EVS- ‘Cockroach’ and its features was done in the class.

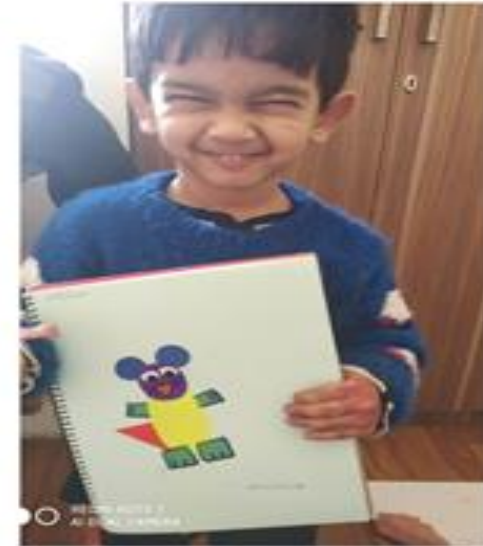
Music- Children practised the song related to the festival ‘आज सन्डे हँ’.

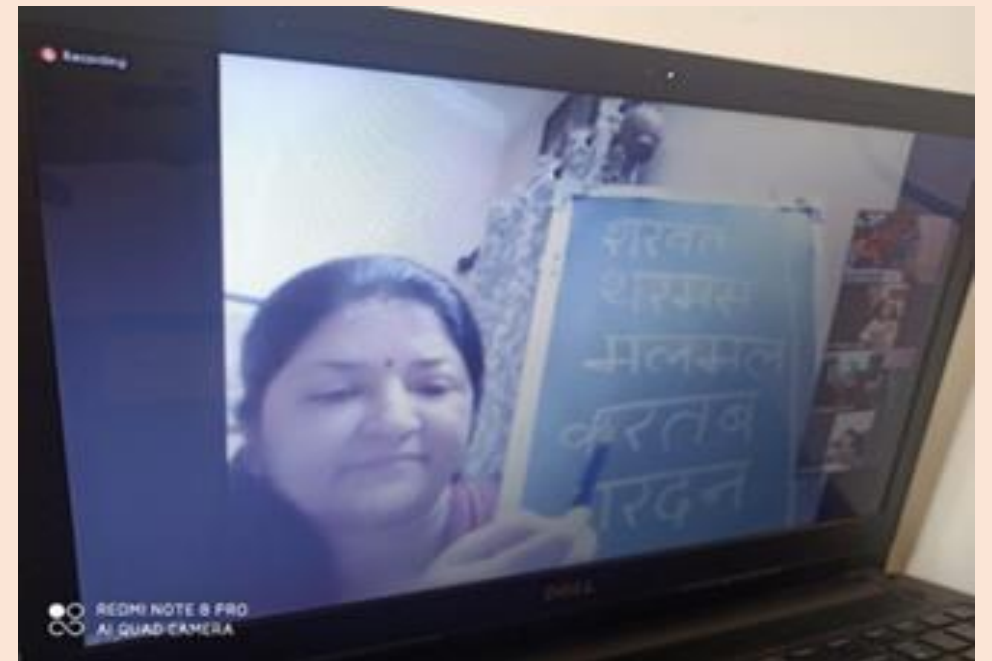
Evs- Discussion on birds and introduction of Vulture and owl were done. The students also learnt few facts about birds.

Music- Students enjoyed learning "Aaj hai Sunday" song in the class.





