# NURSERY

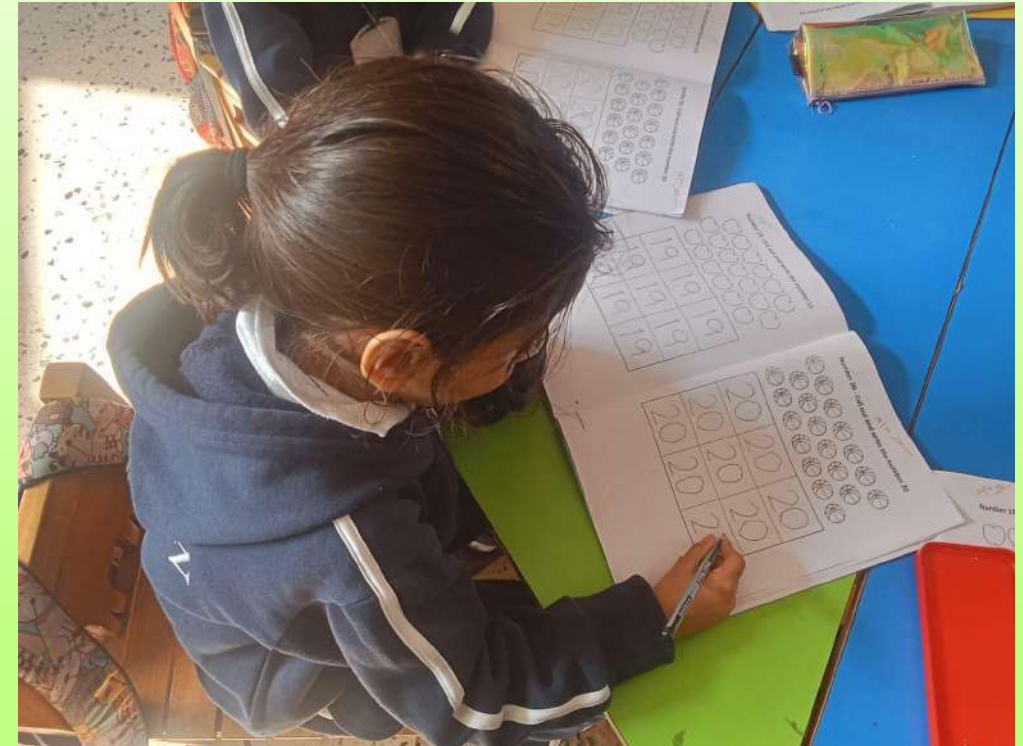


## ENGLISH

Number 20 was introduced to the students. They did counting of number 20 using fish blocks and also practiced writing the number in their workbook.



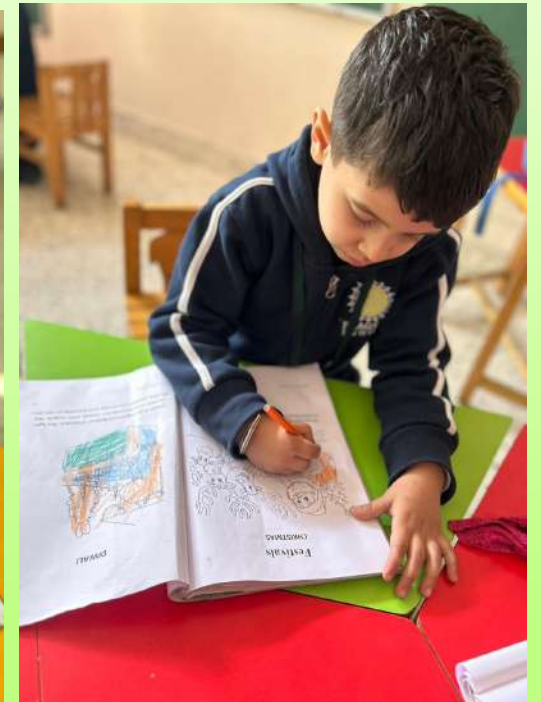
# HINDI

# KINDERGARTEN



## MATHS

Students of kindergarten practiced worksheets based on descending order along with the writing in sequence from 100- 190 in their notebooks. Introduction of counting from 190-200 was done during the week.

