KINDERGARTEN



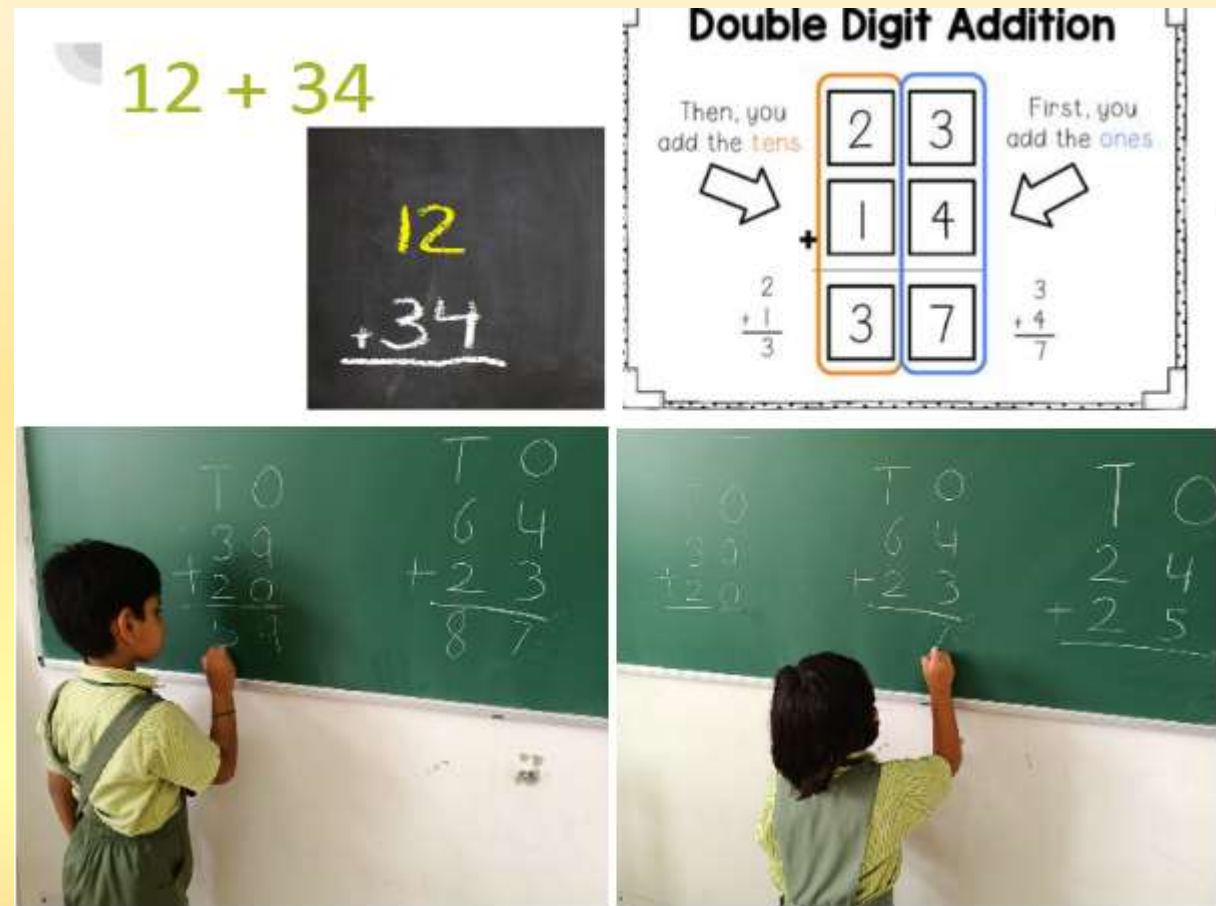
EVS- EVS- Students of KG learnt about Lion and enjoyed colouring worksheets .They enjoyed learning poem also.

Each child got the opportunity to solve the sum on the board.





