Art and craft - Students enjoyed making photo frames in art and craft class .

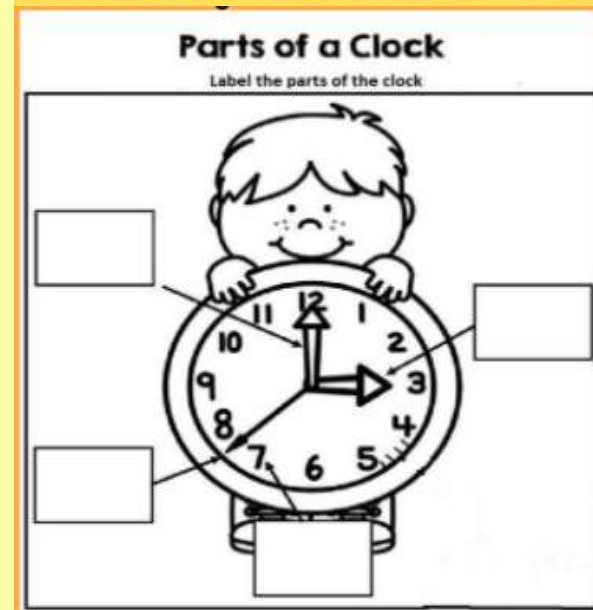
Class activity - Hindi story telling activity was conducted during online classes. Students spoke confidently.

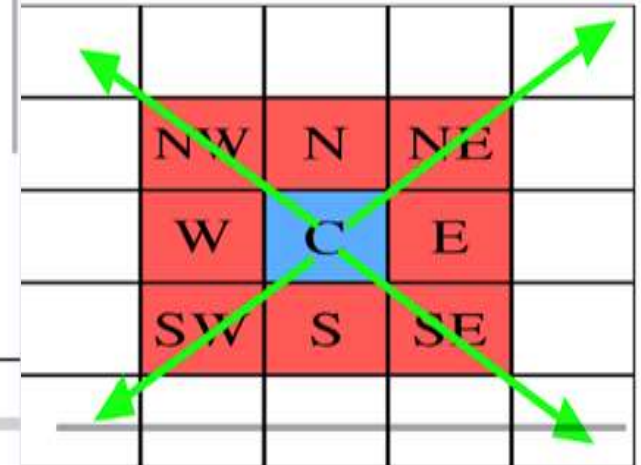
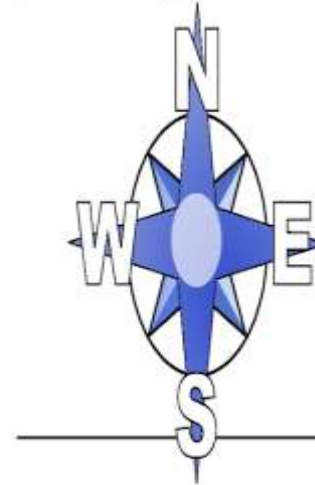


