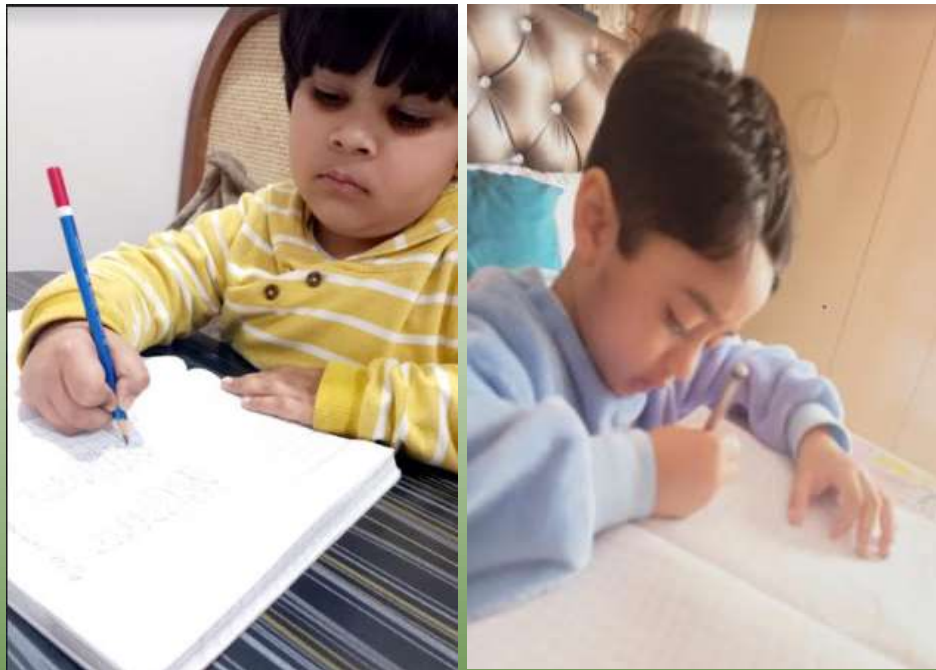

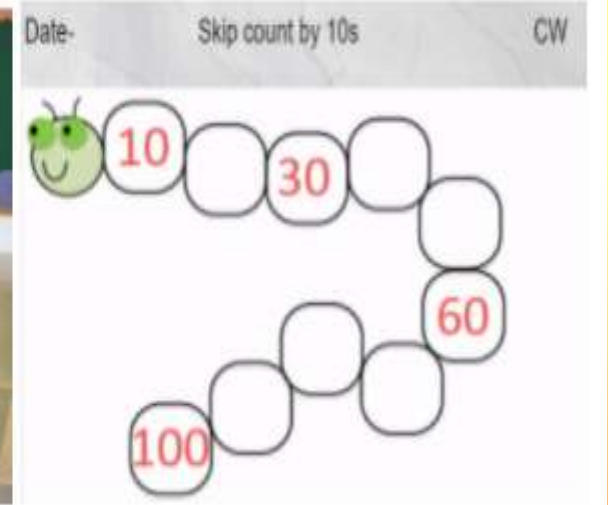
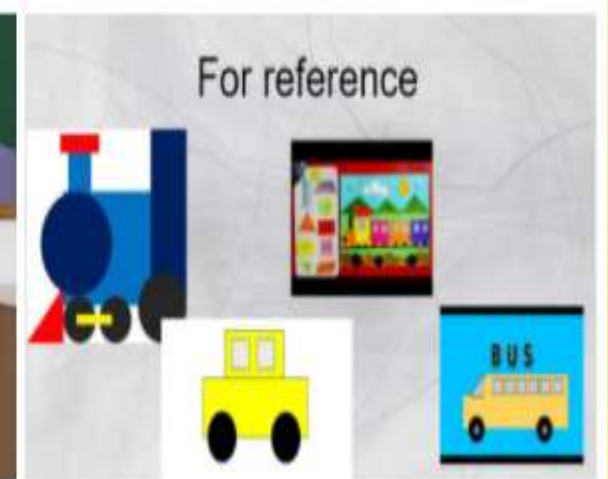
EVS - Revision of different birds were done in the EVS class. Students enjoyed watching the video related to the topic.

