# NURSERY



## ENGLISH

This week, students revised letter V and letter W was introduced. They completed worksheets that reinforced phonics sounds and writing practice. Engaging activities enhanced their recognition and articulation of both letters, demonstrating progress in letter formation and sound association.

# HINDI

This week, the letter ठ was introduced. An engaging worksheet and activities reinforced learning, while a revision of previous letters solidified understanding. Students actively participated, enhancing their pronunciation.



# MATH

This week in Mathematics, Nursery students revised the number 9 and were introduced to the new number 0. They engaged in writing practice of these numbers along with previous ones. The concept of Heavy and Light was also introduced, and students actively participated in the related worksheet, reinforcing their understanding through practical exercises and enhancing their foundational numerical and comparative skills.



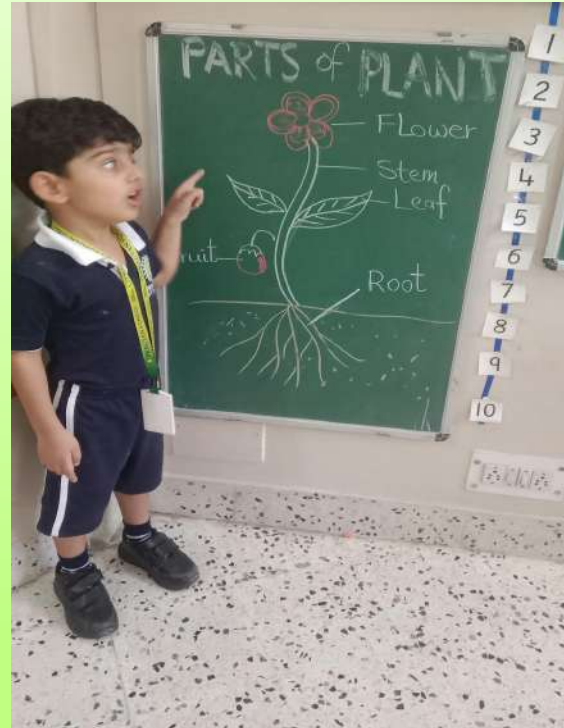
# DANCE

This week students of nursery diligently practiced and learned the dance steps on the song Wash Our Face. They demonstrated commendable progress showcasing their developing skills and coordination.



# ORATORY

Students explored plants through oratory skills, learning about their importance, parts, and characteristics. They confidently spoke a few lines, enhancing their vocabulary and public speaking skills. This activity fostered curiosity and creativity. Students developed an appreciation for nature while building confidence in expressing their thoughts.



# SCIENCE DEMO

This week in Science Demonstration, students learned about parts of the plant and things required for germination. Through hands-on activity, they sowed seeds and observed the process. The teacher demonstrated sowing of seeds, teaching students about necessary conditions for germination, such as water, soil, and sunlight and introducing them to plant life.



# KINDERGARTEN

## ENGLISH



This week, the letter w was introduced. Children practiced writing both letters v and w, and enjoyed colouring various objects related to these letters. In addition, they engaged in paragraph reading activities that included sight words and CVC words to enhance their reading fluency.

# HINDI

This week, the vyanjans ऋ and ॠ were introduced. Children learned various words beginning with these letters in a fun and engaging manner. They also practiced writing the vyanjans and participated in a related colouring activity to reinforce their learning. Additionally, they learned the correct pronunciation and sounds of these letters to support their phonetic understanding.



# MATH

This week began with the introduction of ascending order. Children also practiced backward counting from 80 to 0 and skip counting in their notebooks and workbooks to strengthen their arithmetic skills, number recognition, and counting fluency.



# GENERAL AWARENESS

As part of their general awareness the children learned about different types of animals based on their habitats. The topic was made engaging through interactive discussions and colourful worksheets. The children especially enjoyed colouring various animal-themed worksheets, which helped reinforce their learning in a fun and creative way.



# MUSIC

In music class, the children joyfully practiced melodious songs on the theme of kindness. With their sweet voices and cheerful spirit, they beautifully revised songs for the upcoming Gala Day.



# DANCE

This week, during dance class energy and excitement was quite high as the children practiced enthusiastically for the upcoming Gala Day. With graceful moves and vibrant expressions, they worked hard to perfect their steps and formations.





# ENGLISH

This week, the students revised the topic of "this" and "that". They completed a worksheet to practice using these words and to understand the difference between things that are near and things that are far. The topic of "these" and "those" was introduced. The students also did worksheets to practice this new topic. These worksheets helped them to learn the usage of the above concepts correctly.

