E.V.S: Recapitulation of Ostrich was done in the class. Students enjoyed colouring in the workbook.

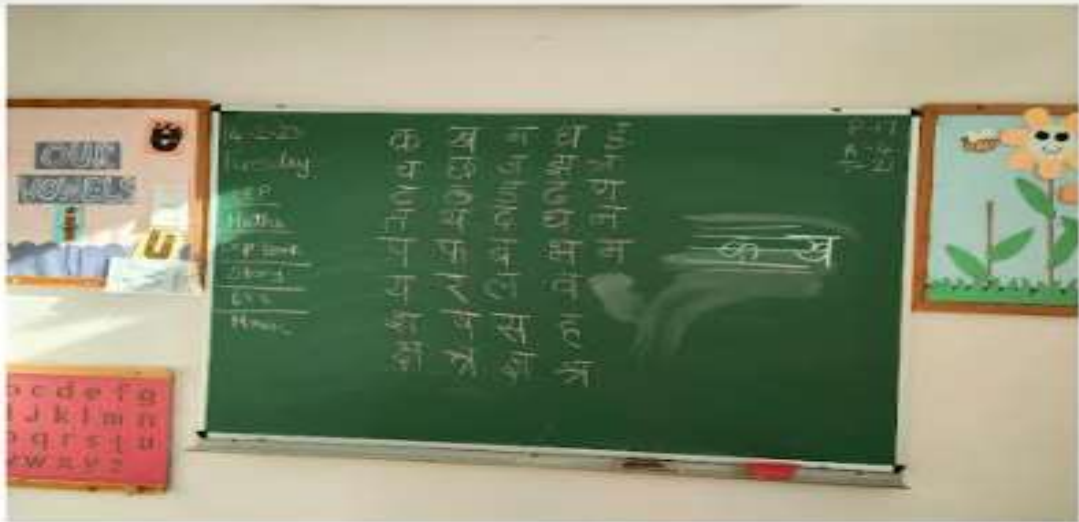
KINDERGARTEN



OUTBOUND LEARNING - NATIONAL ZOOLOGICAL PARK

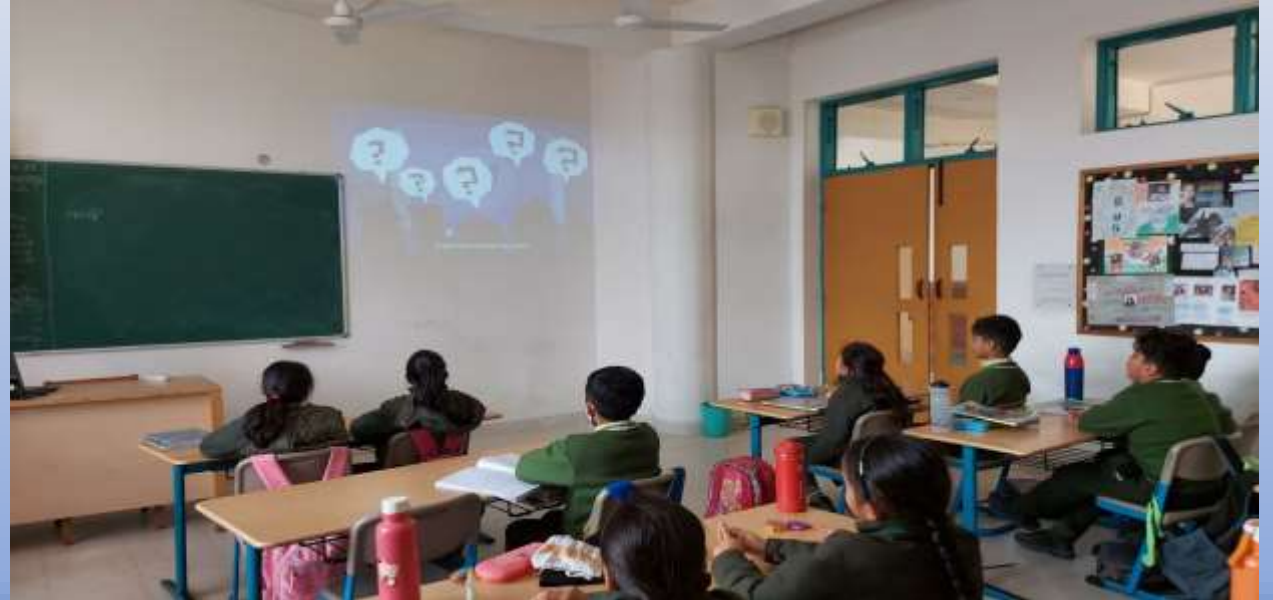
Educational outing allows the students to work as a team. They make lifelong memories among peers, which is no doubt a fun learning experience in itself. Students of class 2 got the opportunity to learn beyond the textbooks. They were privileged to visit the National Zoological park, New Delhi where they got to see different animals, birds and reptiles. They were astonished to see the leopard, Royal Bengal tiger and Jaguar, they seemed tame and snoozing in the Sun. They were stunned to see the beauty of peacocks and white peacocks. They also got to see wolves roaming around, huge bears and hippopotamus, monkeys, and crocodiles. They could relate it to the Chapter: Animals from their EVS textbook and could differentiate the herbivores, carnivores and Omnivores animals. For kids the experience was relishing, they asked different questions like how they are being brought here, how they get food etc and showed keen interest to learn facts about them. The overall educational outing was an enriching experience for the students.

Students of class 3 were introduced to the grammatical concept of Question Words or Wh- Words. Related ppts and videos were shown. They did exercises on Framing Questions too. The ASL was conducted too, wherein the students watched a video and answered the questions based on that.

The in-house Maths Olympiad was conducted at the end of the week and students enthusiastically participated and solved questions based on the topics learnt and logical reasoning.





ENVIRONMENTAL SCIENCE

Students were taught about Kolkata from the chapter- Important Cities of India in which they learnt the history, climate, culture, and tourist attractions of this city.
