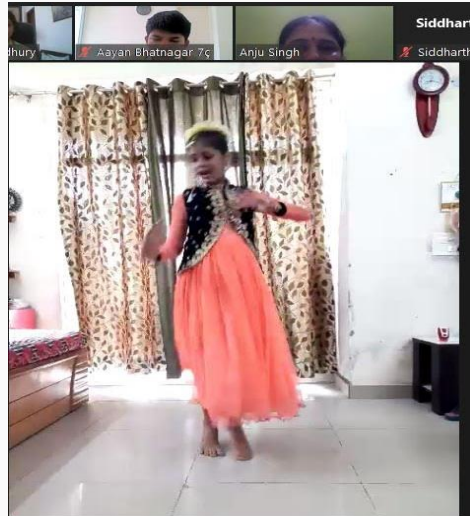

मीराबाई का जन्म जोधपुर राजस्थान के मेड़ता में 1498 में हुआ था। इनके पिता का नाम रतन सिंह राठौर था जो एक छोटे से राजपूत परिवार के प्रमुख थे। मीराबाई अपने माता-पिता की इच्छा से शांति में जीतीं। जब बड़े बाल्यावस्था में श्री तन्त्री उनके माता का निधन हो गया था। मीराबाई के दादा रावदत्ता ने अपने दो बेटों में उनका पालन पोषण किया। रावदत्ता एक शोभा के साथ एक भक्त हृदय व्यक्ति श्री श्री और साधु-संतों का आना-जाना इनके गृहों में रहता था। इसलिए मीराबाई बचपन से ही धार्मिक लोगों के संपर्क में आती रहीं। इनके साथ ही उन्होंने तैर-तलवार, चुड़ैसवरी, शंखचालन, शांकरचालन के साथ-साथ संगीत तथा आध्यात्मिक शिक्षा भी पाई। कहा जाता है कि शांका में 1547 में मीराबाई कृष्णभक्ति करते-करते श्री कृष्ण की मूर्ति में समा गयीं। अर्थात् उनकी मृत्यु होगयी।



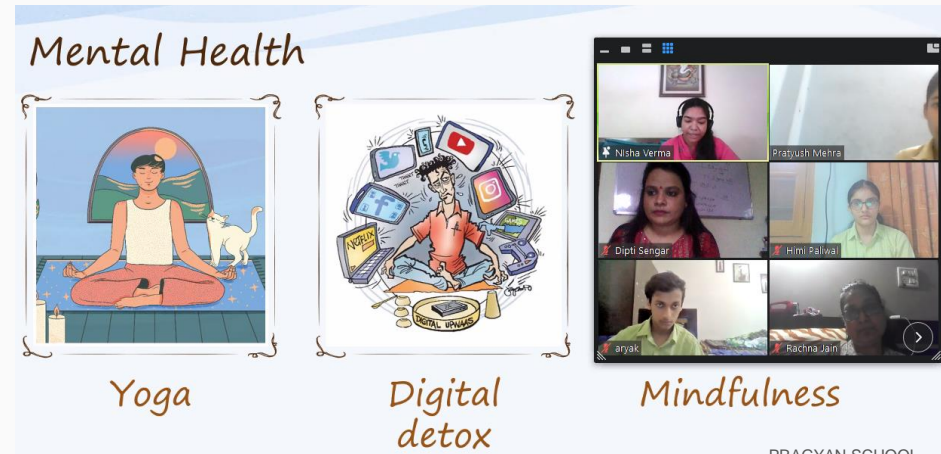
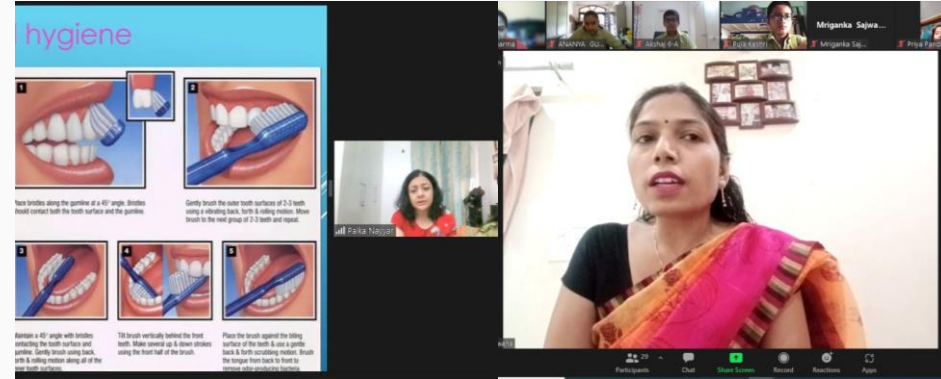
MORNING ASSEMBLY [IX-XII]