# ENGLISH

Students of kindergarten were introduced to 'it' and 'id' family words. They wrote three letter words and sentences in their notebook. Students did worksheets related to the concept. They also practiced writing simple sentences related to family words in their notebook.

As part of the reading scheme, students of kindergarten revised the story of Ben's hen and were introduced to a new story 'A red hen'. They made an effort to read the story in groups and individually.



# HINDI

Children of kindergarten were introduced to vyanjan ढ and ढ through pictures, flashcards and stories. Students practiced writing these vyanjans and did colouring worksheets related to them.



# GENERAL AWARENESS

In continuation with the theme seasons, Autumn season was introduced during class discussion. Children enjoyed colouring worksheets and also learnt a few lines related to the topic.

Music plays an important role in our life. Students of nursery and kindergarten enjoyed learning Christmas carols during music class.



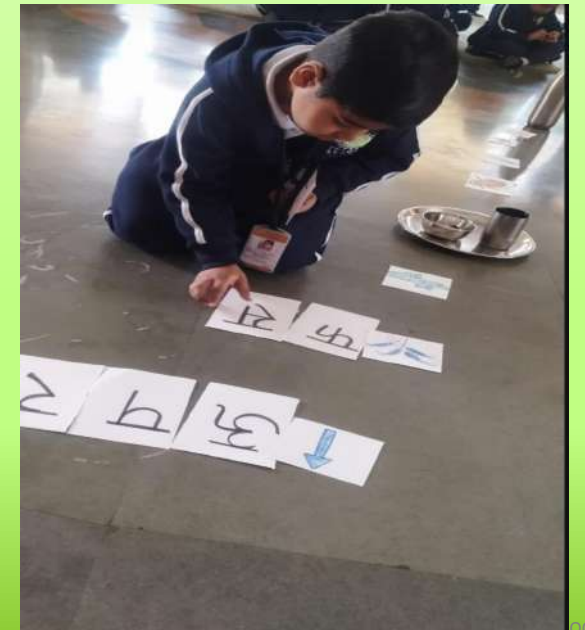
# INTERCLASS WEEKLY ACTIVITY(NUR & KG)

