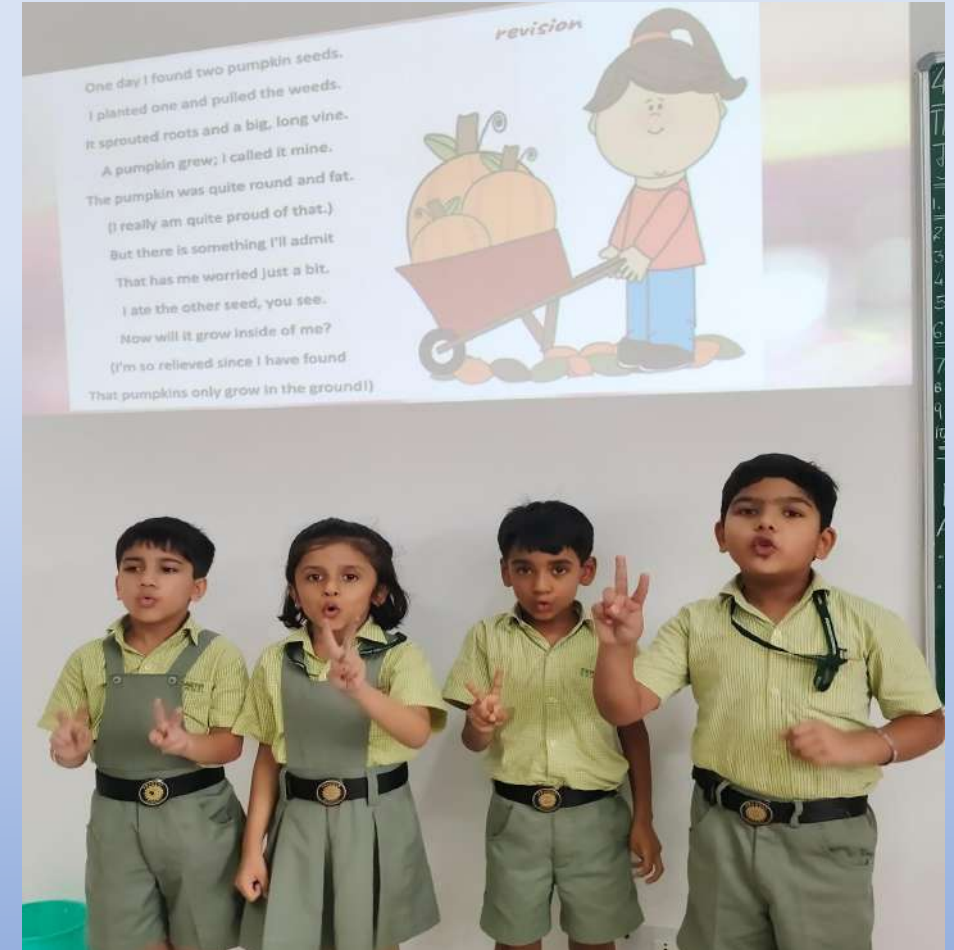
# हिन्दी

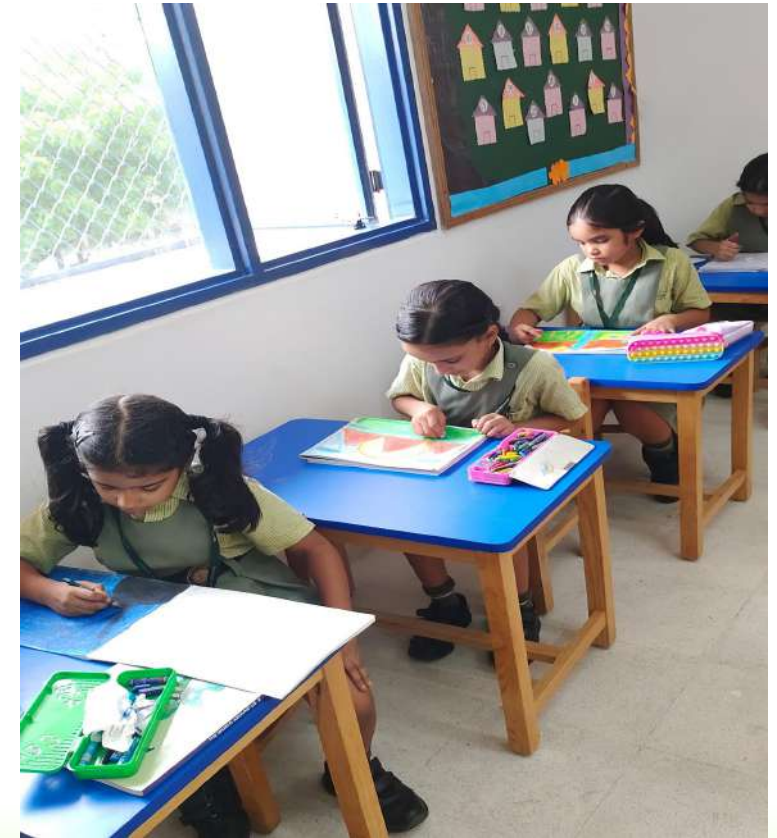
# LIBRARY (1 & 2)

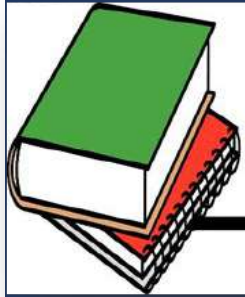




# ENVIRONMENTAL SCIENCE

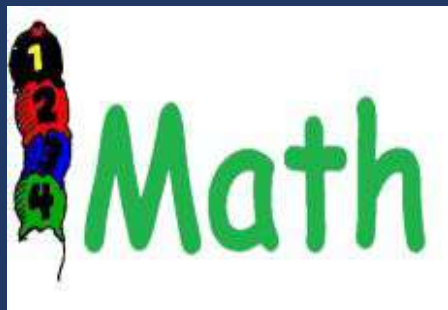




# हिन्दी
