ENGLISH

INTER CLASS ACTIVITY



CLASS ASSEMBLY(NUR-KG)

Morning assemblies fosters discipline, motivation, confidence, values and morals. Utilizing this platform, students of Nursery (A,B,C,D) and Kindergarten (A,B,C,D) had their class assembly this week on the theme 'My Family, My Home', which was a heartwarming celebration of family and home. Students recited poems, shared their feelings about their families, and identified different rooms in a house. They enthusiastically showcased their understanding of family members and their role.



HANDS ON ACTIVITY (KG)

Students of Kindergarten were actively engaged in a revision session where the teacher called out words, and the students selected the corresponding flashcards. This interactive method helped in reinforcing their understanding and recall of the swars.



HANDS ON ACTIVITY (UKG)

During the week students revised the digraphs by actively participating in musical chairs. When the music paused they had to read the word written on their table.





ENVIRONMENTAL SCIENCE

Students of class 1 were informed about the meaning of neighbour, neighbourhood and the importance of them. A discussion on the same was done where each child got an opportunity to share about their neighbourhood.





Adding numbers is a fundamental mathematical concept, essential for the simplest problems in our daily activities. Children of class 1 enjoyed practicing addition sums and used addition properties in the calculation. Related videos and PPTs were shown to kids. Practice worksheets were given for practice.

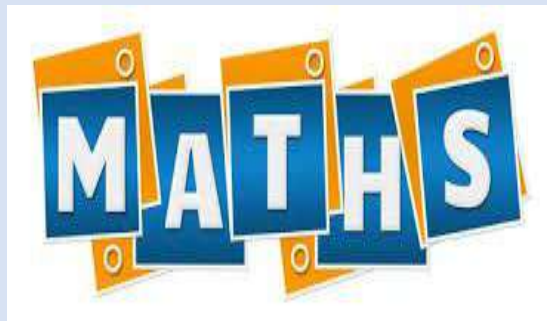




ENVIRONMENTAL SCIENCE

In continuation with the last week, students of class 2 revised the chapter - Neighbourhood and did related exercises in workbook and notebook. They also revised the New words of the month during their EVS class.





Students of class 2 were introduced to Subtraction. They did subtraction using backward counting and number line. Students also practiced some of the questions based on the same concept in their notebooks and workbooks. They were introduced to the table of 7 and revision of tables from 2 to 6 was done. Kids also discussed the words used for differentiating the application of addition and subtraction in their thinking routine activity.



INSTRUMENTAL MUSIC (1&2)



Playing a musical instrument not only stimulates brain activity but also promotes cognitive development and growth. In this context, children in classes 1 and 2 were introduced to the fundamentals of playing the keyboard. They were engaged in practical sessions where they practiced playing alankar, enhancing their musical skills and contributing to their overall brain development.

ART & CRAFT (1&2)



The name 'origami' combines 'ori' (which means to fold) and 'kami' (which means paper), which perfectly describes what origami is. It involves folding a flat sheet of paper multiple times to create unique shapes and sculptures. Students of classes 1 and 2 prepared for their upcoming origami inter class activity. Students of grade 1 learnt to make origami tulip flowers and grade 2 were taught to make fish with origami sheets.

COMPUTER (CLASS 2)

Students of class 2 were introduced to Calculator App. They learnt how to perform arithmetic operations on the Calculator.



VOCAL MUSIC (1&2)



Singing helps children to develop a good sense of rhythm and pitch, which are important for language development. Children of classes 1 and 2 practiced singing the song 'Aao hum sab haath milaayein'.

DANCE (1&2)

Dance is an art to explore your feelings. The students of classes 1 & 2 started learning dance choreography for upcoming school events.



PHYSICAL EDUCATION (1 & 2)

Children of class 1 and 2 enjoyed doing yoga, PT and fun games. Research has shown that games are essential for healthy development in early childhood and beyond. Play lets children practice what they know, and also what they don't. It allows them to experiment through trial and error, find solutions to problems, work out the best strategies, and build new confidence and skills.



CIRCLE TIME

It is important to know our health is important to us. This week the students understood the importance of their health through the topic 'Health is Wealth' and what steps one should take to keep themselves healthy. Children were shown different videos related to the topic.



VALUE EDUCATION
