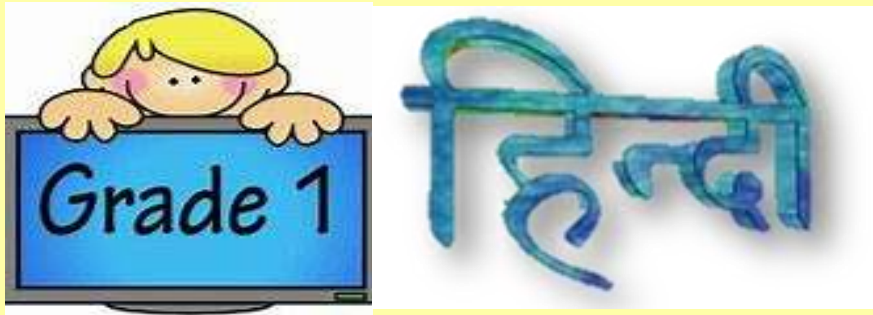

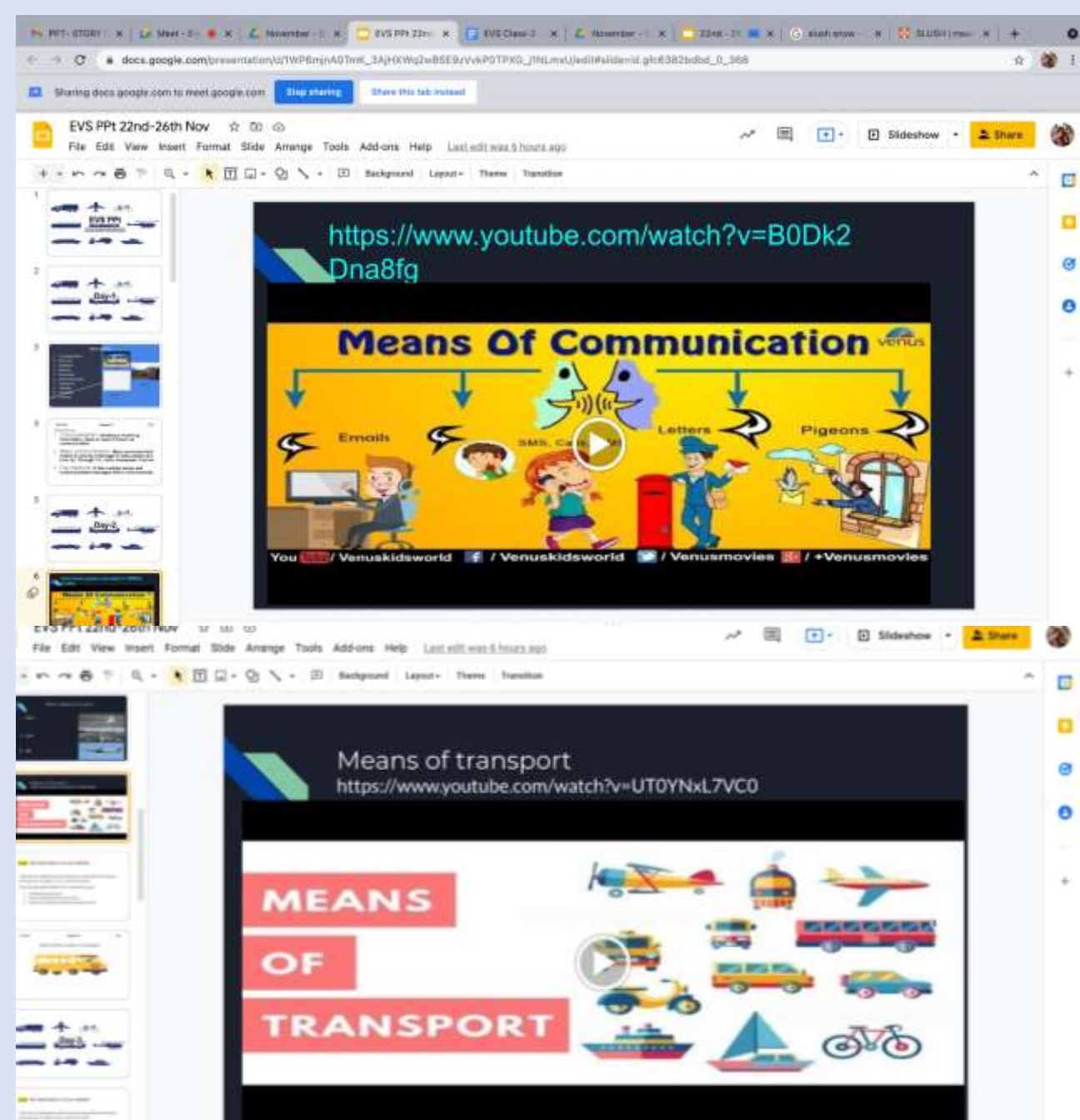


Trees are vital for mankind. As part of the Hindi assessment activity, students of class 2 spoke on the advantages of trees. They also drew a picture related to it.





