Music - Children practiced the song ‘Ram Ram Ram....’.



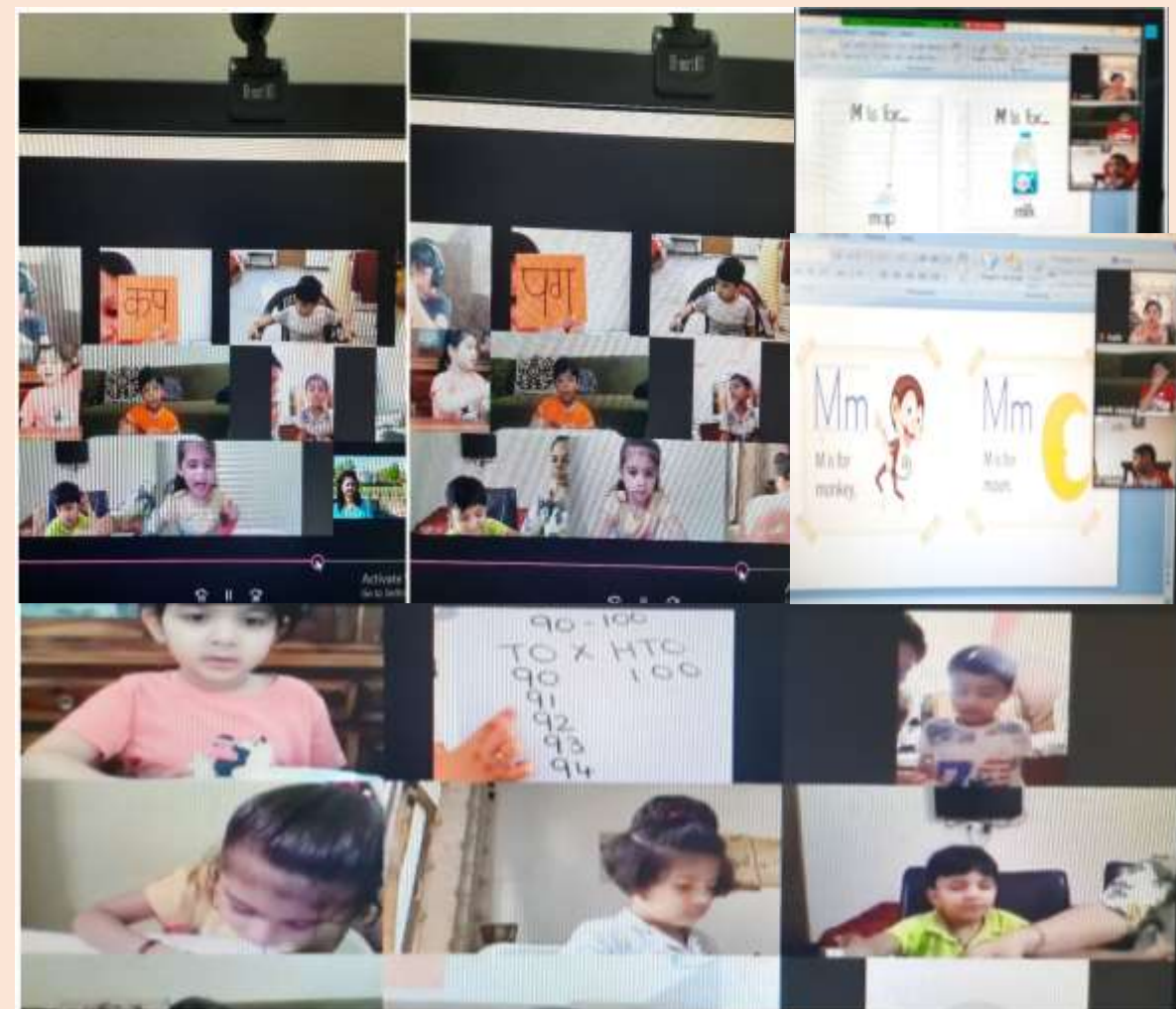
KINDERGARTEN

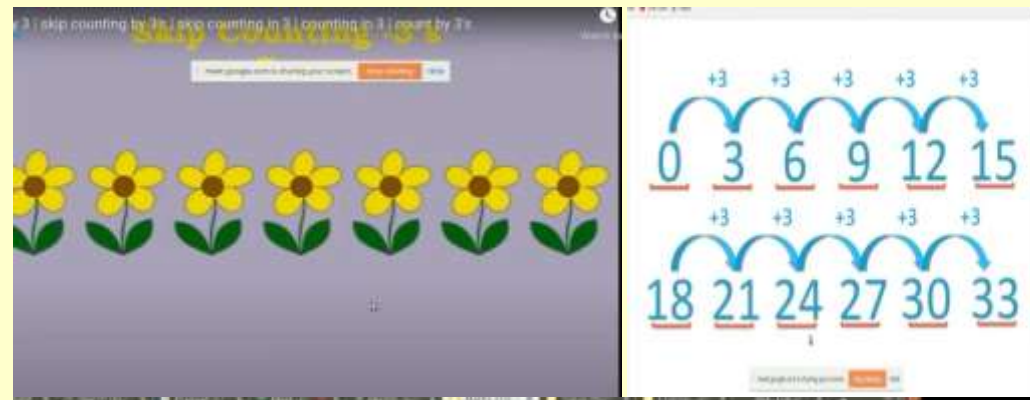
GA - Students learnt about plants and parts of plants during GA class. Students .enjoyed doing a worksheet on the above topic.