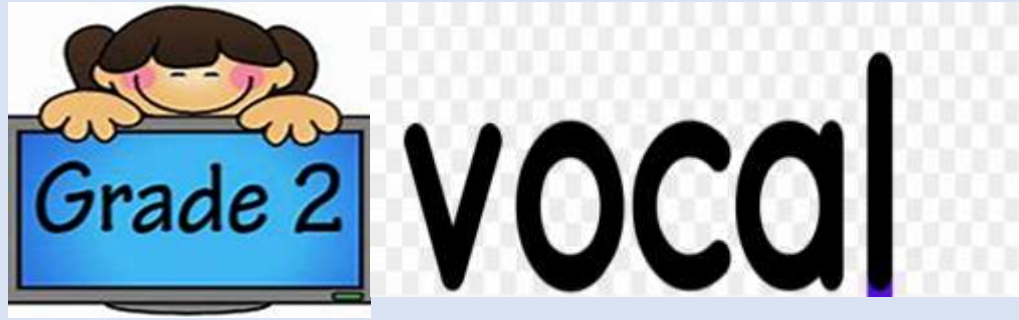

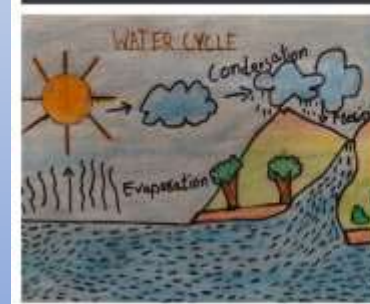
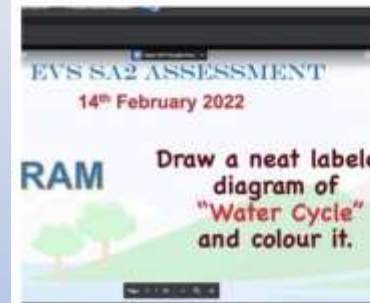

She had an image among her friends and she wanted to protect it.

4. Why did the children urge Pia to bring her pet to her class?
Ans. The children were very excited to hear that Pia had a pet monkey and that too of a rare breed. They wanted to see the monkey and know about what she wore and ate and how she behaved. So they urged Pia to bring her pet to the class.



ENVIRONMENTAL SCIENCE

With the ongoing SA 2 Assessment cycle, the scheduled minor assessments on EVS were conducted throughout the week. Assessments on EVS Diagram, EVS Orals and activity was part of it. The EVS Diagram was on the structure of a seed, Orals were from L-26: Water and Air. The EVS activity on 'Unsung Heroes of India' was based on the less acclaimed freedom fighters of India.

Rani Gaidinliu

Rani Gaidinliu was a Naga spiritualist who revolted against the British rule in India and was also strongly against converting Naga religious practitioners into Christianity. At the age of 13, she initiated the Heraka movement to drive the British away from Manipur. She got arrested at the age of 16 and was put into life imprisonment by the British. Five years later, Nehru promised to get her out and gave her the title 'Rani'. She was released.

Batukeshwar Dutt

Batukeshwar Dutt was an Indian socialist revolutionary and independence fighter in the early 1900s. He was born on 18th November, 1910. He is best known for having exploded two bombs, along with Bhagat Singh, in the Central Legislative Assembly in New Delhi on 8 April 1929.

After they were arrested, tried and imprisoned for life, he and Singh initiated a historic hunger strike protesting against the abusive treatment of Indian political prisoners and eventually the British gave rights for them.

