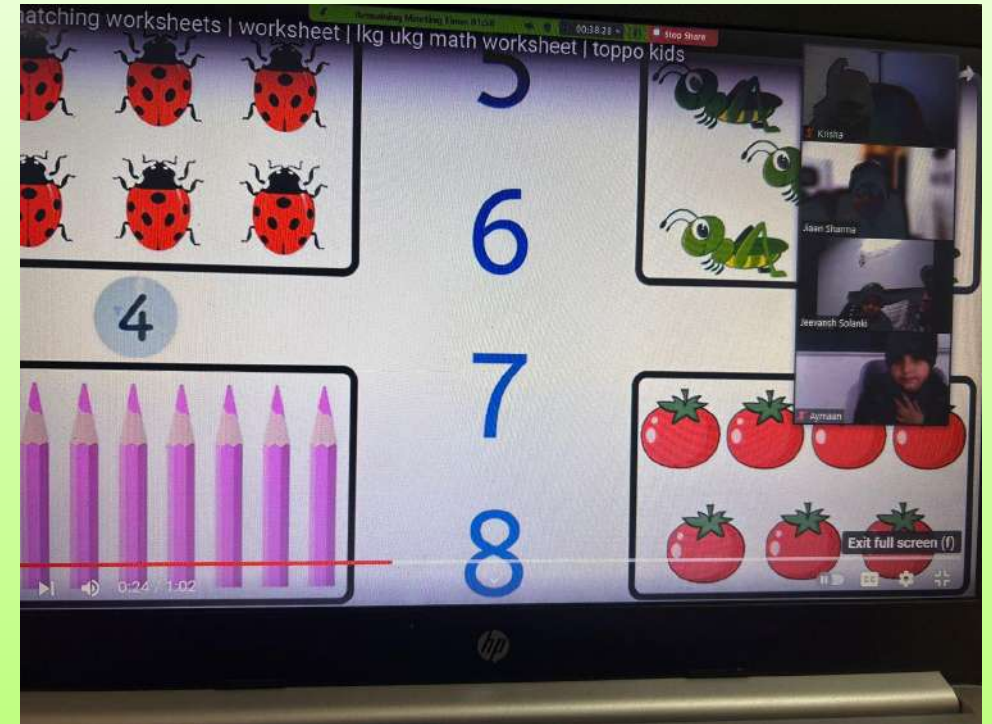
ENGLISH

This week students did recapitulation of all the letters with the help of pictures along with the phonic songs. Students also practiced letters matching with the correct pictures and enjoyed story time as well.



MATHS

KINDERGARTEN



ENGLISH

This week 'ug' and 'ut' family words were introduced to the students through flashcards. Students also practiced reading sentences with these family words. Recap of 'o' family words and sight words was done too.

MATHS

Recap of number names from 1-12 was done in the class. Students of kindergarten enjoyed learning the concept of addition. They learnt the concept of addition through pictures, objects and forward counting. Students solved worksheets based on addition and number names.



HINDI

Recap of three, four letter words and simple sentences was done in Hindi class. Introduction of 'ड' and 'ह' vyanjans was done during the week. Students practiced writing these vyanjans in their workbook and notebook.



GENERAL AWARENESS

Discussion about different festivals celebrated in our country was done in class. Children were taught about Lohri and Pongal. They also enjoyed colouring worksheets related to the topic.

