HOTS OLYMPIAD 2020

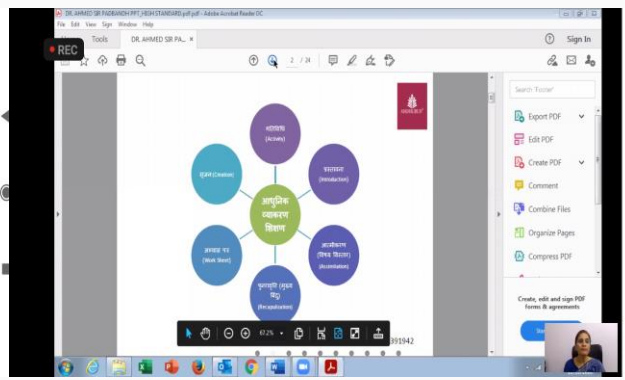
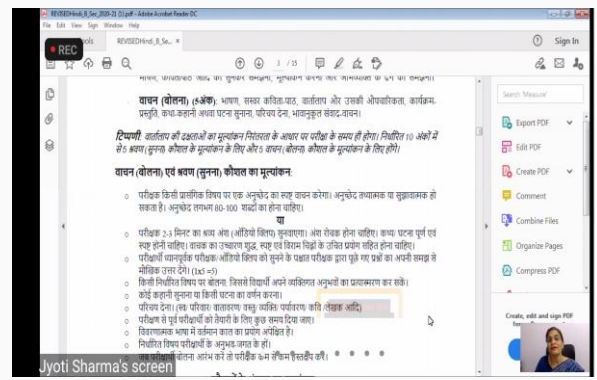
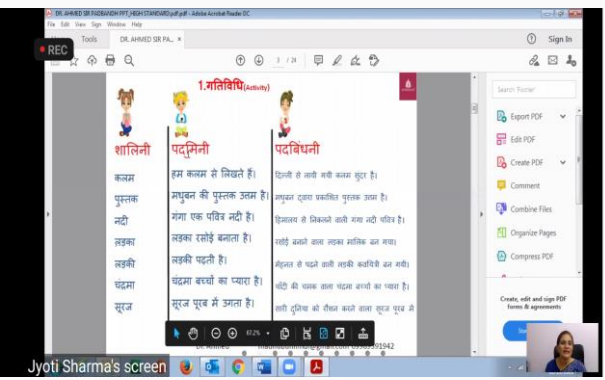
Class: VI- VIII