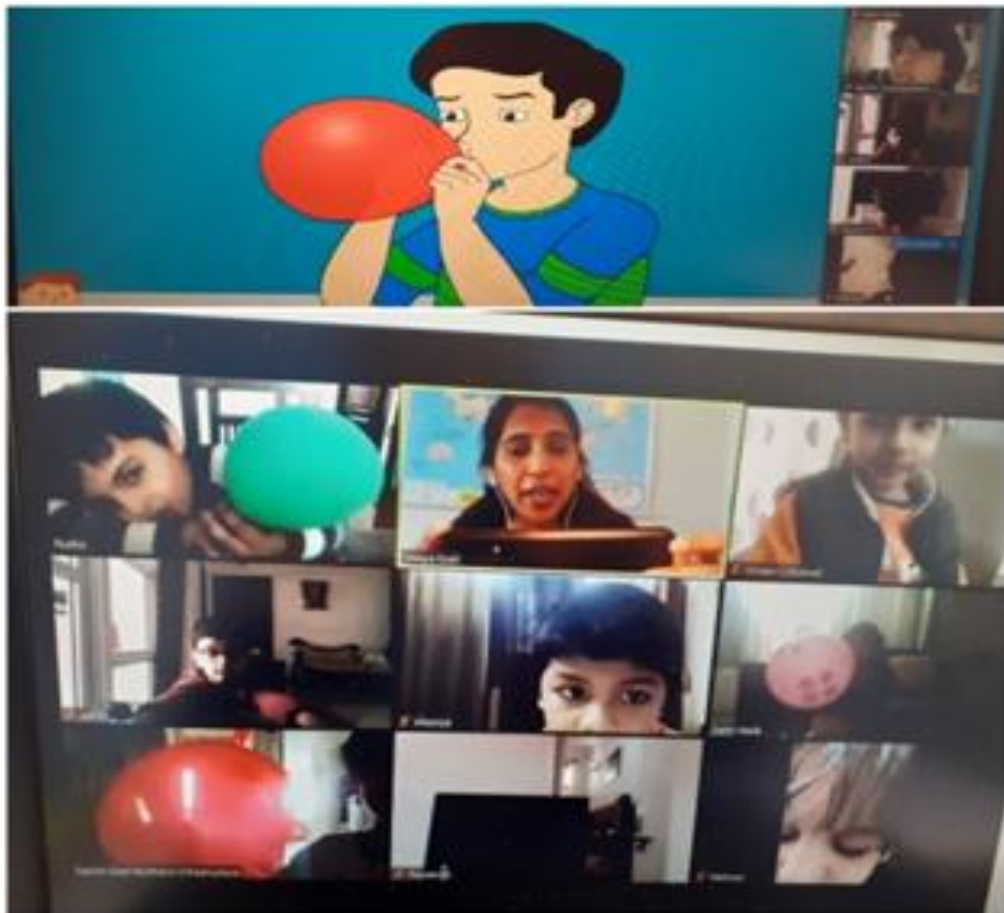

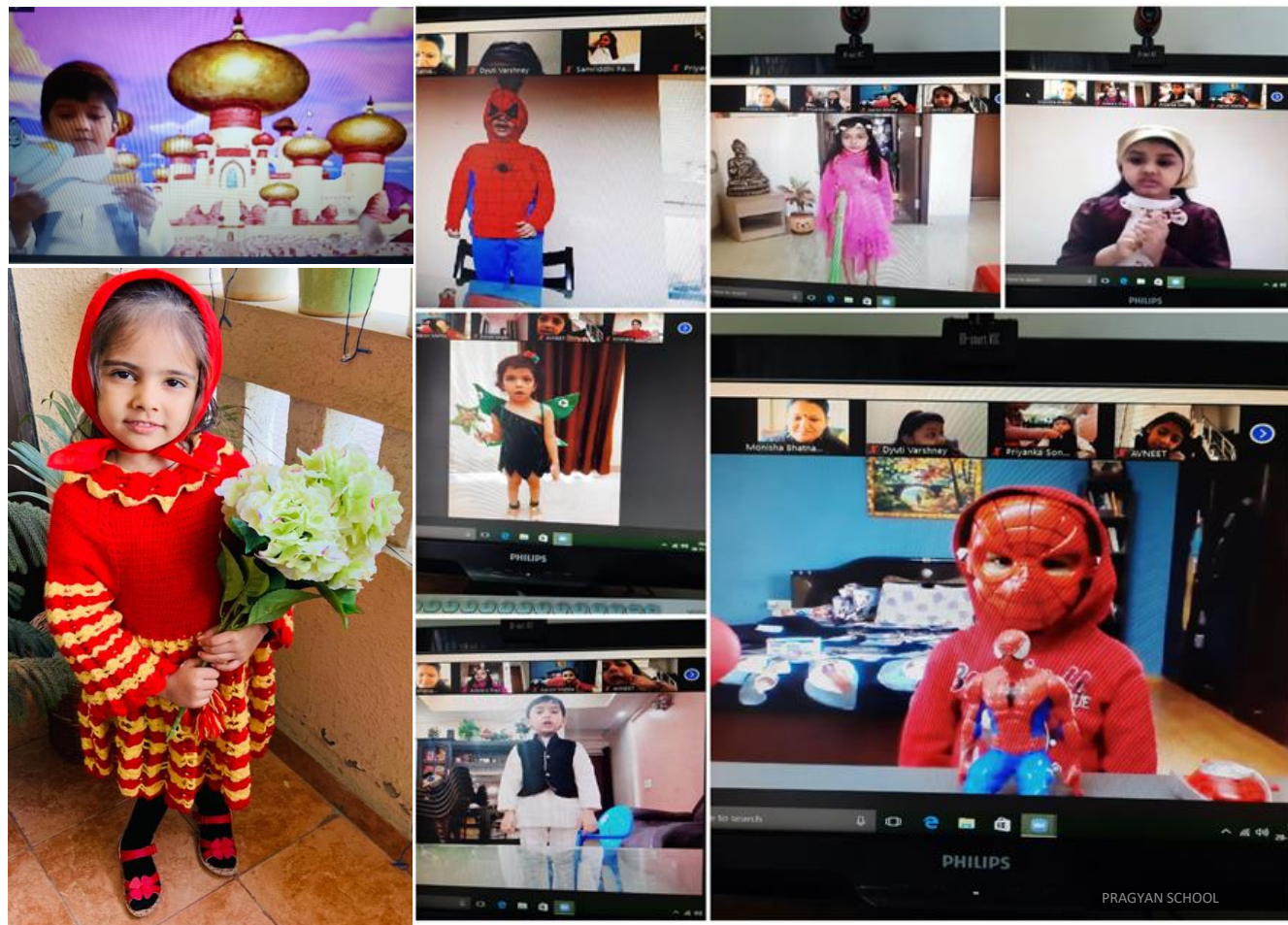


Science demonstration- properties of Air was taught by showing PPT and balloon activity. .Students learnt few lines like all living things need air to breath etc

