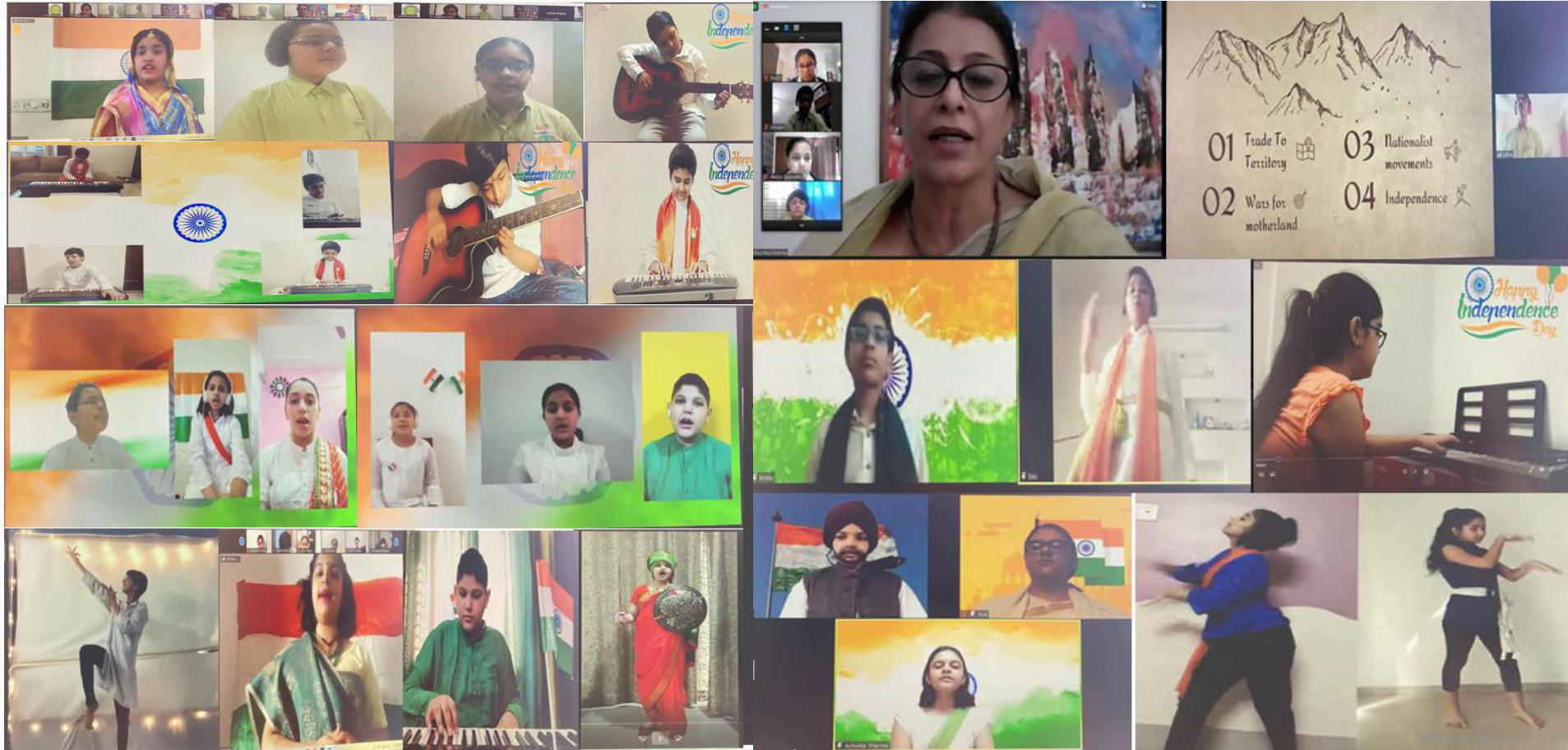

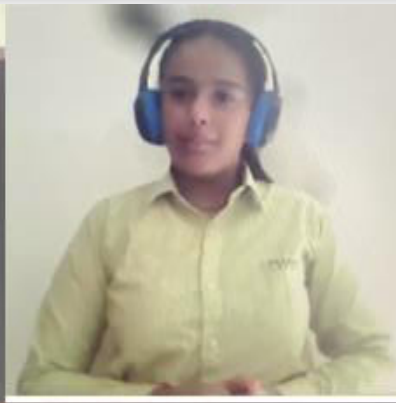