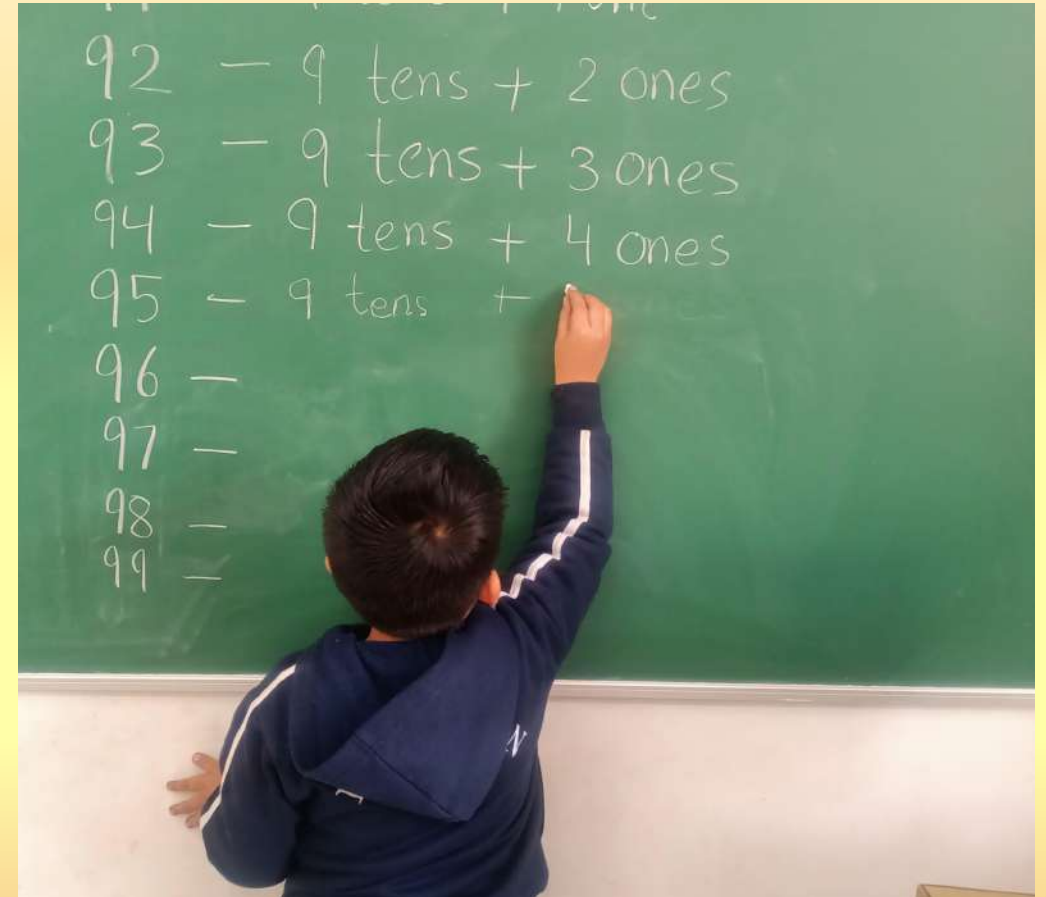




# Math

# हिन्दी

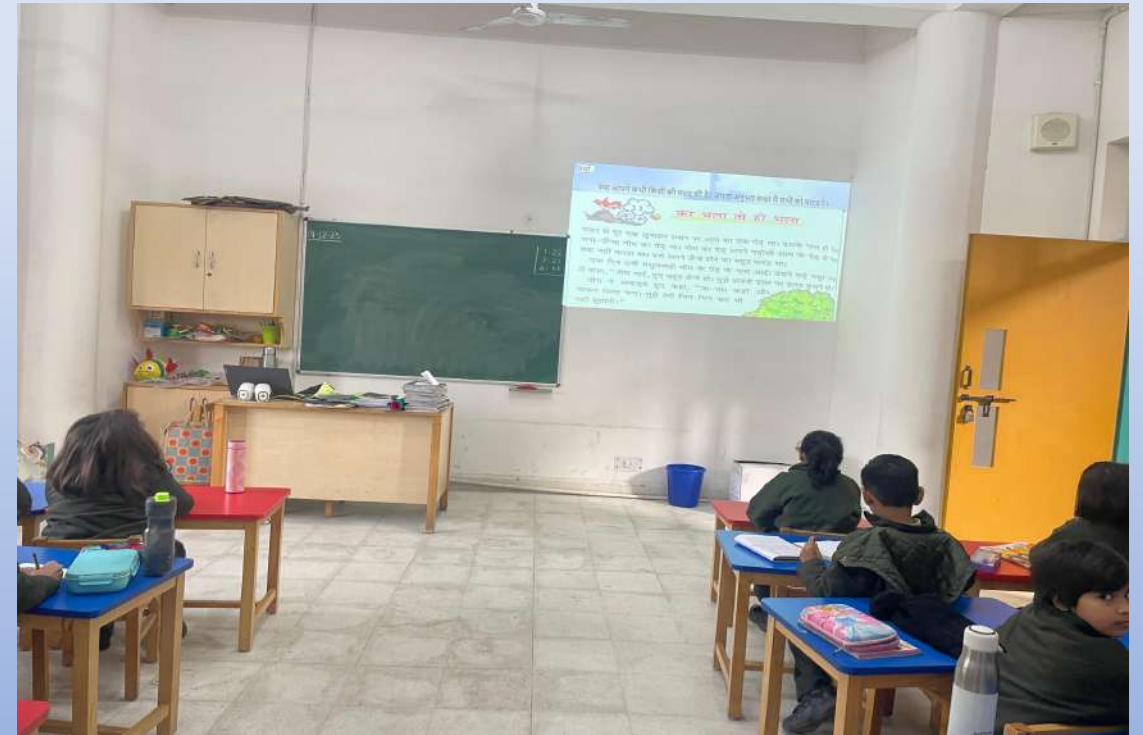

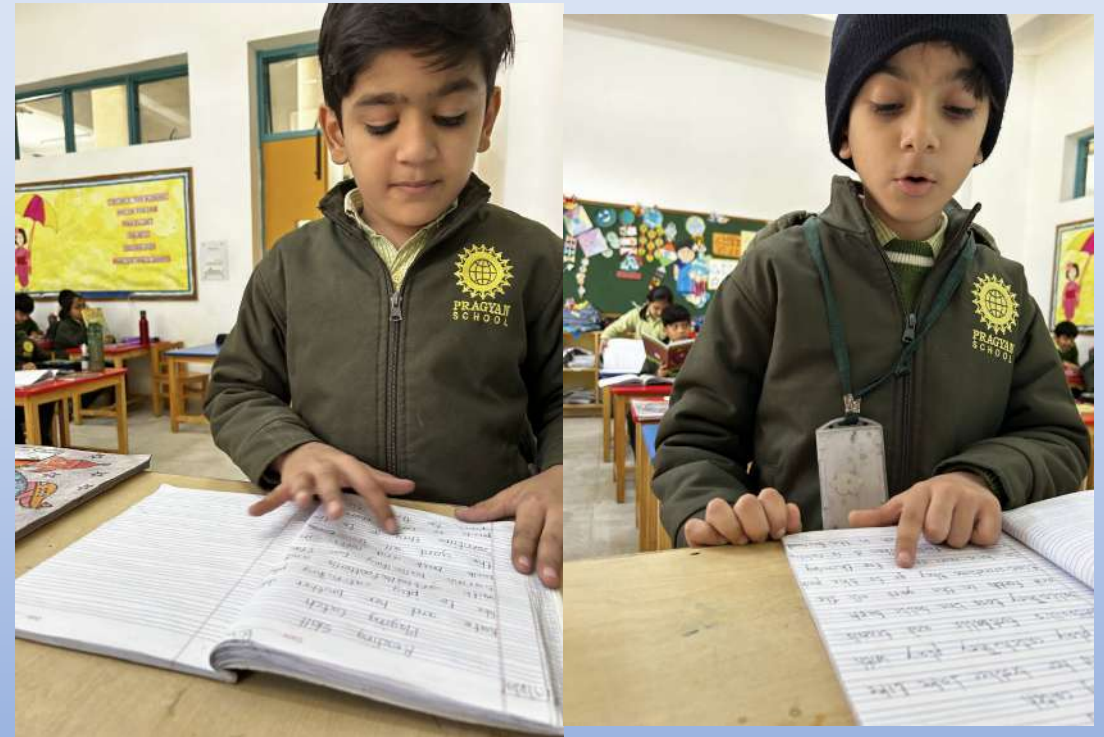
# हिन्दी

# COMPUTER(1&2)

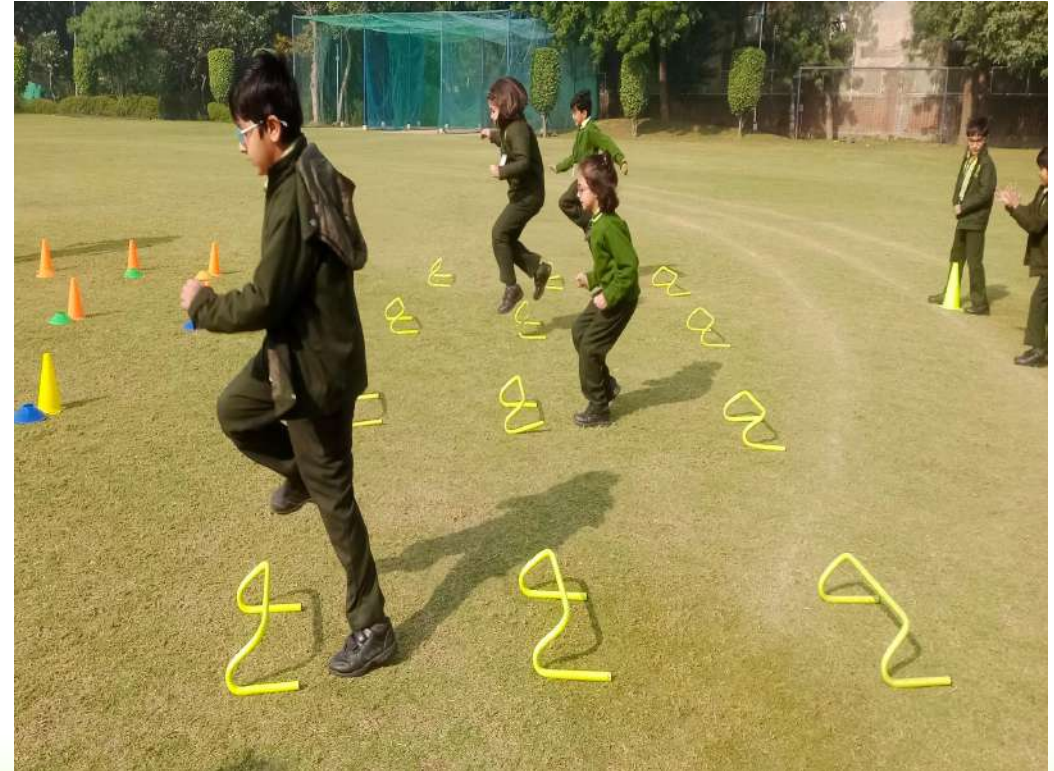
