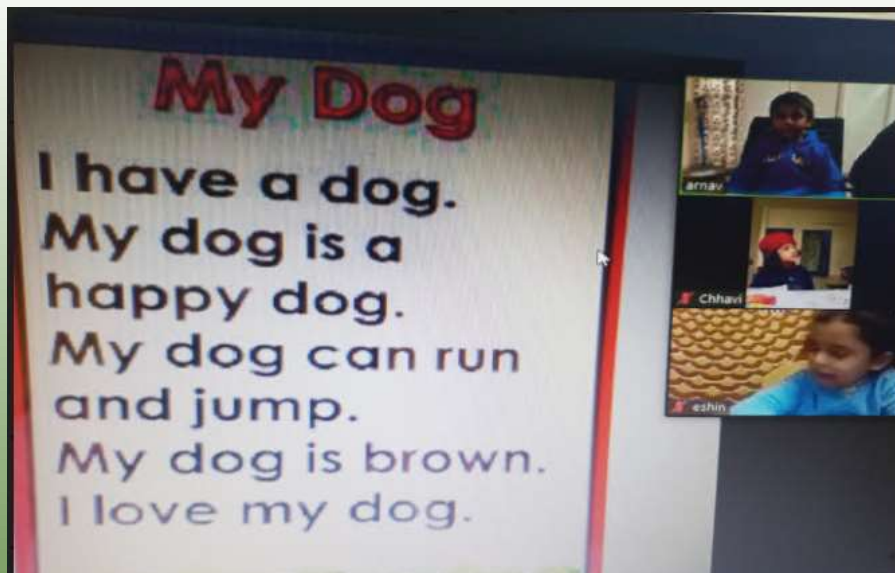

Dance- Students practiced the dance on the song 'Aayi holi re' song.

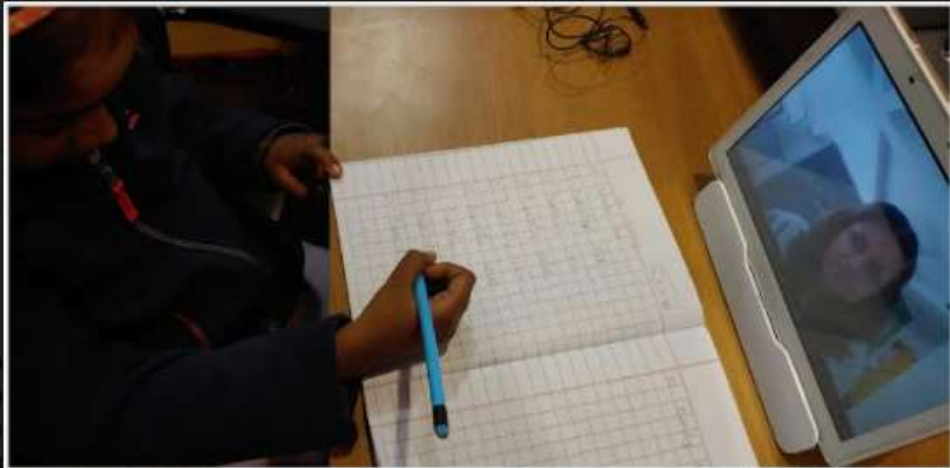
Music – Students learnt a song 'Hey bhagwan tujhe pranam'.

