NURSERY



ENGLISH

This week, students learned the letter R, its phonic sound, and related words. They coloured worksheets and practiced writing, revising previous letters. Through these activities, students stabilized letter recognition, demonstrating progress in literacy skills and confidence in identifying the letter R.

HINDI

This week, students were introduced to the letter अ. They coloured a worksheet based on this letter and revised previous letters. Students enthusiastically found new words starting with these letters. The class showed active participation and excitement in learning new words and sounds, demonstrating progress in their literacy skills.



MATH

This week, our nursery students were introduced to Number 12. They completed the worksheets related to 12 and revised previous numbers through engaging activities like run, find the number and stop. Students showed enthusiasm and actively participated, demonstrating a budding understanding of the concept.



HANDS ON ACTIVITY

The students engaged in hands-on activities to learn numbers 1 to 10, reinforcing their understanding of math concepts. Through interactive games like Pick and Sit and Run, Find the Number, and Stop, they developed number recognition and stability skills. These activities promoted active learning and a deeper grasp of numbers.



EDUCATIONAL OUTING

This week, nursery students visited a temple, exploring its significance and culture. They observed rituals and architecture, fostering curiosity and respect. The visit introduced them to community values and diversity, providing an enriching experience. Students enjoyed the outing, developing their understanding of the world around them.



CIRCLE TIME

In Circle Time, students explored various flowers like roses and lotus, learning about their colours and significance. They understood that flowers are a part of plants. Students actively participated, answering teacher's questions and completing a related worksheet. Their curiosity and engagement were evident as they shared their thoughts and knowledge about different flowers.



KINDERGARTEN



ENGLISH

This week, the children were introduced to the am and ad word family words alongside letter x. They actively engaged in identifying, reading, and writing words such as jam, ham, dam, mad, sad, and bad etc. The students practiced writing these words in their notebooks. This not only strengthened their writing skills but also supported the development of their speaking and phonemic awareness.

HINDI

This week, children were introduced to the letters र and स. They learned new words starting with these letters, which helped in building their vocabulary. To make learning fun and interactive, children did coloring and writing activities using worksheets related to these letters. They also revised framing two letters words along with the letters learned in previous weeks to strengthen their understanding.



MATH

This week, children were introduced to the concept of tens and ones to help them understand numbers better. They learned how numbers are made using tens and ones, which is an important step in building strong math skills. They also practiced arranging numbers in ascending order. These activities helped improve their number sense and made learning math fun and engaging.



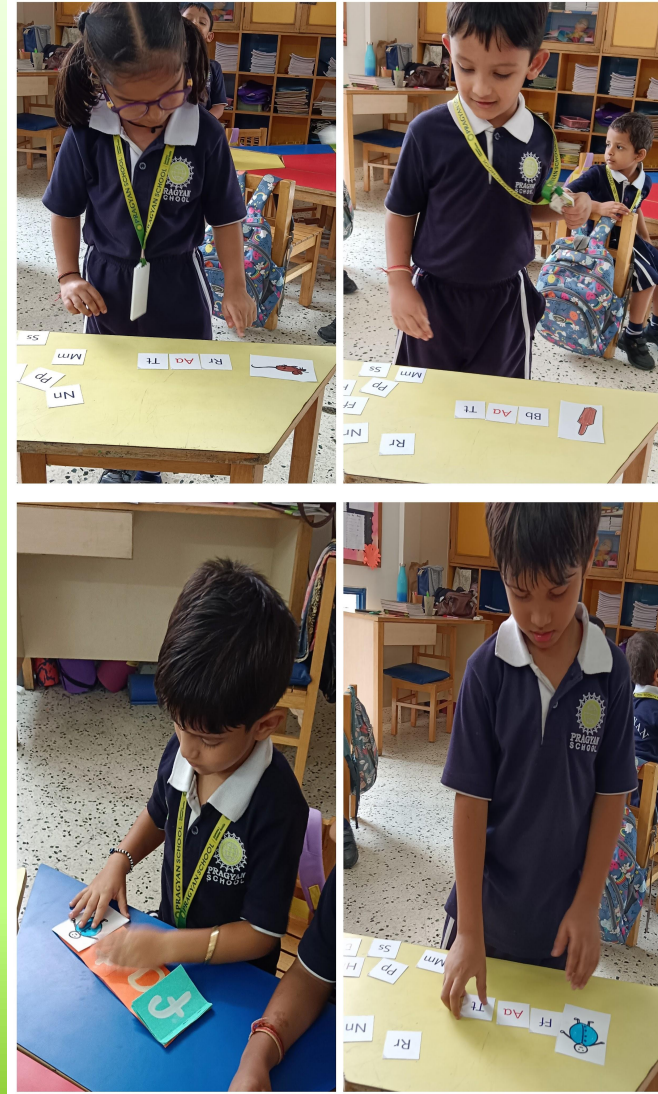
GENERAL AWARENESS

During the general awareness sessions this week, children learned about different animal habitats like forests, deserts, water, and snow. With the help of flashcards and coloring worksheets, they enjoyed exploring where different animals live. It was a fun and educational experience for the children!



