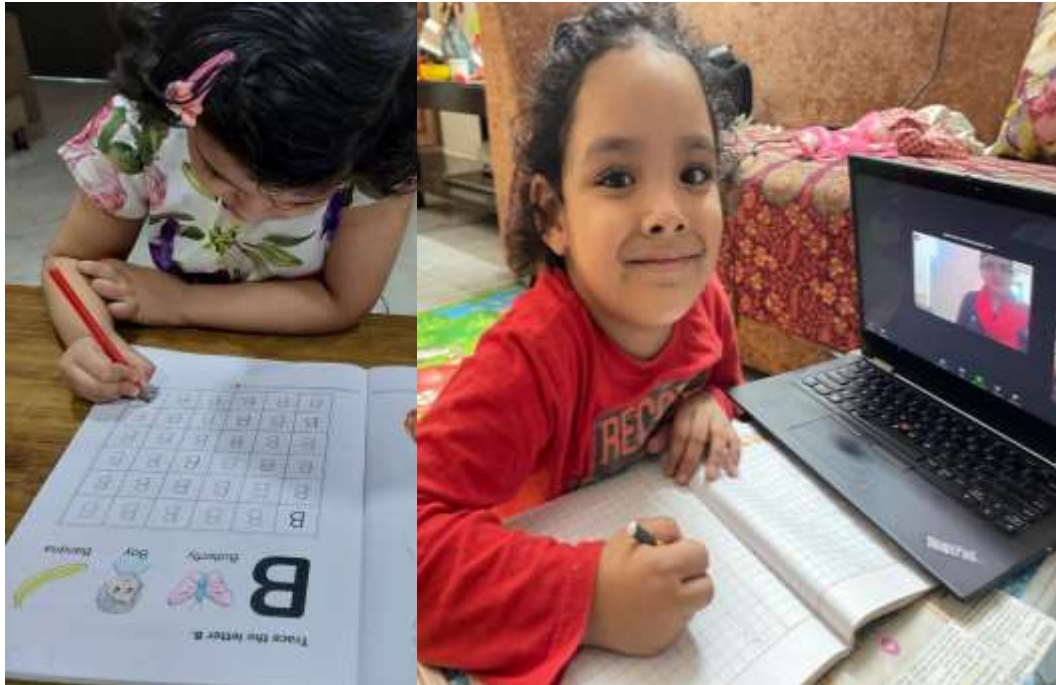
English – Introduction of letter ‘B’ was done by doing worksheets and picture reading was also done where students can identify the pictures related to the letter B.

Science Demo – Air is introduced in the class by inflating the balloons and by showing the breathing function through the lungs.





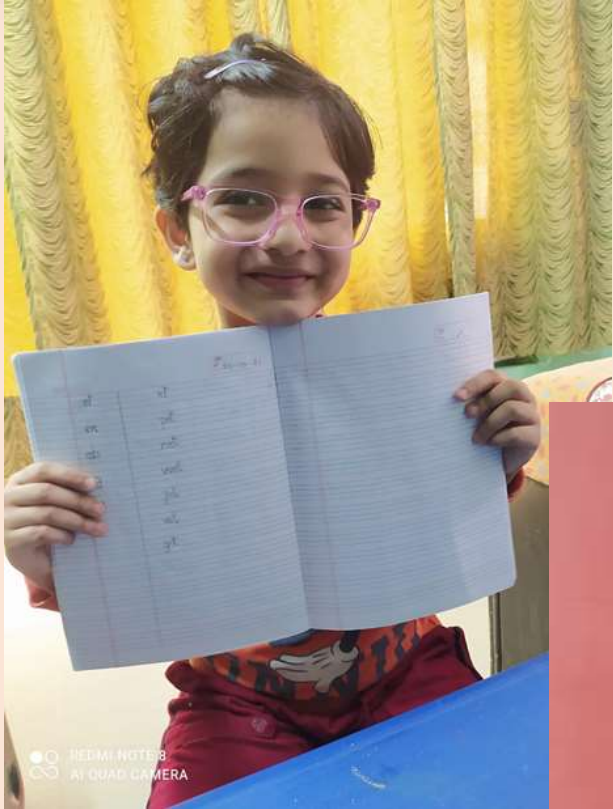
General Awareness - Air transport was done by colouring the worksheets where students can identify few vehicles name of air transport.

