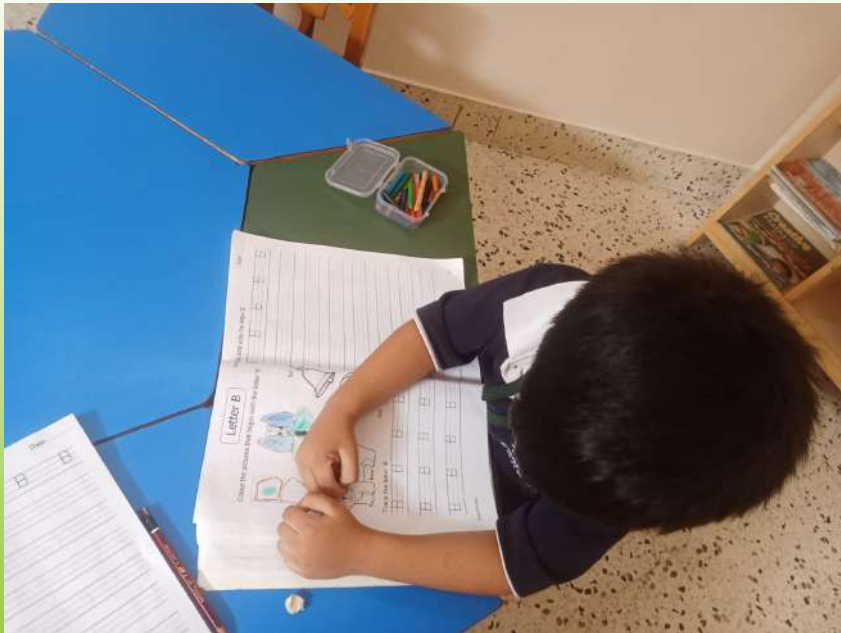

# NURSERY



## ENGLISH

# KINDERGARTEN

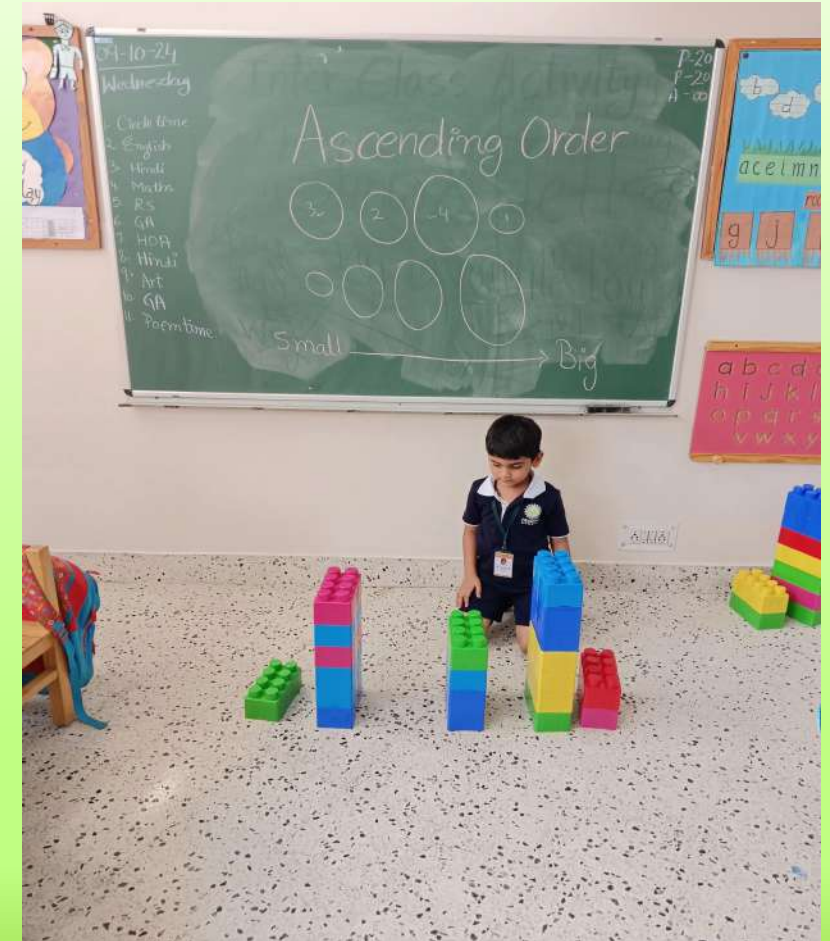
## ENGLISH



Sight words were revised with the students and the letter "y" was introduced using its phonetic sound. The students actively participated by identifying and sharing words that start with "y." They also completed a worksheet on the letter "y" to reinforce their learning.