ART AND CRAFT (1 & 2)

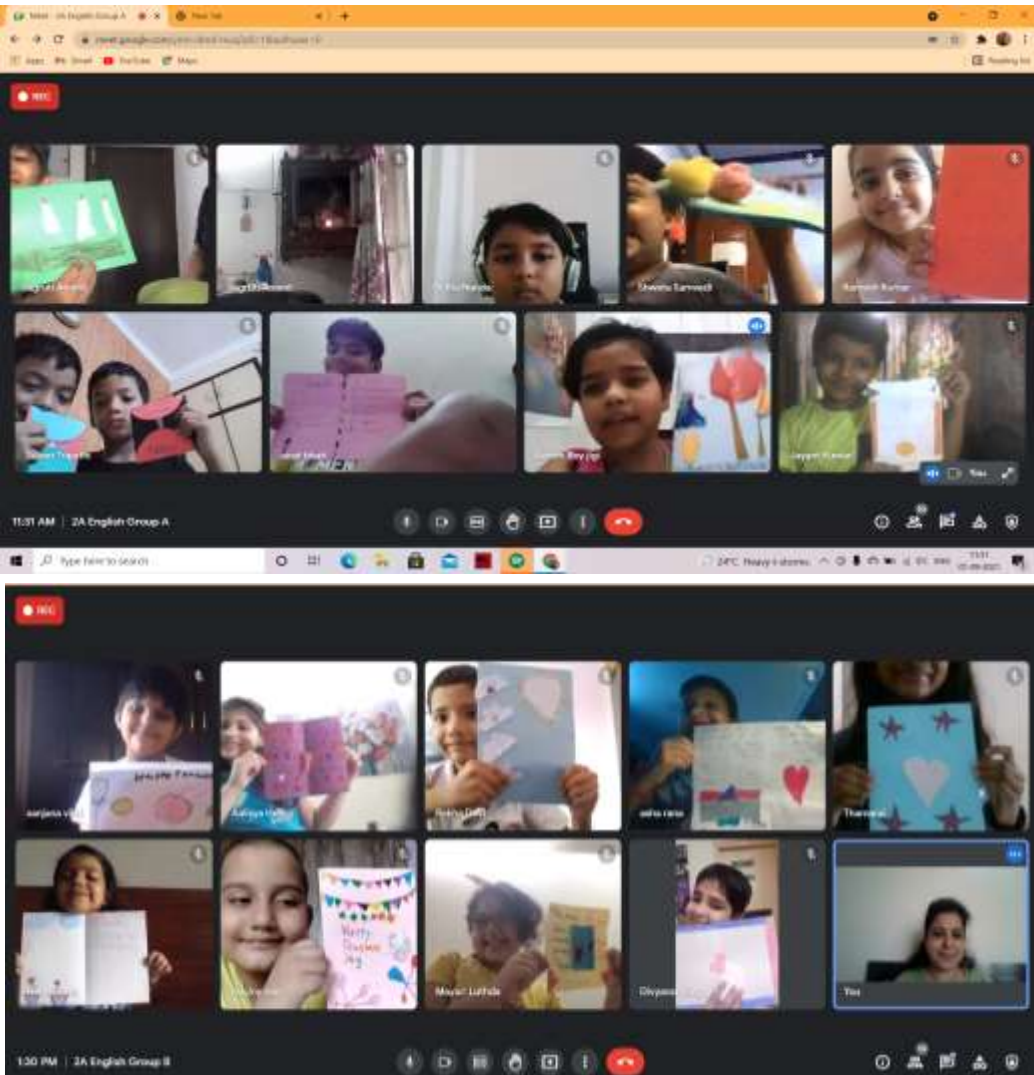
Students of classes 1 & 2 enjoyed the planned craft activity. They were taught to make hand made cards. Students made the card with paper and added craft and showcased their creativity.