Ordinal Numbers

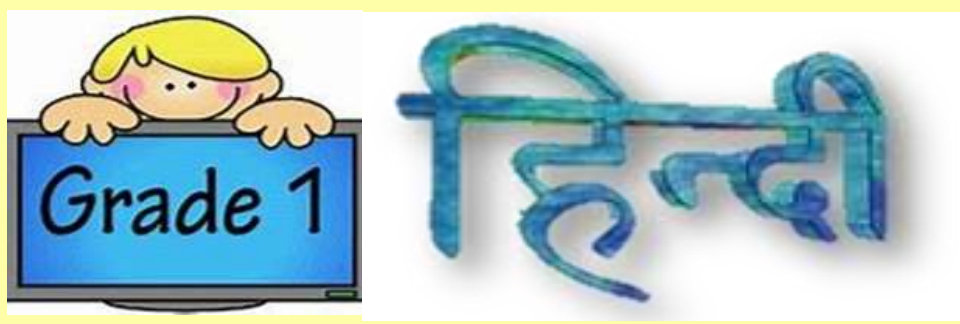

Cardinal numbers tell 'how many' of something, they show quantity. Ordinal numbers tell the order of how things are set, they show the position or the rank of something. Children enjoyed learning it with the help of videos and written work done in the class.

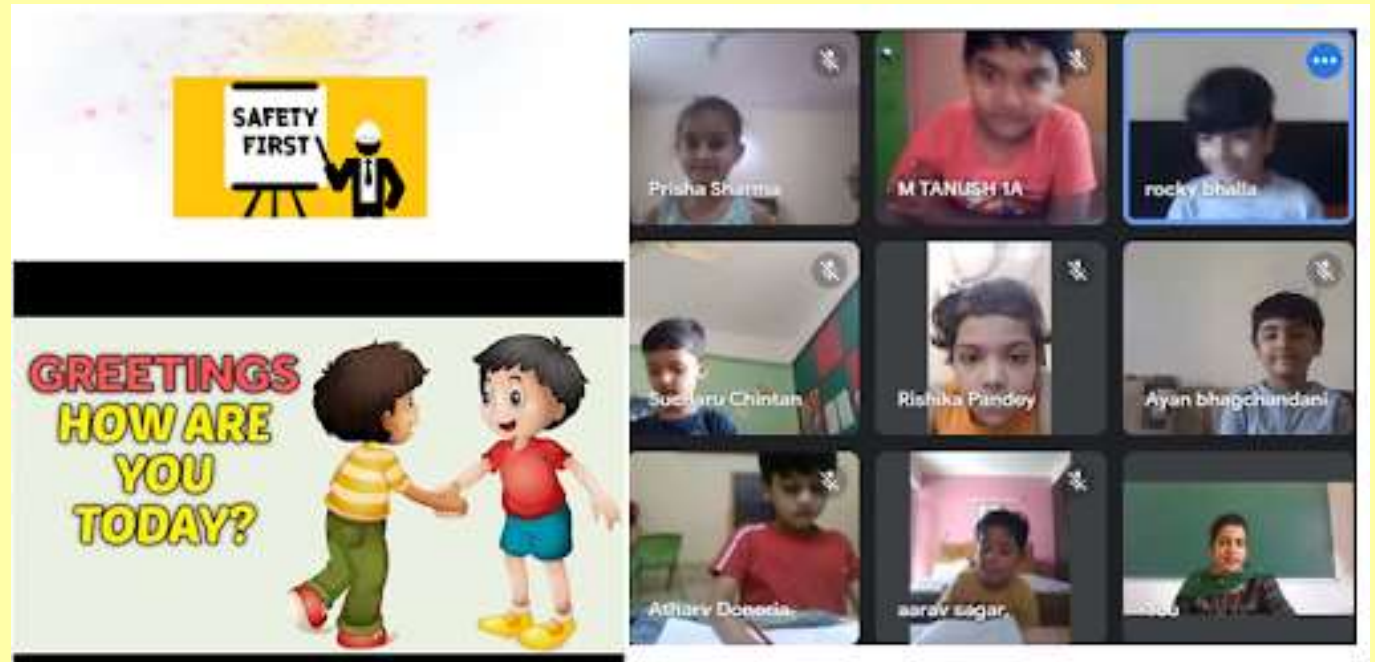

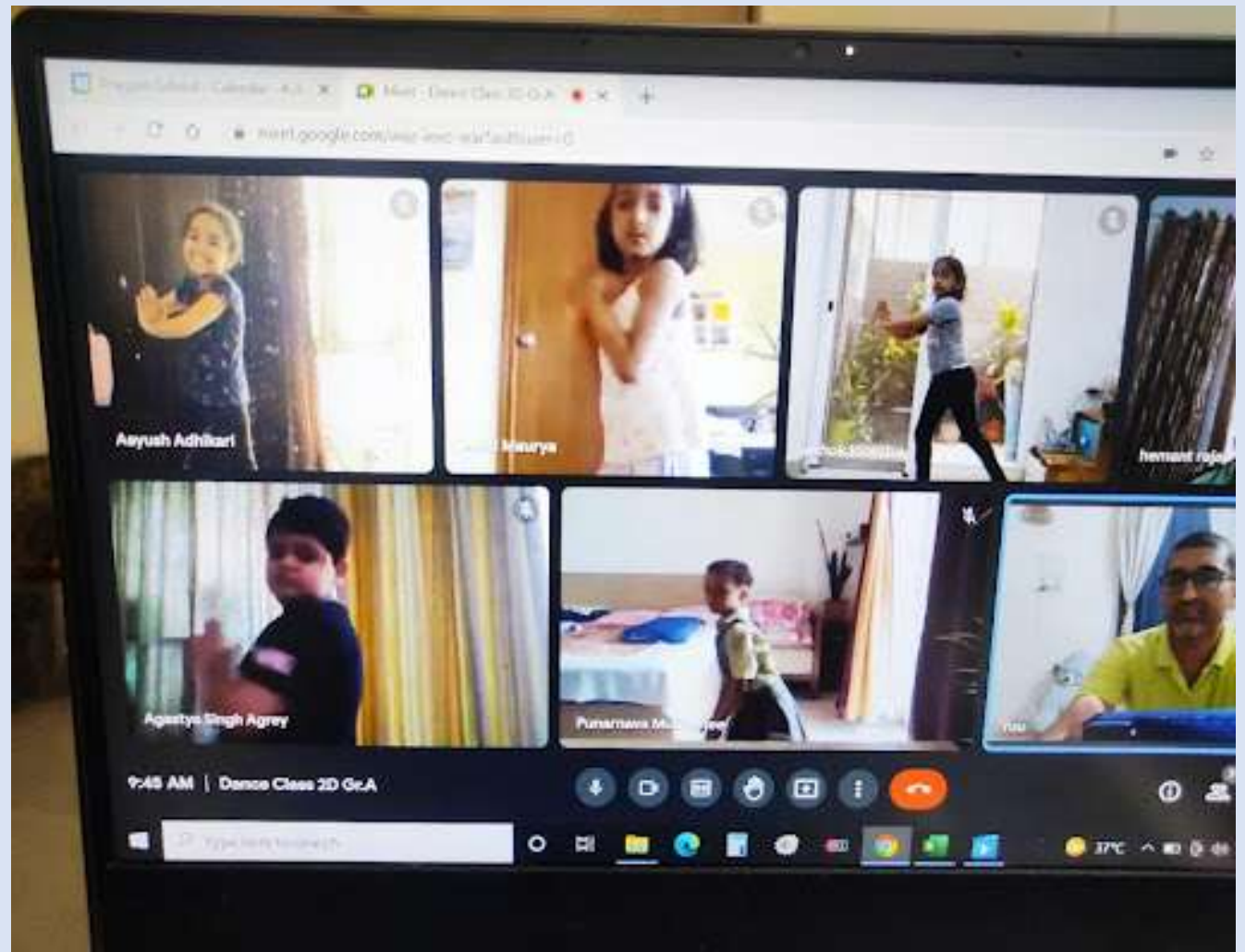
ENVIRONMENTAL SCIENCE

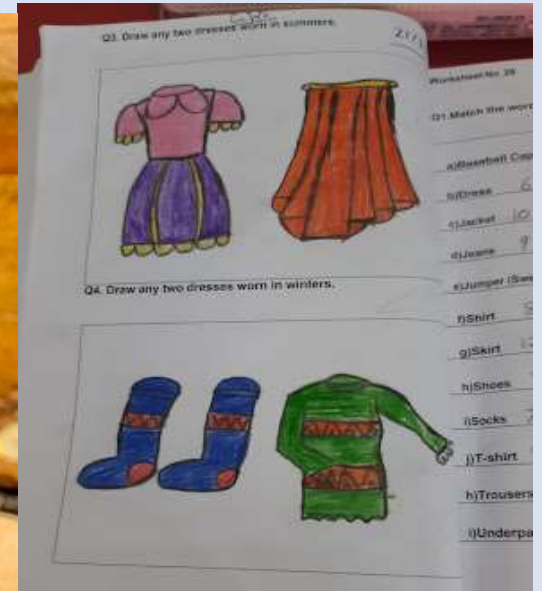
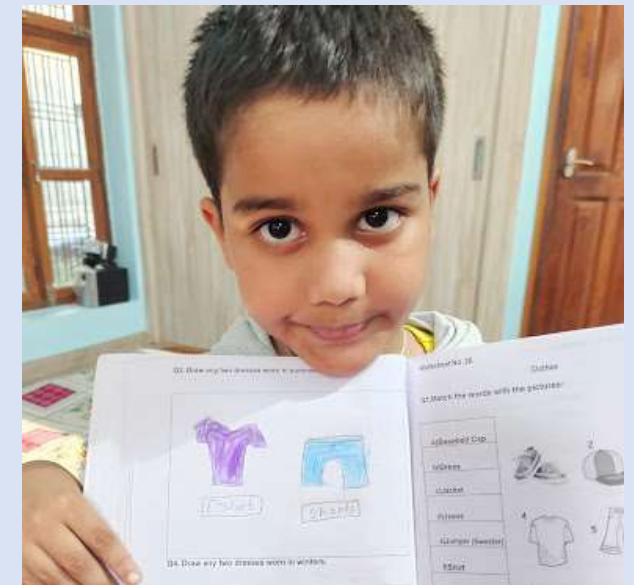