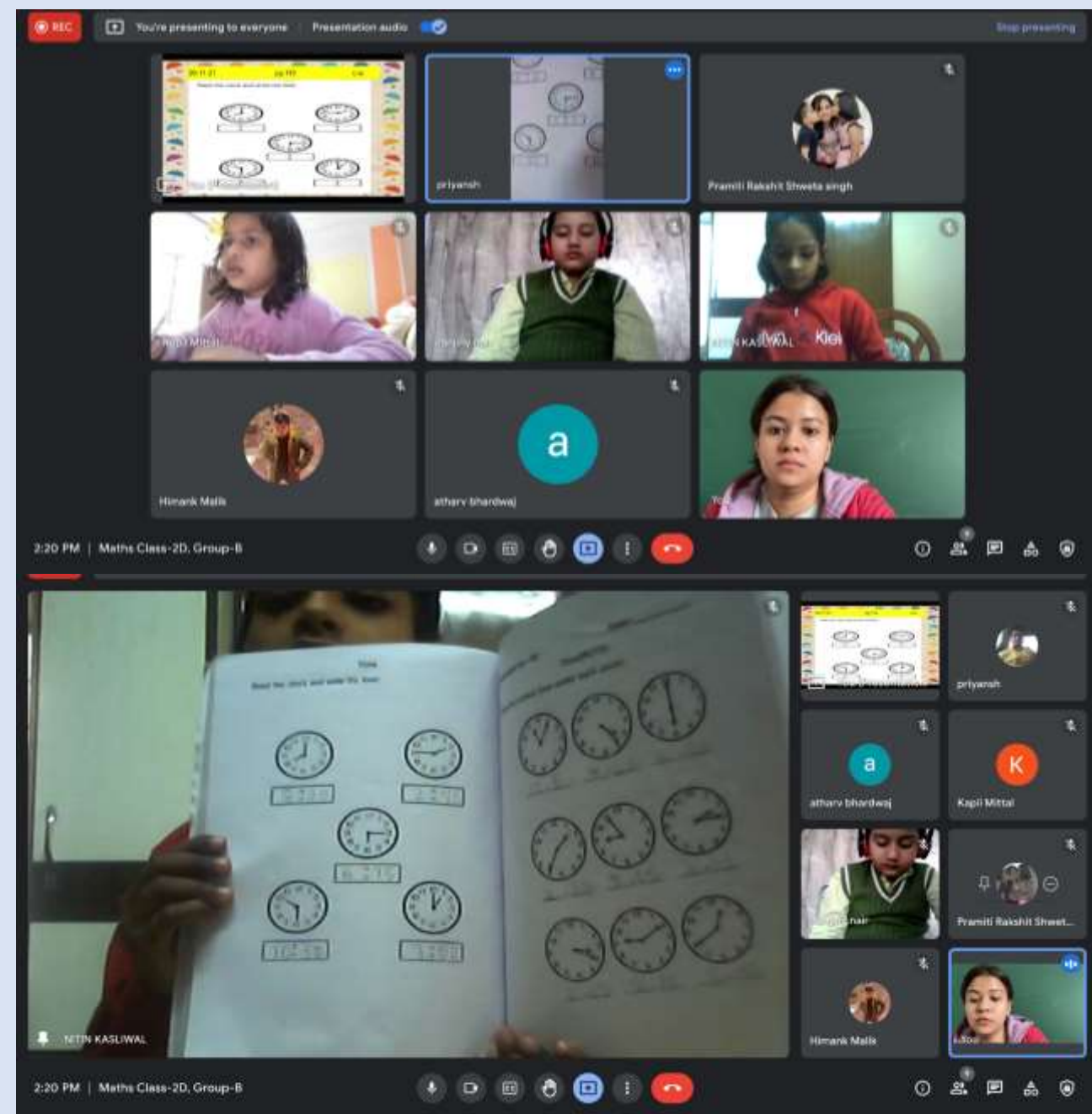
ENVIRONMENTAL SCIENCE

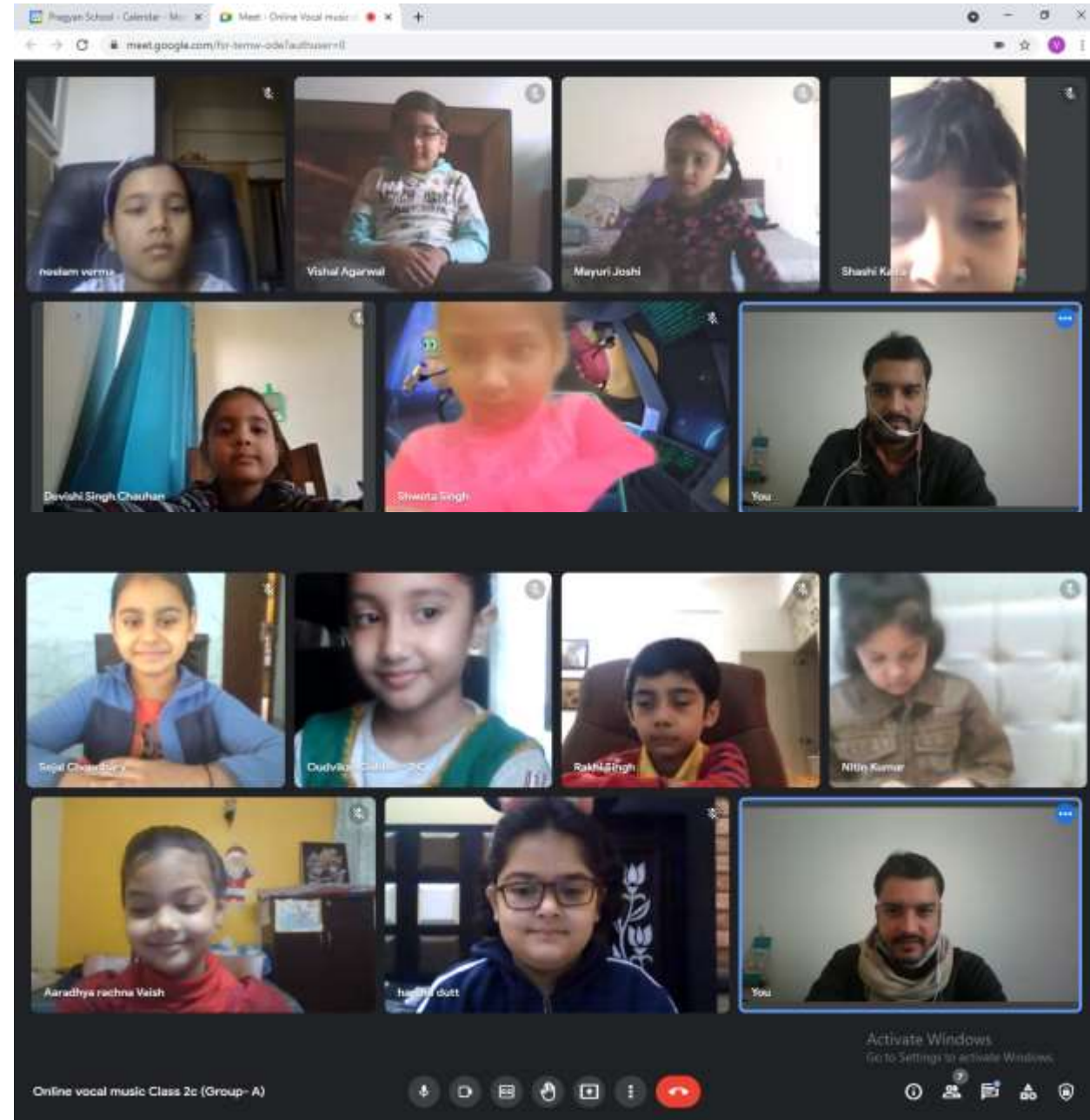

PHYSICAL EXERCISE (1 & 2)