INTER-CLASS WEEKLY ACTIVITY (1&2)

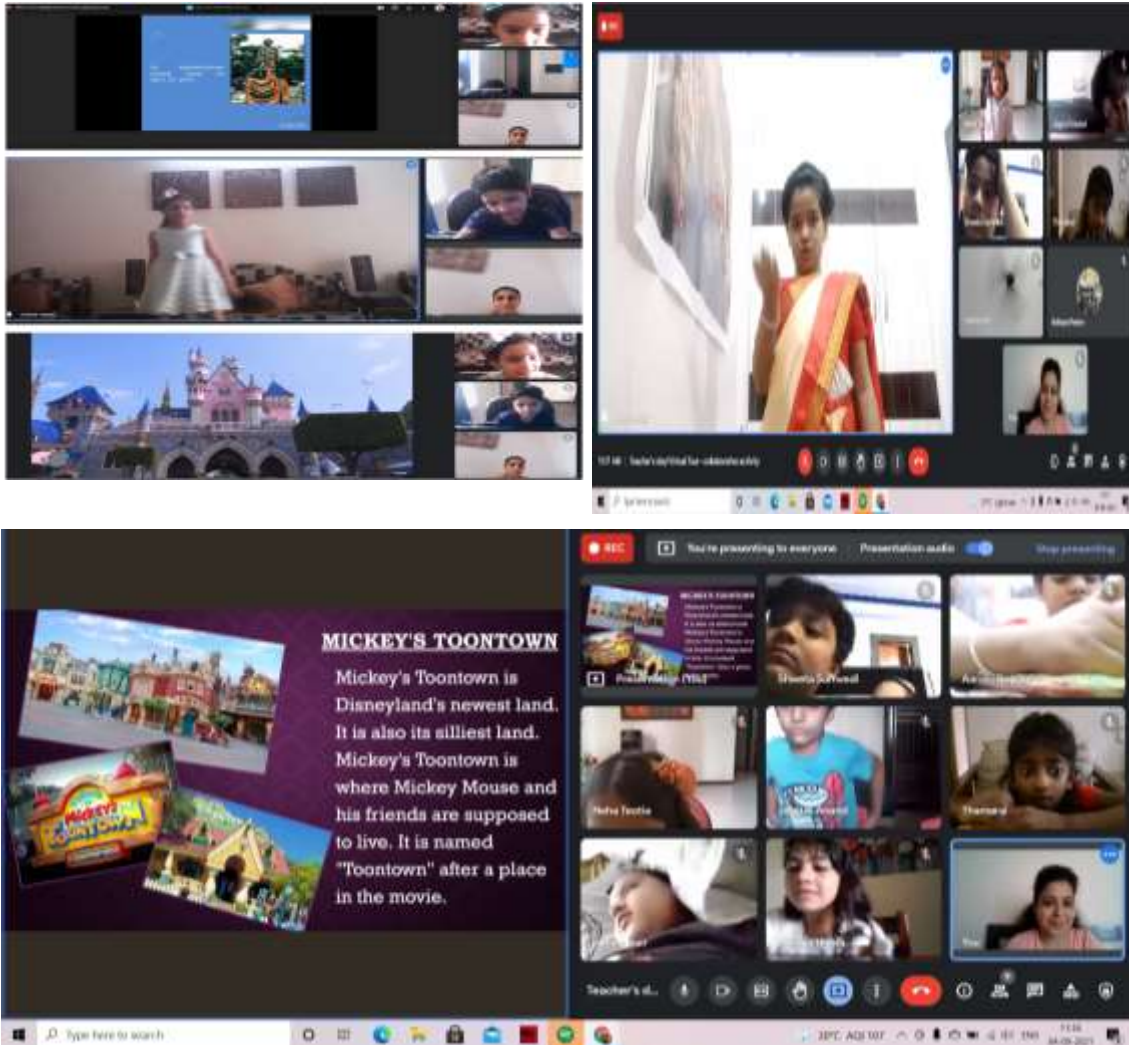

COLLABORATIVE SESSION (1&2)