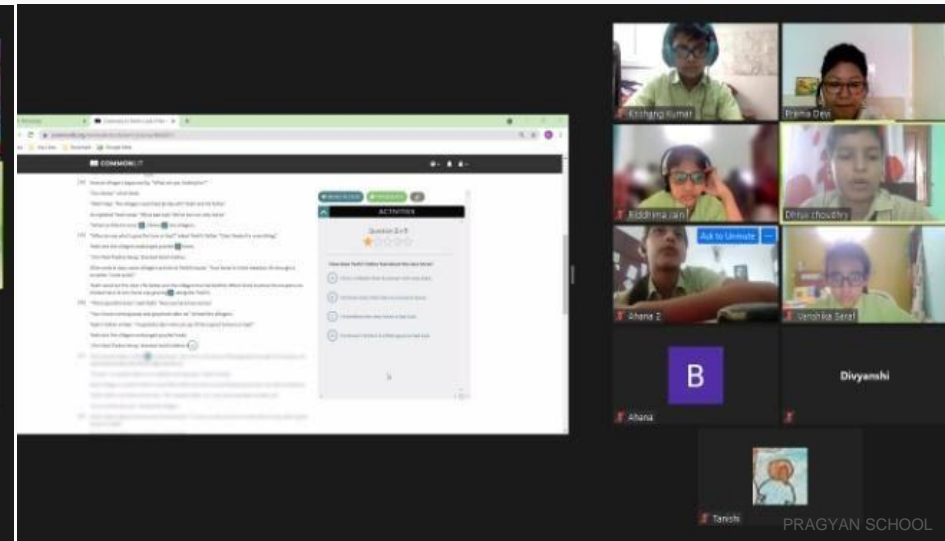
PARENTAL INVOLVEMENT : ASSEMBLY [IX- XII]