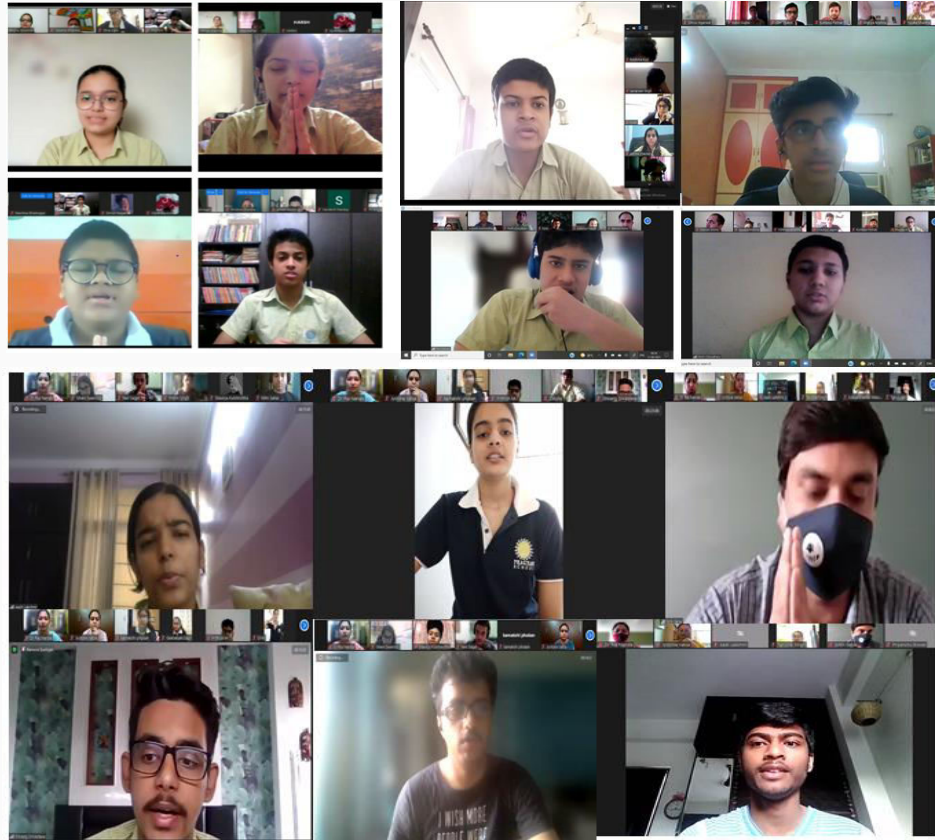
MORNING ASSEMBLY [VI-VIII]