HANDS ON ACTIVITY

This week, the children enthusiastically participated in hands-on activity sessions based on Hindi and English. On the first day, they identified different vyanjans through flashcards. Each child picked a card and confidently sounded out the letter. On the second day, they formed two-letter words. In English using picture flashcards they learn CVC words. Through these engaging activities, the students enjoyed learning their letters and CVC words in a playful and interactive manner.





ENGLISH

This week in English, students completed worksheets on 'oo' and 'ee' sound words in their workbooks as well as in their Early Learner books. The digraphs 'ck' and 'ng' were introduced, and students wrote words with these digraphs in their notebooks. Opposites were also introduced, and students did related worksheets. These activities enhanced their phonics skills, vocabulary, and understanding of word meanings.



HINDI

This week in Hindi, students made sentences using the given words with 'आ की मात्रा' on their own in their notebooks. In a separate activity, they added 'छोटी इ की मात्रा' to the given words to form correct and meaningful words. These activities helped enhance their vocabulary, understanding of मात्राएँ, and sentence formation skills.



MATH

This week in Math, skip counting by 2 and 5 was introduced, and students completed worksheets related to the topic. They also revised single-digit addition in their notebooks and practiced arranging numbers in ascending order from 161 to 180. These activities enhanced their number sense, counting skills, and understanding of basic addition and number order.



GENERAL AWARENESS

This week in General Awareness, students were introduced to the topic of food. A class discussion and conversation were held, during which students shared their thoughts about healthy and junk food. They also completed a worksheet related to the topic. These activities enhanced their awareness about healthy eating habits and developed their speaking, listening, and critical thinking skills.



JADUI PITARA

In Jadui Pitara English activity, students did opposites, which enhanced their vocabulary and developed their thinking and comparison skills. In Mathematics, they did skip counting by 2, which strengthened their number sense and improved their sequencing skills. In General Awareness, students took out one flash card of a festival and spoke about it, which developed their knowledge, confidence, and speaking skills. In Hindi, they placed the इ की मात्रा flash card in front of a vyanjan and read the sound, which enhanced their reading, pronunciation, and language skills.



EDUCATIONAL OUTING

Last Friday (26-09-25), the Kindergarten and Upper Kindergarten students went on an educational trip to a nearby Gurdwara. The children observed the peaceful atmosphere and learned about the significance of the place of worship. They also understood values like respect, sharing, and humility. The visit proved to be a meaningful experience for the young learners.



MUSIC

This week in Music class, students rehearsed the Sargam and learned its correct pronunciation and notes. They also learned a song during the session. These activities enhanced their musical understanding and improved their listening skills, vocal clarity, and sense of rhythm.





This week, the little learners of Class 1 began with the Poem and Words of the Month, followed by a joyful revision of has/have through the story *The Selfish Giant*. They then revisited describing words, confidently identifying and using them in interactive exercises. Moving forward, the children were introduced to prepositions—in, on, under, over, behind, and between—through engaging notebook activities. Their excitement grew as they explored prepositions further the next day with lively, hands-on exercises that made learning both interactive and enjoyable. The week was filled with enthusiasm, curiosity, and steady growth in both language skills and confidence.