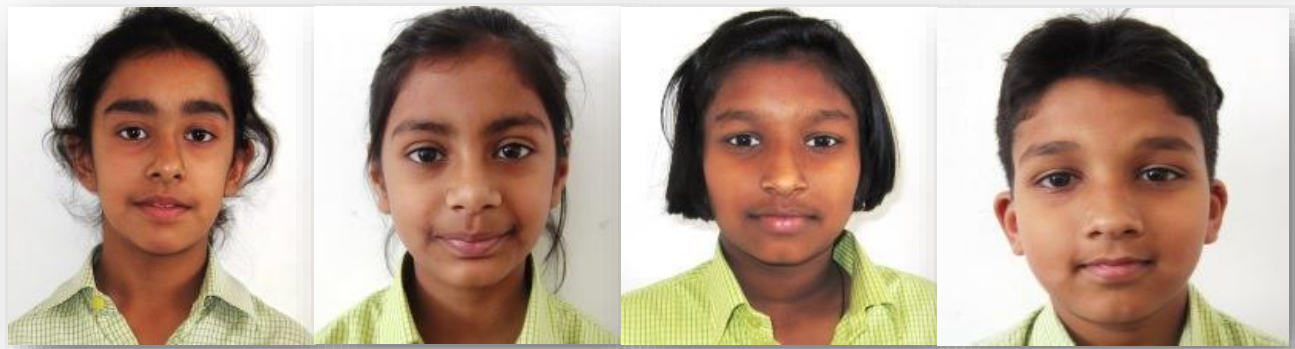

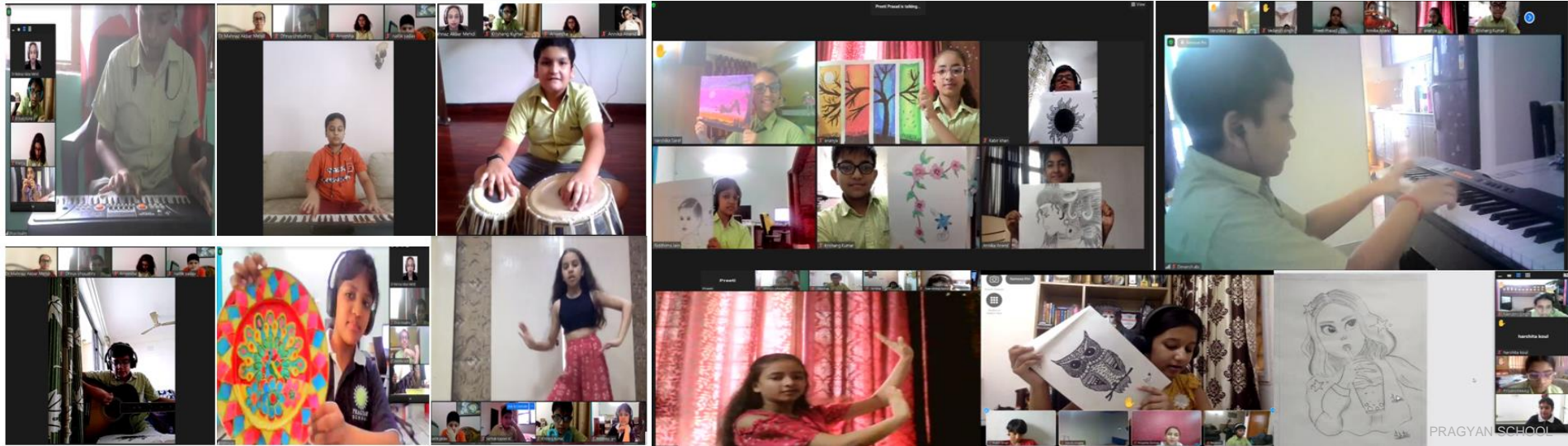

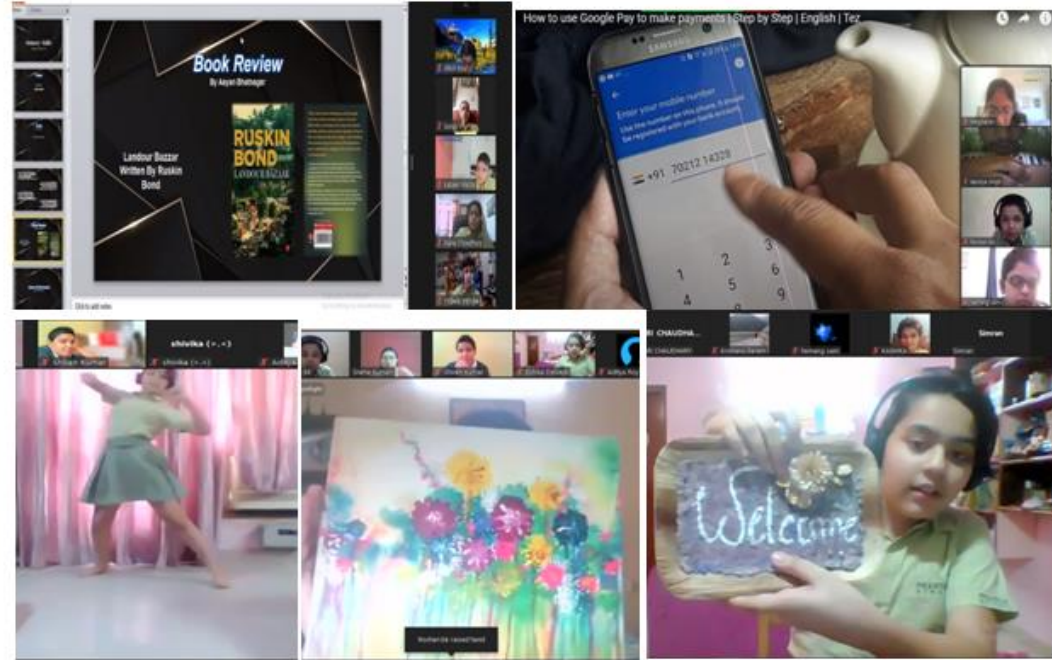
CLASS TEACHER PERIOD - VI