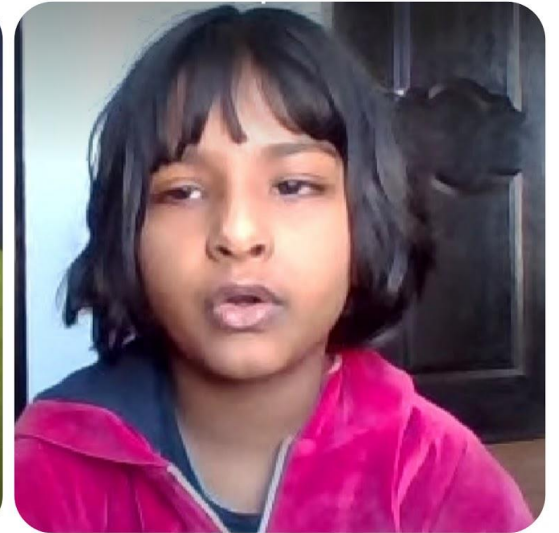

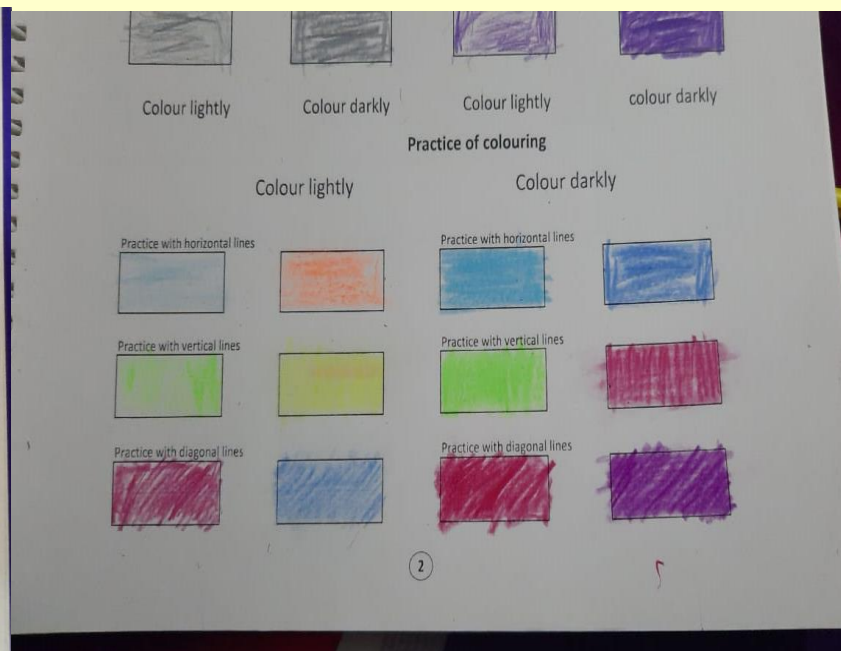
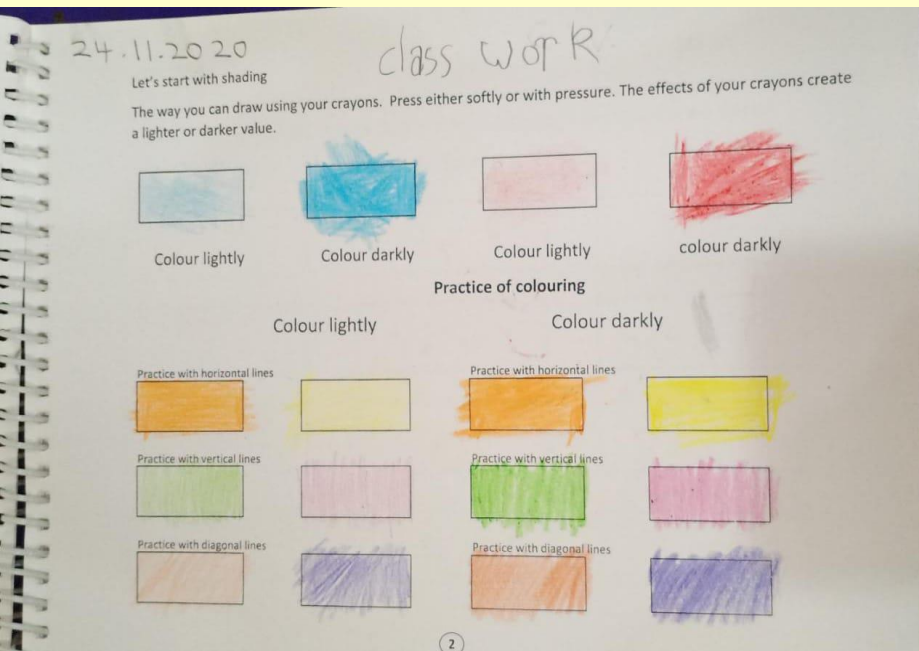

The students of grade 1D learnt the song 'Bande Hain Hum Uske' teaching them the importance of doing hardwork in life.






Students of classes -1 A and 1B learnt some steps of shading. They really enjoyed colouring lightly and darkly in different ways.




