NURSERY

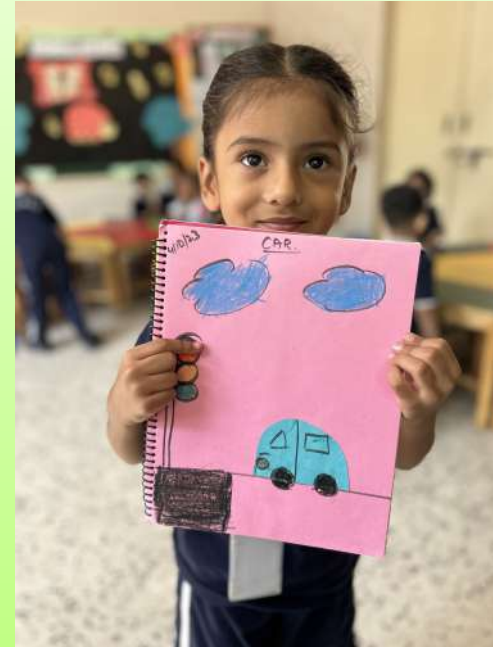
YOGA

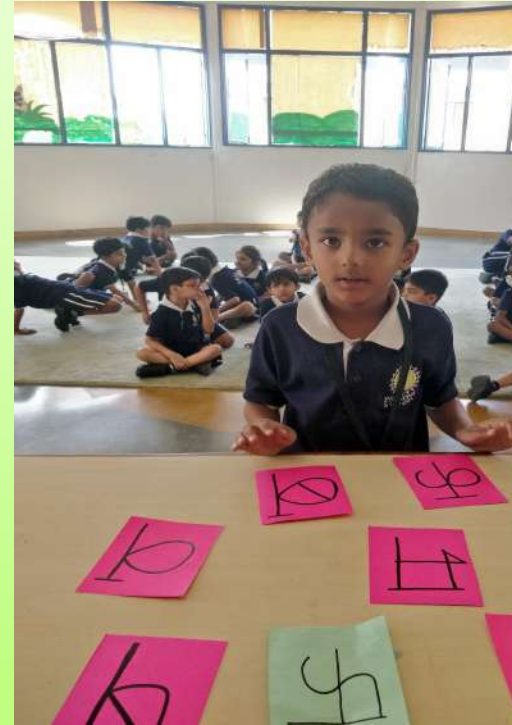
MUSIC

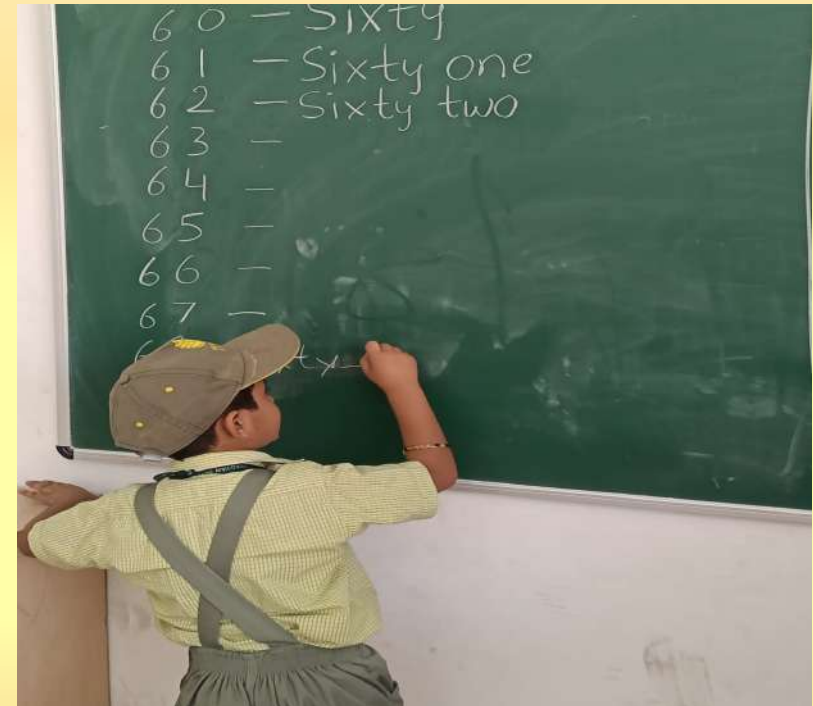




Math

Children of class 1 learnt number names for 60 - 69 and tens and ones for 50 - 59 and 60 - 69. Number names help identify numbers easily. Learning how to pronounce numbers is an important part of Mathematics. It is easy to explain the problem sum more clearly with the help of number names. While speaking the name of numbers, children develop their pronunciation skills.