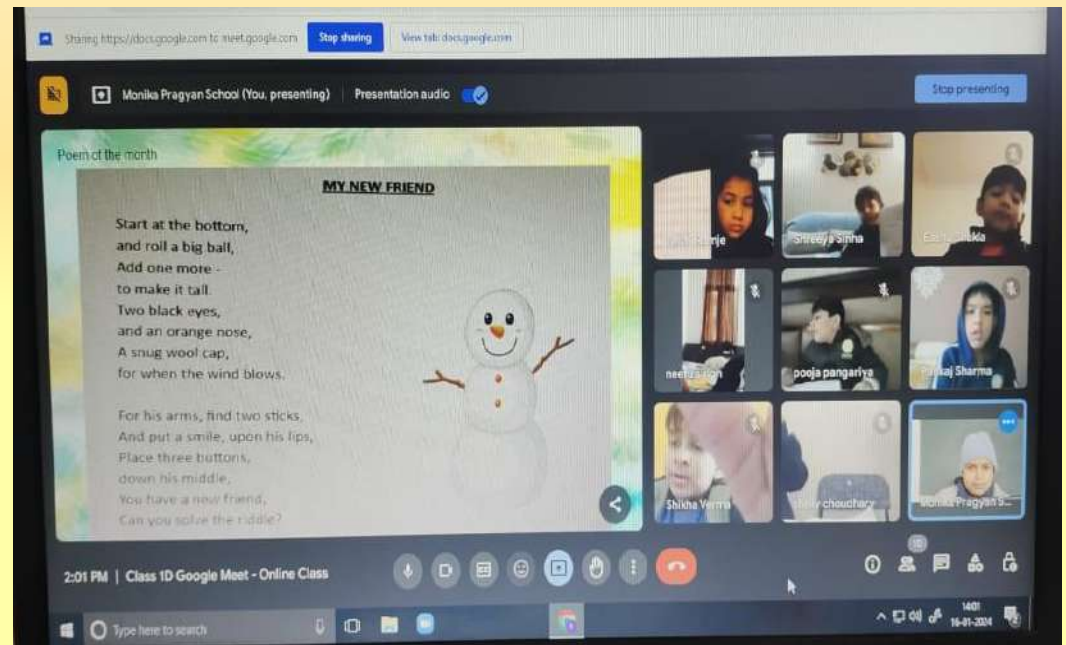
MUSIC (NUR & KG)