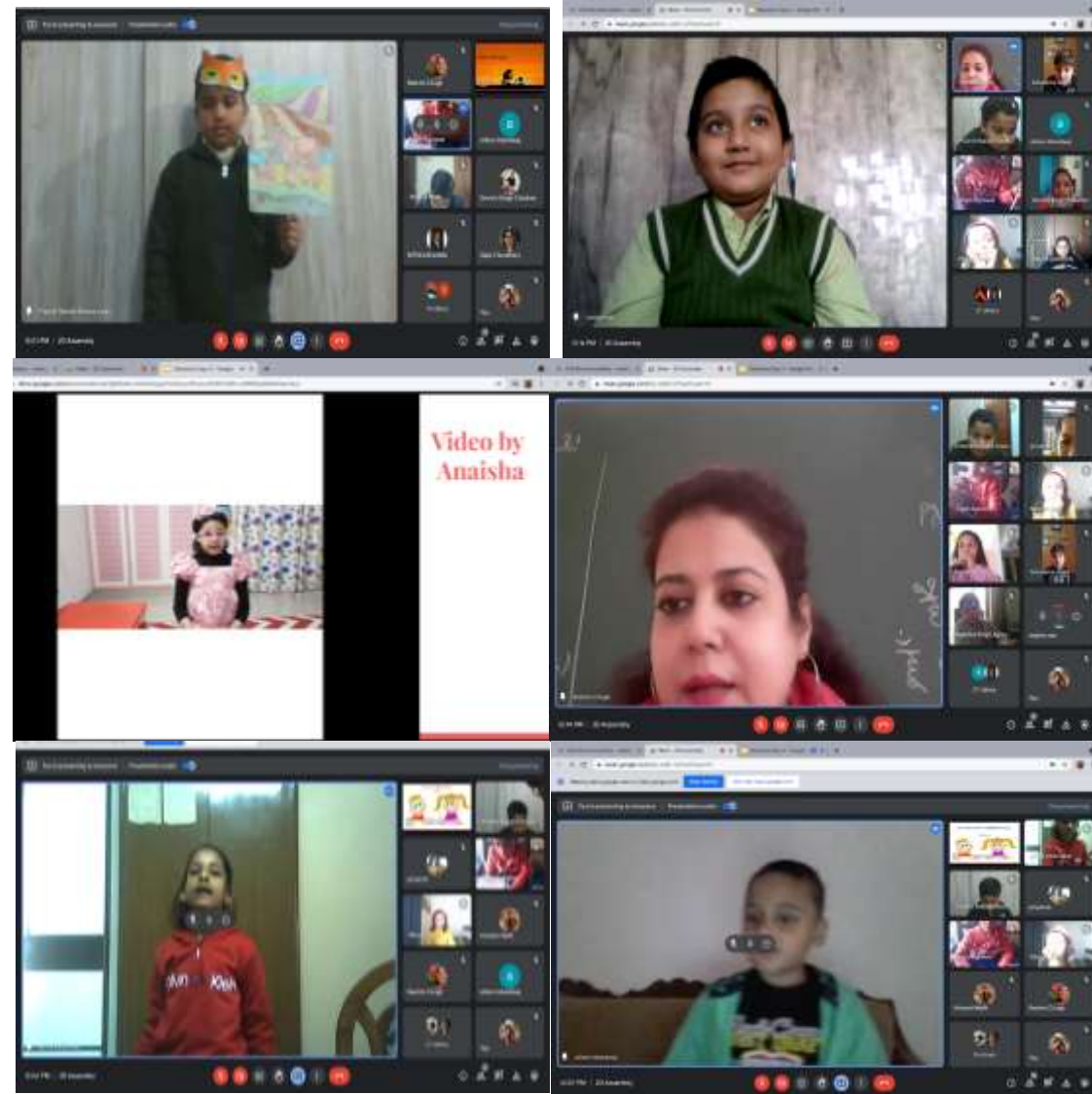

They also participated enthusiastically in activities of physical fitness components development through different drills. Students of online classes learnt yoga asanas and ways to develop physical fitness components. Children enjoyed outdoor activities and on swings. It helps them in overall fitness and being active along with fun. Swinging helps develop gross motor skills—pumping legs, running, jumping. Swinging helps develop fine motor skills—grip strength, hand, arm and finger coordination. Swinging develops a child's core muscles and helps with the development of balance.