Students of class 1 were introduced to a new chapter “Little folks in the garden” during their English class. Prior to the chapter a brief discussion on the topic insects was performed where each child tried to name a few insects they know and if they were ever bitten by any of them. The discussion was targeted to make kids aware of basic characteristics of insects. Their body, food and habitat. A video presentation on the same was done to add more clarity on the topic. Later a class activity was performed where they made a collage on different insects.

Festivals are often a time of great celebration and help believers to remember important beliefs in their religion. Religious celebrations bring faith communities together to celebrate these shared beliefs and values.

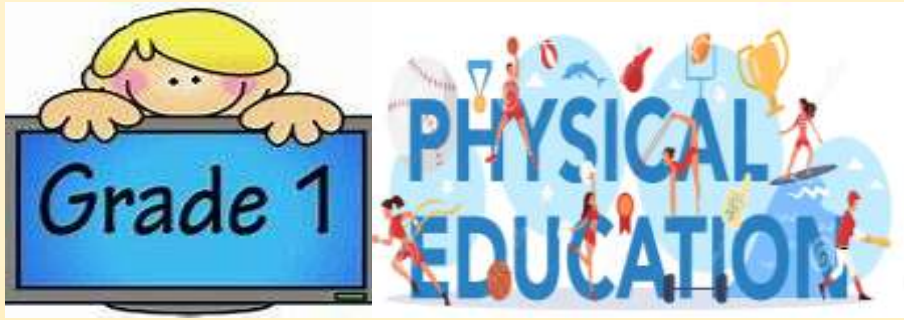
This week children learned about the diverse religious festivals and the ways we celebrate them. They were able to relate with many festivals so it became more joyful and interesting while discussing with them.

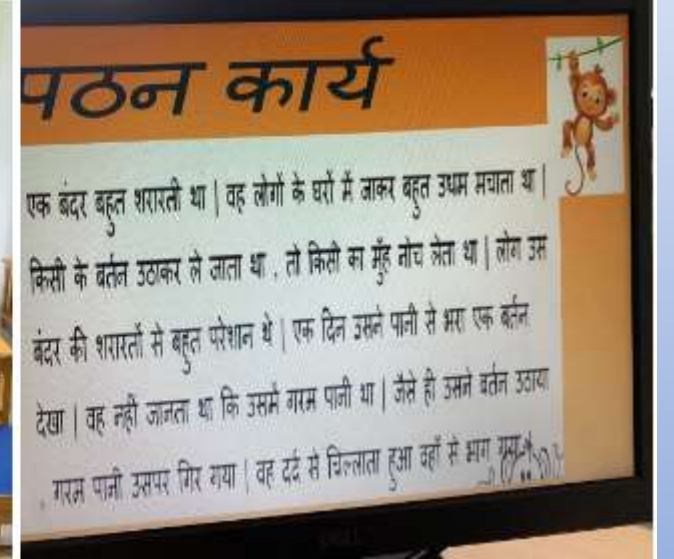
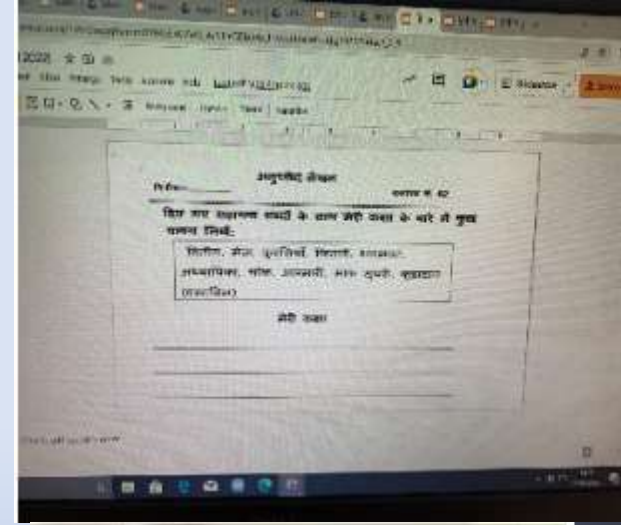
Caring is paying attention to others, protecting others, and being considerate. There are many ways to be caring.