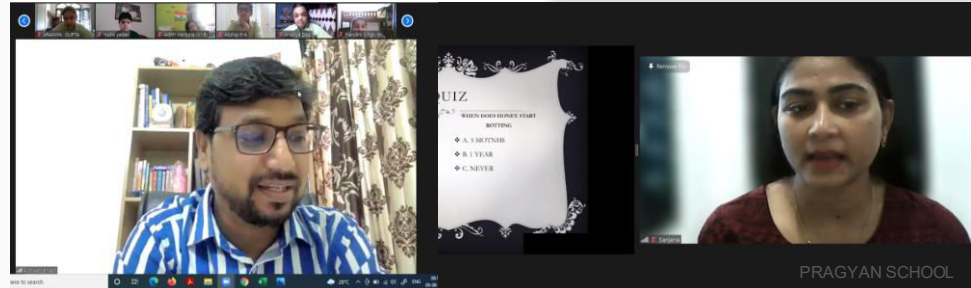
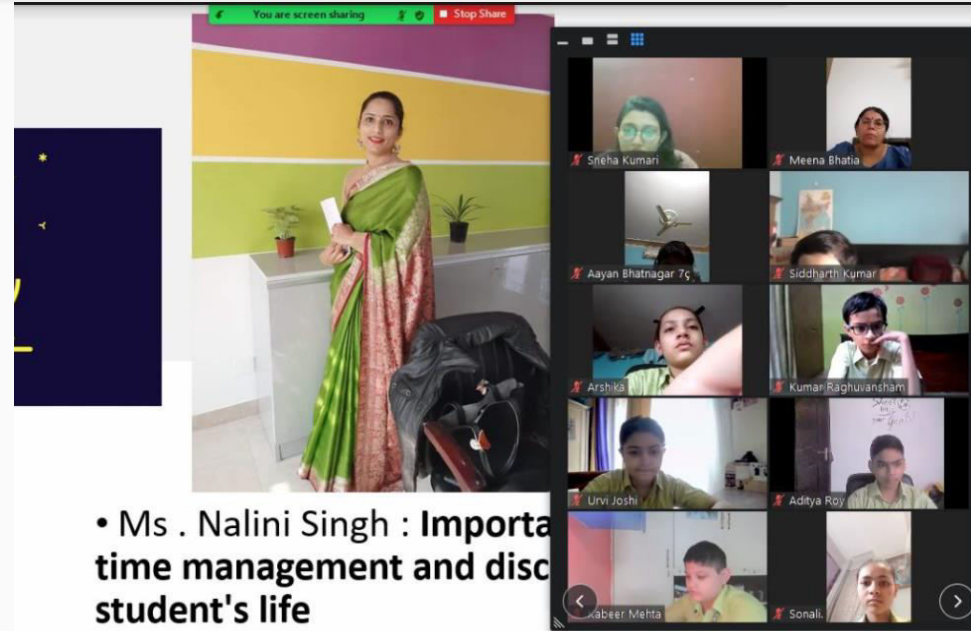
MORNING ASSEMBLY [IX-XII]

