Activity- Hindi Rhyme time activity was conducted and children recited few rhymes very confidently.







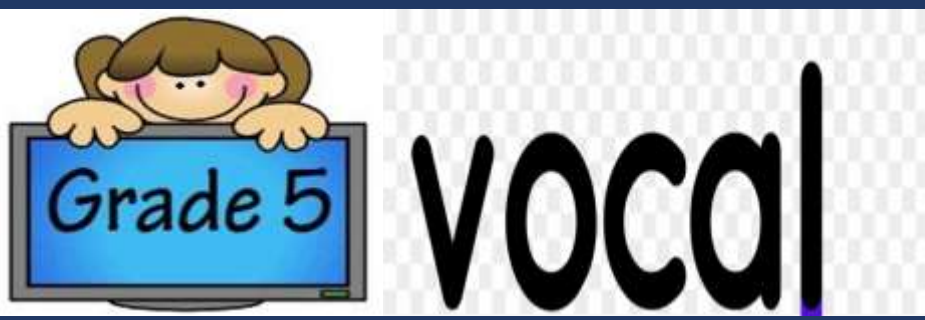




ENVIRONMENTAL SCIENCE