# HINDI

This week, in Hindi, the students practiced words of इ की मात्रा . They read words with इ की मात्रा and completed worksheets related to the matra to improve their understanding. Students also attempted dictation on the topics covered so far. Through these activities, the students developed reading, writing, pronunciation, and listening skills.



# MATH

This week, in Math, the students practiced counting from 181 to 200. They completed worksheets to strengthen their understanding of these numbers. They also did worksheets of what comes before and after the numbers from numbers 181 to 200. Through these activities, the students developed number recognition, improved their counting skills, and gained a better understanding of number order.



# GENERAL AWARENESS

This week, in General Awareness, a new topic, 'Festivals', was introduced to the students. During class discussion students shared their views on how they celebrate different festivals. They also completed worksheets related to the topic. Through these activities, the students learned about the importance of festivals and understood how and why different festivals are celebrated.



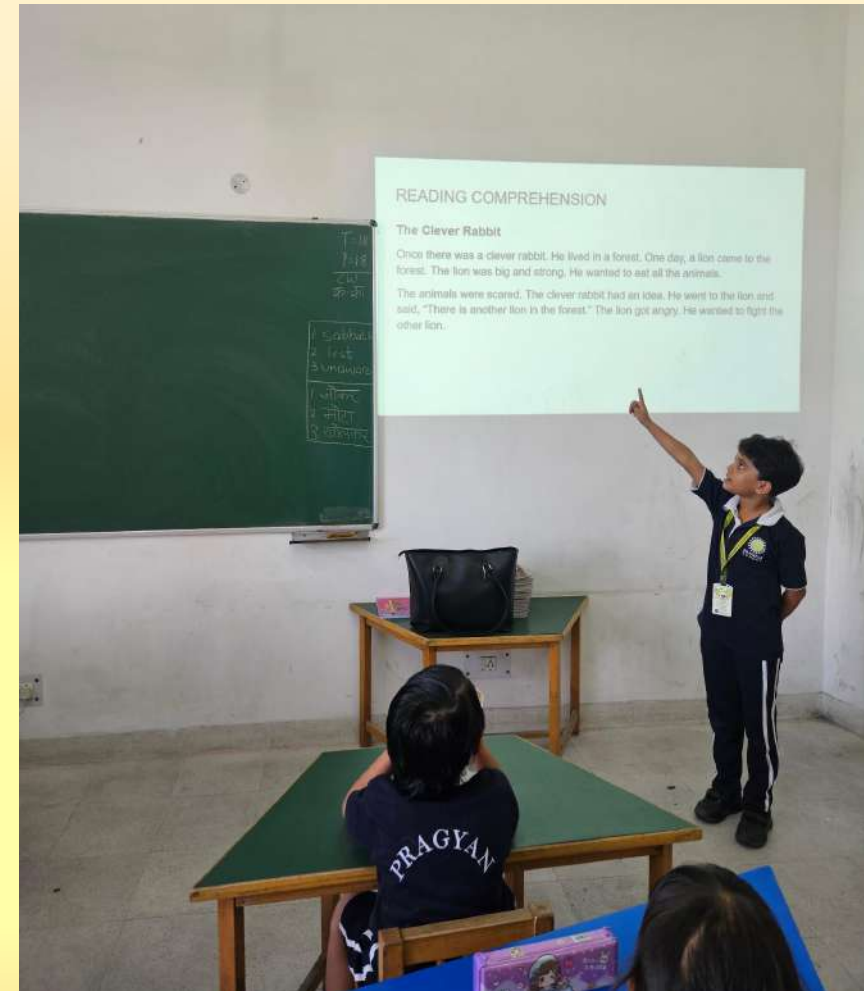
# ART & CRAFT

This week, in the Art and Craft class, the students did a freehand drawing of a beach scene. They learned simple shading to enhance their drawing. Through this activity, the students improved their creativity, hand movement, and understanding of light and dark. They also got better at observing and drawing.





This week children were introduced to describing words through engaging notebook work and a creative writing task. They further strengthened their understanding by completing workbook pages related to the topic. Moving ahead, the concept of gender words was explained with both notebook work and workbook exercises. The week concluded with reading an unseen passage ‘The clever rabbit’, which helped enhance their comprehension and fluency.





# हिन्दी

कक्षा 1 के बच्चों ने पिछले सप्ताह हिंदी विषय में विविध और रोचक गतिविधियाँ कीं। उन्होंने चित्र देखकर उनके नाम लिखने का अभ्यास किया, लिंग भेद से संबंधित अभ्यास पूरे किए तथा दिए गए अक्षरों से दो-दो शब्द बनाने का कार्य किया। बच्चों ने अपने पसंदीदा फल का चित्र बनाकर उसका नाम भी लिखा, जिससे उनकी रचनात्मकता और शब्द भंडार में वृद्धि हुई। बड़े उत्साह के साथ उन्होंने “होली” पाठ का पठन एवं अभ्यास किया। इन सभी गतिविधियों के माध्यम से बच्चों की भाषा कौशल, लेखन क्षमता और पठन कौशल में सराहनीय प्रगति देखी गई।





Students of Class 1 practiced important concepts in mathematics. They learned to do skip counting by 4's and 5's, revised the tables of 4 and 5, and also engaged in dodging table exercises to strengthen their number sense. These activities helped the children improve their counting skills, recall of multiplication tables, and overall confidence in handling numbers.