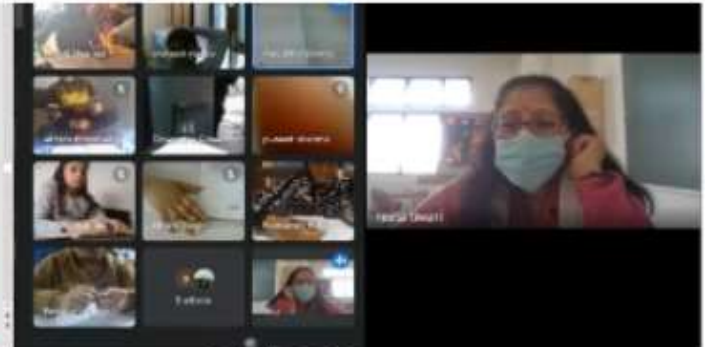

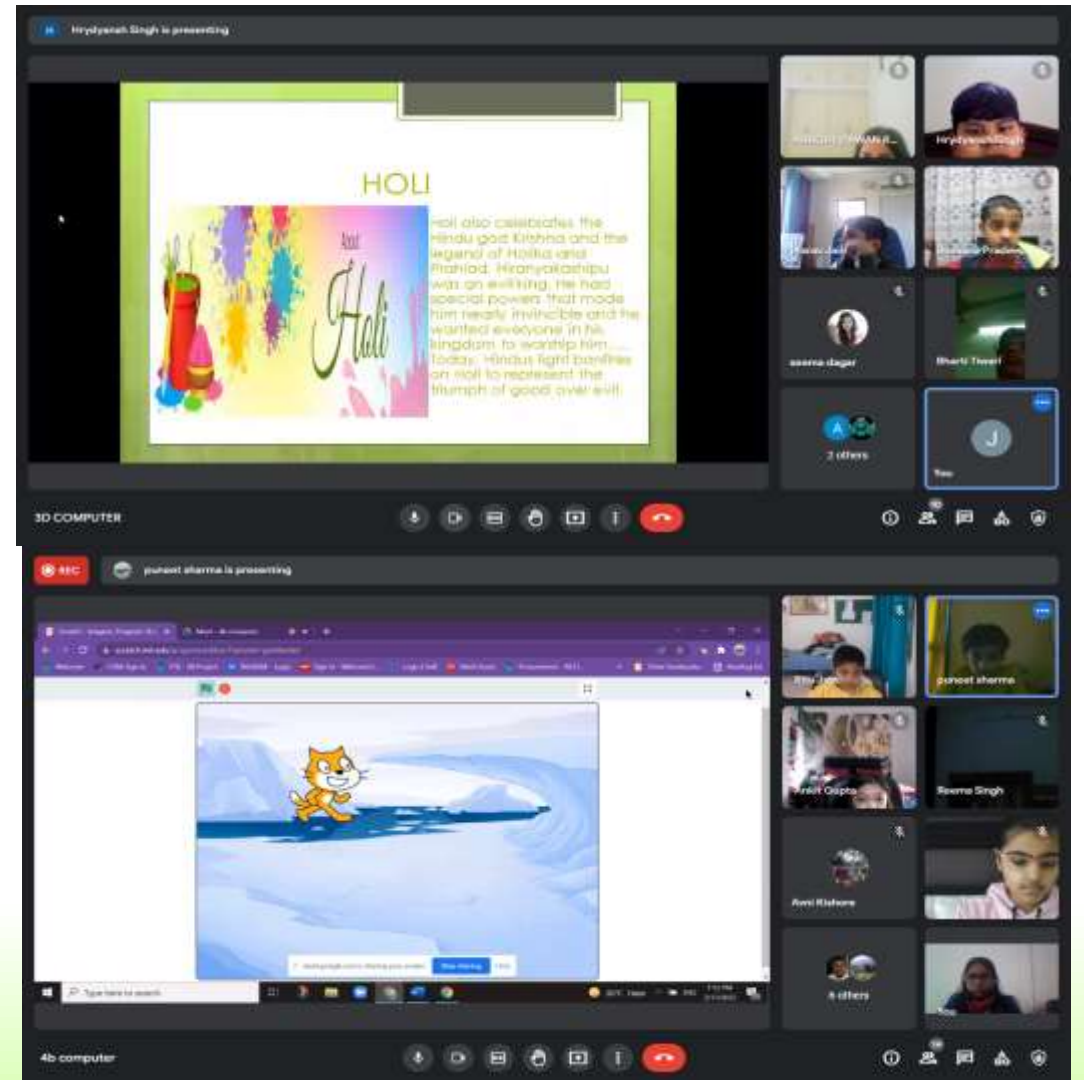


COMPUTER (3-5)

Students of Grade 3 learnt some more features of Ms-powerpoint like adding of pictures and background. They have also made presentation on the topic HOLI.