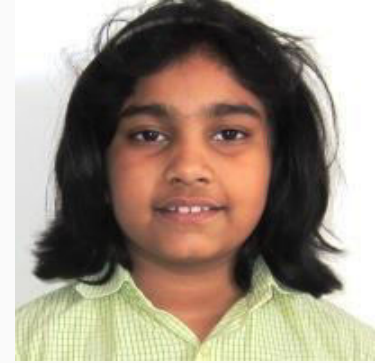

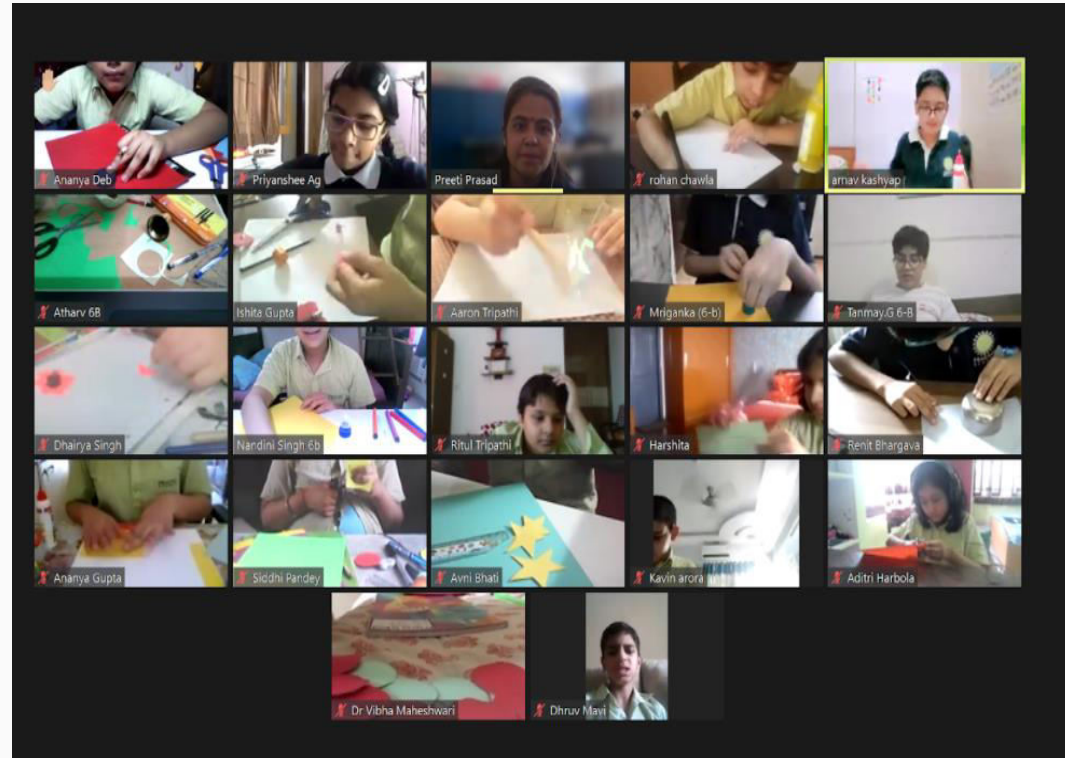
ENRICHMENT ACTIVITY: HINDI - VI

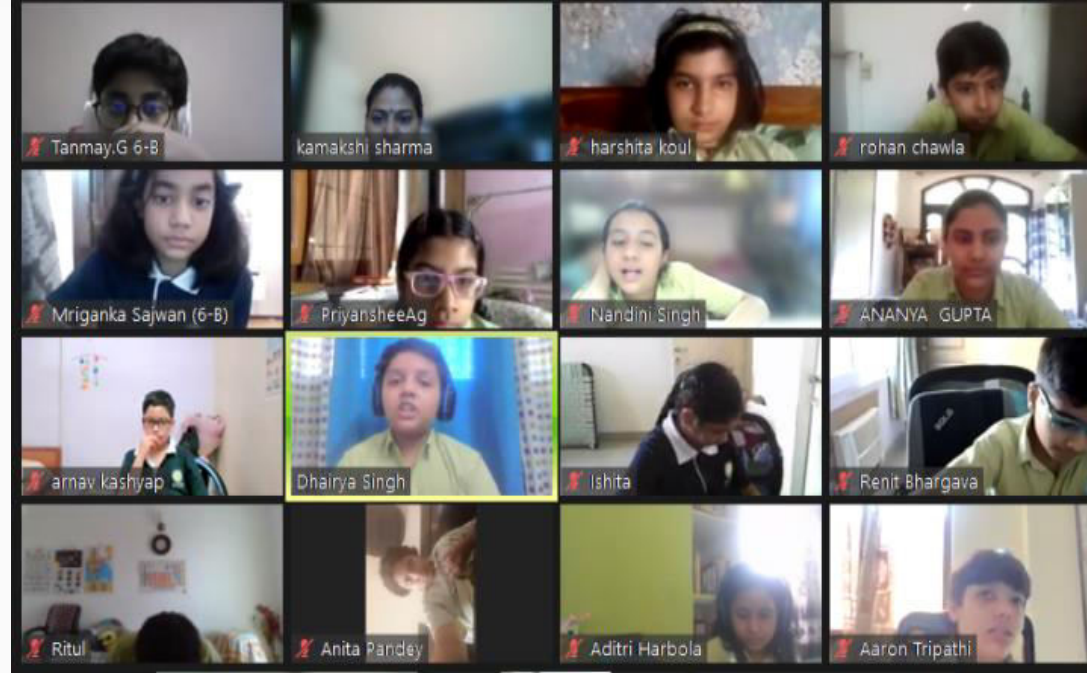
ENRICHMENT ACTIVITY : MATHS - VI

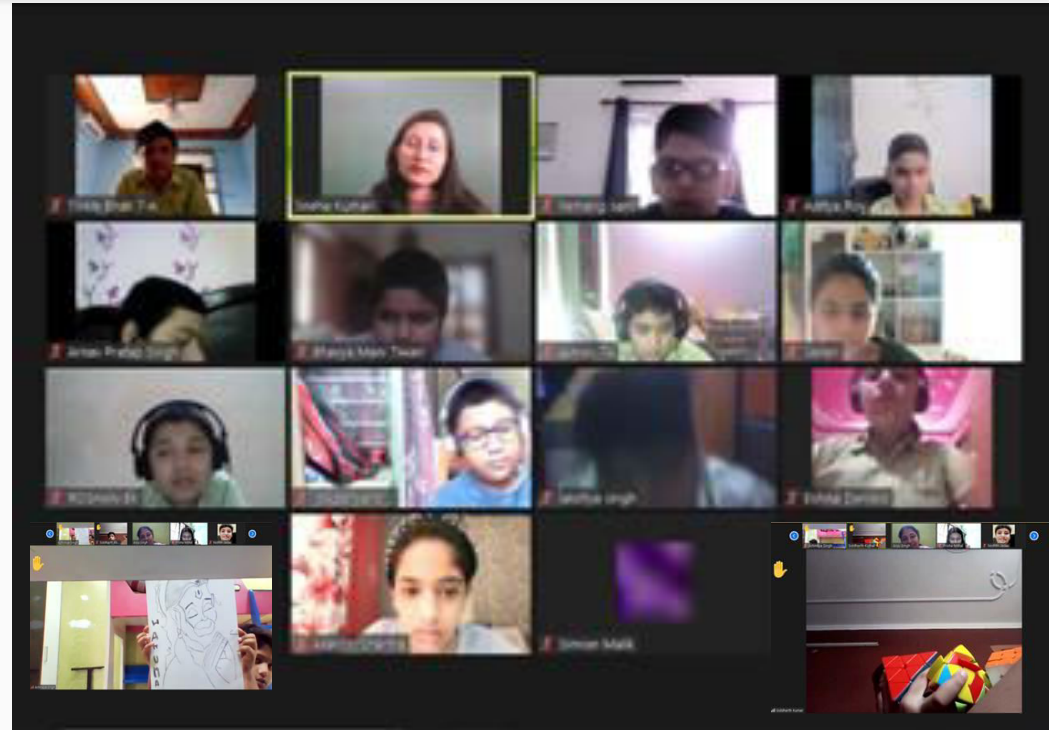
CLASS TEACHER PERIOD - VI



PROCEDURE:

- 1) Cut a square of side 11 cm (8cm + 3cm) and paste it as shown in figure 1.
- 2) Cut a square of side 8 cm, a square of side 3 cm and 2 rectangles of length 8 cm and breadth 3 cm.
- 3) Arrange the squares and rectangles as shown in figure 2.
- 4) Side of square formed in figure 2 is $(a + b)$ where $a = 8$ cm and $b = 3$ cm.

