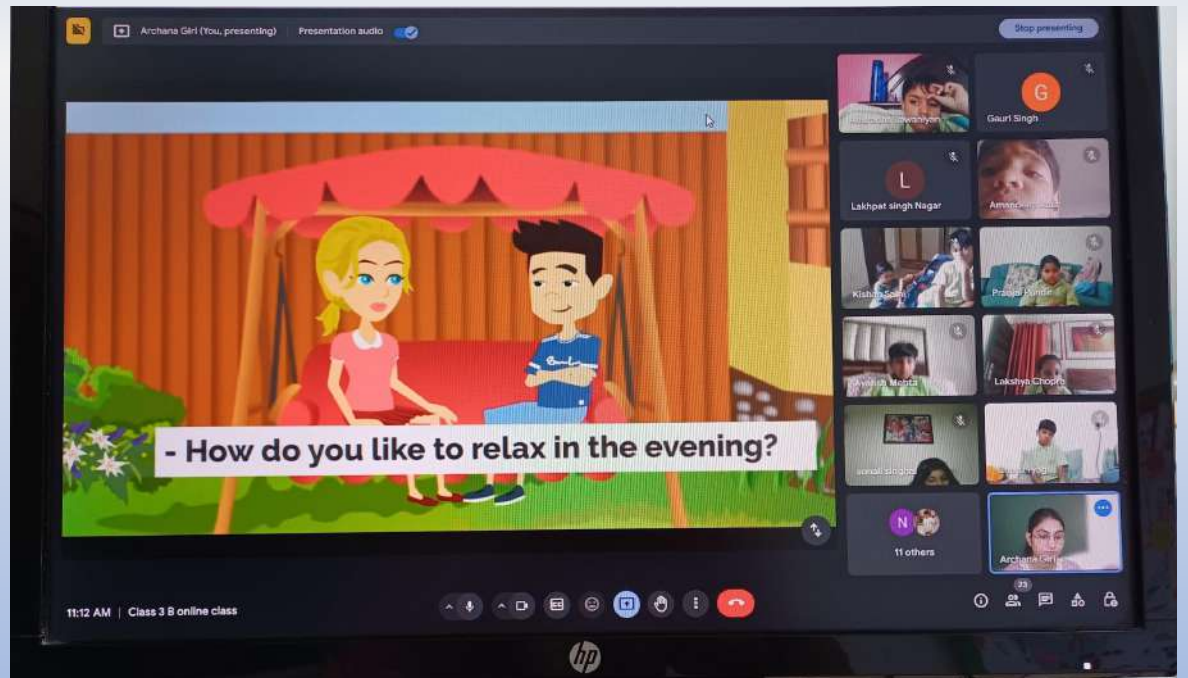
COUNSELING SESSION(1&2)