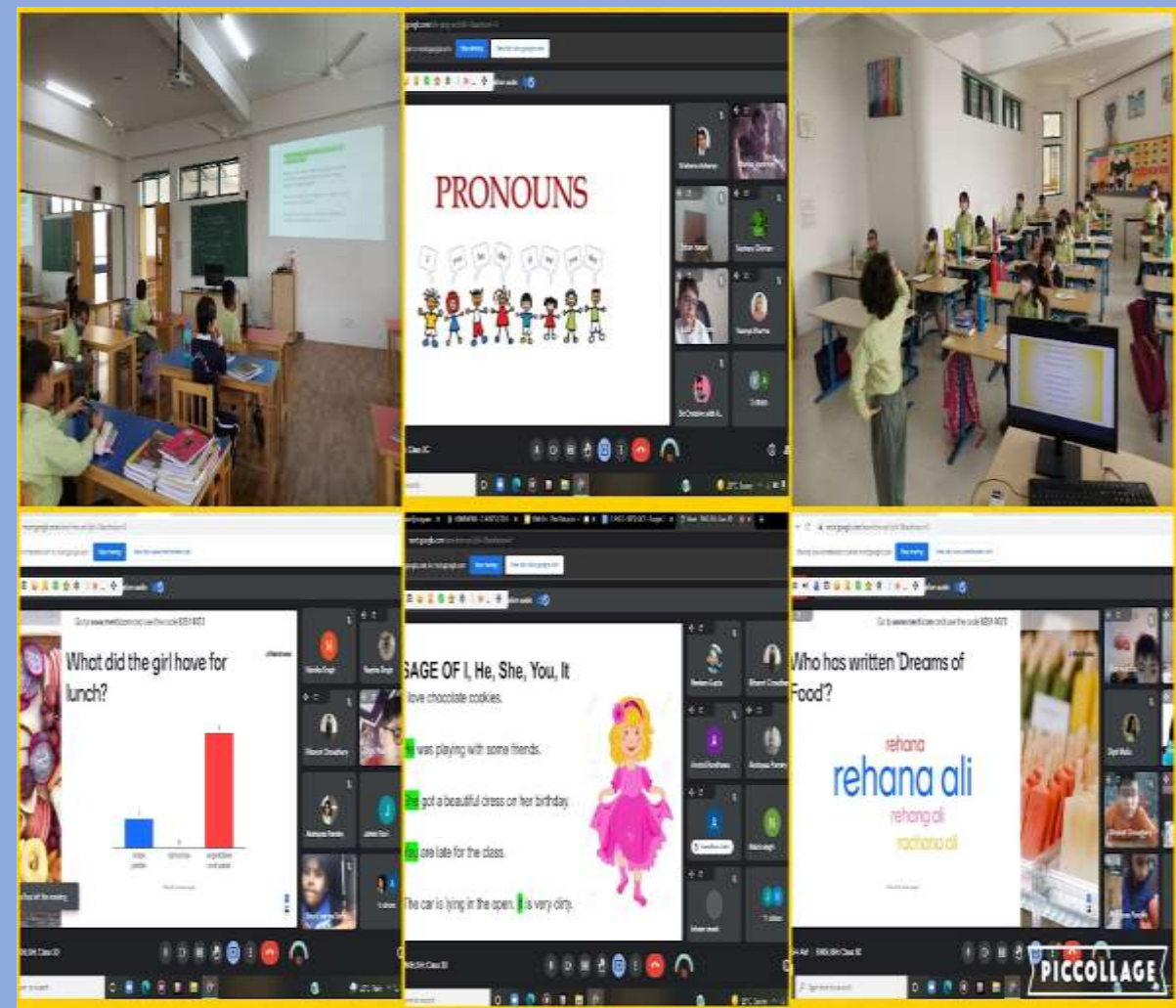
Virtual Tour to National Rail Museum / Qutub Minar

- Students of classes 1 & 2 enjoyed A virtual tour to the Rail Museum and Qutub Minar, respectively. Children of class 1 enjoyed seeing the vast galleries, the museum features simulations of coaches, diesel, locomotives, signaling systems, Fairy queen, a special train, electric and steam engines. Students of class 2 were informed of the historical background of the tallest brick minaret and ‘victory tower’. They were made aware of different monuments that form part of the Qutub complex. Children were amazed and astonished to gain knowledge on both the virtual tours through a video. They were asked some questions based on the same.

