# NURSERY



## ENGLISH

Letter X was introduced to the children with the help of pictures and different objects. They also enjoyed the Jolly phonics song of letter X. Students did worksheets related to the letter in their workbook and also practiced writing X in their notebooks.

## ENGLISH

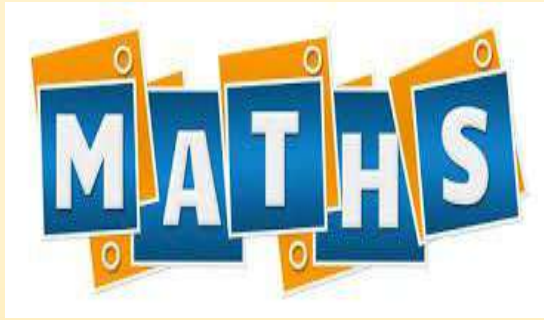




# ENVIRONMENTAL SCIENCE

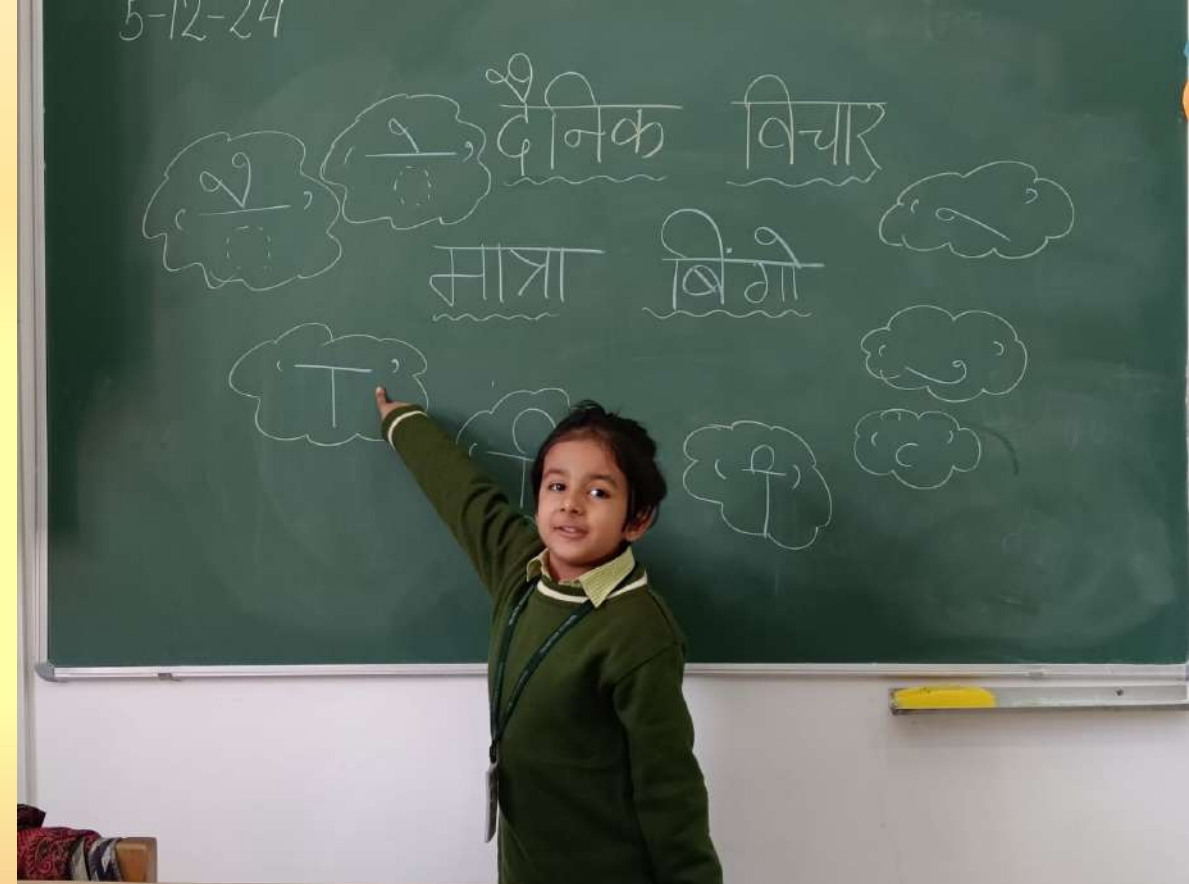

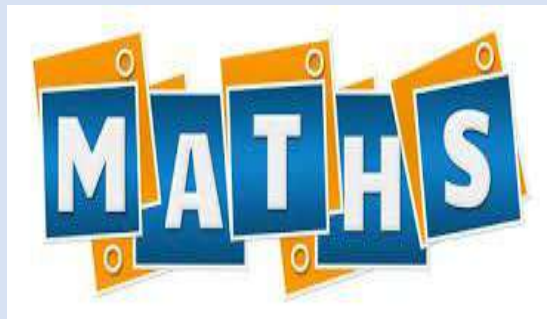

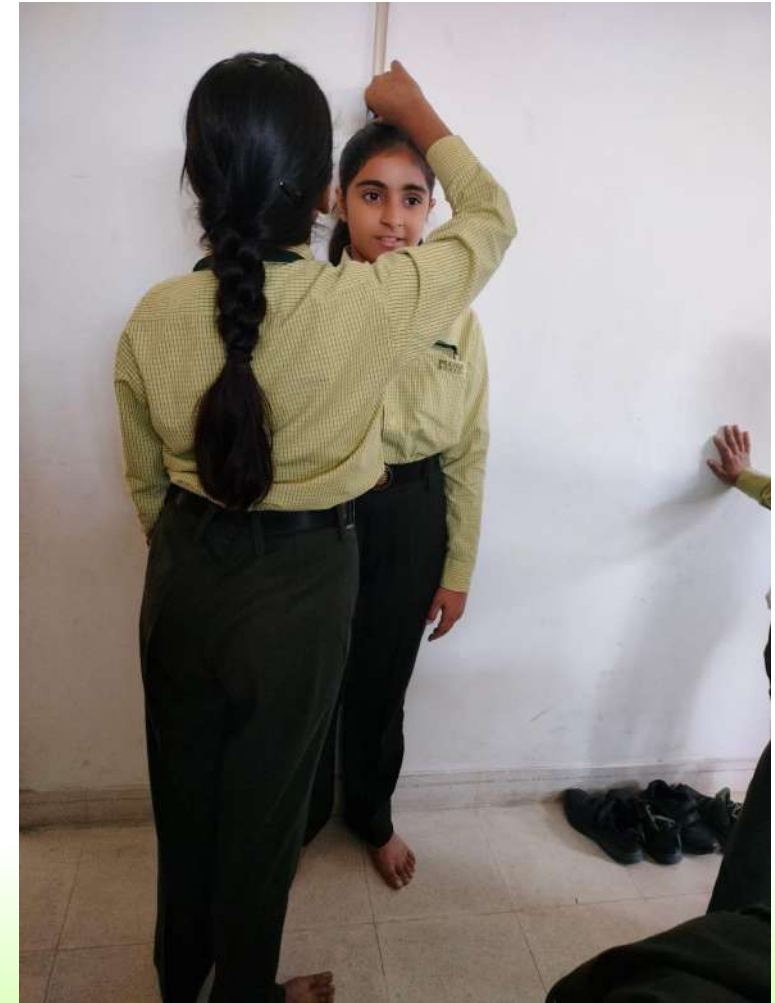
# WESTERN VOCAL CLUB