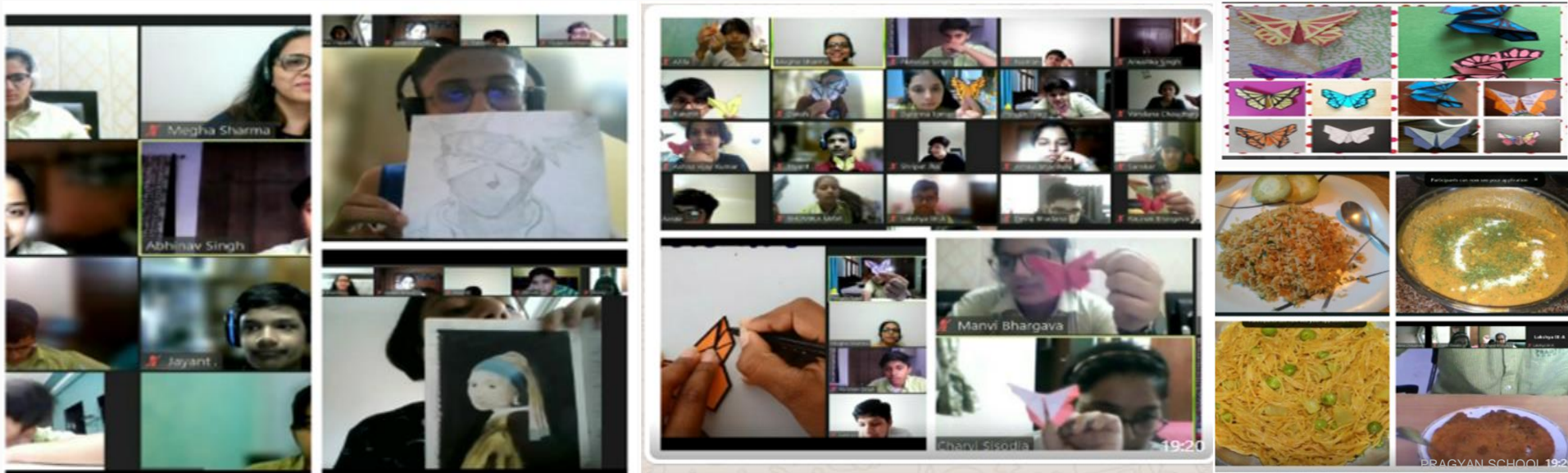
CLASS TEACHER PERIOD - VIII

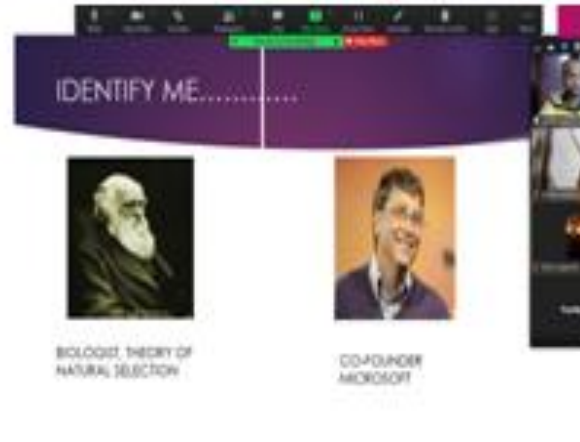
CLASS TEACHER PERIOD - IX