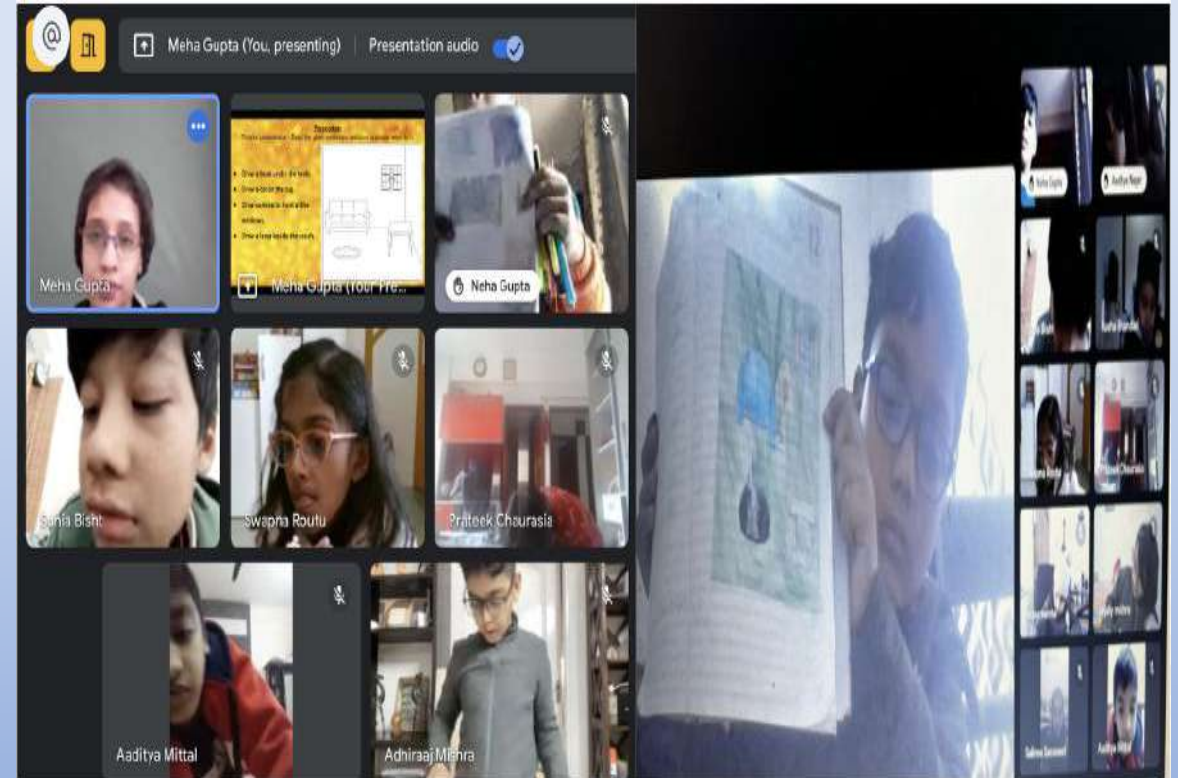


“Revision is just another step towards perfection” The concept of money was revised during maths class. The students were explained about the practical application of the concept. They also revised tables taught through dodging.