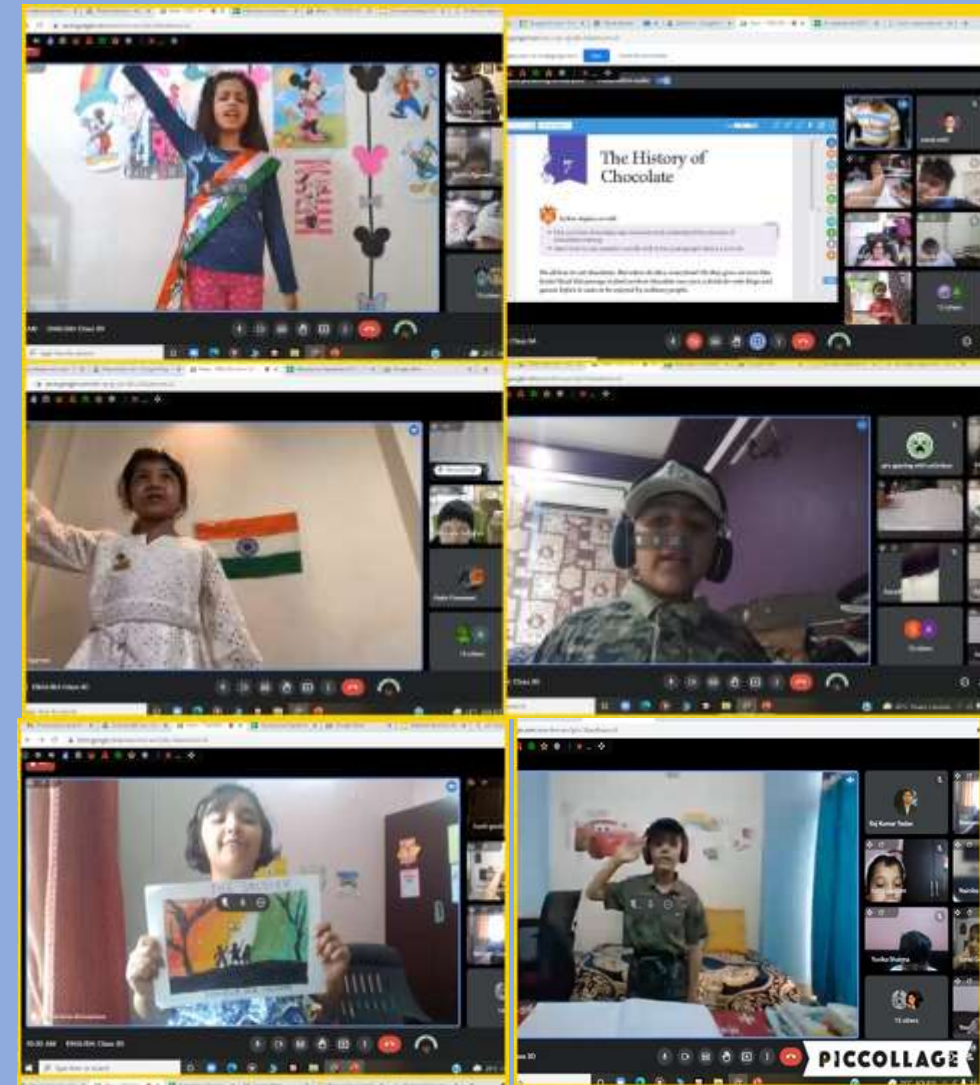

This fun filled and interesting session culminated on a lighter note, by the students who voluntarily participated to perform on the occasion of teachers day.