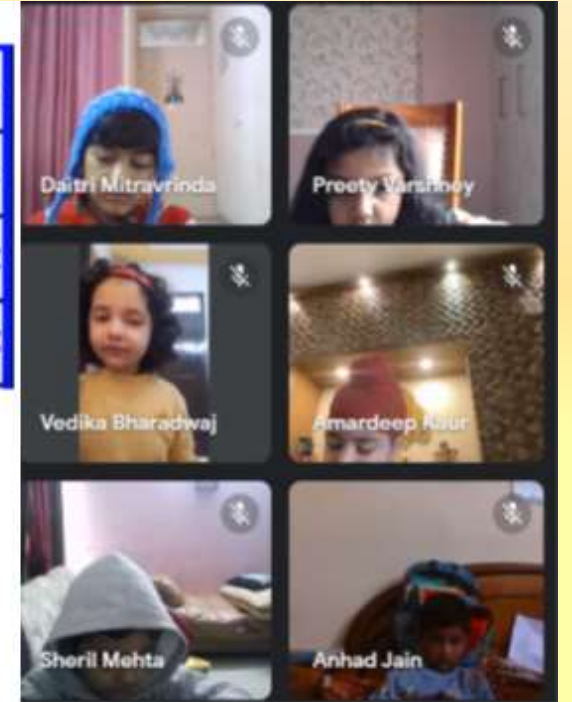

ENVIRONMENTAL SCIENCE

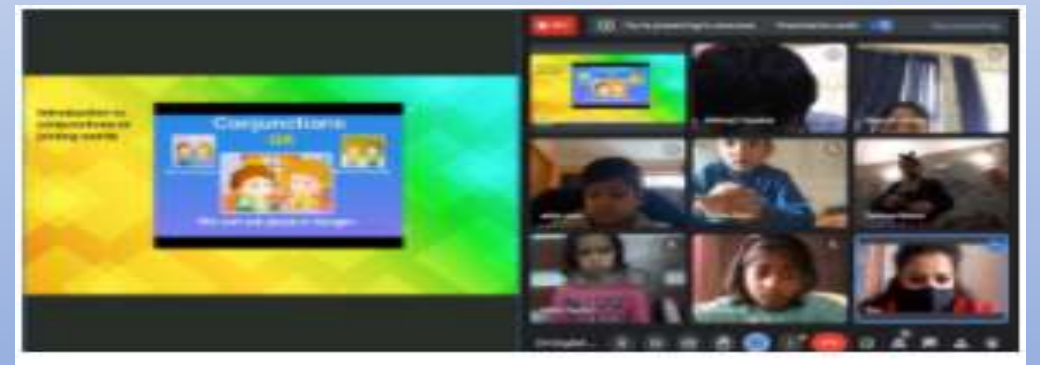
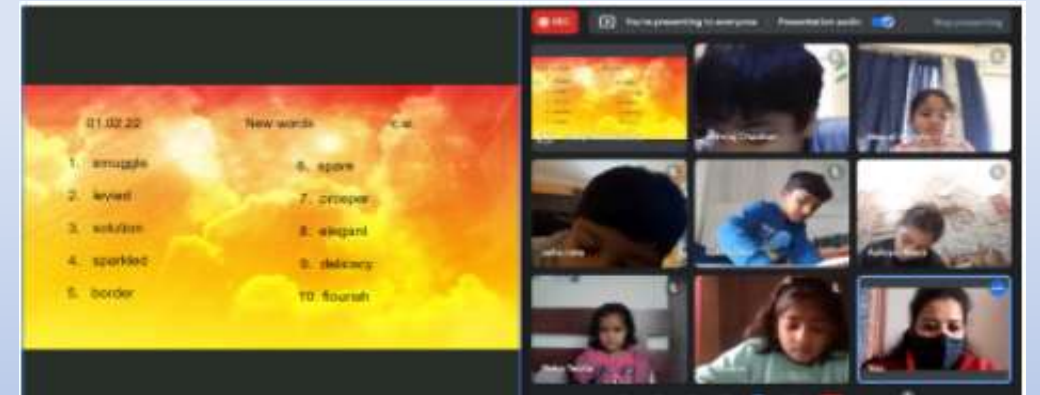
Math