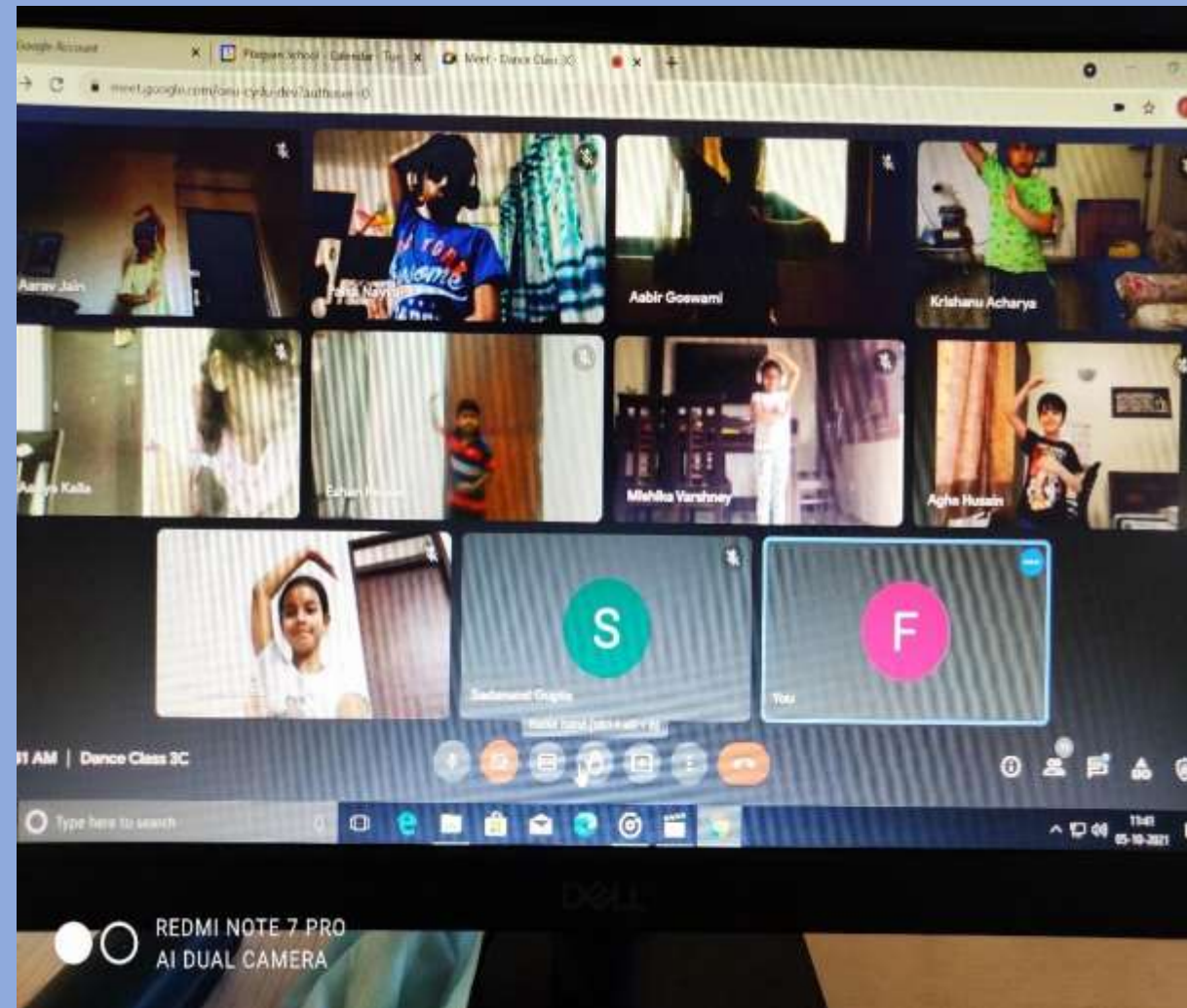

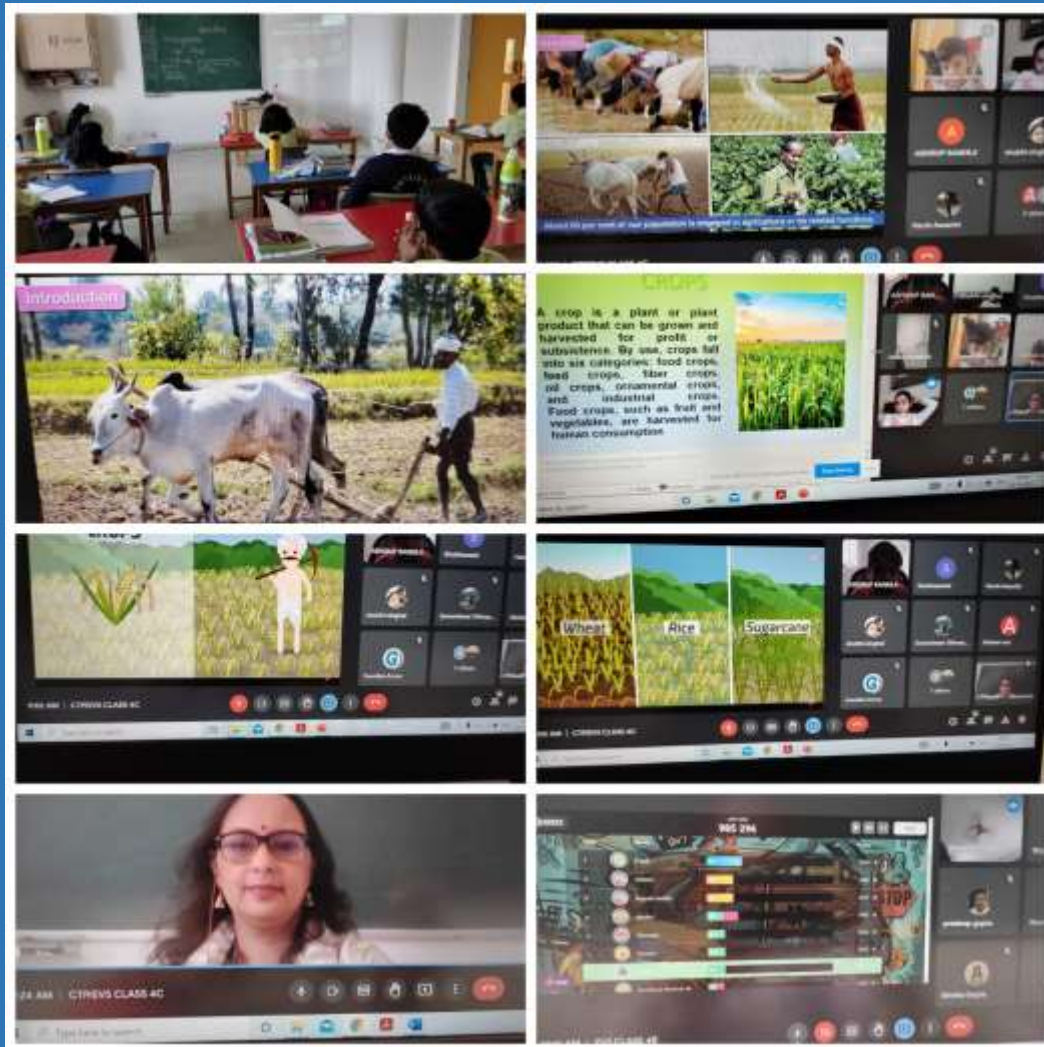
Contemporary Dance

Students of class 3 learned a contemporary dance sequence with a blend of Bharatnatyam on the occasion of Diwali.