Students of class 1 made beautiful Christmas poster in Tux Paint with the help of stamps and paint brush.

Students of class 4 studied viram chihan & samvad lekhan this week. They completed all the exercises related to both the topics in their Hindi Workbook.

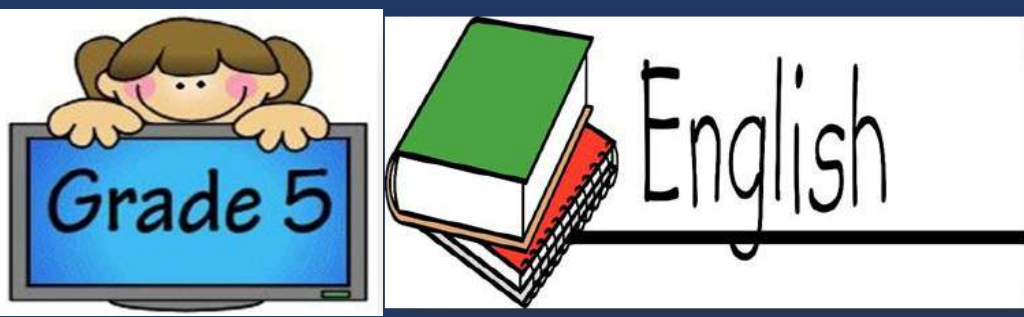




# ENVIRONMENTAL SCIENCE

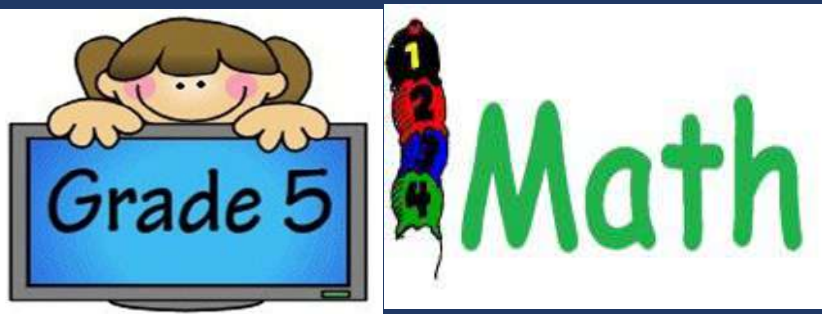
