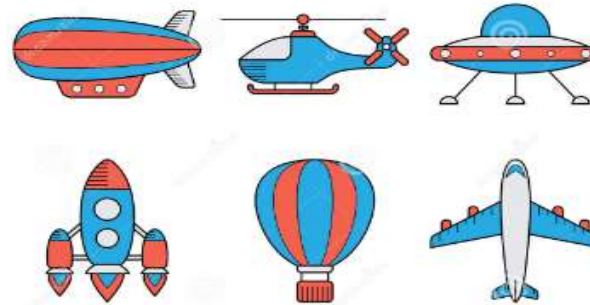


ENVIRONMENTAL SCIENCE


INTER CLASS WEEKLY ACTIVITY - HINDI CALLIGRAPHY

Conjunctions are joining words. They join words or sentences.





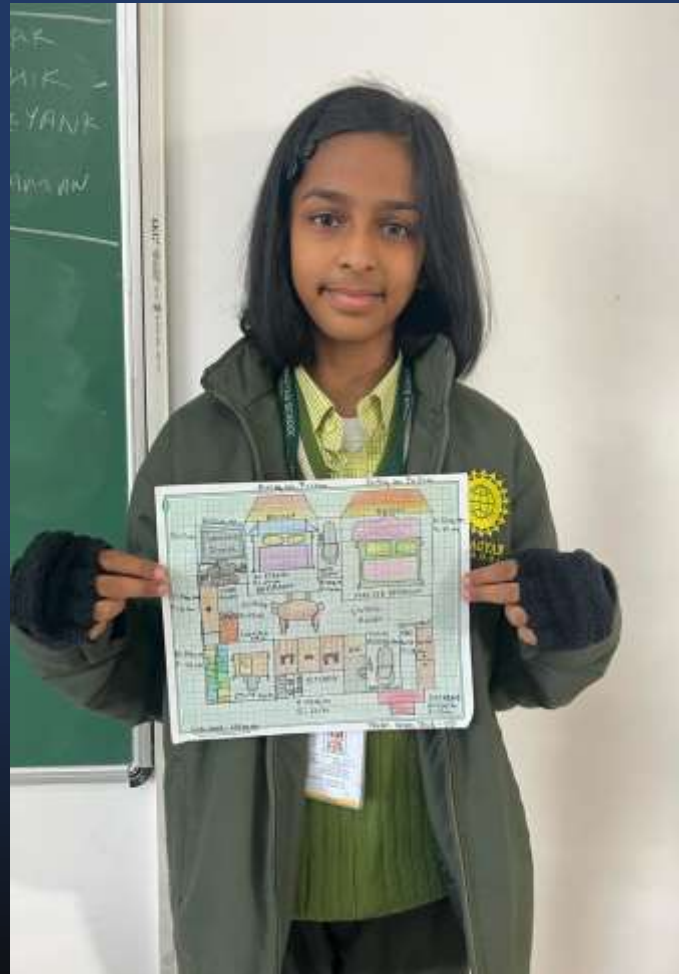

ART & CRAFT (3&4)

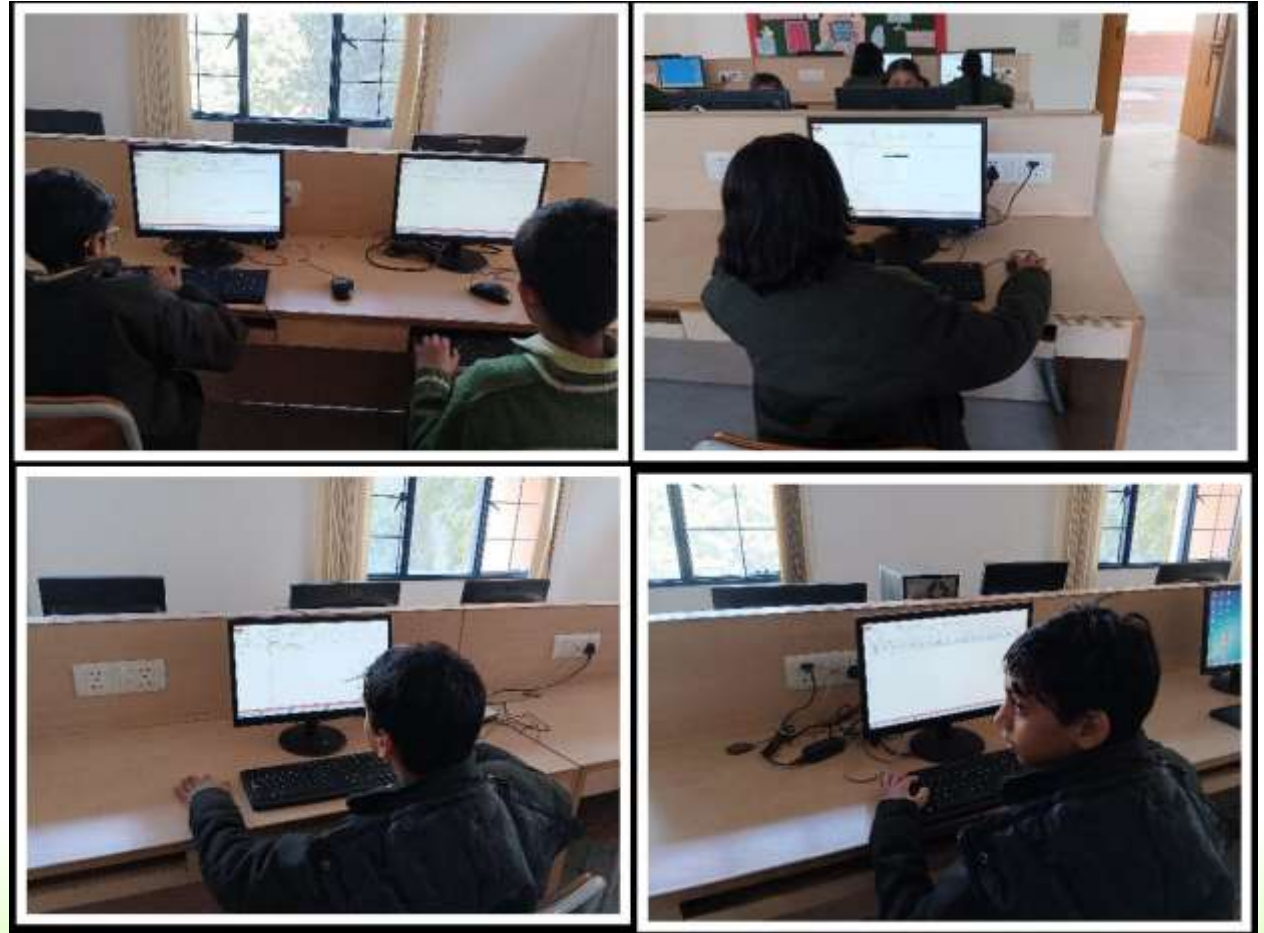
Few sections of classes 3 & 4 did poster making on Republic Day. Making a poster allows the students to answer a question by using their imagination and creativity.
