ENGLISH

Letter C was introduced to the students with the help of picture flashcards. They did colouring of C related pictures in their Letter Book and tracing of the letter C in their workbook.

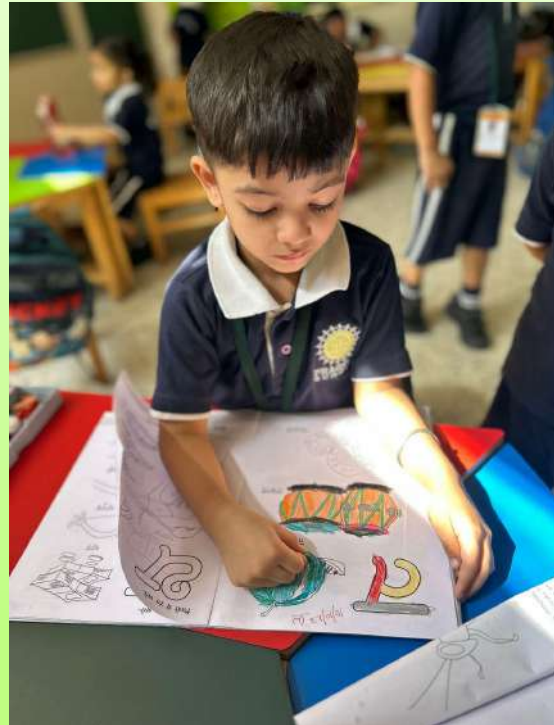
MATHS

The children of Nursery learnt a few steps on a happy song.

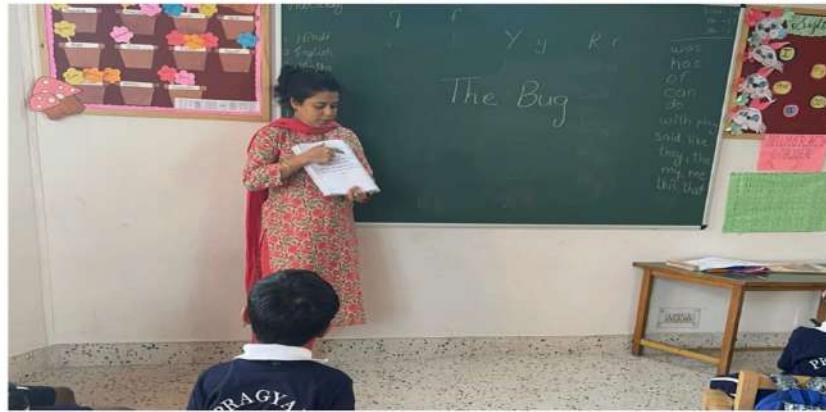


KINDERGARTEN

ENGLISH

A phonetic approach to reading shows a child how to blend the sounds as they progress to read words. Children in kindergarten started with the reading of 'a' sound story Zat & Nat through phonics and sight words. They also learnt letter 's' and 'ap' family words.

Under the reading scheme, students also made an effort to read independently the lesson 'The bug'.



MATHS

Back counting 80-0 was done orally and in the notebook. Worksheets related to skip counting of 5s were done in class. Revision of the concept of after, before and in between numbers was also done during the week.



HINDI

Introduction of vyanjan ' ल' was done through stories, pictures and flashcards. Written practice of the same was done in their workbook and notebook. New two letter words were introduced in class. Children were taught to join vyanjans and read the words aloud.



GENERAL AWARENESS

Discussion on road transport was done during general awareness class. Children enjoyed colouring the worksheets of bus and auto rickshaw.



EVS

This week the children learnt about the water animal, seahorse and its habitat. They enjoyed colouring worksheets related to the topic.

YOGA (NUR & KG)

CLASS ASSEMBLY (NUR)

The students of class nursery (A,B,C) conducted the assembly on the topic Food on 10th,11th and 12th October, 2023. Students spoke about different varieties of fruits and vegetables.