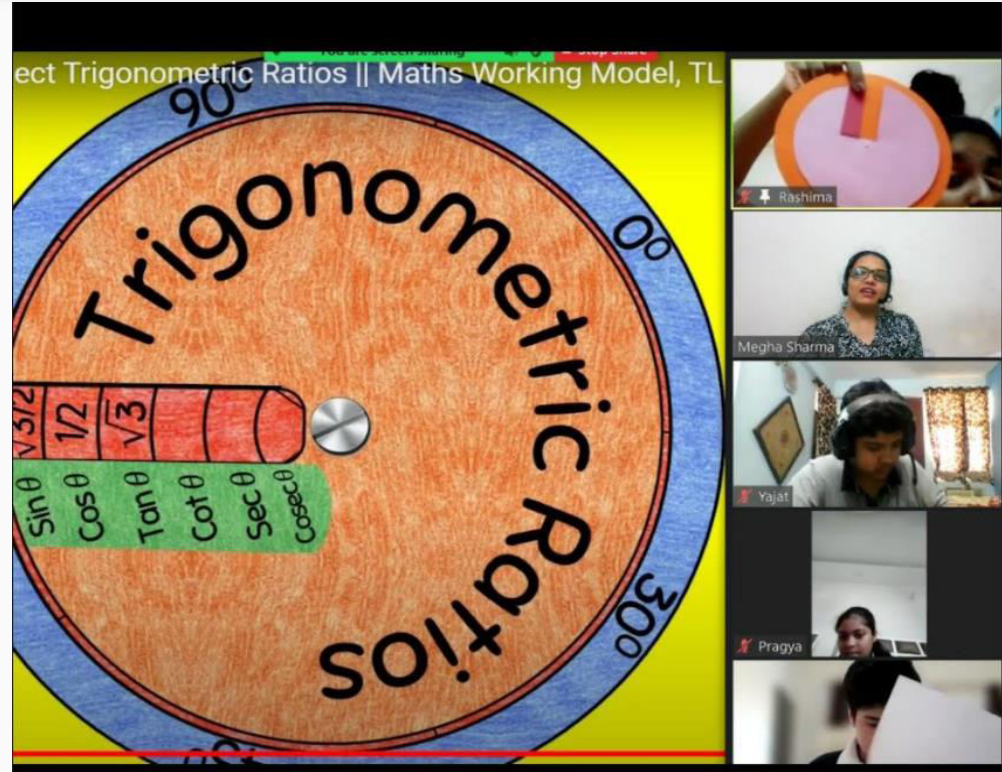
Students of class IX A did art integrated activity on lines and angles, they prepared tessellation using lines and angles.