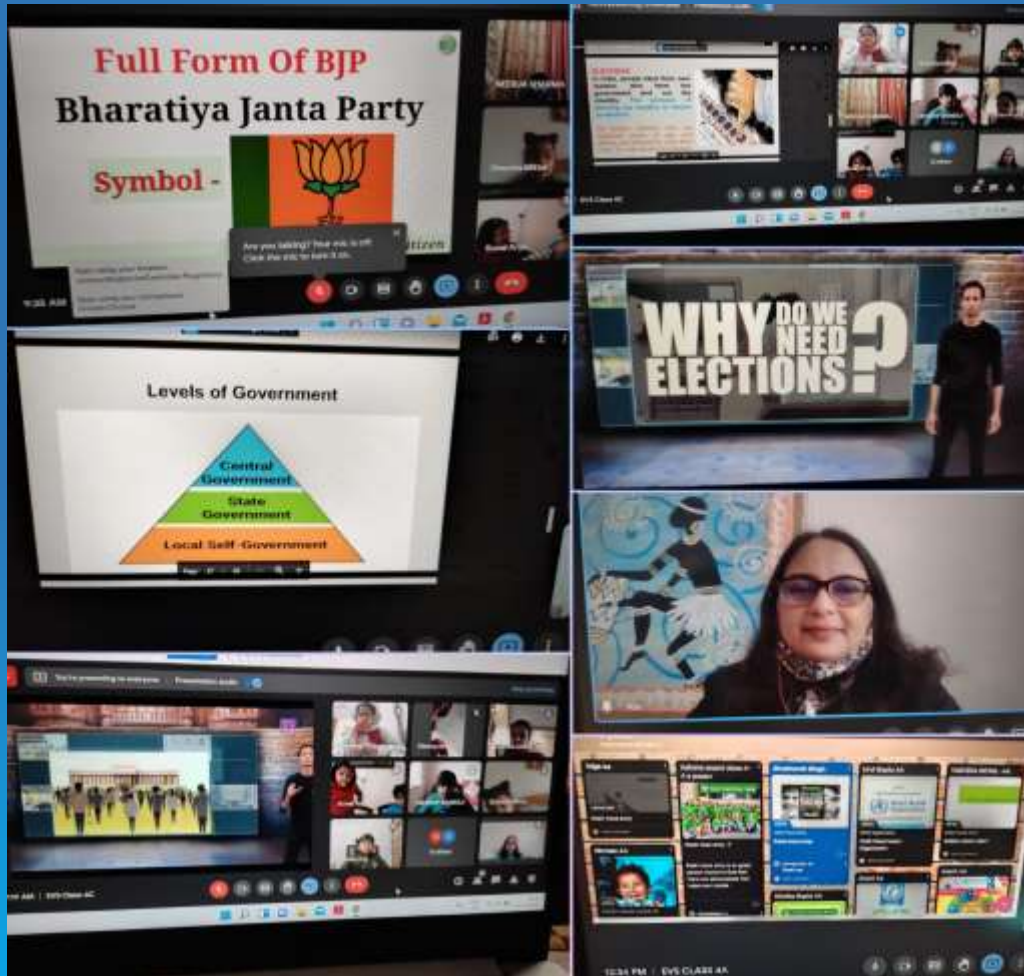


Students of Class 3 learnt various foot steps and jumps with rhythm. They also started learning new dance sequences for Holi on the contemporary/fusion music.