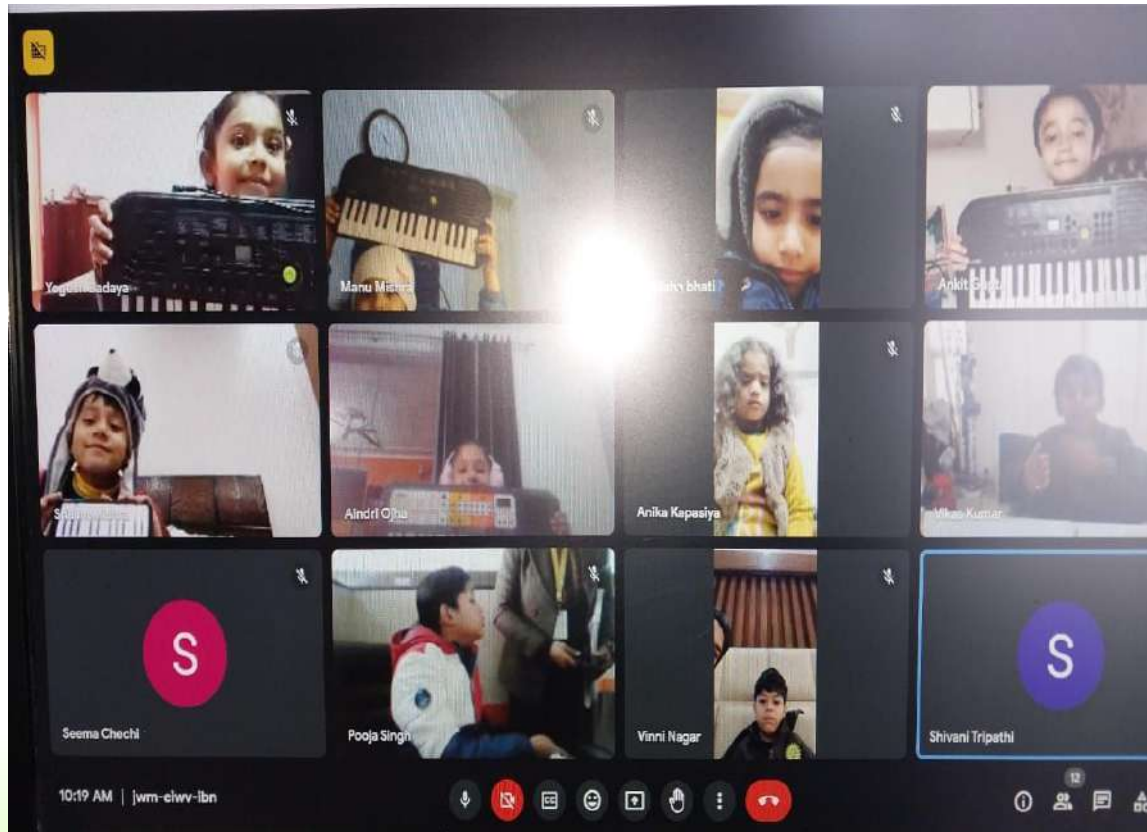

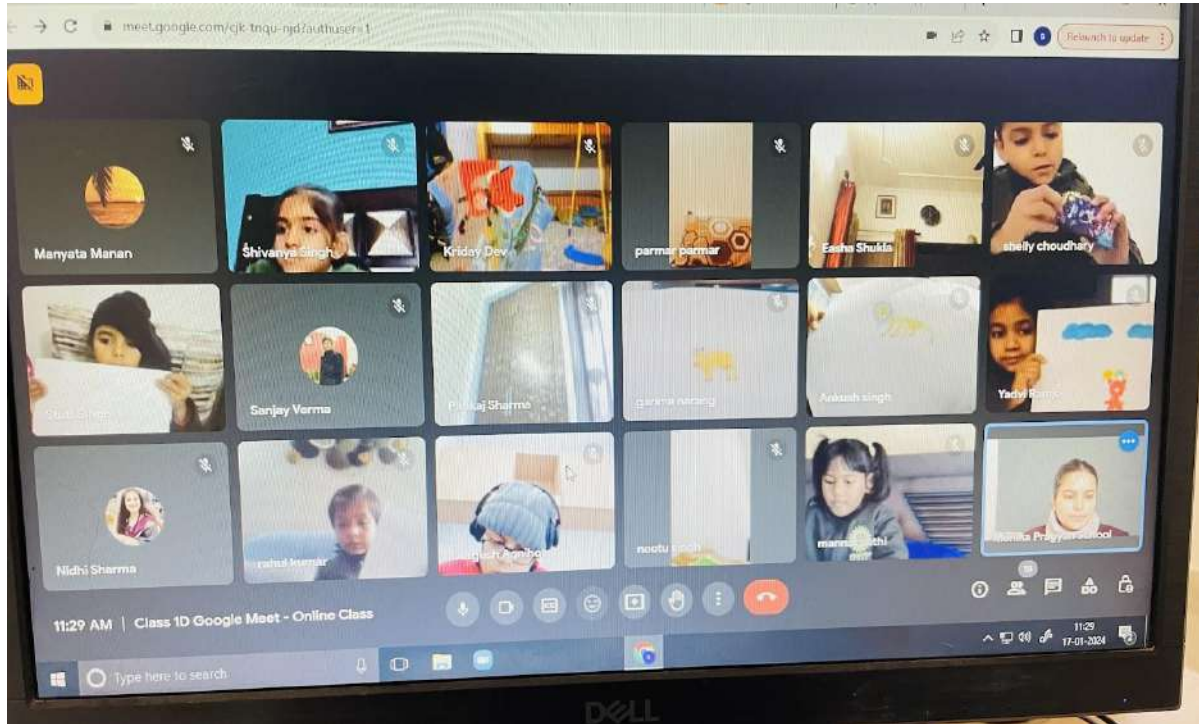

VOCAL MUSIC (1& 2)