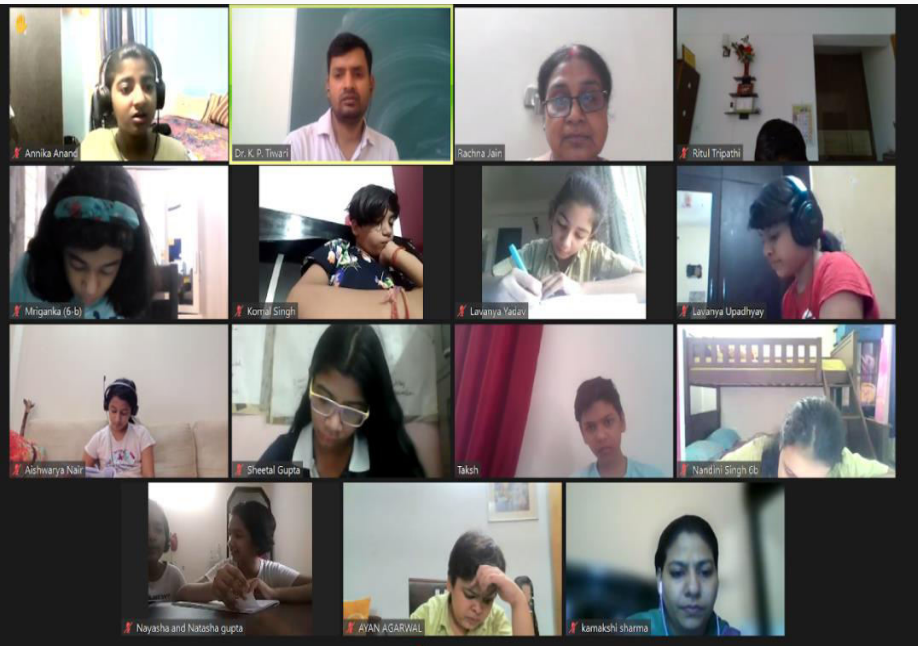

DEBATING AND JOURNALISM CLUB



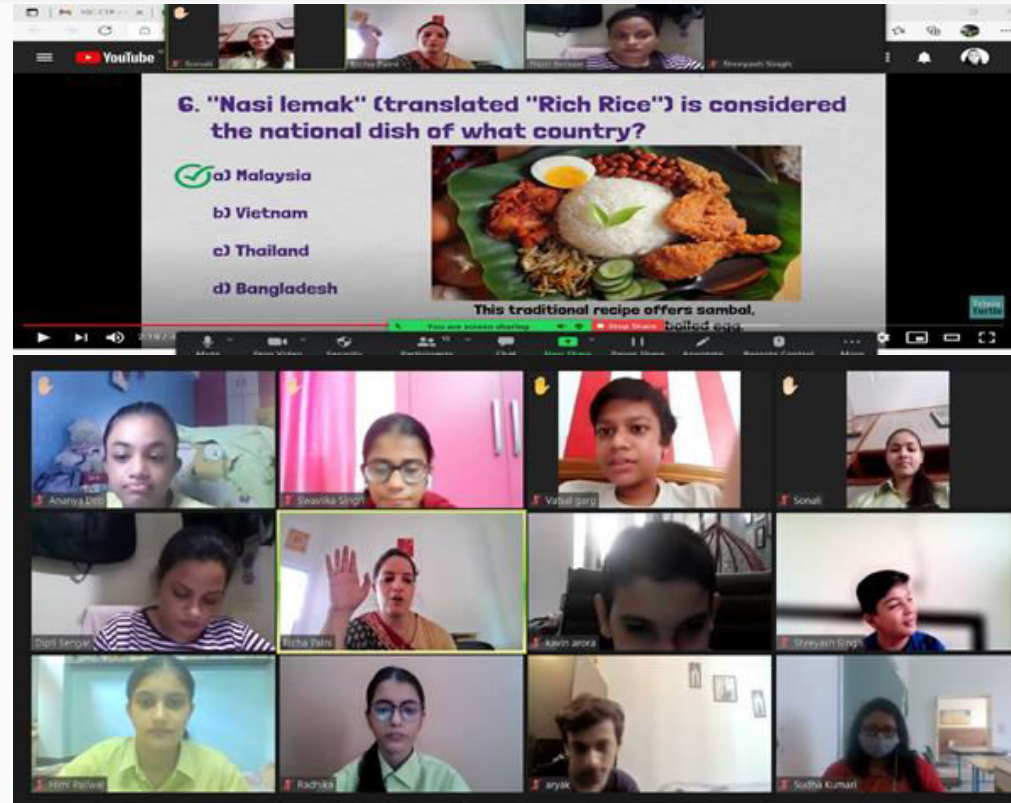