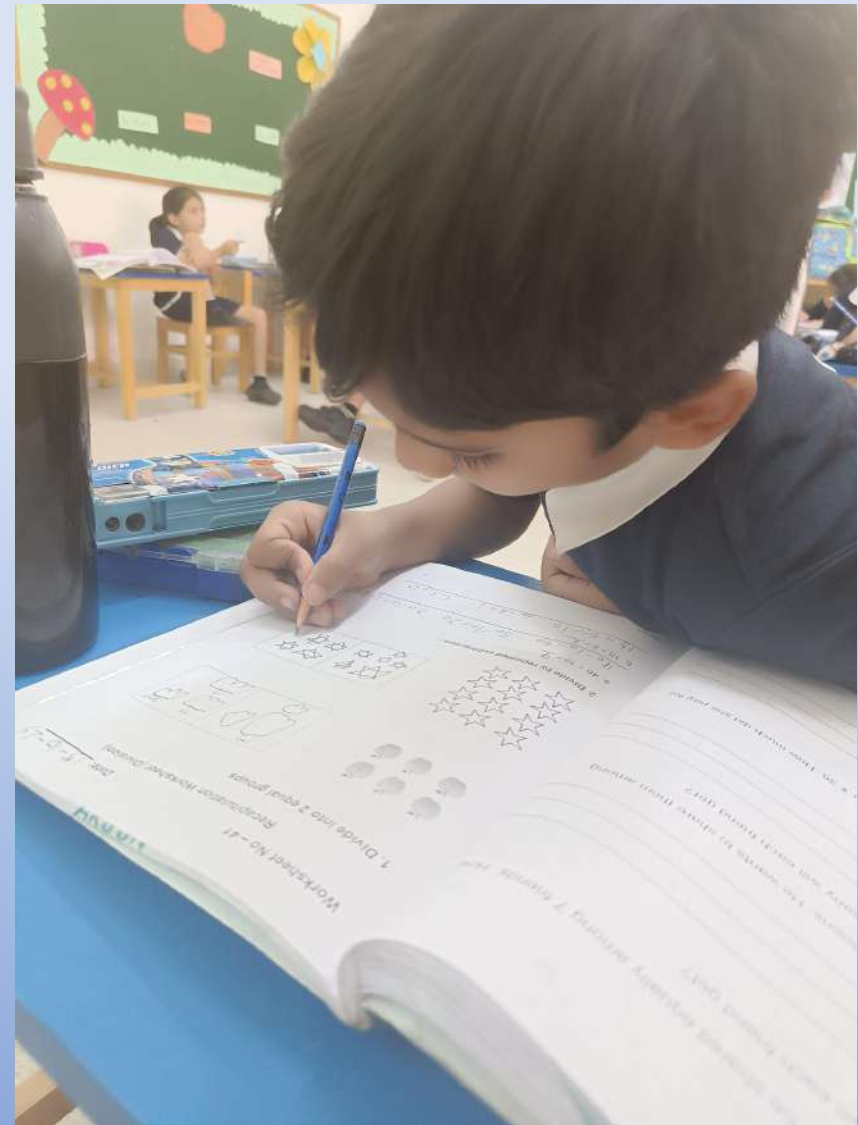




Math

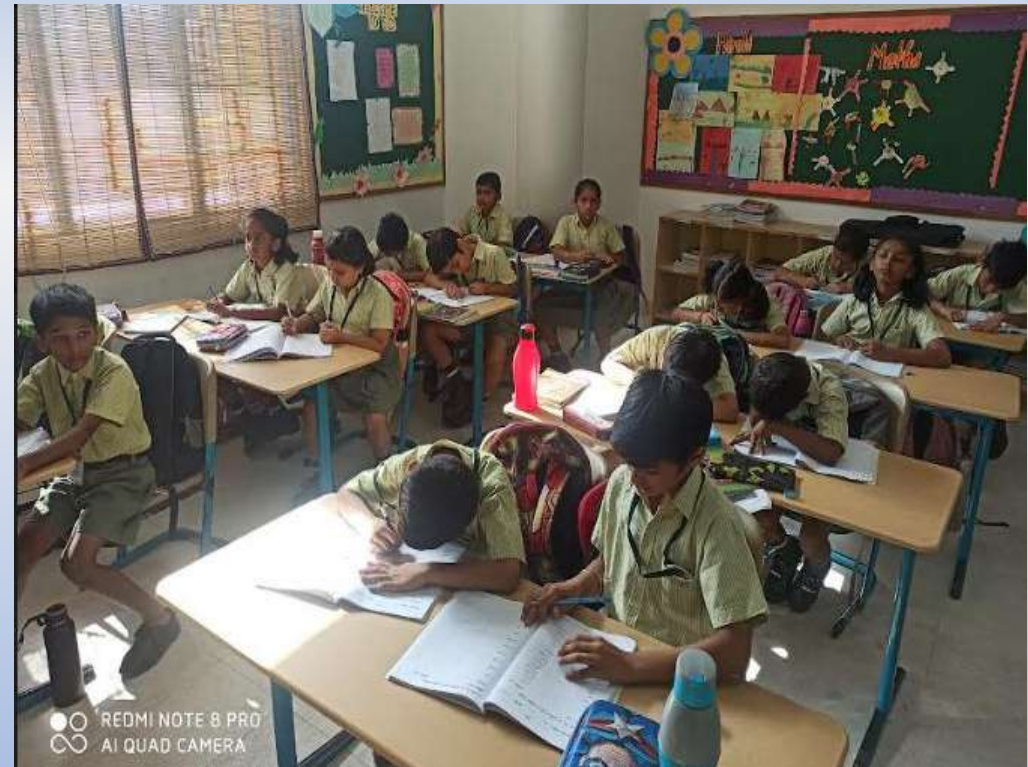