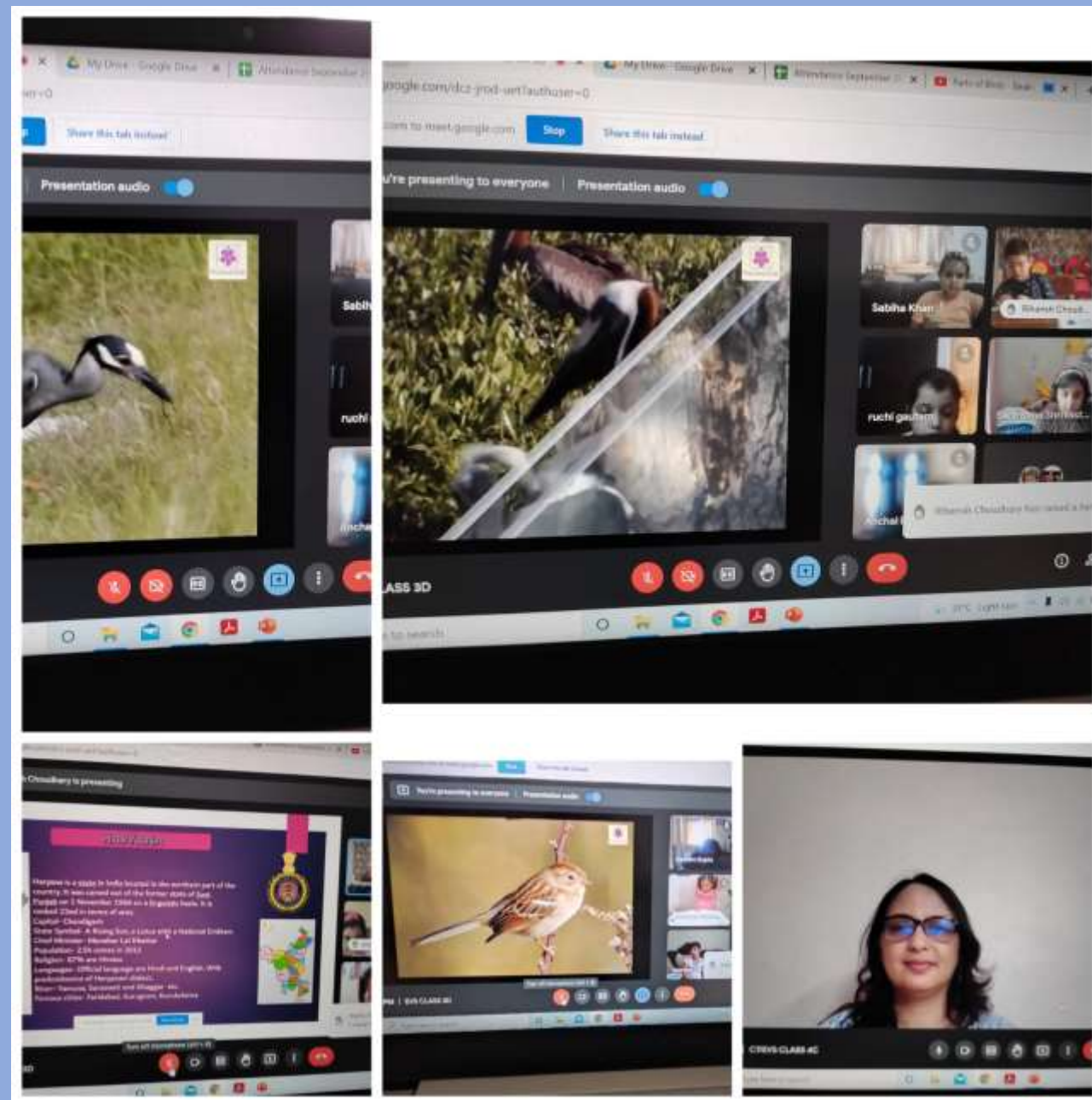

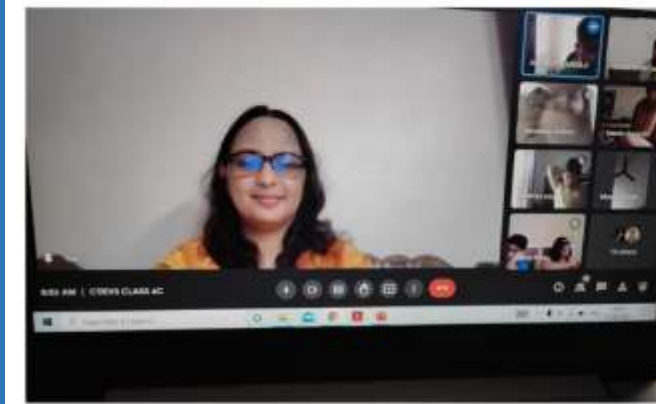
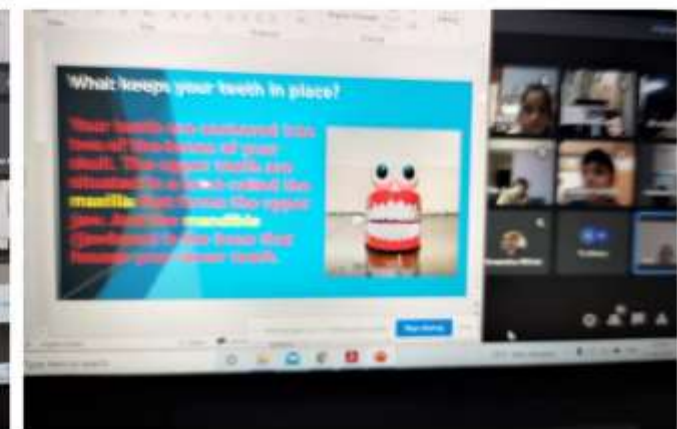
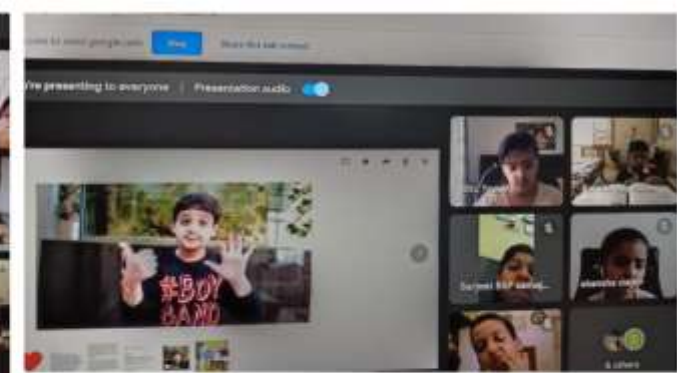


Students of Class 3 learned some more variations of hand gestures. They also revised the ongoing dance steps and learned more steps on the contemporary/Fusion music.