INTERACT CLUB

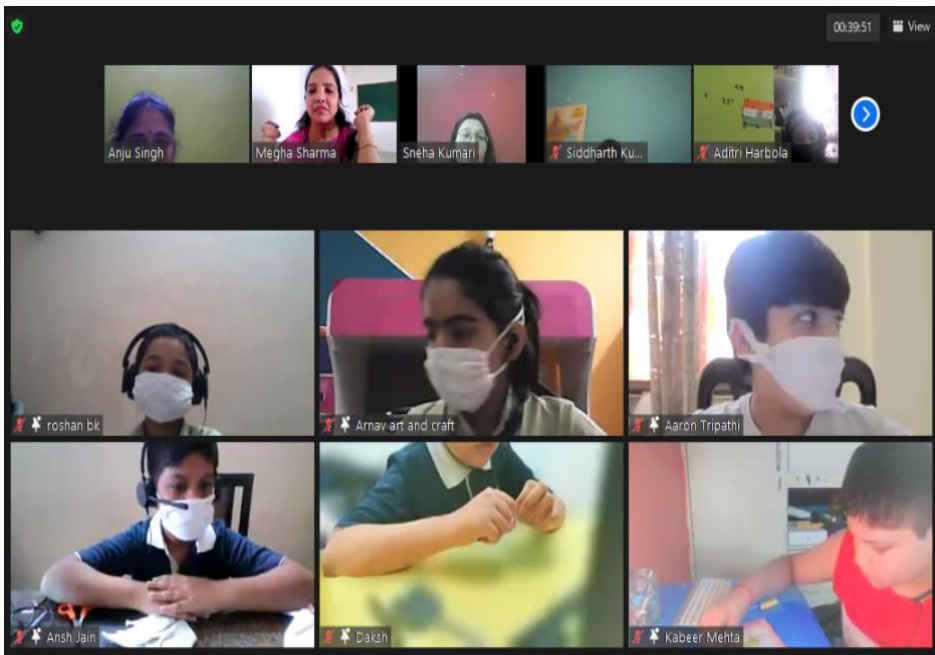

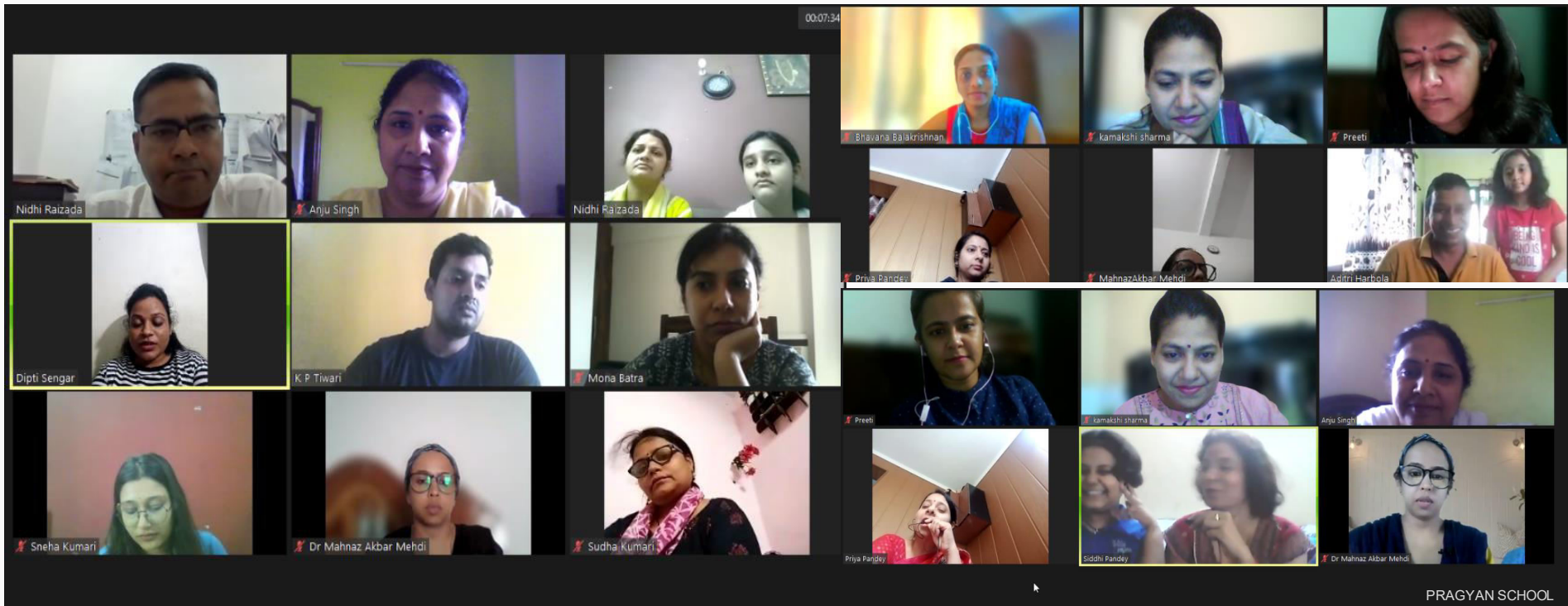