1. The sun rises in the East and sets in the West.

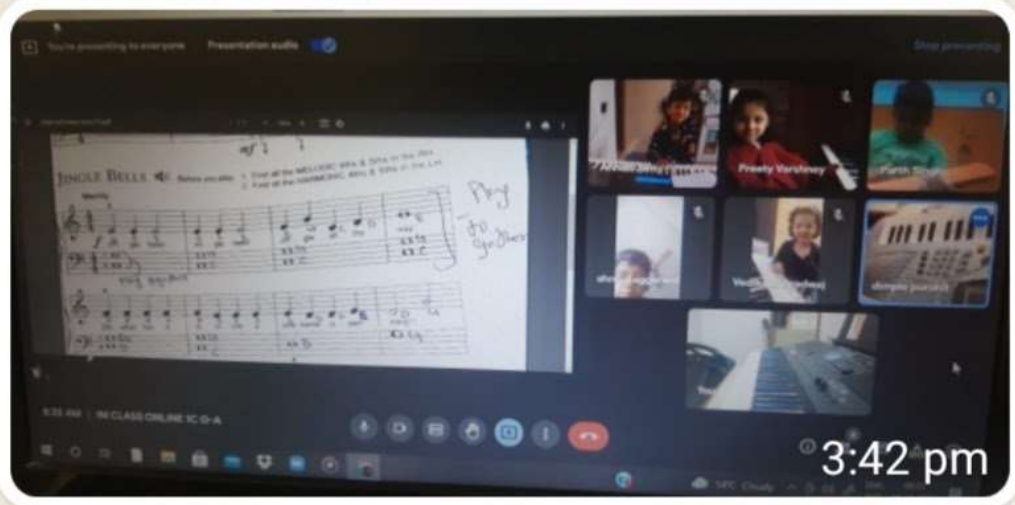

- Respect means that you accept somebody for who they are, even when they're different from you or you don't agree with them.