# ENVIRONMENTAL SCIENCE

The week began with a fun-filled AIL activity, where children drew and coloured scenes of their favourite festivals. They also took part in a creative task that encouraged both illustration and critical thinking. As the week progressed, they revised the topic *of food*, solved a worksheet on festivals, and wrote questions–answers in their notebooks. The week concluded with the introduction of a new chapter — *Good Habits*.





The students of Class 2 demonstrated a clear understanding of adjectives as describing words through engaging exercises and written tasks. They also participated enthusiastically in poem recitation and reading exercises. As part of an Art-Integrated Learning (AIL) activity, they drew beautiful garden scenes and described them using adjectives like *colorful*, *green*, *pretty*, and *bright*. This creative blend of art and language made learning adjectives fun and meaningful.





# हिन्दी

The chapter covered the following topics like natural fibres and man-made fibres, importance of clothes, types of clothes according to different seasons, clothes worn by people living in different regions etc. The students have actively participated in classroom discussions, showing a clear understanding of the concepts.



# COMPUTER CLASS 1 & 2



In Computer class, children learnt to create a colourful nature scene using Tux Paint. They explored different tools like shapes, stamps, and the magic eraser, which made their drawings even more exciting and creative. The activity turned into a joyful blend of art, imagination, and technology.

# PHYSICAL EDUCATION

Children of classes 1 and 2 actively participated in regular exercise sessions, fun games, and a 50-meter race. Students of Grade 3 revised multiplication and subtraction in their notebook and workbook. They also continued practicing table dodging, multiplication properties and word problems in their workbook.

