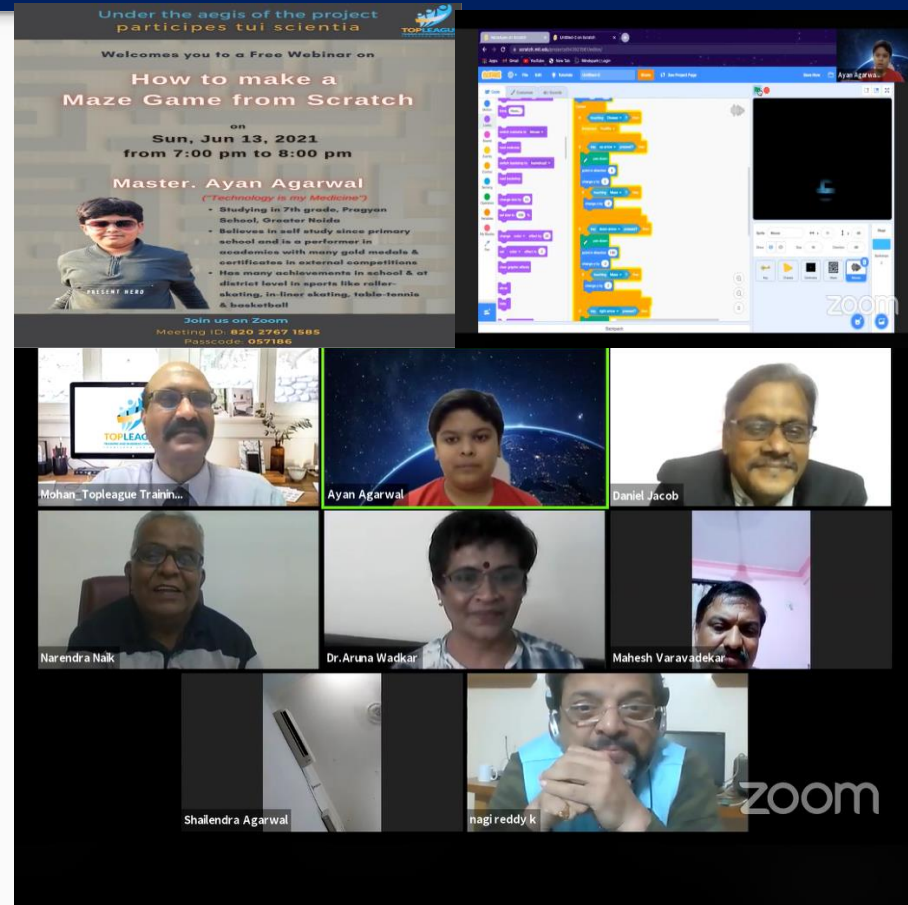

Even social media, with all its potential benefits, has a more insidious side, and the fact that people are vulnerable to persuasive technologies doesn't help either.

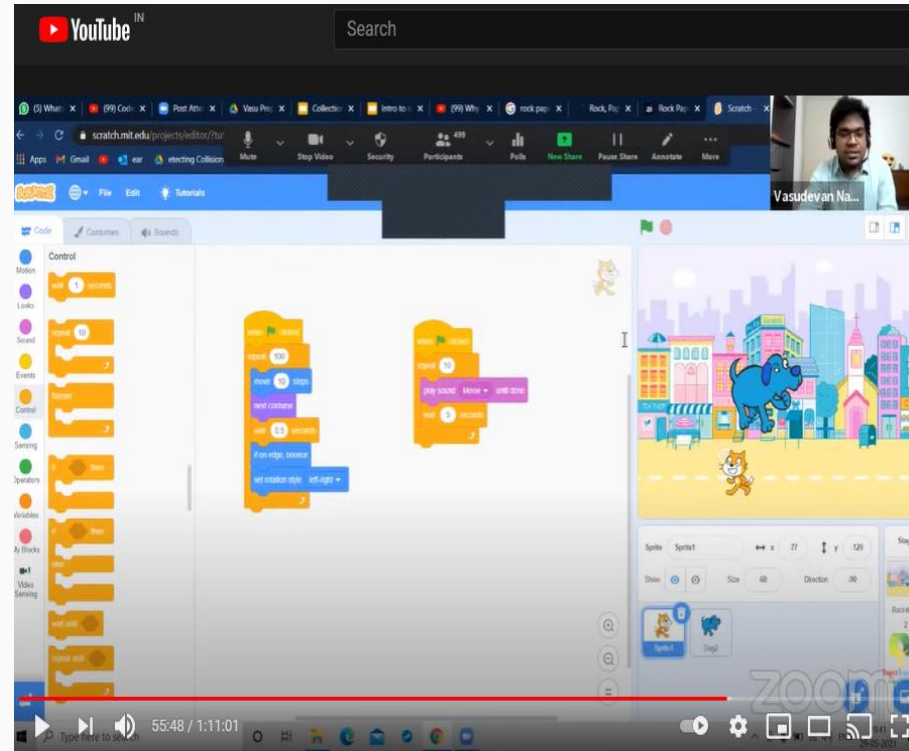
# MASTER TRAINER