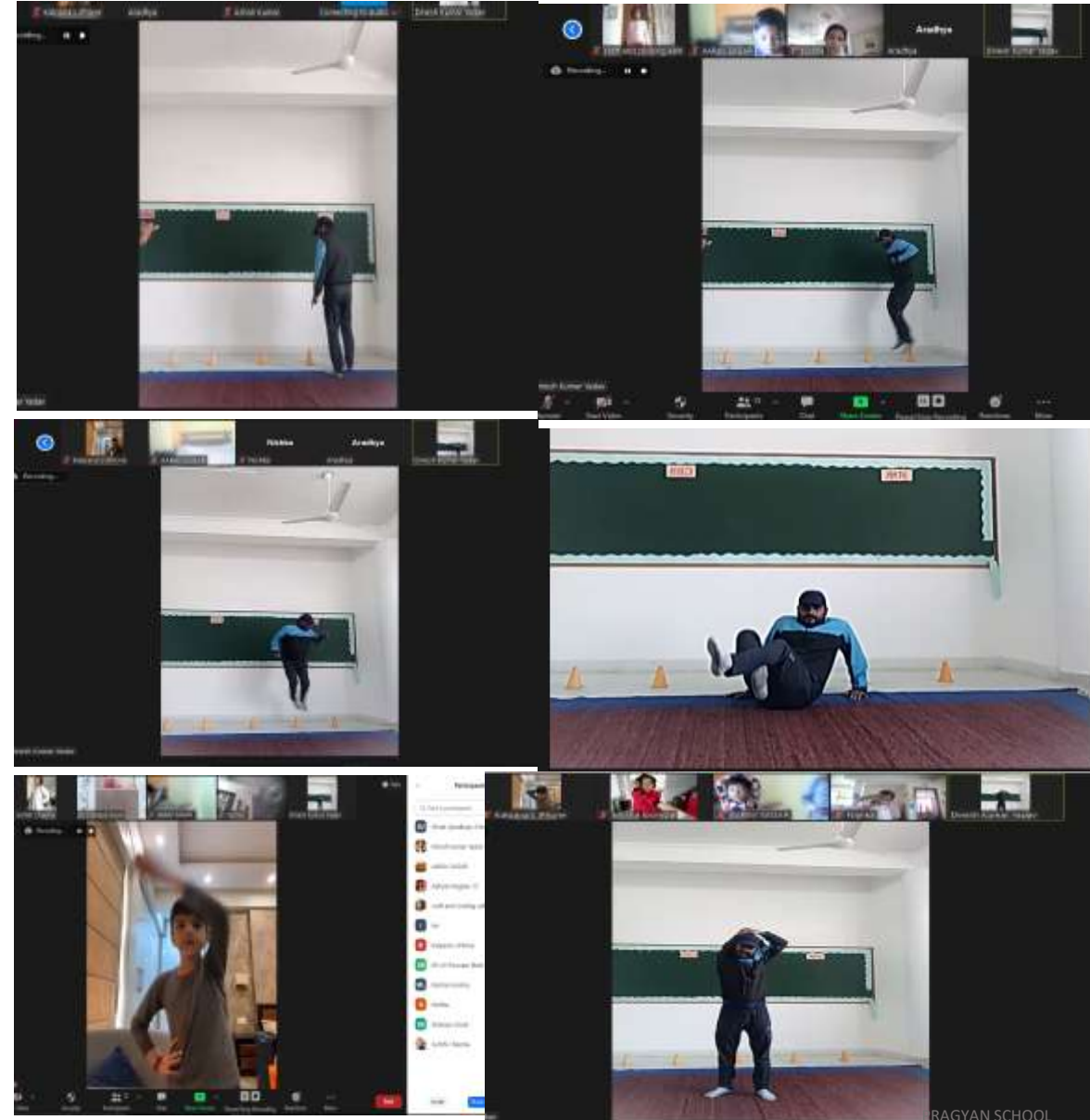
INTER CLASS WEEKLY ACTIVITY- MATHS QUIZ

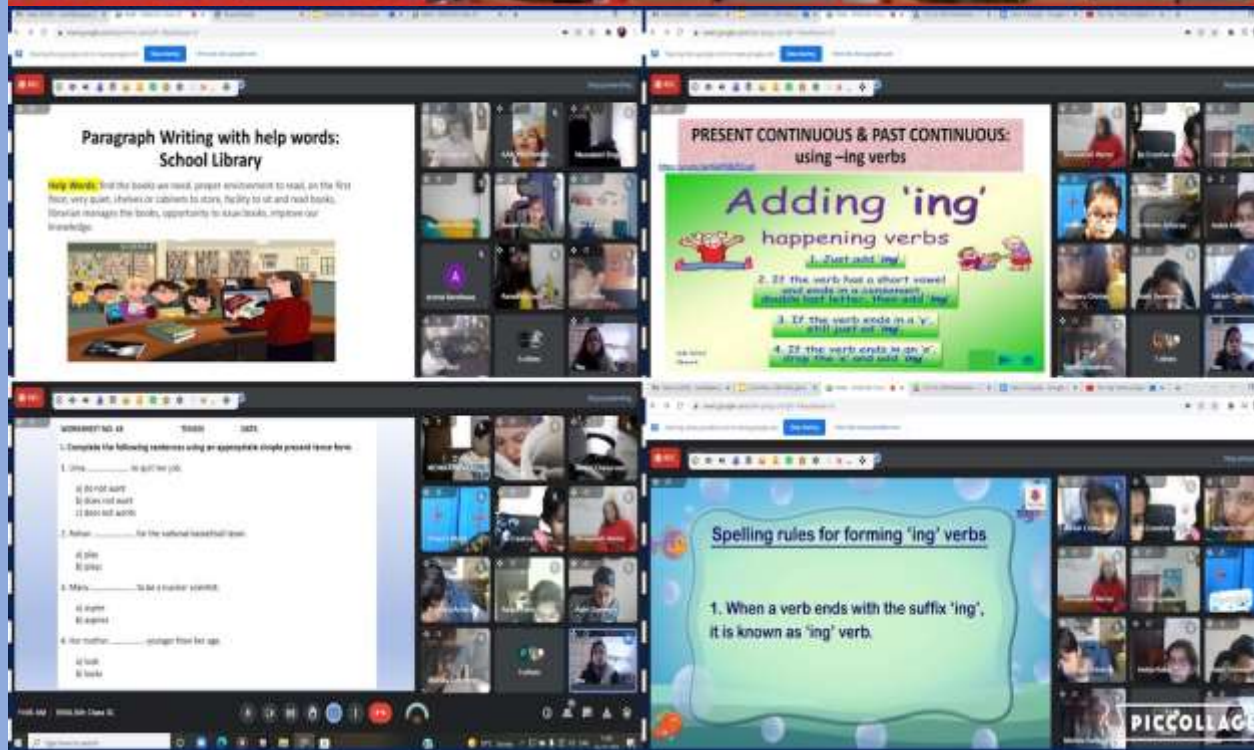
WELLNESS SESSION

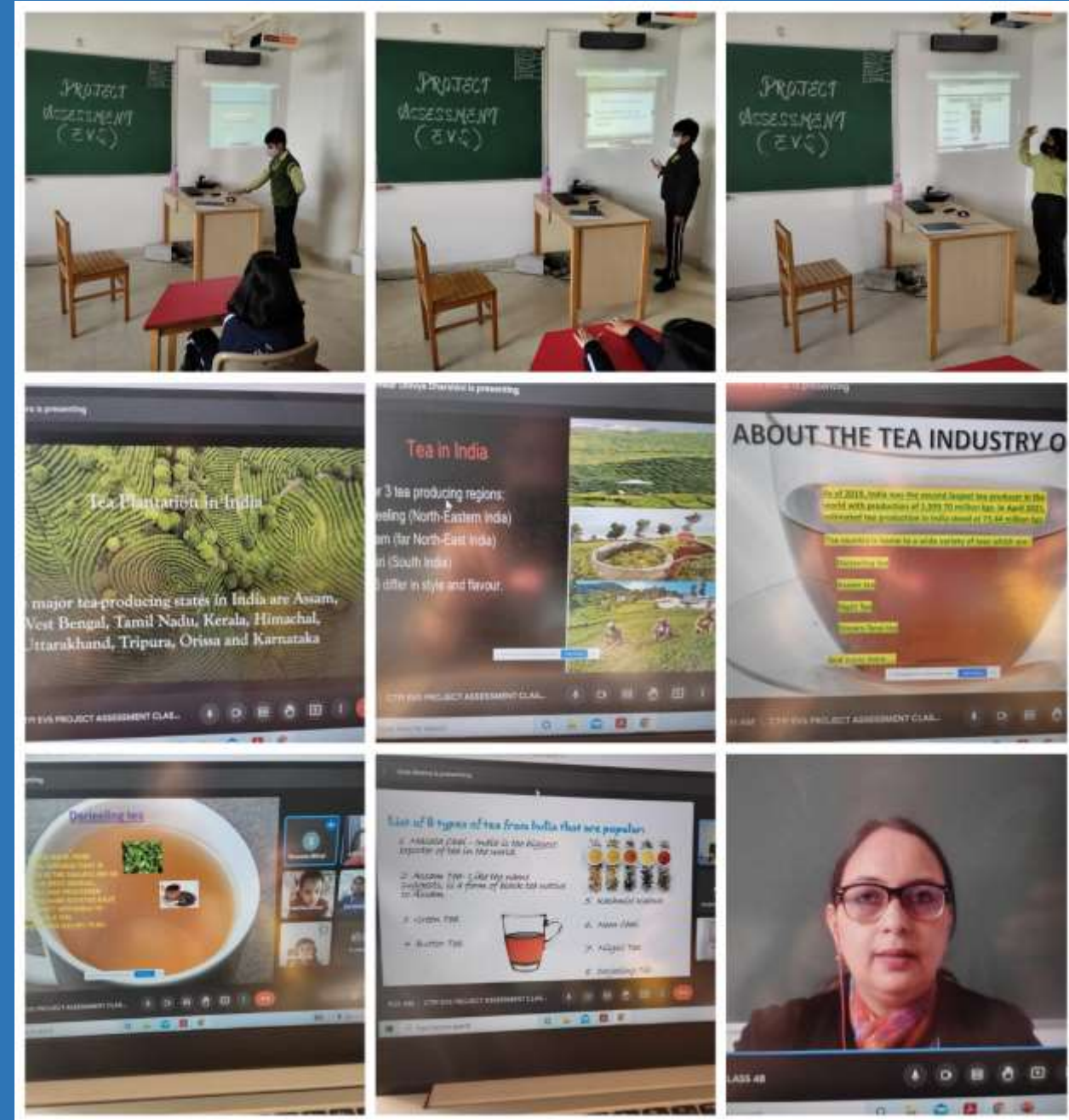


Students of class 3 had their assessments of poem recitation, writing skill and dictation during this week. They also revised the lesson, “Himmat na Haro”.