COLLABORATIVE SESSION – EVS QUIZ

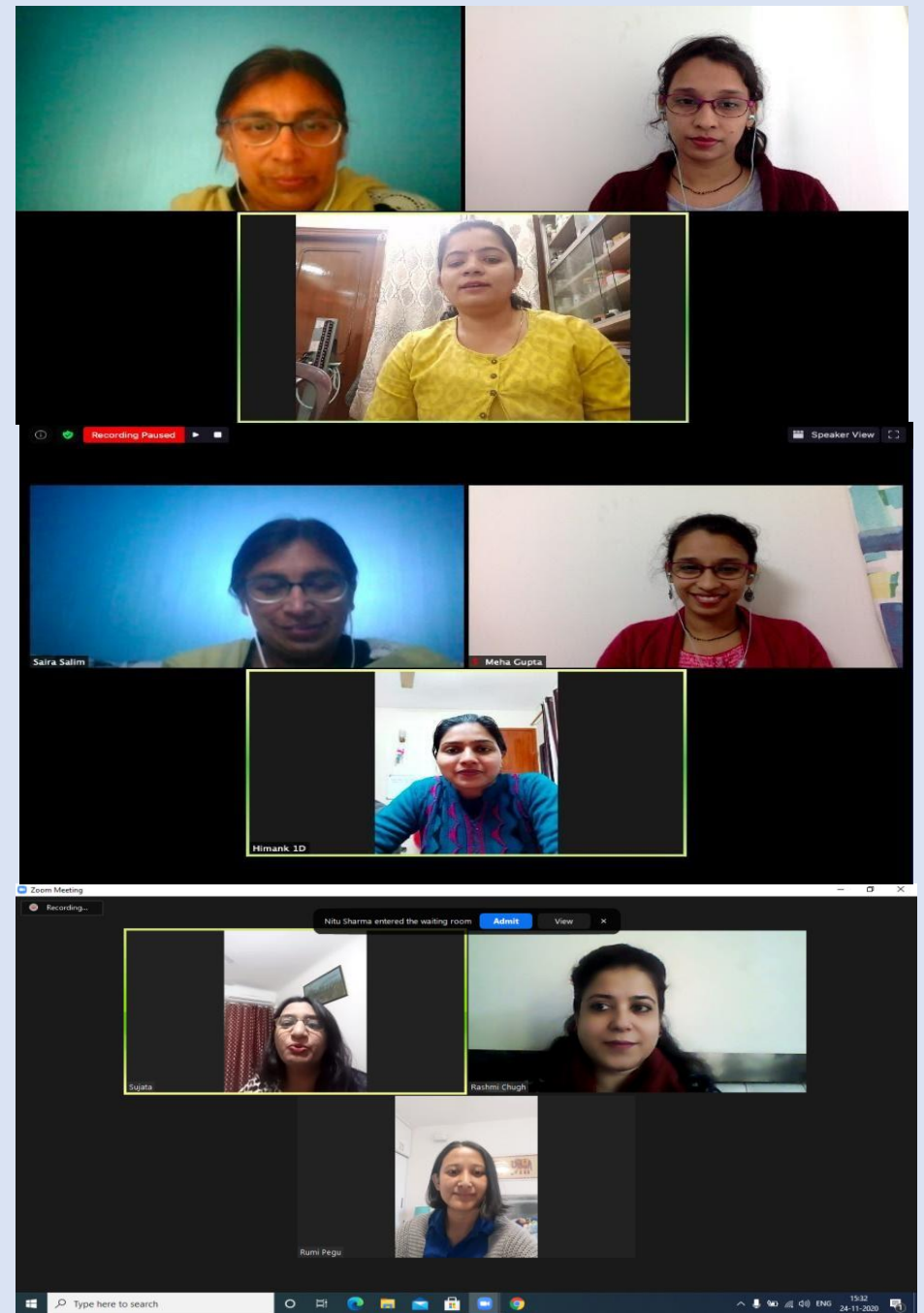
INTER-CLASS COMPETITION CLASS-2

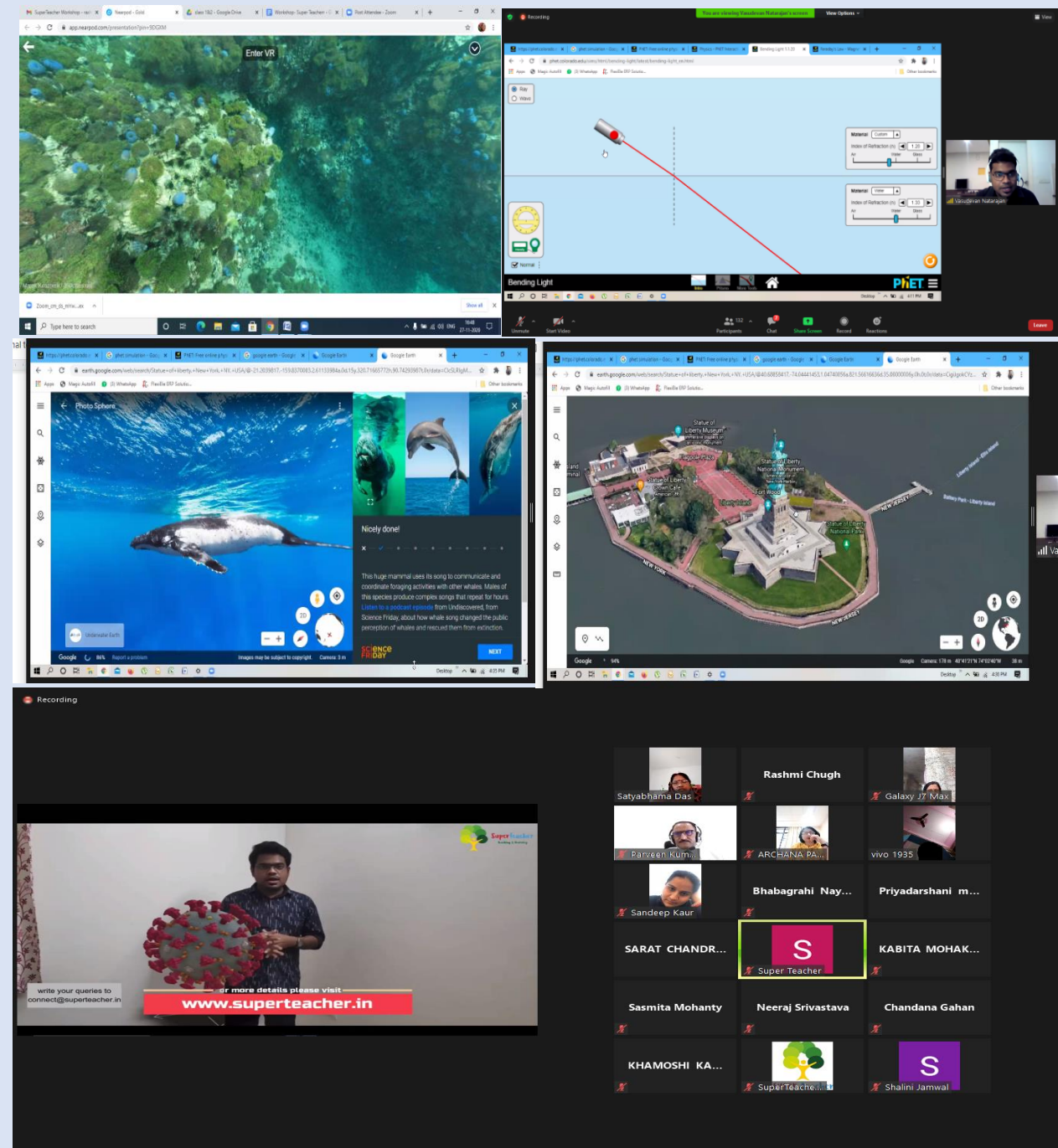
ONLINE PARENT-TEACHER MEET

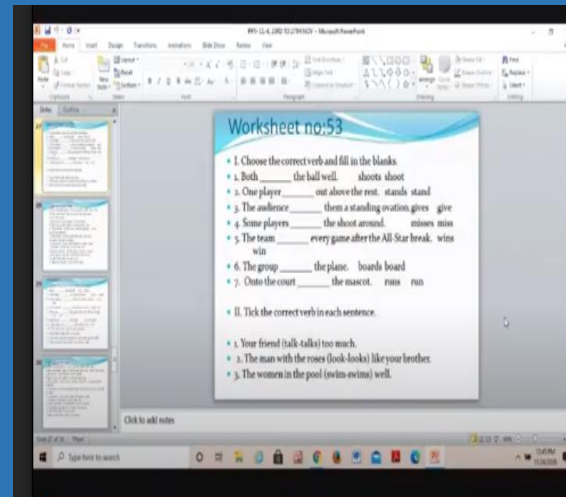


Students of class 3 did worksheets on "Vachan" in the workbook. They were shown a powerpoint presentation for quick reference. They also did reading and hindi activity.