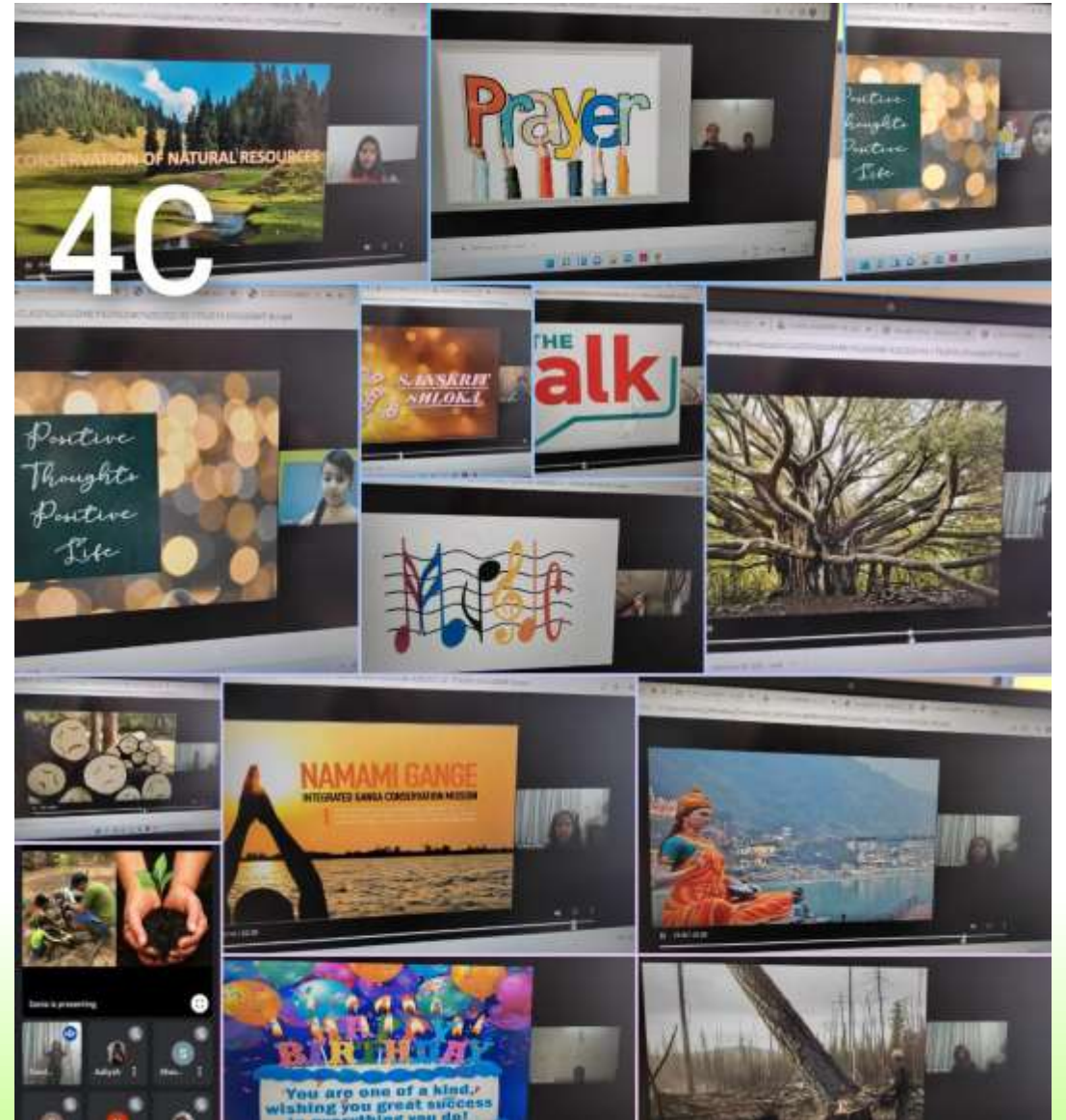
CLASS ASSEMBLY (3A) : ASSEMBLY ON WORLD AROUND US