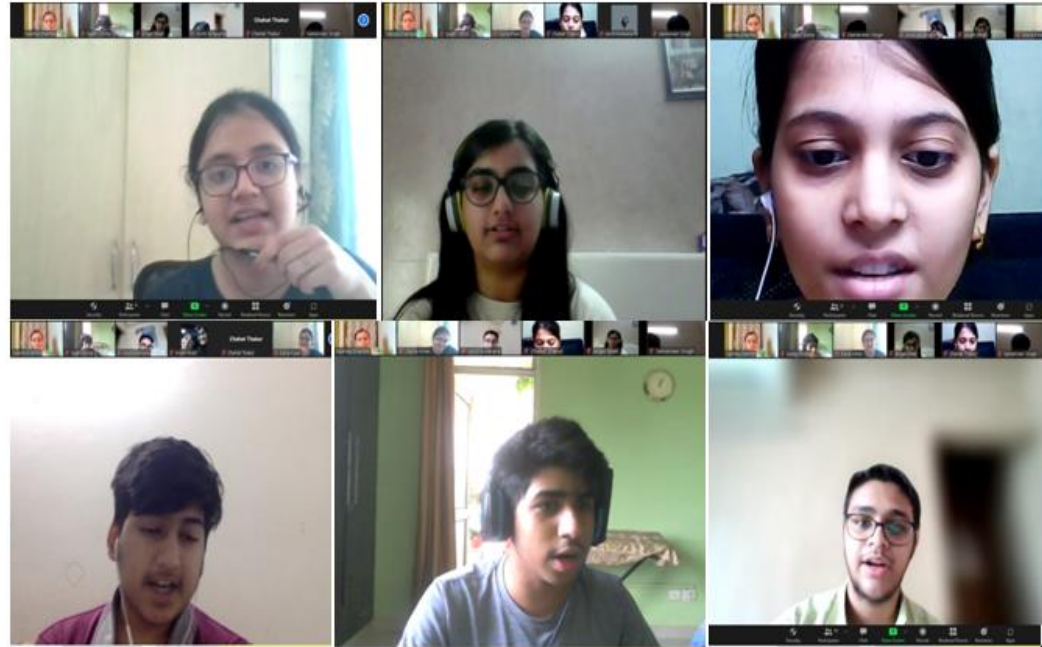
CLASS TEACHER PERIOD - X

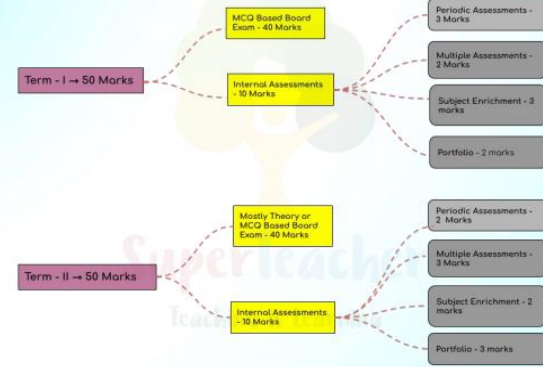

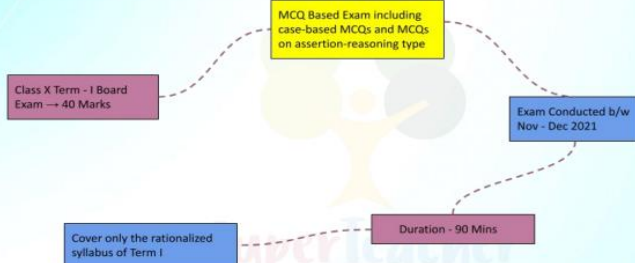
WEBINAR