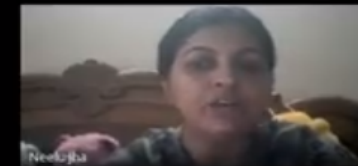
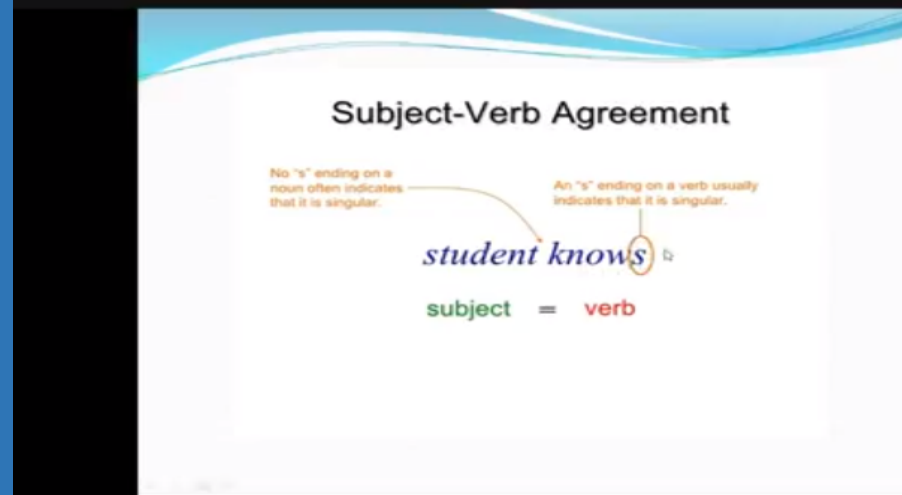

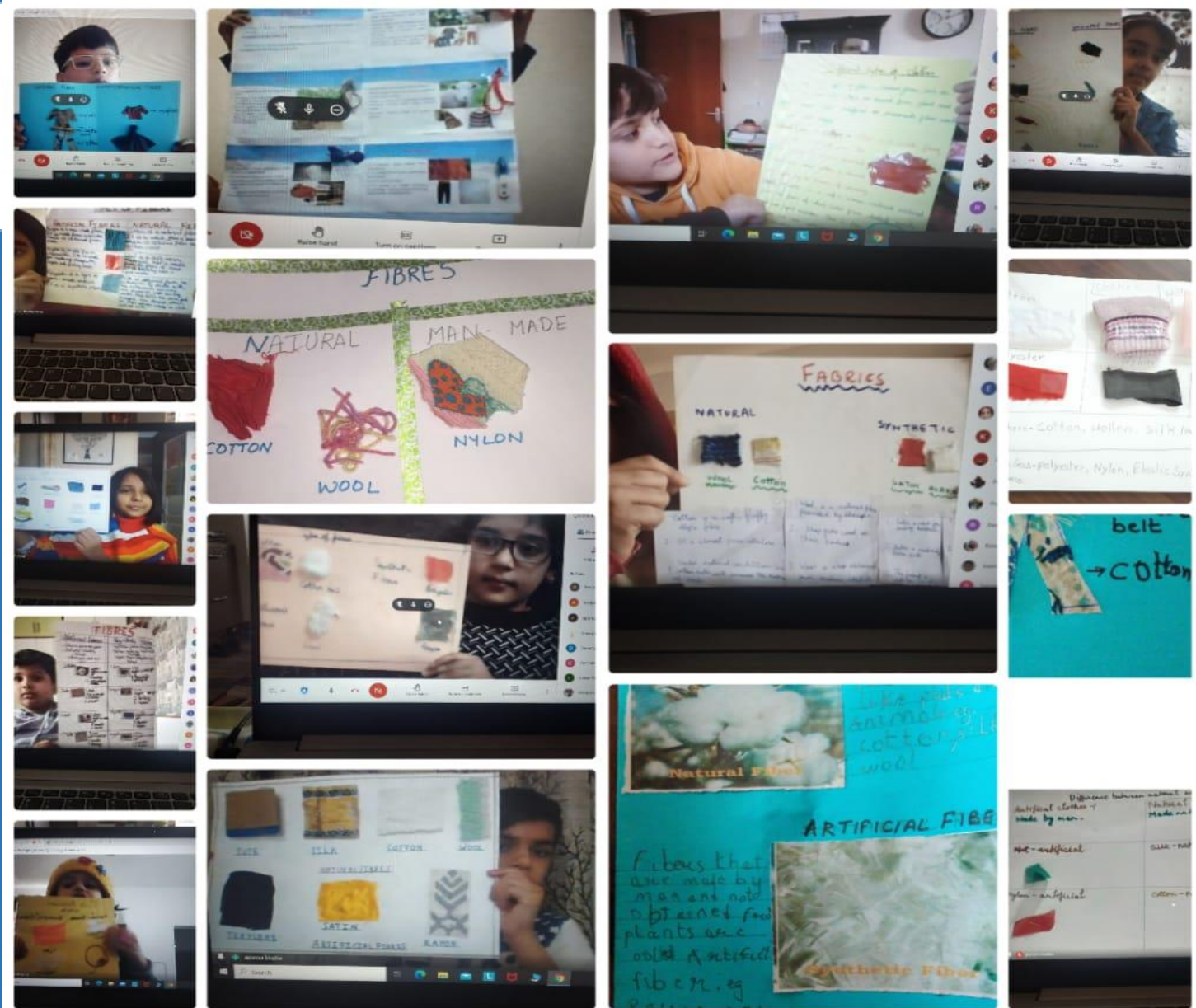
The formative assessment of Hindi for students of class 4 took place this week. The students did creative writing work, poem recitation and reading.