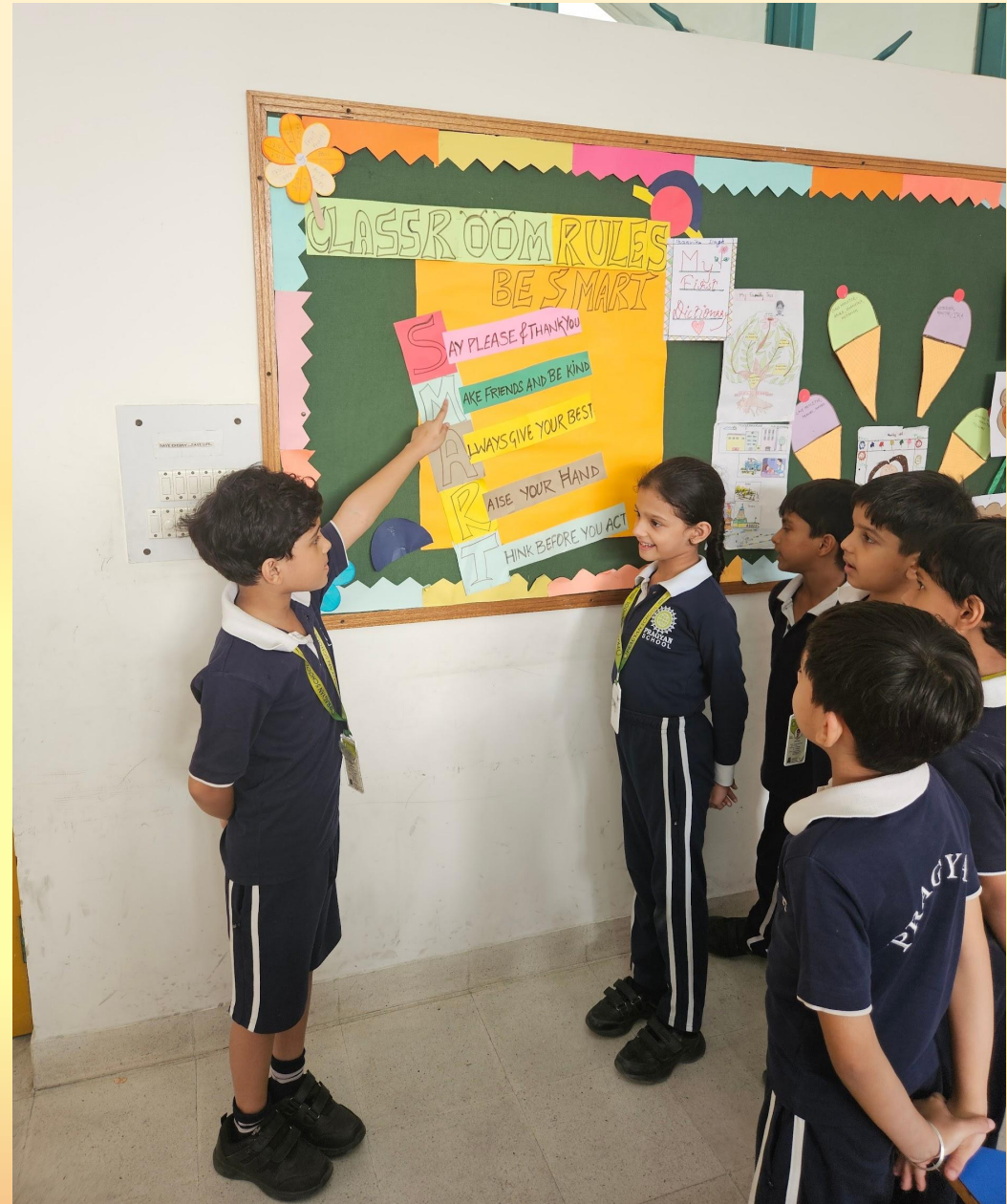

ENVIRONMENTAL SCIENCE

The children engaged in various activities on the topic of Good Habits. They completed notebook work where they wrote and illustrated their understanding of healthy practices. Workbook exercises were also practiced, reinforcing the importance of following good manners in everyday life. Through these sessions, students enjoyed learning how small positive habits help in shaping a disciplined and happy life. Children also revised classroom rules.





Students of class 2 revised the new words and the Poem of the Month with proper practice. They also took part in reading exercises, which helped improve their fluency, confidence, and understanding. The concept of pronouns was revised in class where students depicted some pronouns using art integration in their notebooks.

Class 2 students explored 2D and 3D shapes and drew real-life objects based on them. They also revised the multiplication table of 8 and took part in interactive activities to strengthen their concepts. The children showed enthusiasm and creativity while connecting shapes with objects from daily life.





ENVIRONMENTAL SCIENCE

The students of Grade 2 explored the importance of food for the body, learning how it provides energy, supports growth, keeps us healthy, and protects us from illnesses. They actively participated in discussions and activities, connecting food concepts to their own daily eating habits. The students also engaged in a STEM activity on the food pyramid, understanding the significance of a balanced diet and the right proportions of different foods for good health. They enjoyed arranging the items creatively and shared examples from their own meals, making the learning both interactive and meaningful.

A fun clapping activity based on different multiples was conducted and thoroughly enjoyed by the students. Related worksheets were also completed in class to reinforce the concept. Additionally, a revision of division was carried out during the Mindspark classes.





ENVIRONMENTAL SCIENCE

The students of Grade 4 successfully completed the chapter **Natural Resources of India**. They learned about the **different types of forests** found in our country and gained knowledge about **national parks and wildlife sanctuaries**. The chapter helped them understand the significance of conserving forests and protecting India's rich biodiversity.





This week, Class V explored Verbs and Tenses in detail. To make the concept more engaging, students also participated in a lively ‘Time-Travel Interview’ activity, where they stepped into the role of time travelers and answered questions in past, present, and future tenses. In addition, students had a focused Mindspark session, where they practiced grammar-based exercises at their own pace. This adaptive platform helped them strengthen individual concepts and apply their learning more effectively.