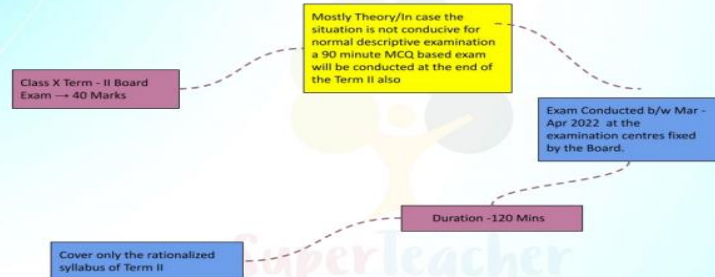
Scheme of Examination



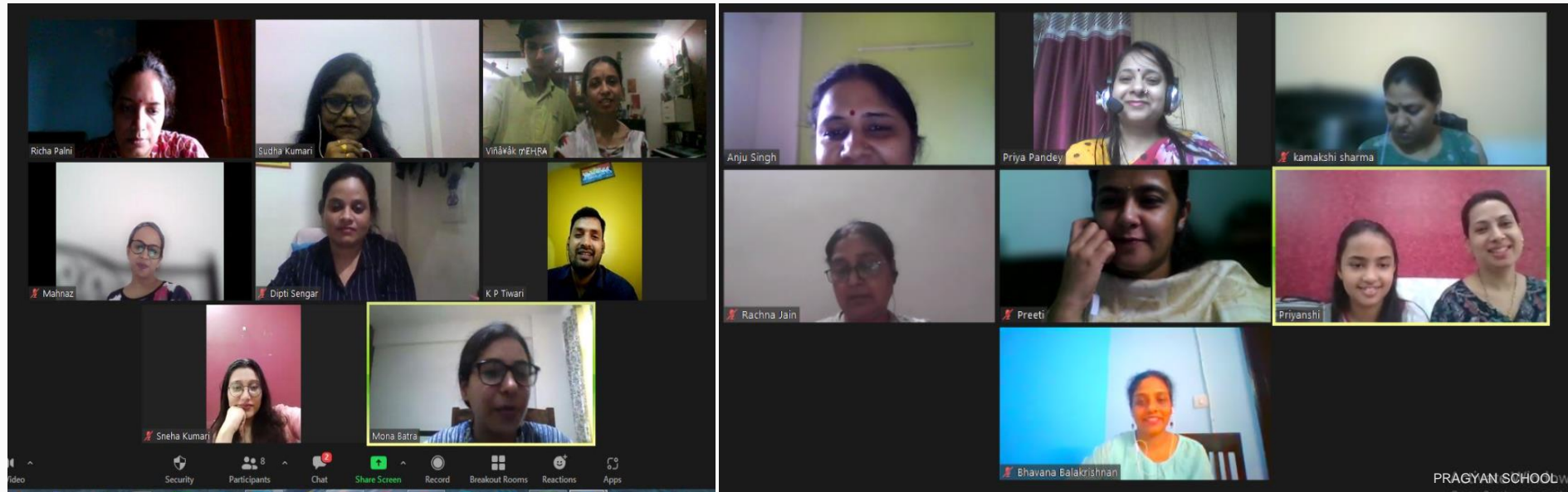

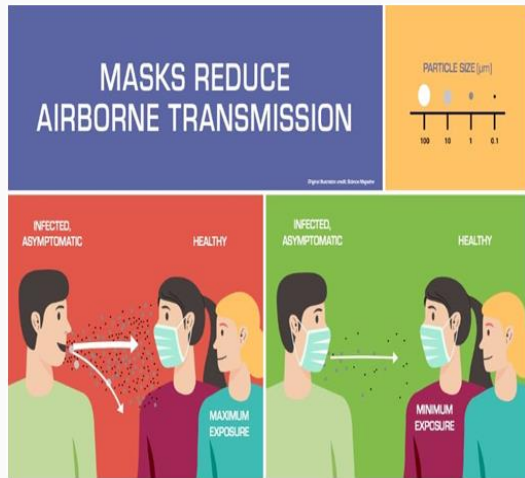