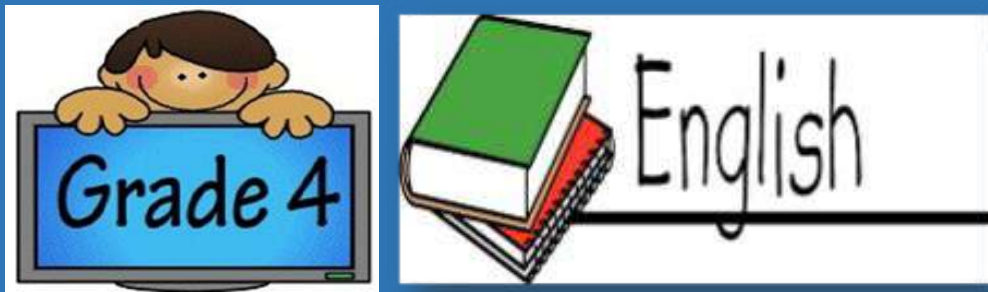




# ENVIRONMENTAL SCIENCE

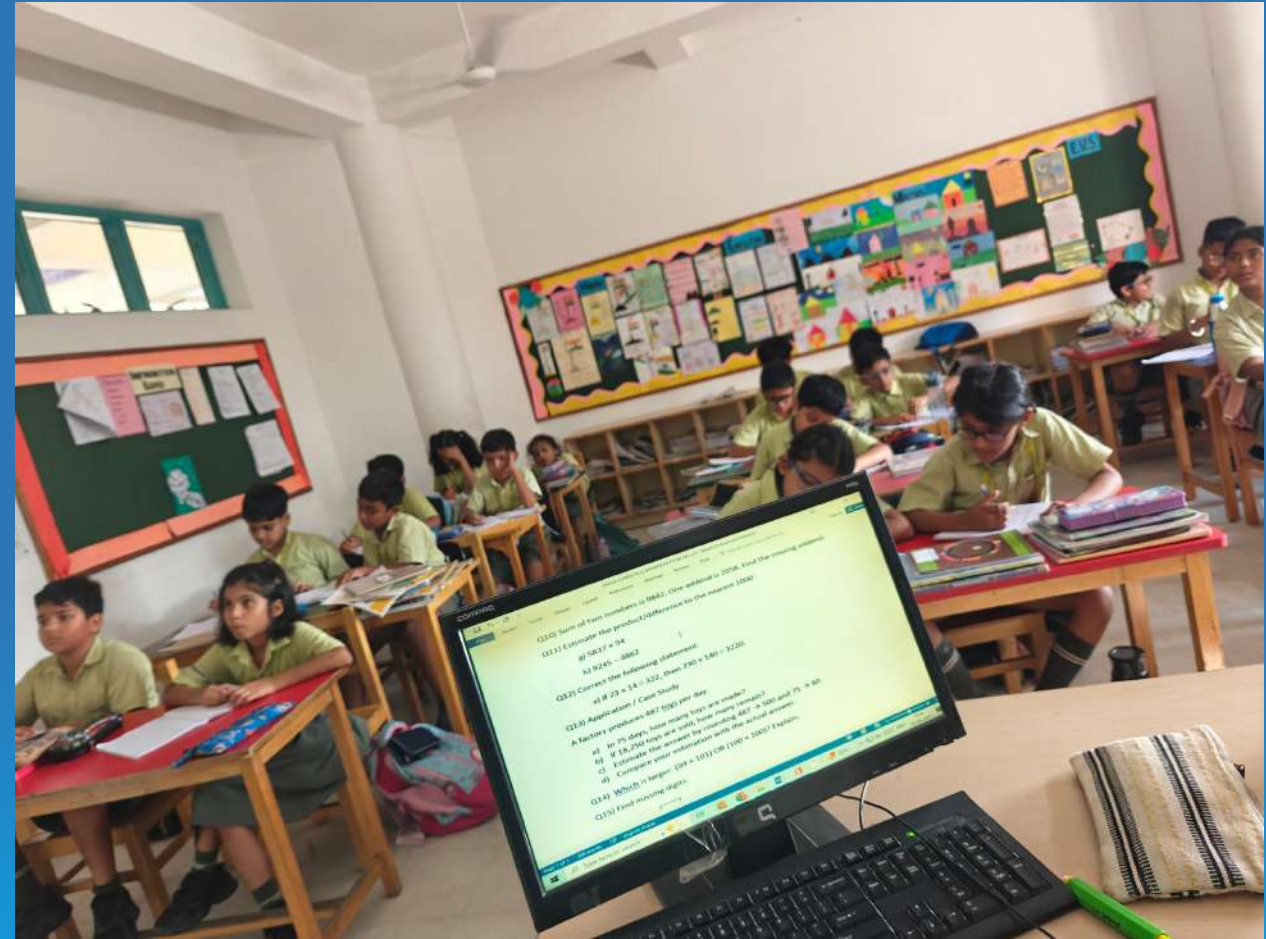
# हिन्दी

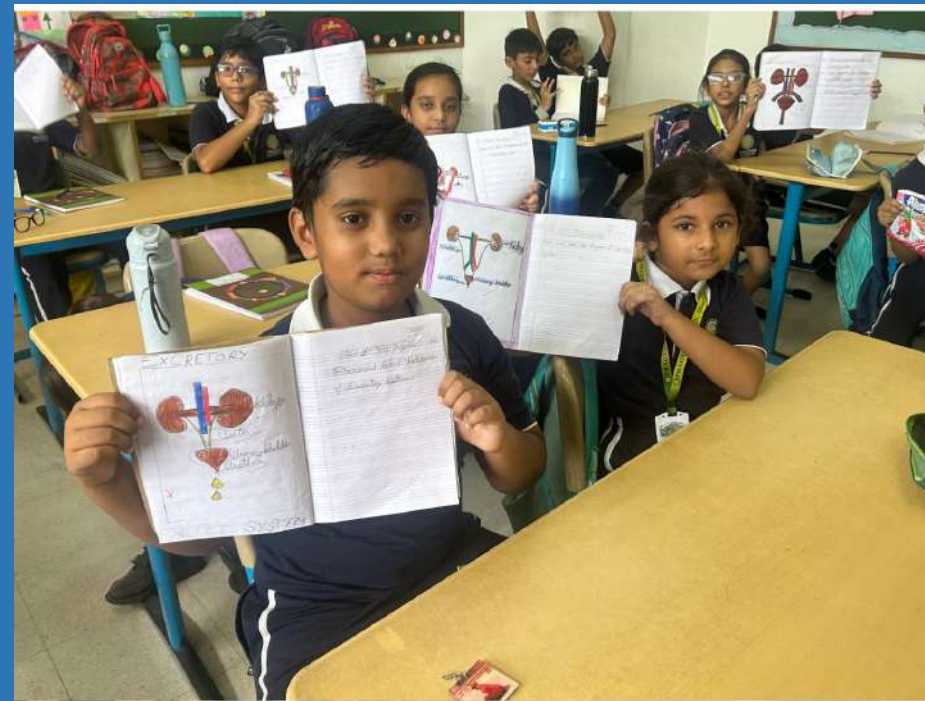
