# NURSERY



## ENGLISH

# KINDERGARTEN

## ENGLISH



Students of kindergarten learnt two letter words 'op' and 'og'. Introduction of the letter 'i' was done with the help of flash cards, pictures and stories. Students practiced writing the letter 'i' in their workbook and notebook.

# MATHS

Revision of the concept of after, before and between numbers was done. Students practiced these concepts through different strategies like flash cards, hopscotch etc. Introduction of the concept of greater than and smaller than was done with crocodile mouth.

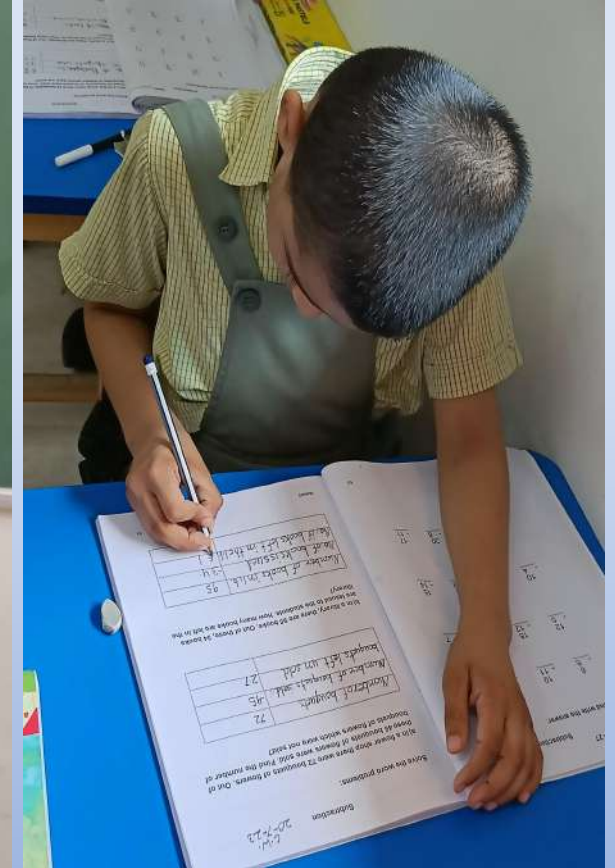




# Math

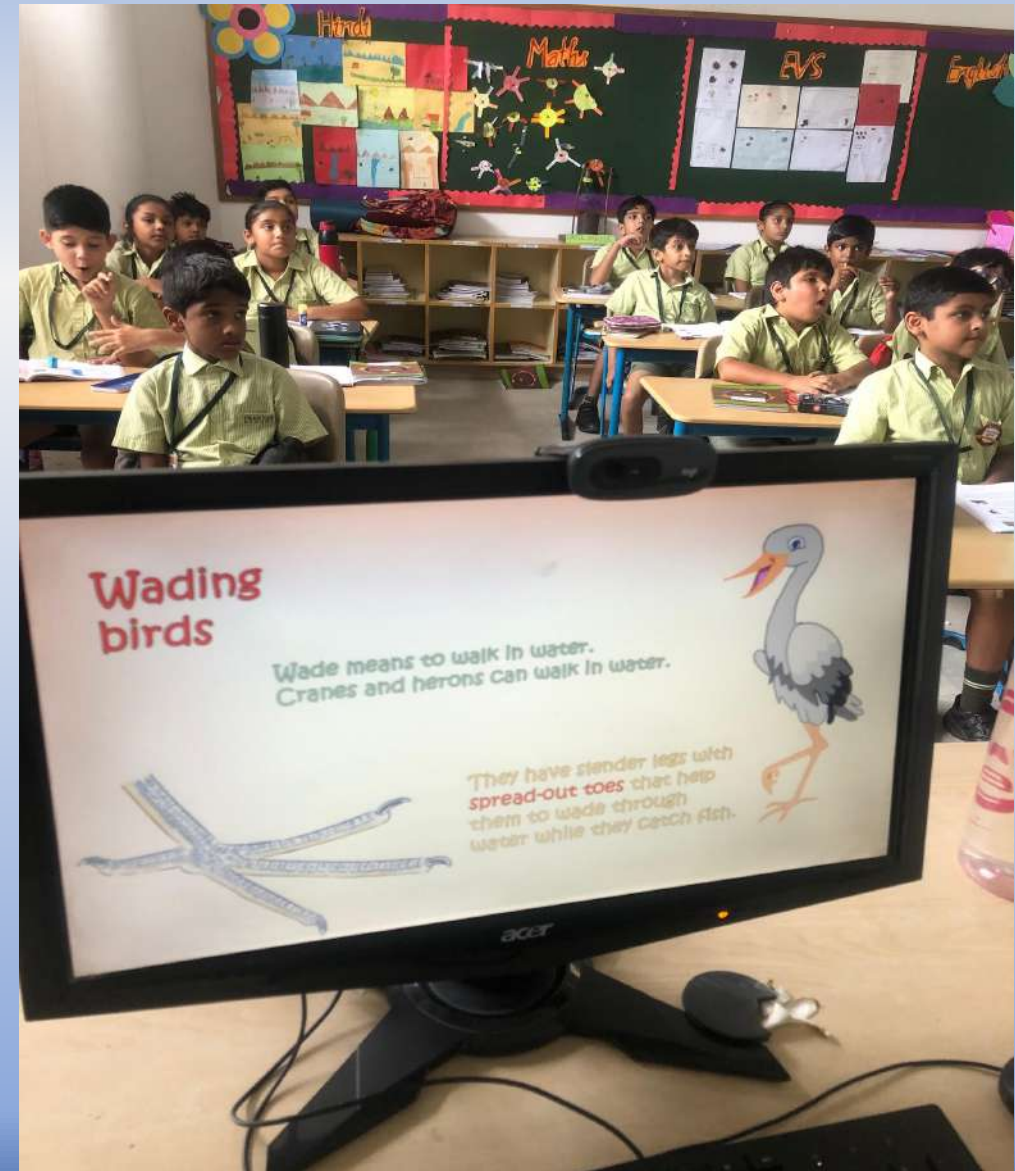

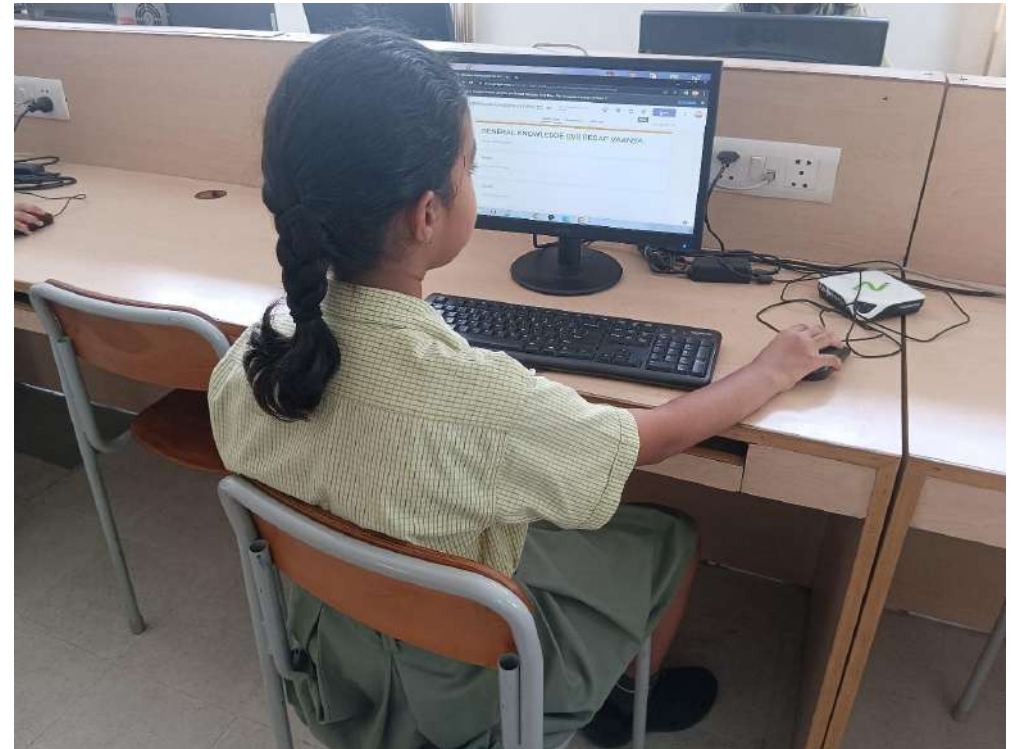
# ART & CRAFT (3&4)