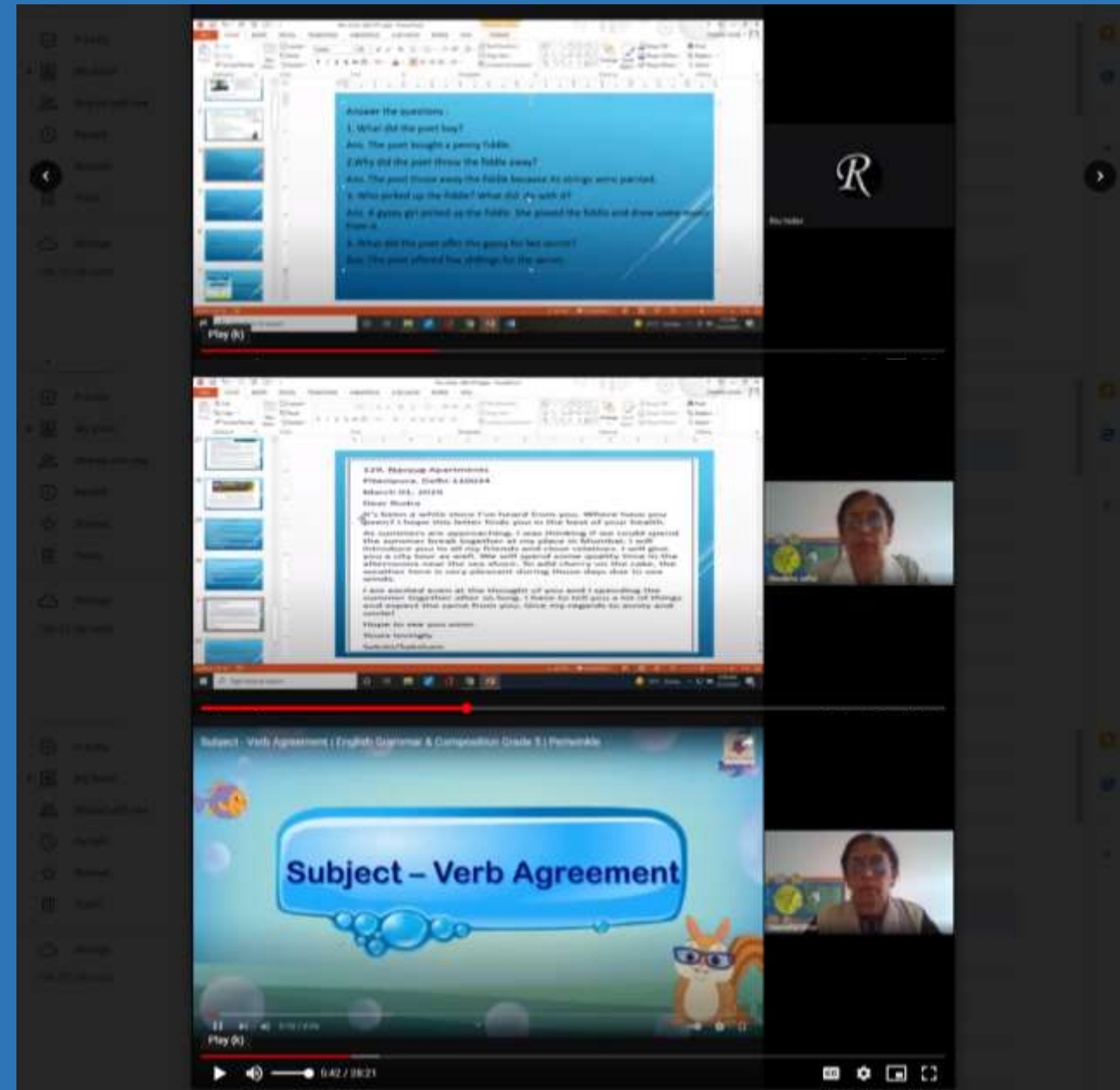




Students of class 4 had the assessments of poem recitation, writing skill and dictation during this week. They also revised kriya in Hindi grammar.