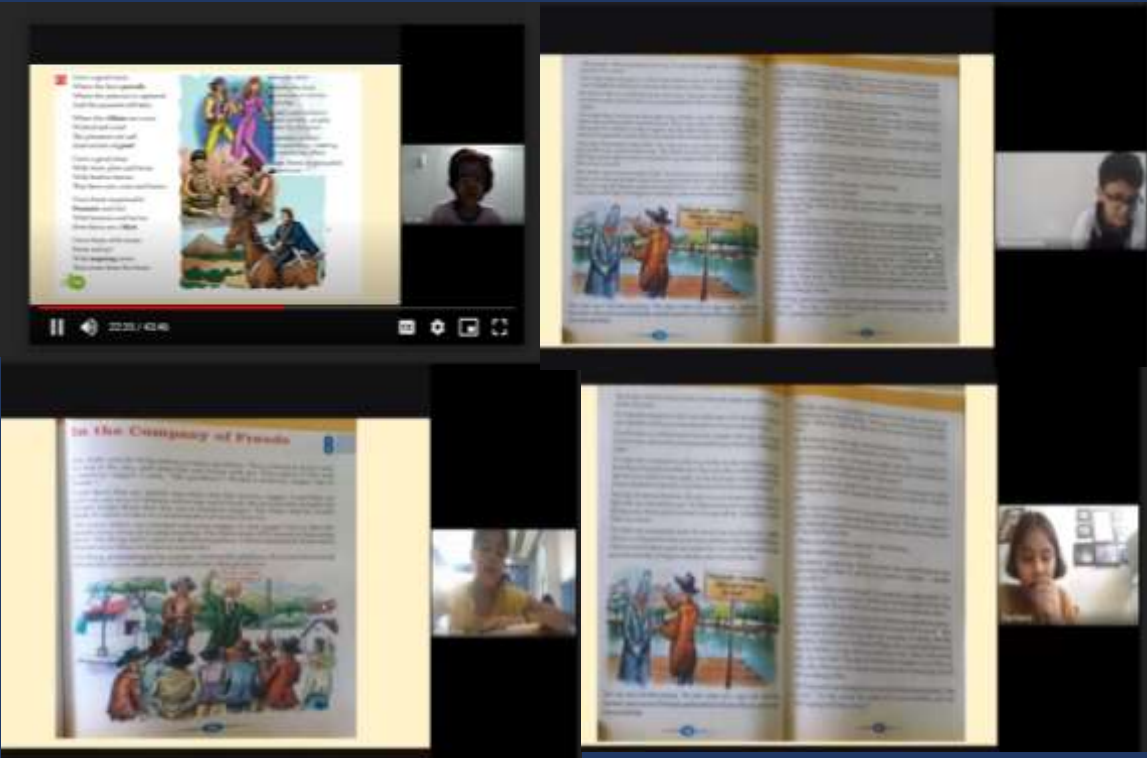
Grade 4 MATH