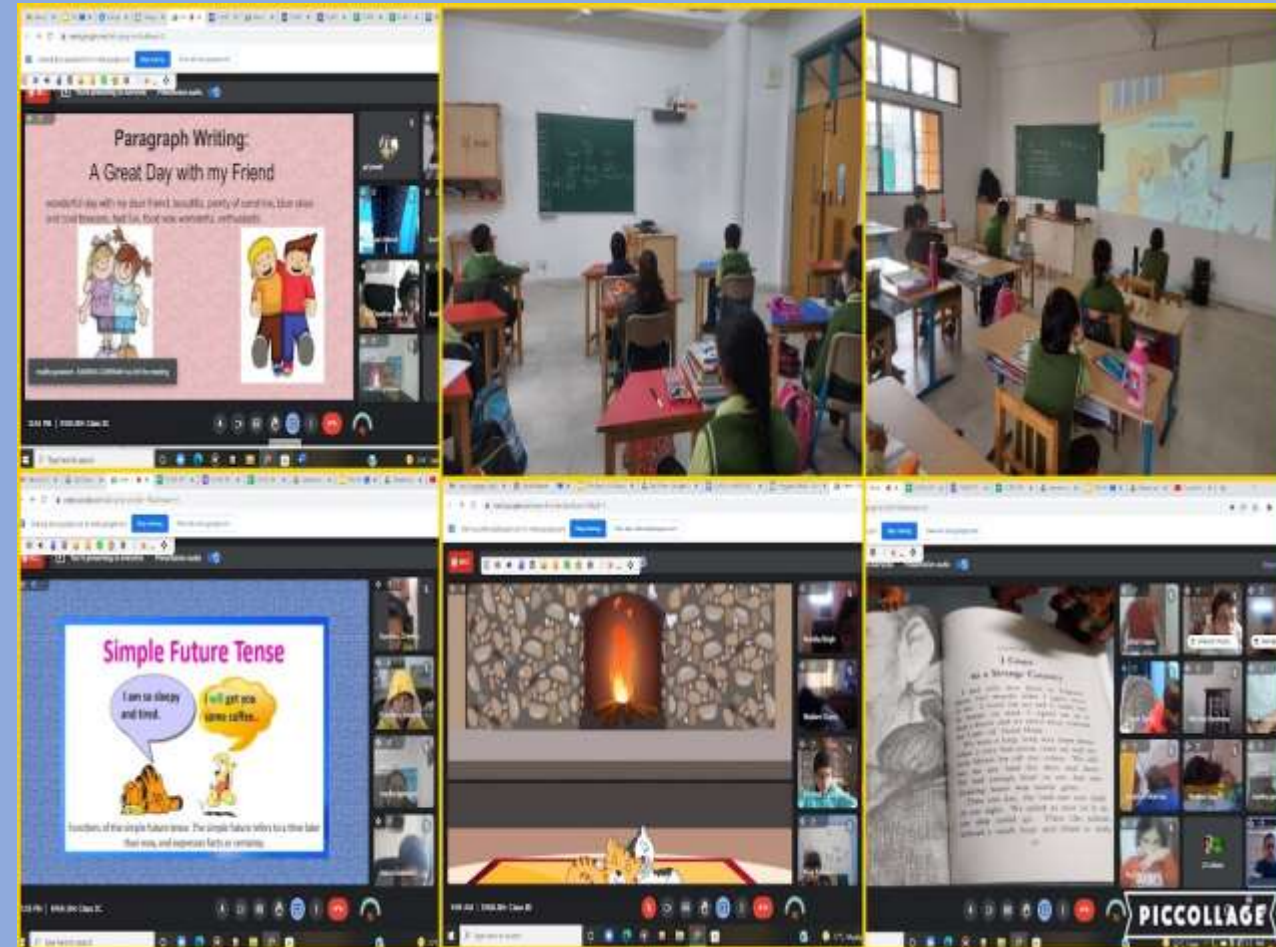
Why is Respect Important

- Respect is something that needs to be earned.