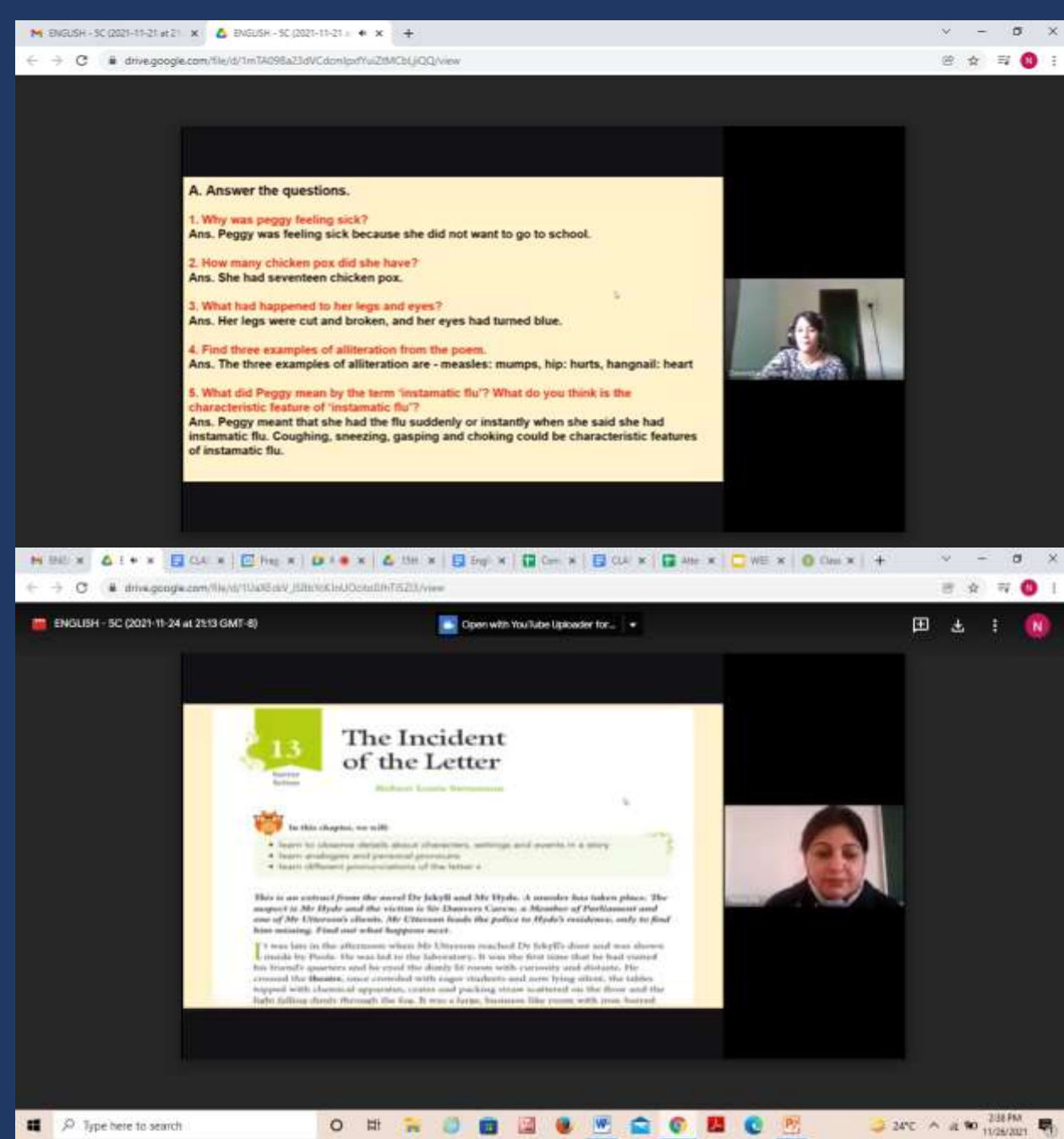

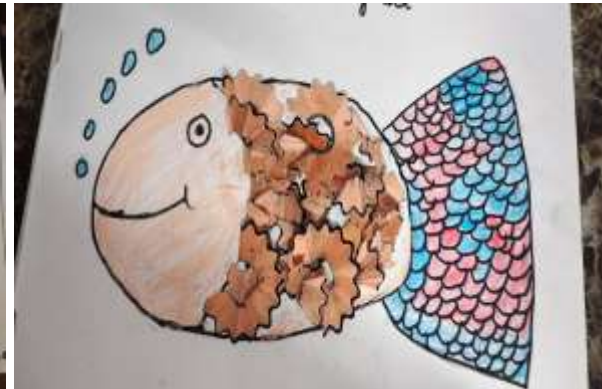