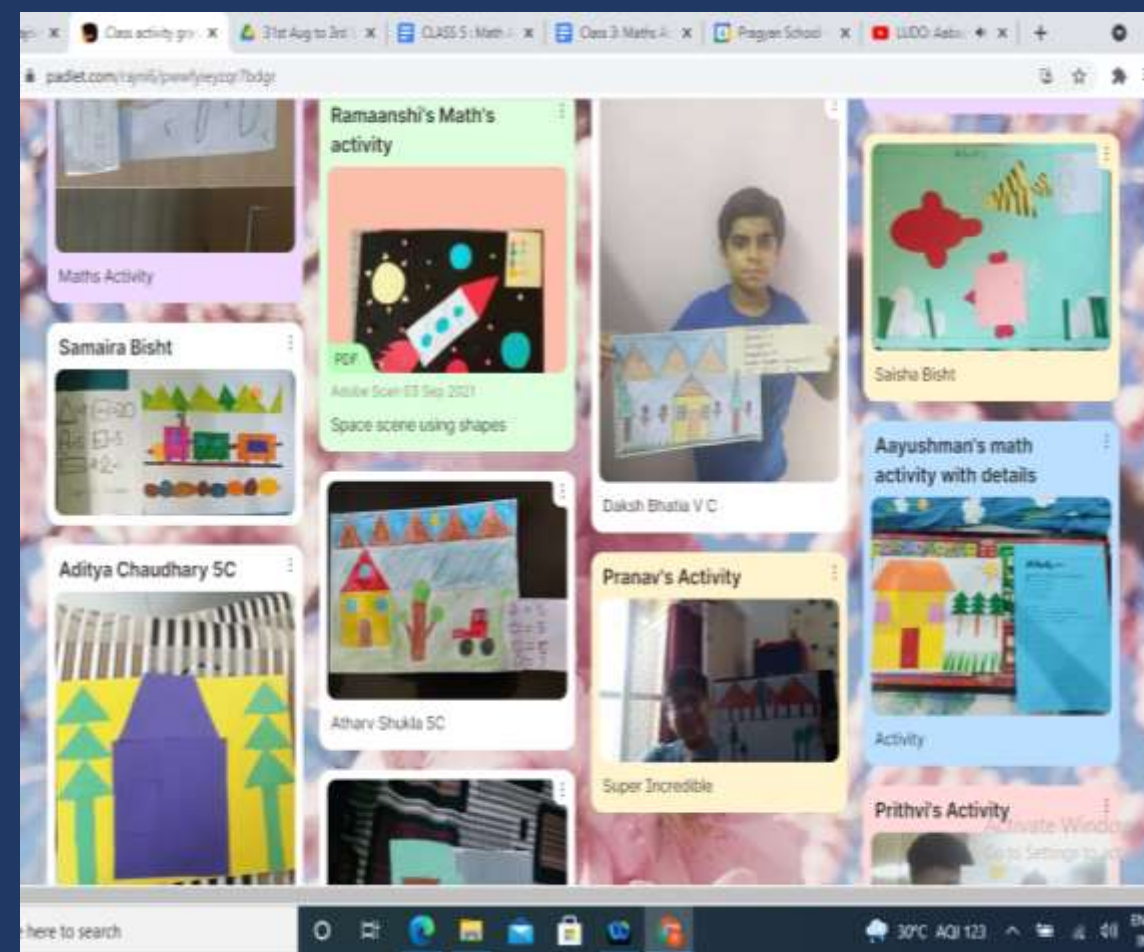





Math ACTIVITY

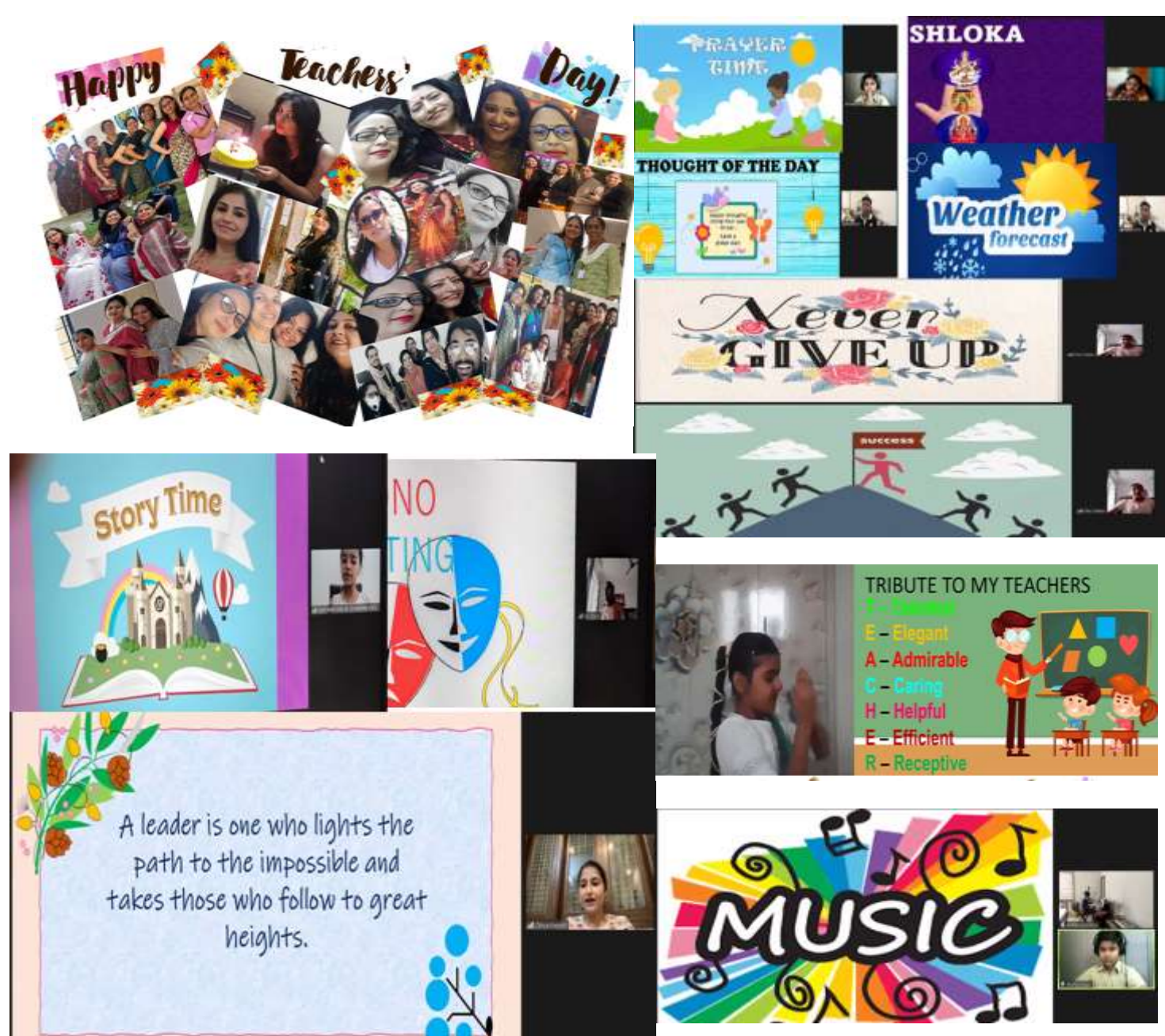