# MATHS

This week, our young mathematicians explored the concept of ascending order in a fun and interactive way, using colorful blocks of varying sizes, students arranged them from smallest to largest, learning how to organize numbers in a step-by-step sequence. This activity not only made the learning experience enjoyable but also helped reinforce their understanding of ordering numbers visually and practically.



# HINDI

Students were introduced to the vyanjan र. To make learning more engaging, students were encouraged to colour pictures beginning with vyanjan र. This helped them associate visual creativity with language learning.



# GENERAL AWARENESS

Students of kindergarten learnt about India and Turkey. They tried to locate the two countries on the globe. They were made aware of the flag of Turkey and the comparison between the flags of India and Turkey. They compared the two flags by their colour and symbols. Students were made aware of the national flower of India (Lotus) and that of Turkey (Tulip).



# EASP

This week kids were engaged in a fun and challenging Hat race where they cross hurdles and reach designated cones. At each cone, they placed a marker on top, mimicking a hat. This exercise allowed physical coordination, agility, and balance, while also encouraging teamwork and focus as they navigated the hurdles and completed the task efficiently.



# MUSIC

A delightful music can make children happy and joyful. Feelings of joy and happiness play a vital role in child development. This week in music students learned 'Saja do ghar ko gulshan sa.....' demonstrating improved pitch and rhythm awareness.



# HANDS ON ACTIVITY (KG)

The students revised their sight words in an engaging way by jumping on the words and recognizing them independently. They also created two-letter words using flashcards, which further enhanced their understanding. This interactive activity was thoroughly enjoyed by the students.





## ENGLISH

During this week students did the reading of passages named Tick-Tock and Mink's piggy bank. Teacher read the passage and asked questions to understand and develop their listening skills. Listening to stories or passages exposes children to new words and concepts, helping to expand their vocabulary and understanding of language.

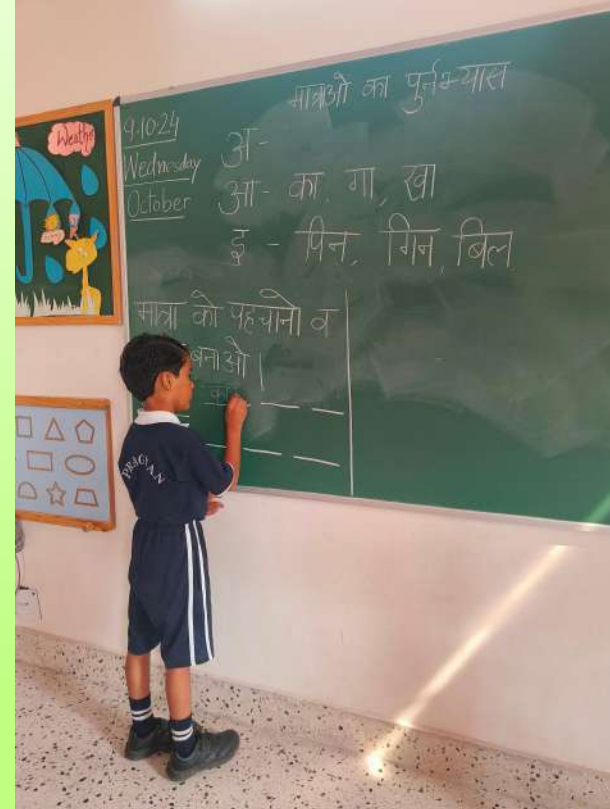
# MATHS

During this week students practiced skip counting by 3's ,10's, number names 1-10, what comes after before and in between for (100-200 ). They revised the above concepts in the form of worksheets in their workbook. Skip counting by 3s and 10s allowed children to build number sense, understand multiplication and place value, and develop strategies for problem-solving, making these skills valuable for their early math development.



# HINDI

During this week students recapitulated आ,इ matra. Students were made to recognise matra and write two words related to each matra.



# GENERAL AWARENESS

Students of UKG were introduced to the differences between Asia and Antarctica, focusing on their distinct habitats and animals. It was a valuable insight for the students, where they got the opportunity to explore. Students revised the facts and showcased them through a presentation at the Gala day event that helped them reinforce their understanding.



# HANDS ON ACTIVITY (UKG)

During this week students had done skip by 3 's and 10's. Skip counting enables children to count faster and more efficiently. Instead of counting each number one by one, they learn to group numbers, which is particularly useful for counting large sets of objects.