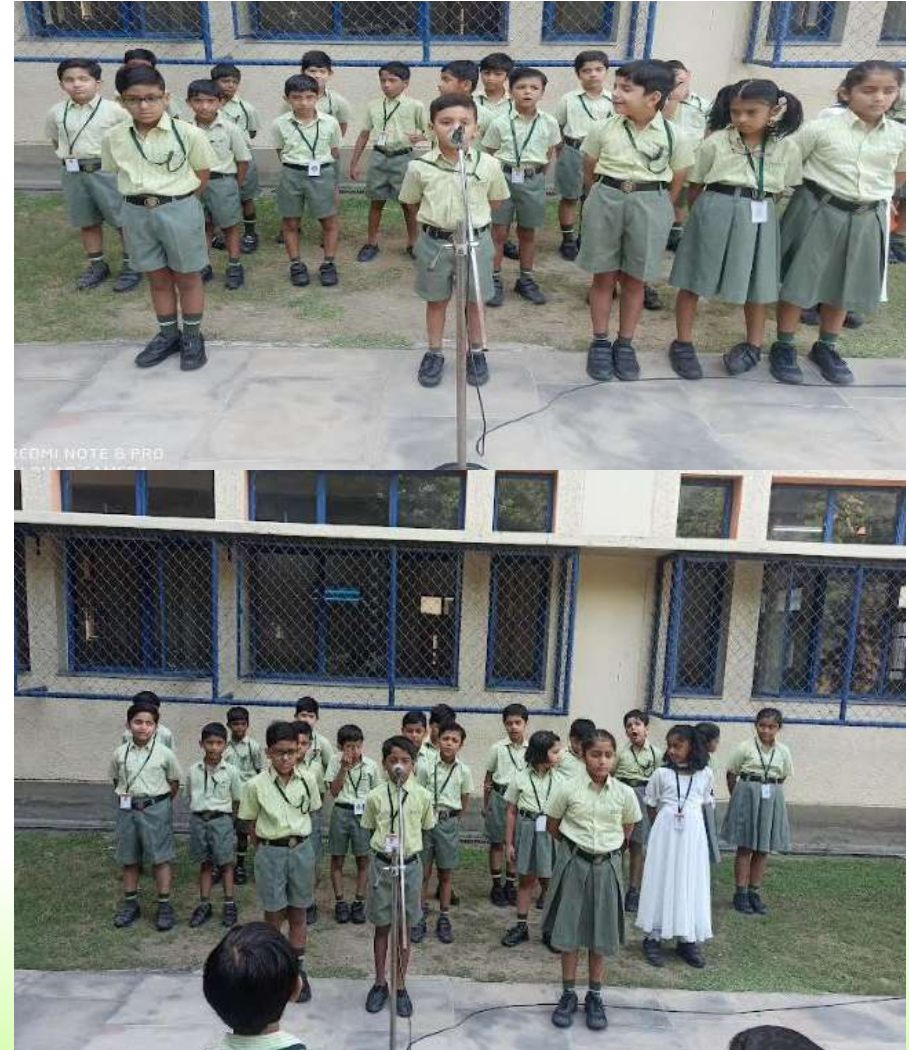
CLASS TEACHER PERIOD