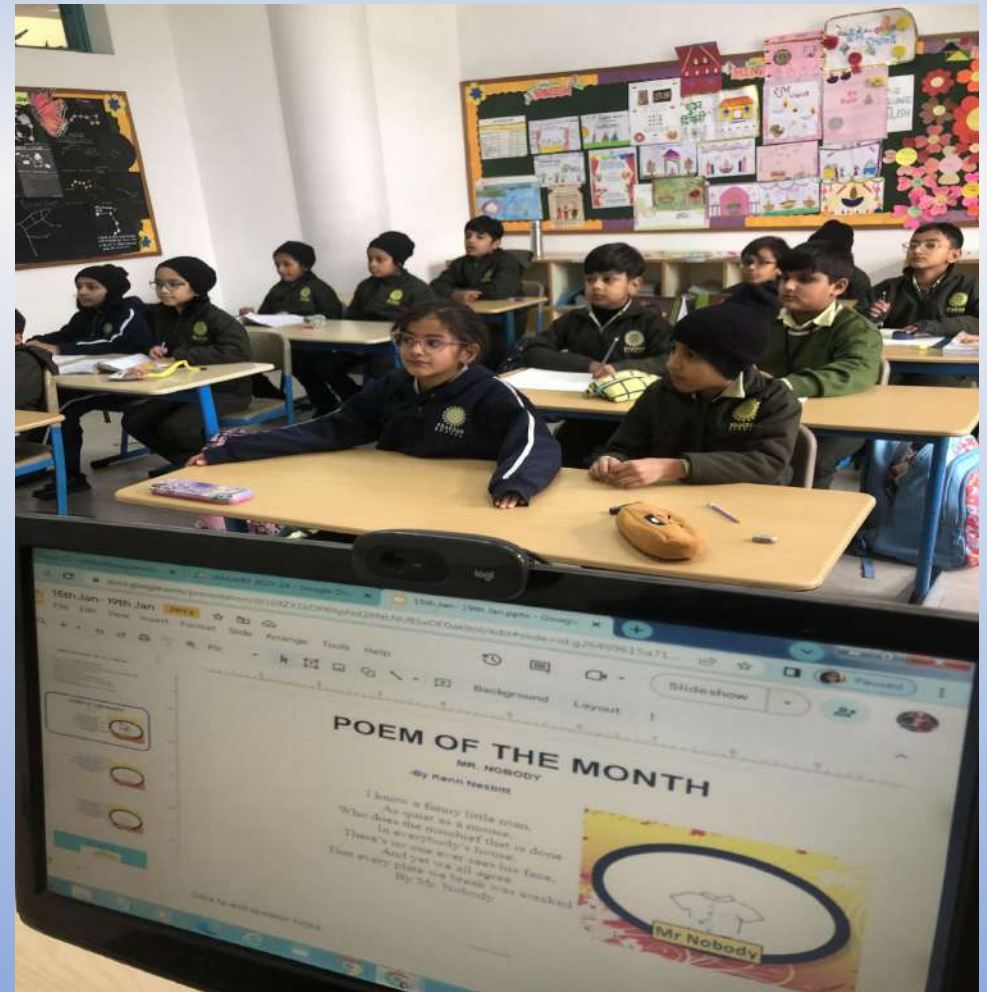


Students of class 3 studied Vakyansh ke liye ek shabd and did all the exercises. They also revised the poem “Makar sankranti” and new words of chapter “ Holi masti v harshoullas ka tyohar”.





Students of Class 3 were introduced to the topic “Time”. They did revision of concepts taught in class 2. They were also taught how to read time close to 5 minutes. After joining the school offline, students were able to solve the worksheets on the topics taught in the workbook.





ENVIRONMENTAL SCIENCE

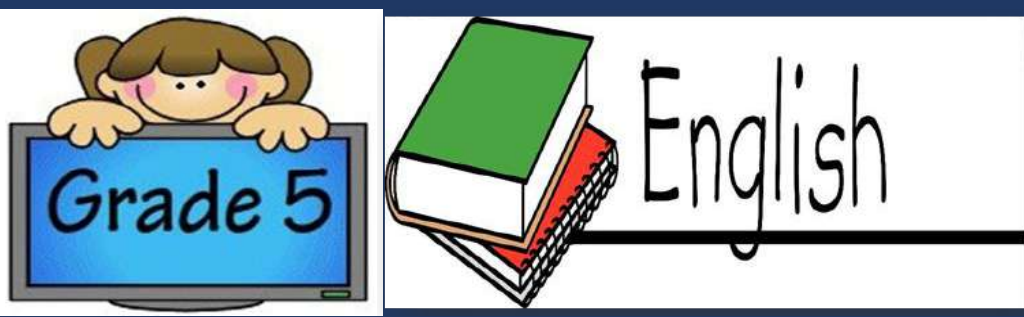