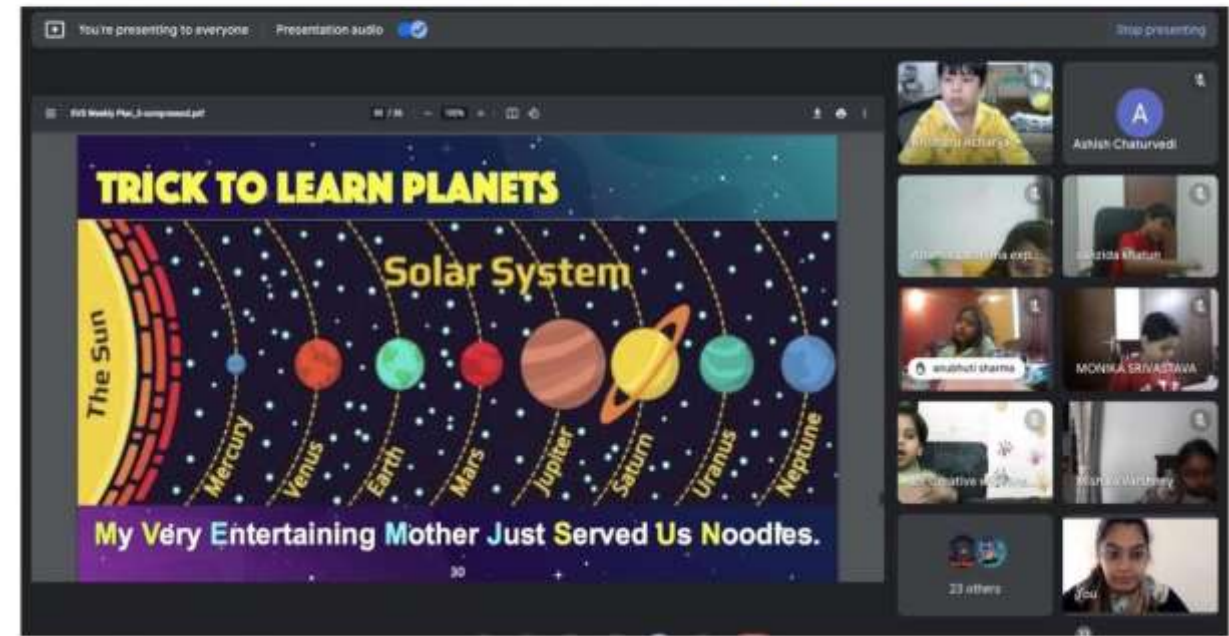

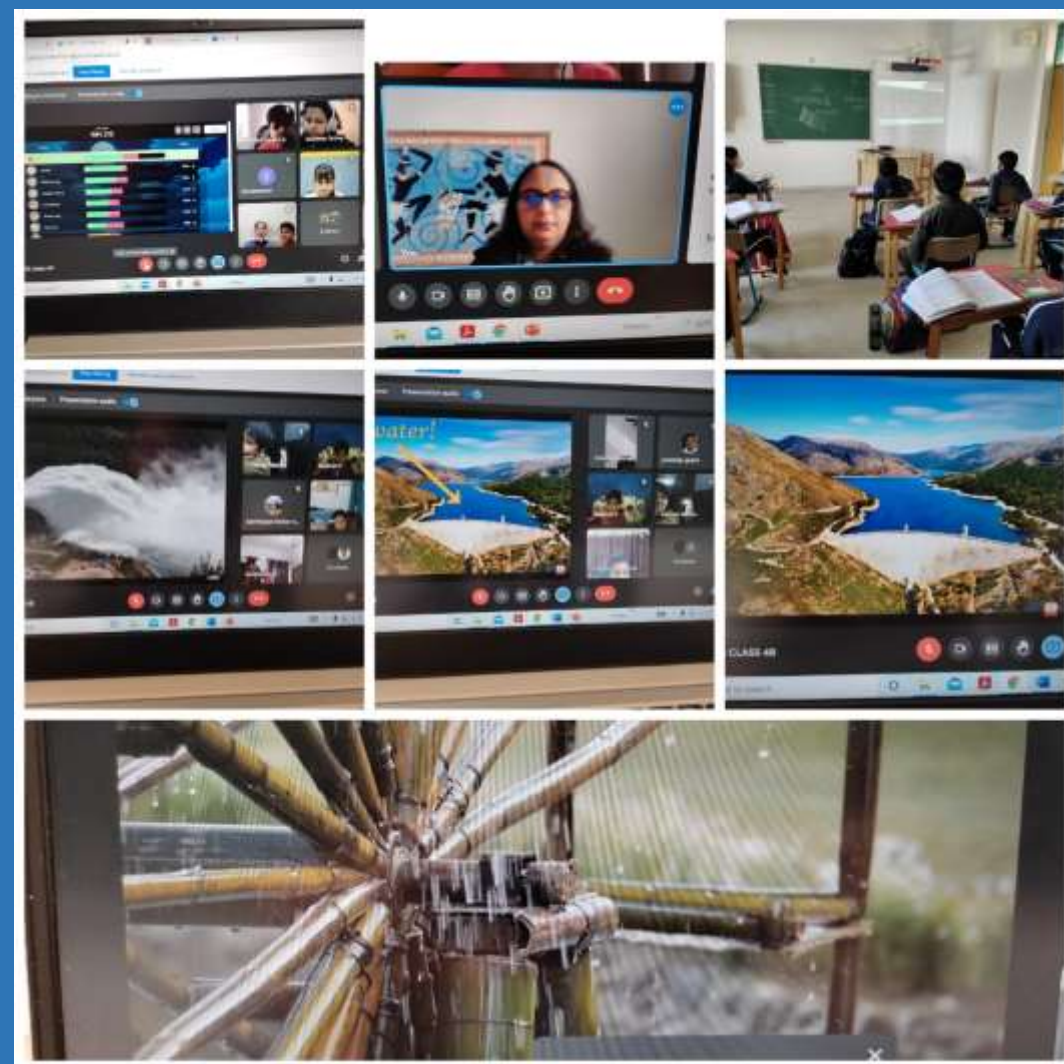

ENVIRONMENTAL SCIENCE

ENVIRONMENTAL SCIENCE

L-12: The Struggle Towards Complete Independence

Civil Disobedience Movement:

- It was launched by Gandhiji in 1930
- The prevalent Salt Law prohibited Indians from manufacturing salt. Only the British Government's authorised agents could do so while Indians had to pay a very high tax on its purchase.
- On 12 March 1930, Gandhiji started the historic Salt March to break the law at Dandi in Gujarat. Gandhiji along with seventy-eight followers walked a distance of approximately 380 kilometres from Sabarmati to Dandi.
- On 6 April 1930, Gandhi reached Dandi and openly violated the Salt Law by making salt at the seashore.



The students of grade 5 were introduced to the various movements that led to the independence of India with the introduction of L-12: The Complete Struggle for Independence. Events like Rowlatt act, Jallianwala Bagh massacre, Simon Commission formation was discussed in detail. Discussion on major movements like Non-cooperation, Civil Disobedience and Quit India was initiated and explained through documentaries. Oral and written evaluation of the lesson was also done to check the knowledge and understanding of the students.