CLASS TEACHER PERIOD (3 - 5)

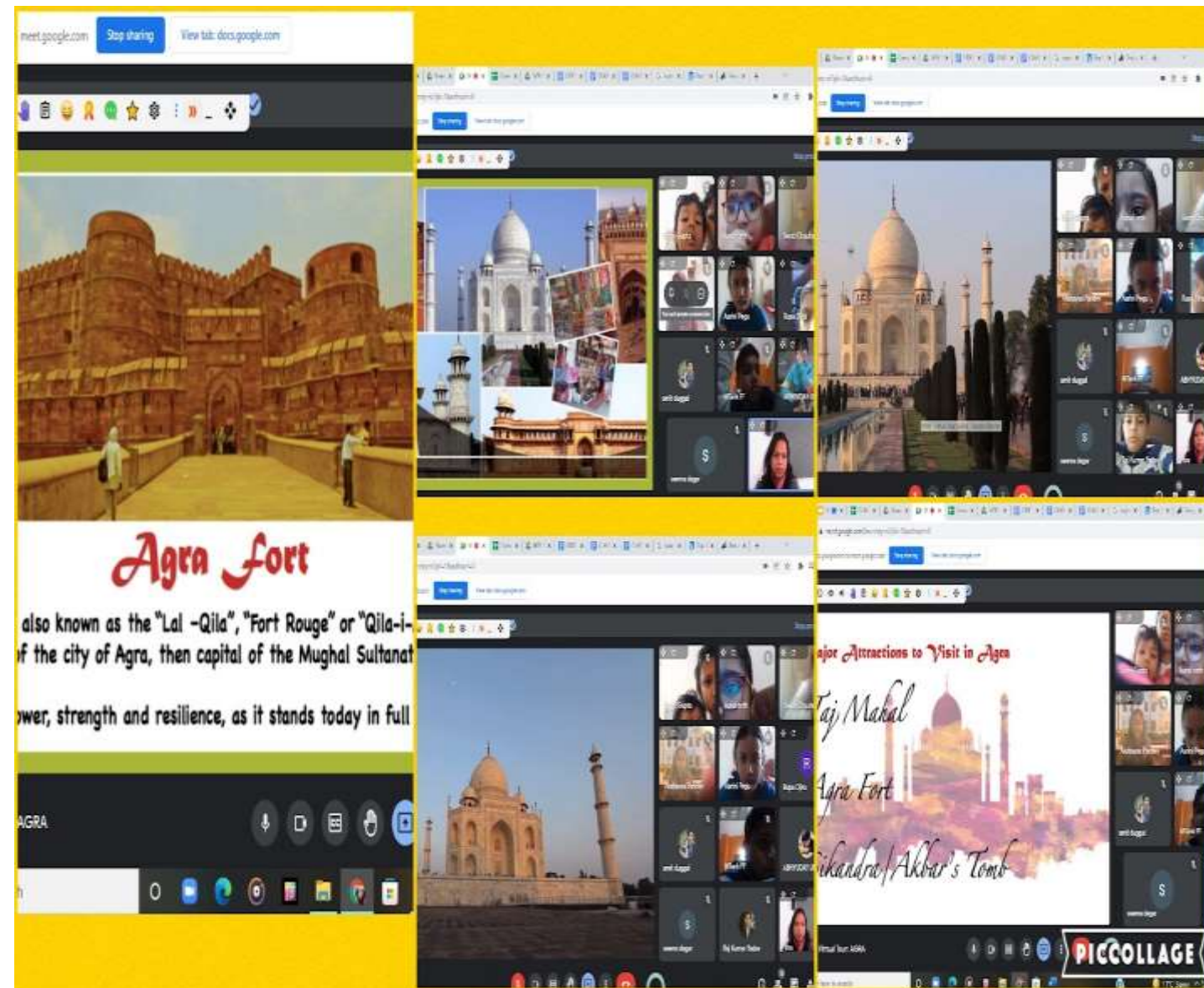




