CYBER SECURITY TIP OF THE WEEK

“THINGS TO KNOW ABOUT CYBER BULLYING”



Cyberbullying is bullying with the use of digital technologies. It can take place on social media, messaging platforms, gaming platforms and mobile phones.

How to respond to cyber bullying -

1. Do not reply to the bully.
2. Do not retaliate.
3. Block the person.
4. Keep all the emails and other messages that the bully sends as evidence.
5. Report to the platform where the bullying took place.
6. File an official report with the police.