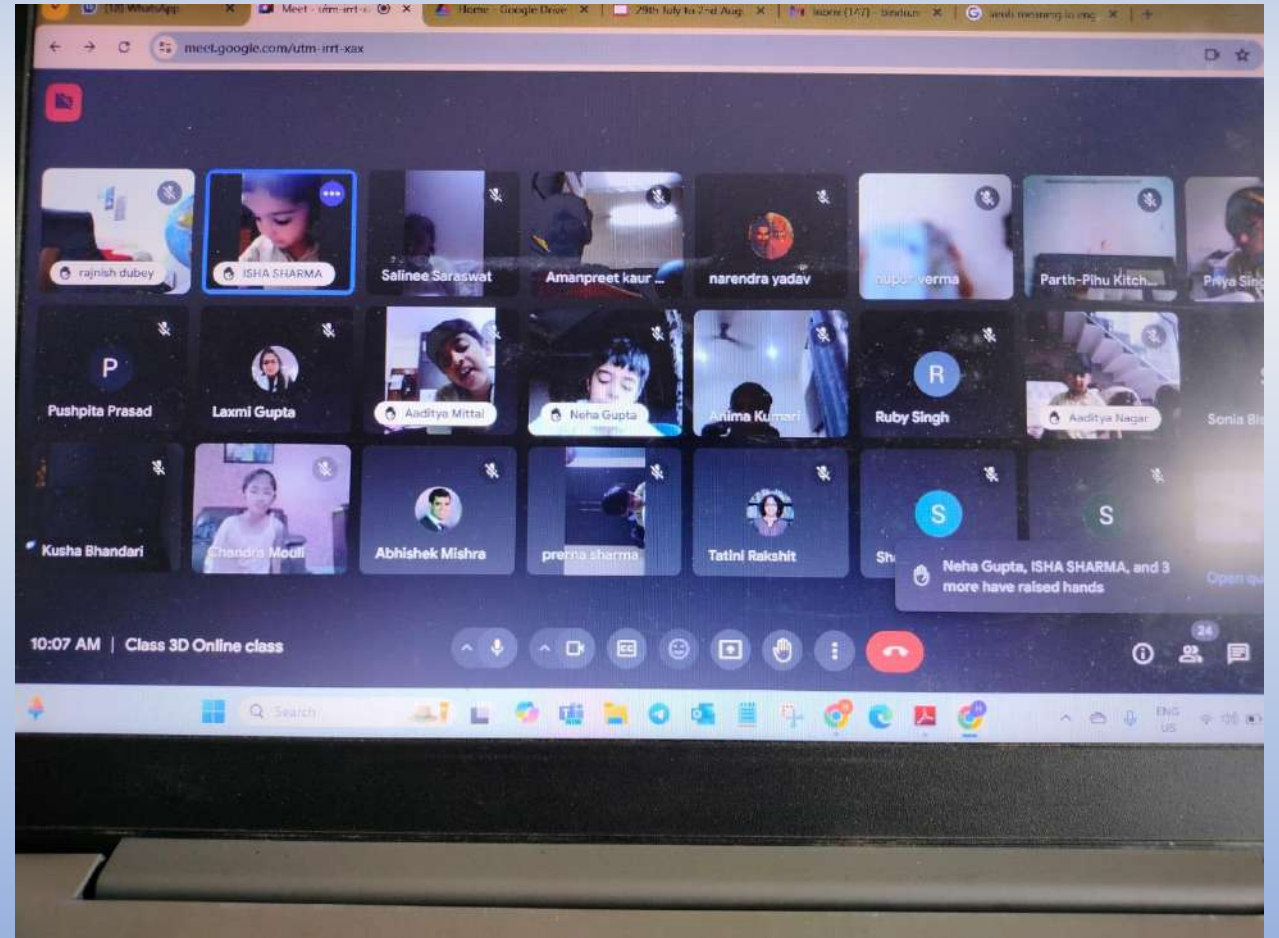

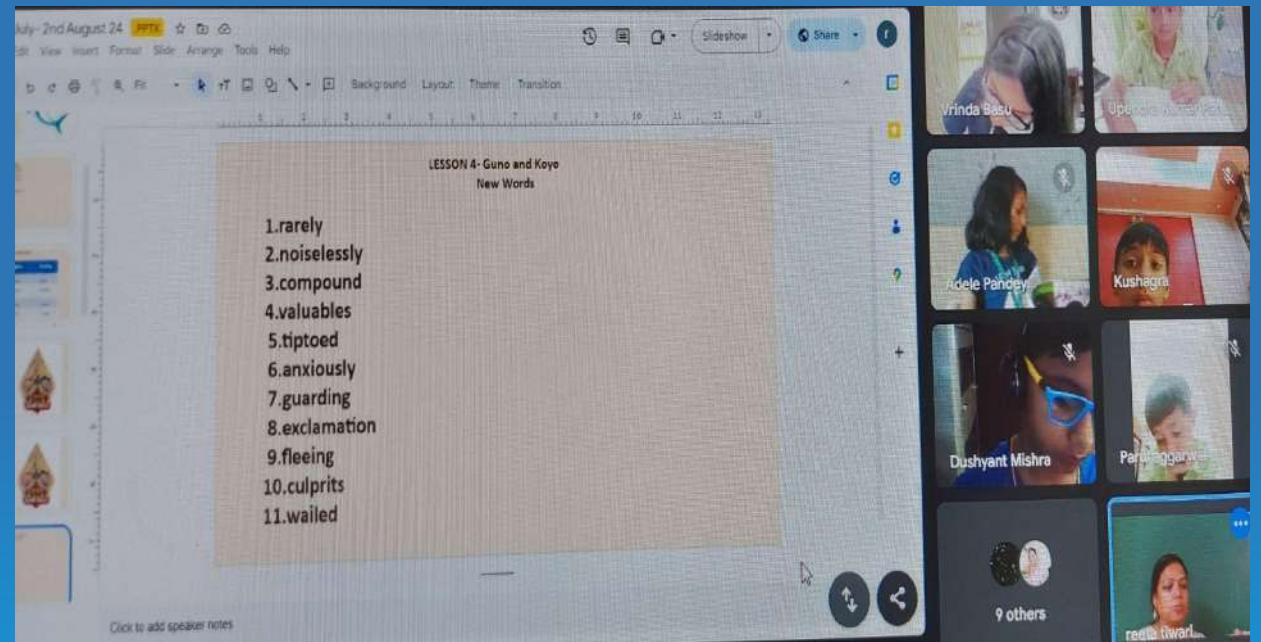