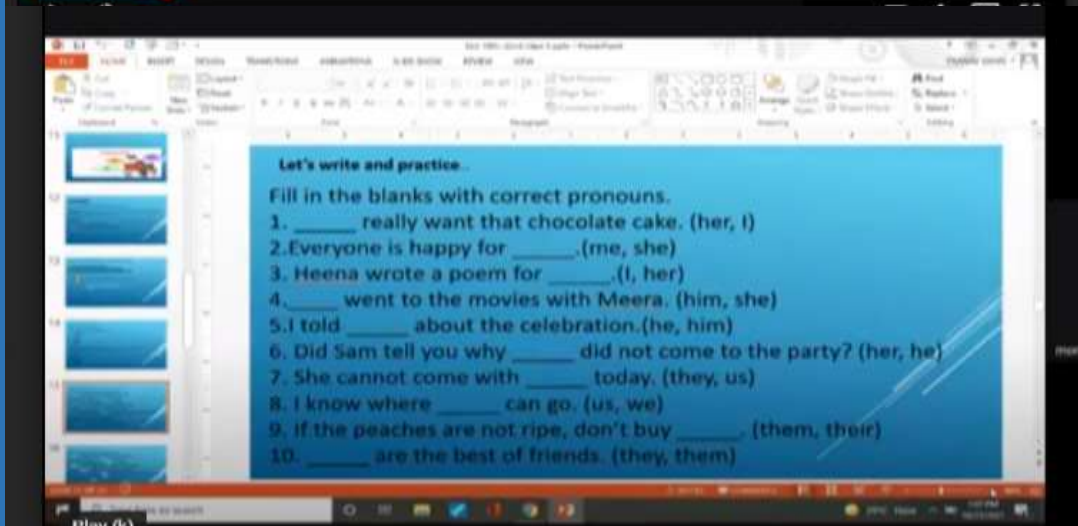
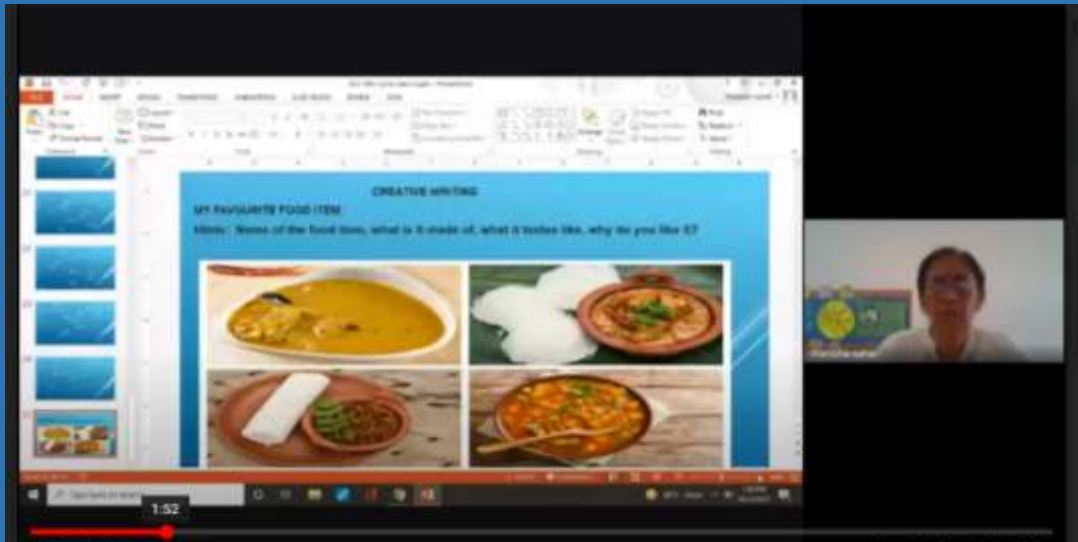
ENVIRONMENTAL SCIENCE

Types of Force

Magnetic Force:

- Magnets attract other magnetic objects such as iron and steel.
- A magnet can influence other magnets or magnetic materials in the area around it. Scientists call this a field of force or magnetic field.
- The ends of a magnet are known as its poles.
- Each magnet has two poles—North Pole and South Pole.
- The magnetic effect is the strongest at the poles.

Types of Force

Electromagnetism:

- A wire coil that has an electric current running through it produces a magnetic field. This is called electromagnetism.
- A nail that is inserted into the coil becomes magnetised.
- However, the nail only stays magnetised while the current is flowing.
- The more turns in the coil, and the greater the current used, the stronger the magnetic field will be.

CLASS TEACHER PERIOD (3-5)

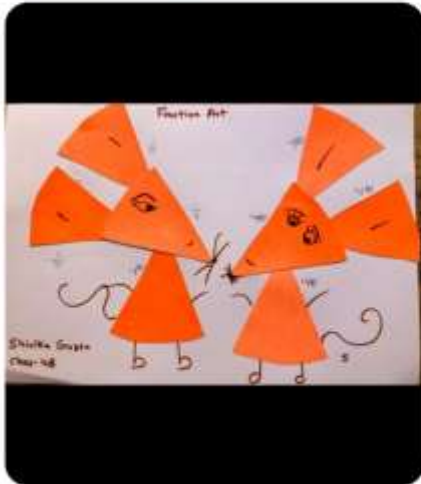
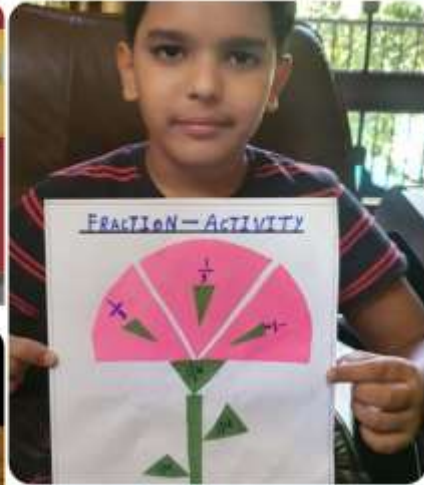