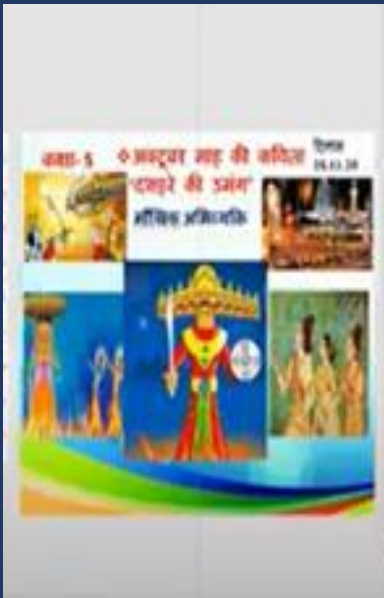

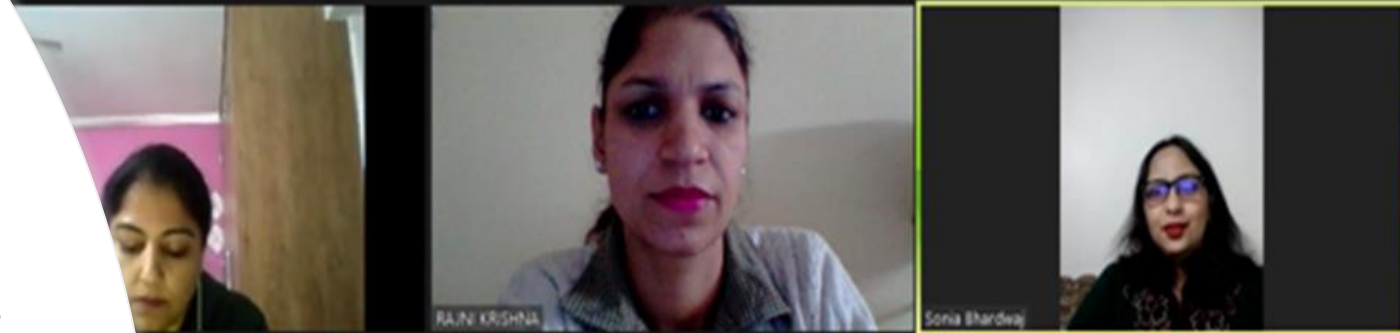