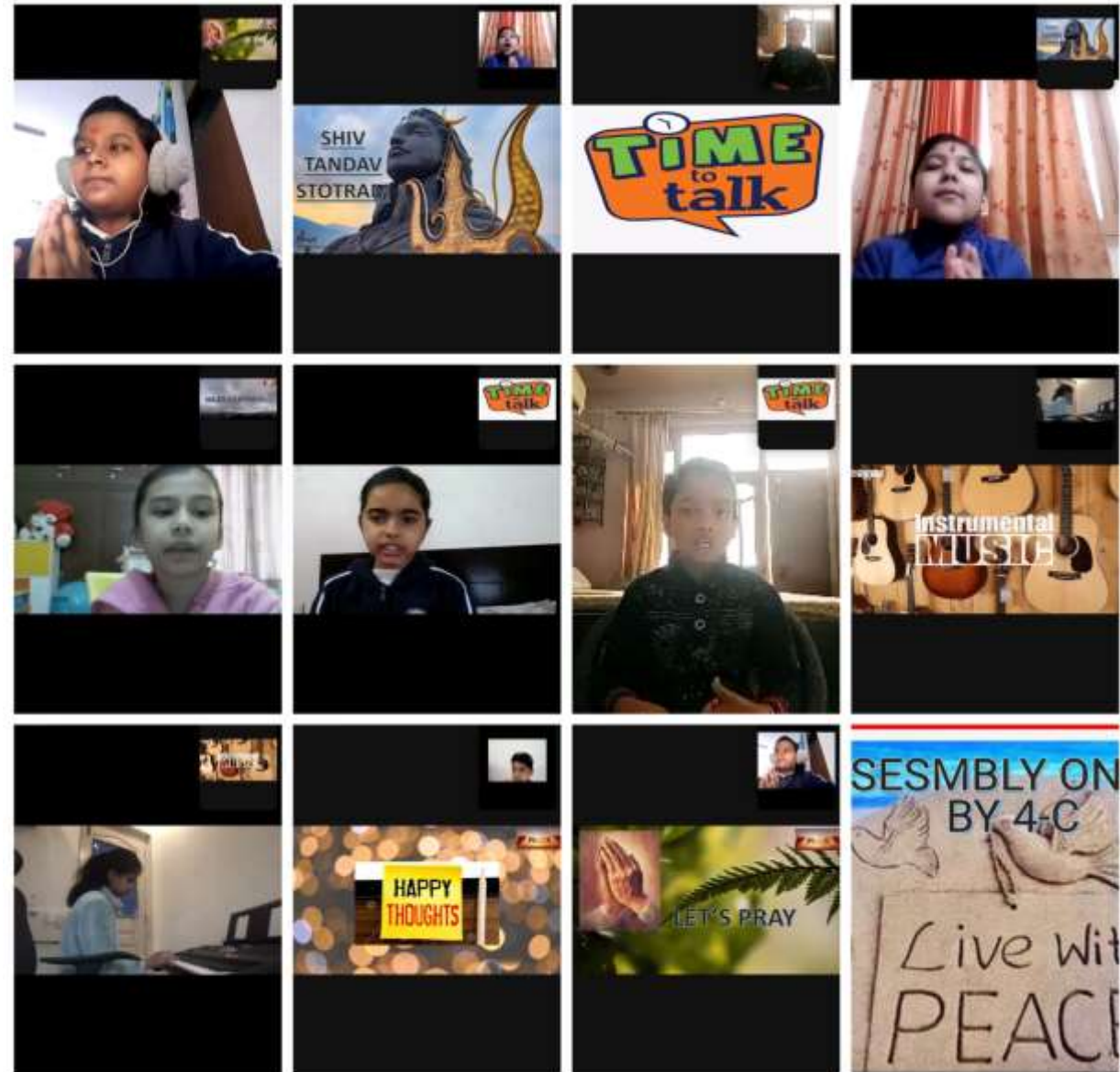
ASSEMBLY: 3B- PEACE

CLASS TEACHER PERIOD (3 - 5)