Division skills can be applied to real life concepts. As children handle money, share items between friends and cut food into portions they are beginning to build up their division skills as part of their everyday life. Students of class 2 were introduced to the Chapter: Division, they learnt the facts of division and could divide with the help of repeated subtraction. They enjoyed solving division sums with the help of tables.



INSTRUMENTAL MUSIC (1&2)



Tabla is the most famous percussion instrument of North India. Children of class 1 and 2 enjoyed doing Tabla boal practice and xylophone (playing on the grand staff).

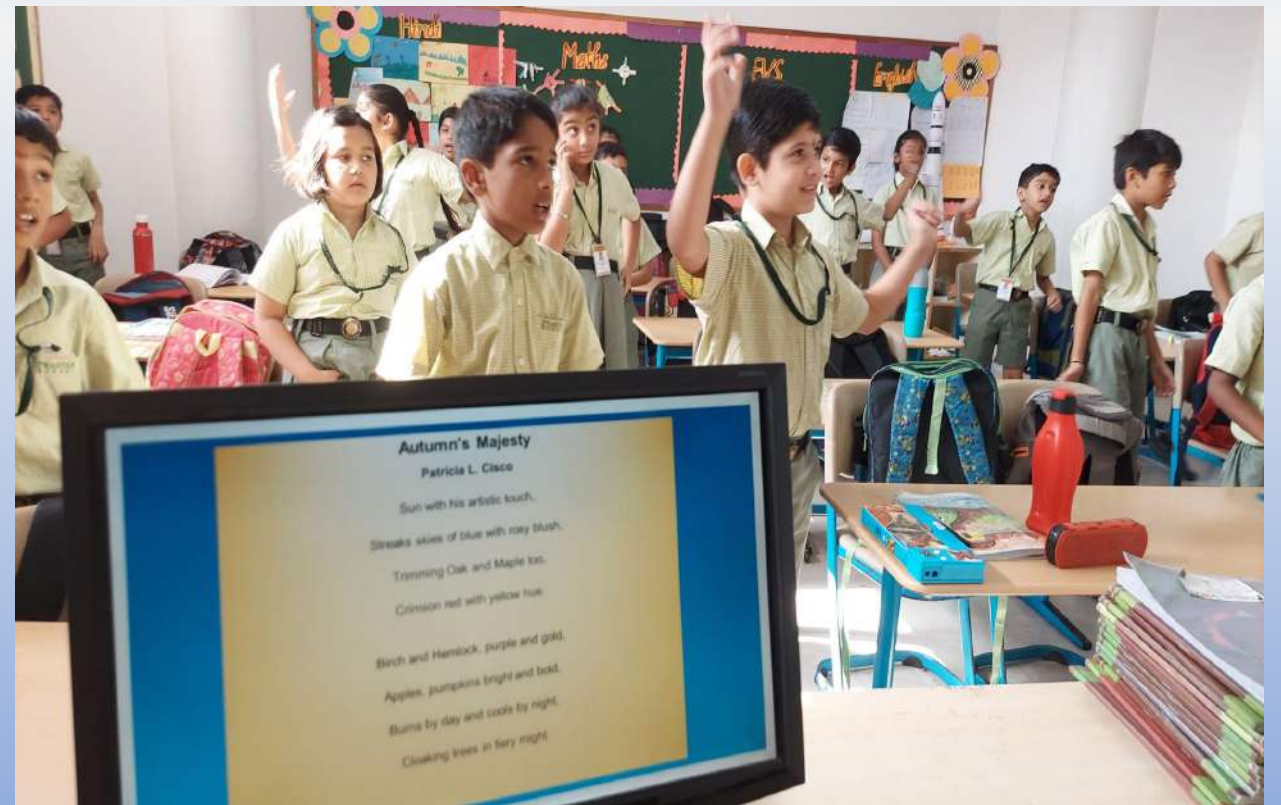

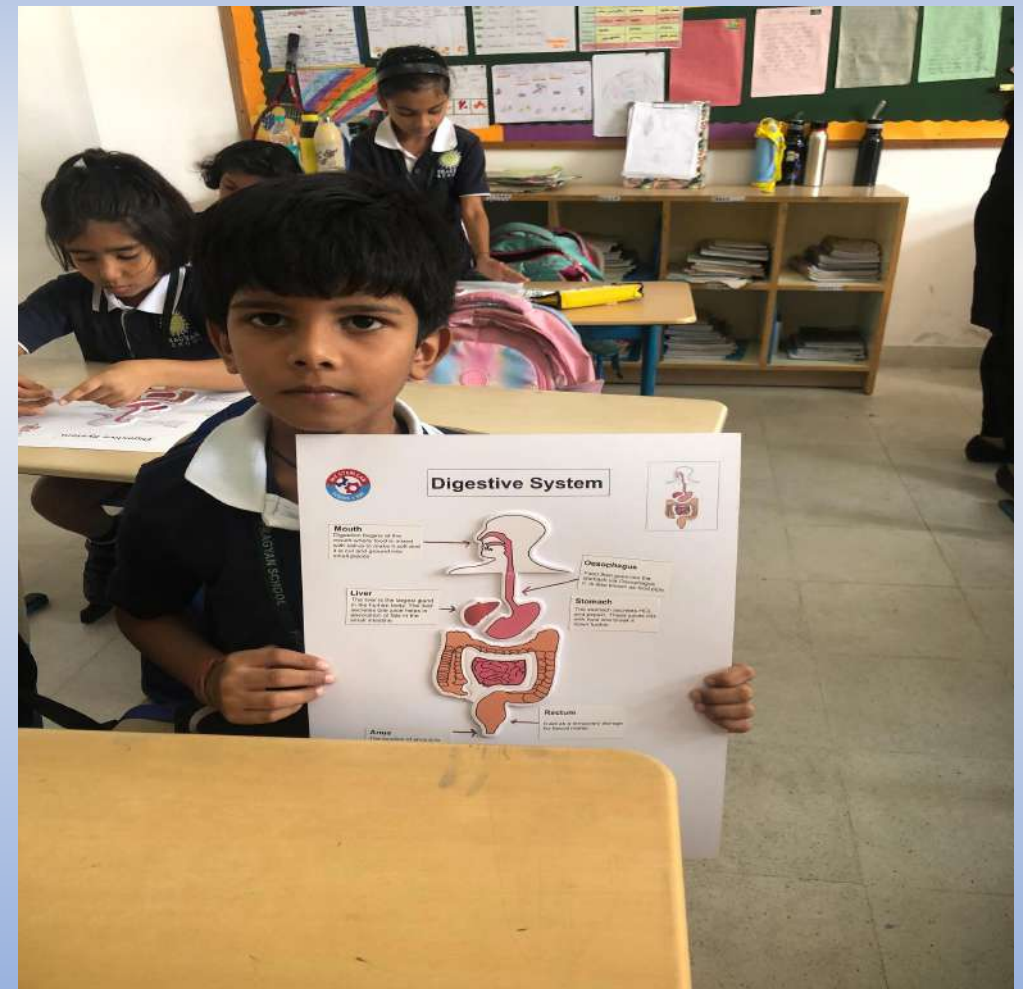
Students of Class 3 did the Poem and New Words of October. They also read the chapter Himmat na Haro and did word meanings.





ENVIRONMENTAL SCIENCE

The students of Grade 3 completed the chapter National Symbols and Emblem in which they learned about India's various National symbols and their significance. Videos and ppt related to the topics taught were shown to the students in the class. The students also did STEM activity on the Human Body wherein they made a digestive system by arranging the puzzles and labelled the organs involved.

ENVIRONMENTAL SCIENCE

The students of grade 4 studied the chapter-Teeth in which they studied about the uses of teeth, different types of teeth and how we can take care of our teeth. They also completed the notebook work of this chapter. The children enjoyed watching videos related to the topic taught in the class. As a part of the stem lab activity, the students made a clay model of teeth in which they learnt about the different shapes of the teeth and their uses. The enjoyed doing this activity and it was a very good learning experience for them.





Students of grade 5 wrote the question and answer of the lessons, The Secret Cavern and the Barber's Wife in their notebooks. They revised the concept of Subject - Verb Agreement in grammar and did a few exercises based on it in their notebook and workbook.