# SKILL BASED LEARNING

This week, our Kindergarten and UKG students accomplished a wonderful milestone by setting up a table all on their own in class. Through this skill based learning, they developed several essential skills. They practiced teamwork as they collaborated to complete the task, enhanced their fine motor skills by carefully placing items like plates, spoons, and napkins, and demonstrated responsibility by taking ownership of their individual roles. Additionally, they gained an understanding of basic etiquette by recognizing the importance of maintaining a neat and organized dining setup.

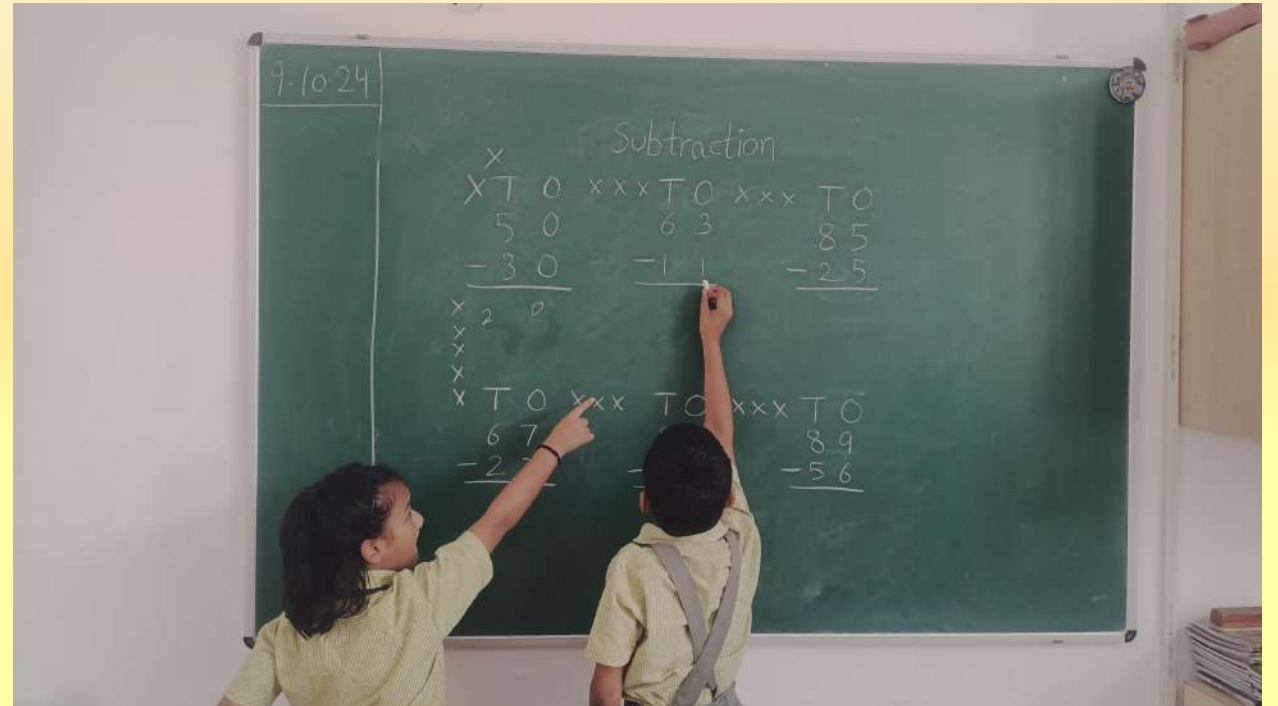
# ENVIRONMENTAL SCIENCE

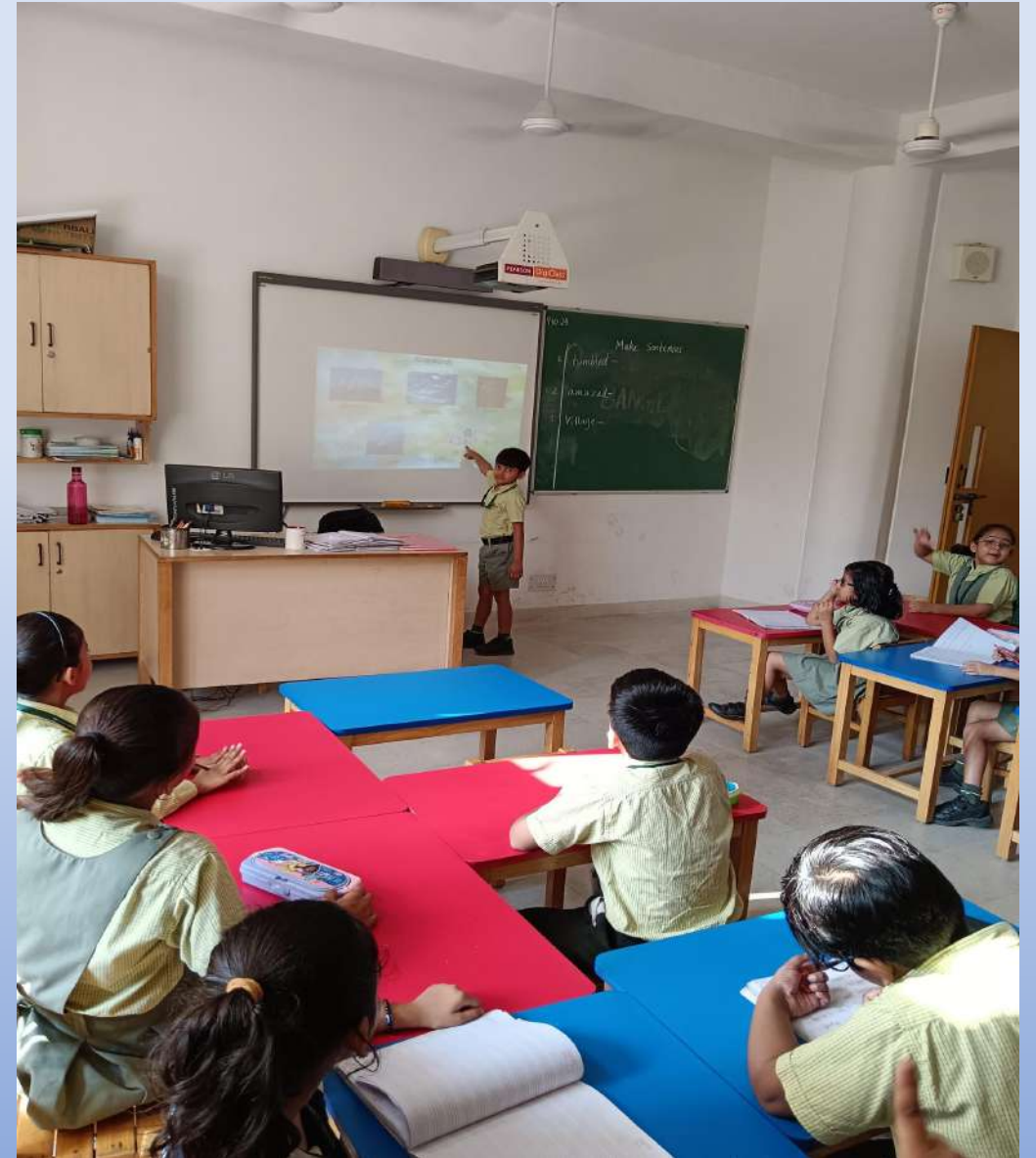
# हिन्दी

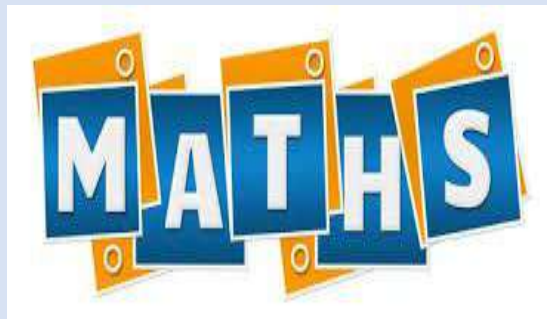
The children of class 2 were enthusiastic and enjoyed the learning of action words. They participated in a fun art activity. They drew pictures of themselves doing different actions. This activity helped them learn and understand action words better. Next, they crafted simple sentences using new words of the month. This engaging activity reinforced their understanding of framing sentences.





Class 2 students had a productive week, reading the chapter "FOOD" individually and answering related questions in their notebooks. They also revised the new words related to the chapter and demonstrated their understanding of healthy eating by drawing a balanced plate. This multifaceted approach helped students develop reading comprehension, critical thinking, and creativity skills.





Students of class 2 participated in a thinking routine activity centered around the concept of division through which they were encouraged to think of real life applications of division. They also understood the key terms related to division and did a few worksheets based on the same. They practiced doing division on the number line in the workbook and notebook. Oral revision of tables from 2 to 9 was also done in the class.

# ENVIRONMENTAL SCIENCE

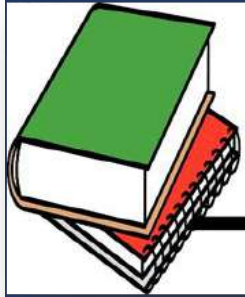