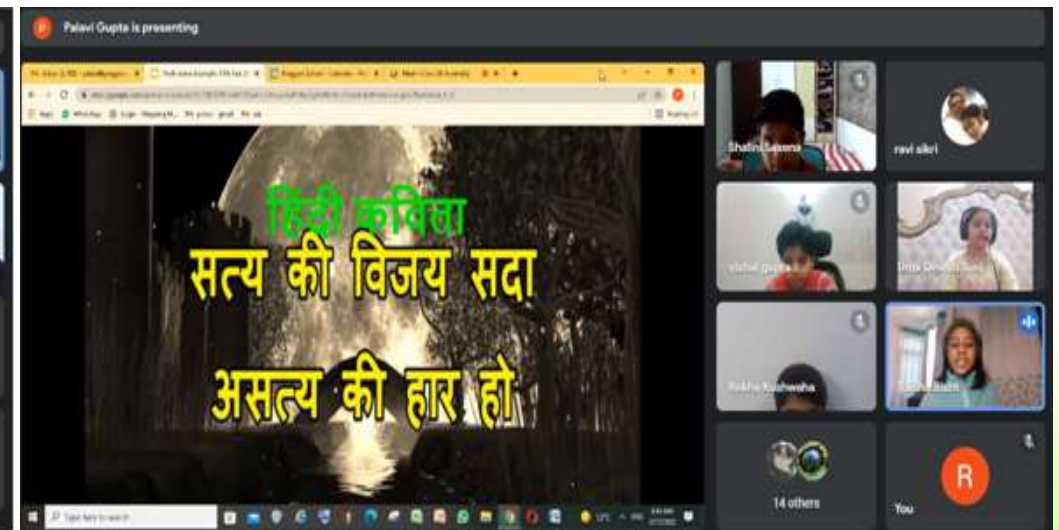
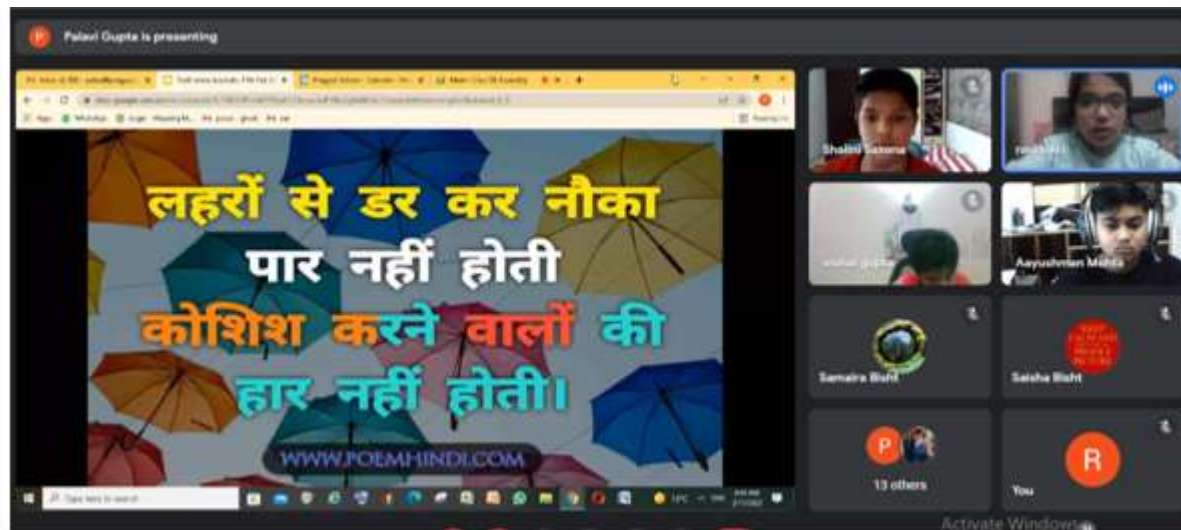
CLASS ASSEMBLY (4C)