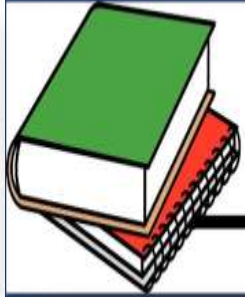




ENVIRONMENTAL SCIENCE

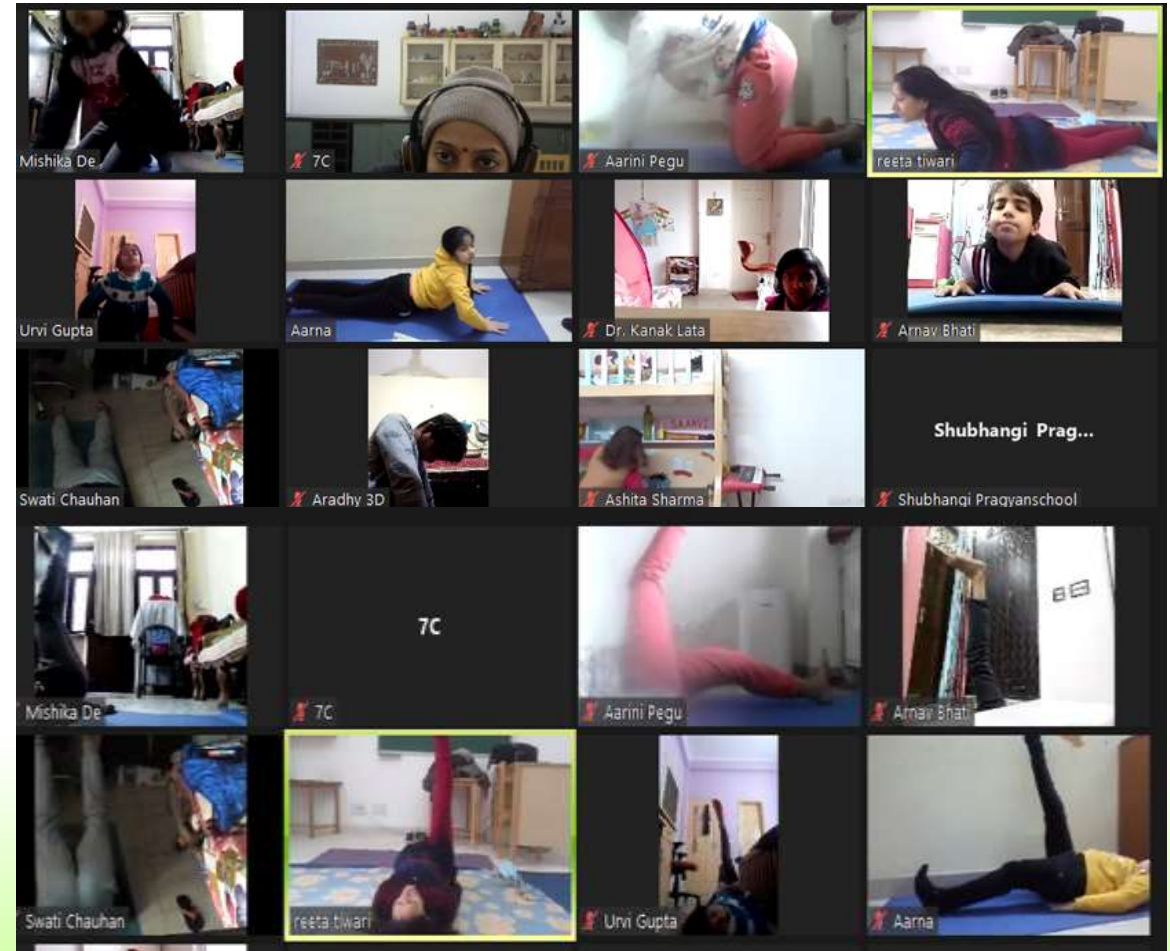

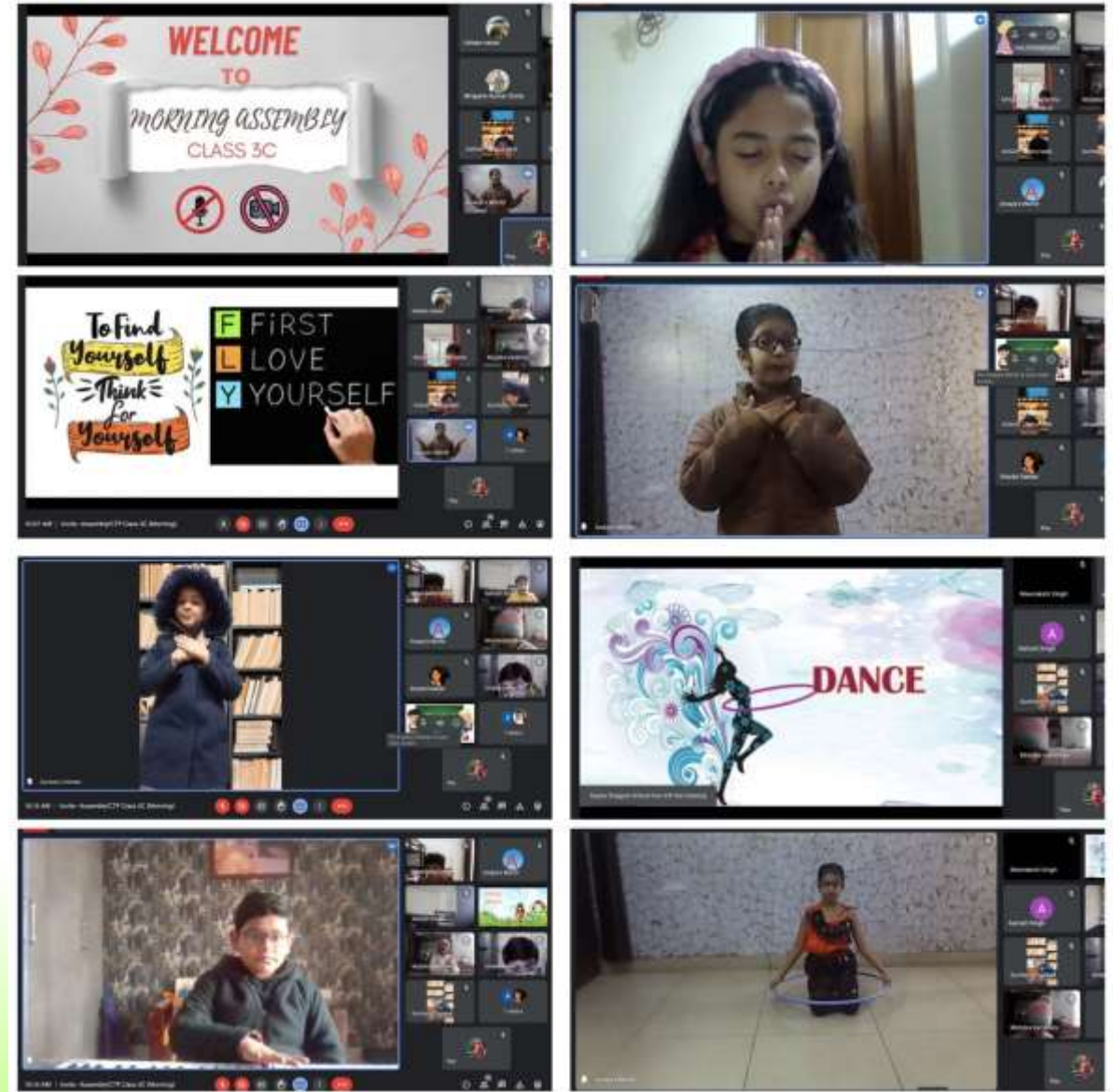