ENVIRONMENTAL SCIENCE

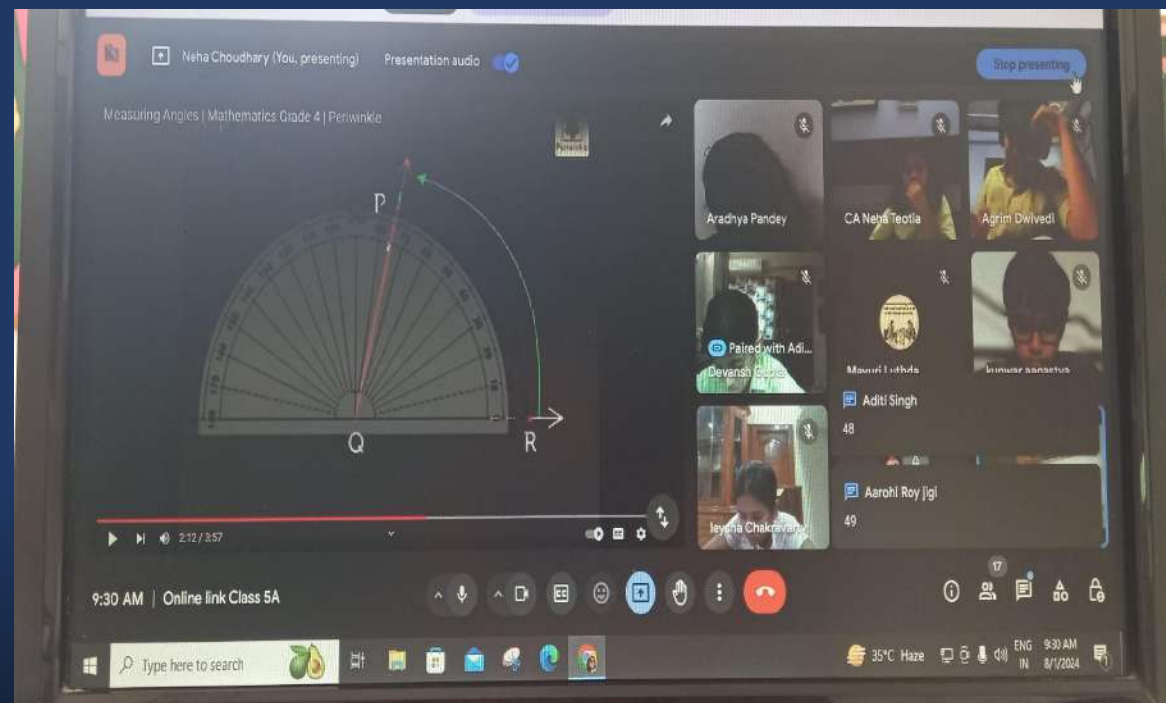
हिंदी