Grade 5

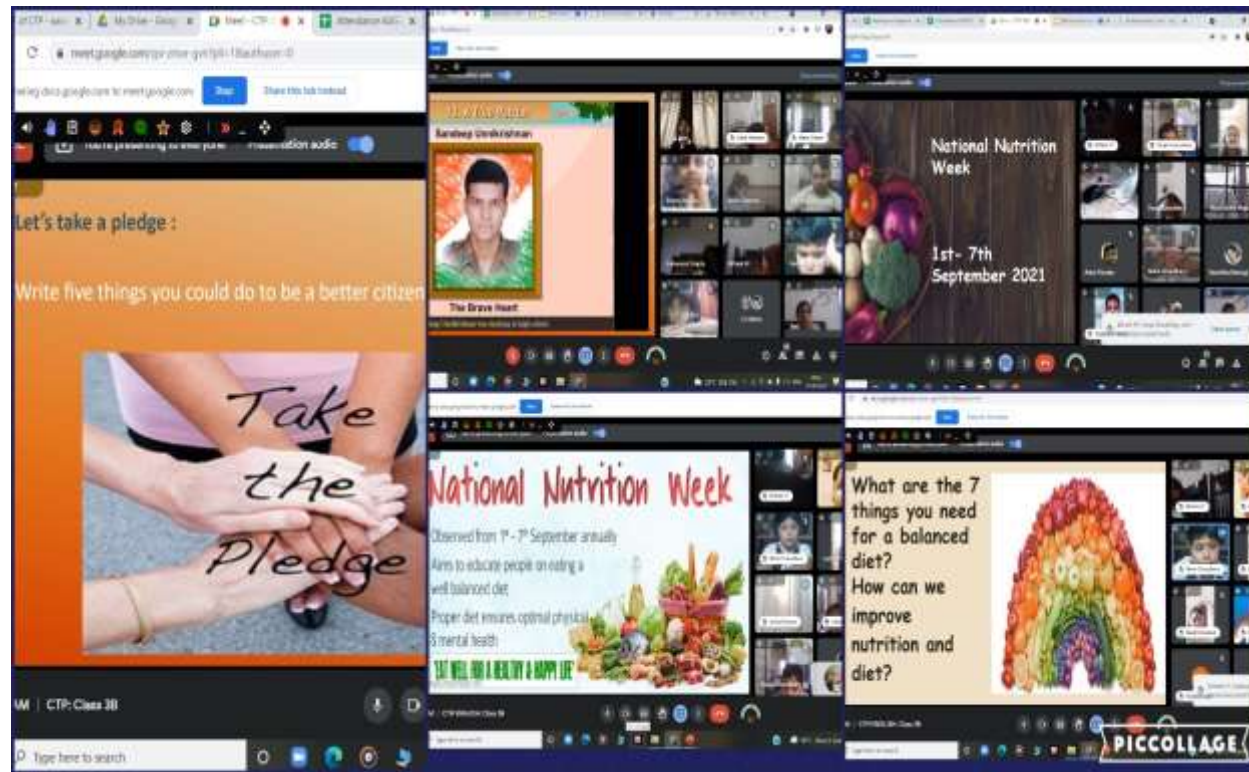
CLASS ASSEMBLY – 4B

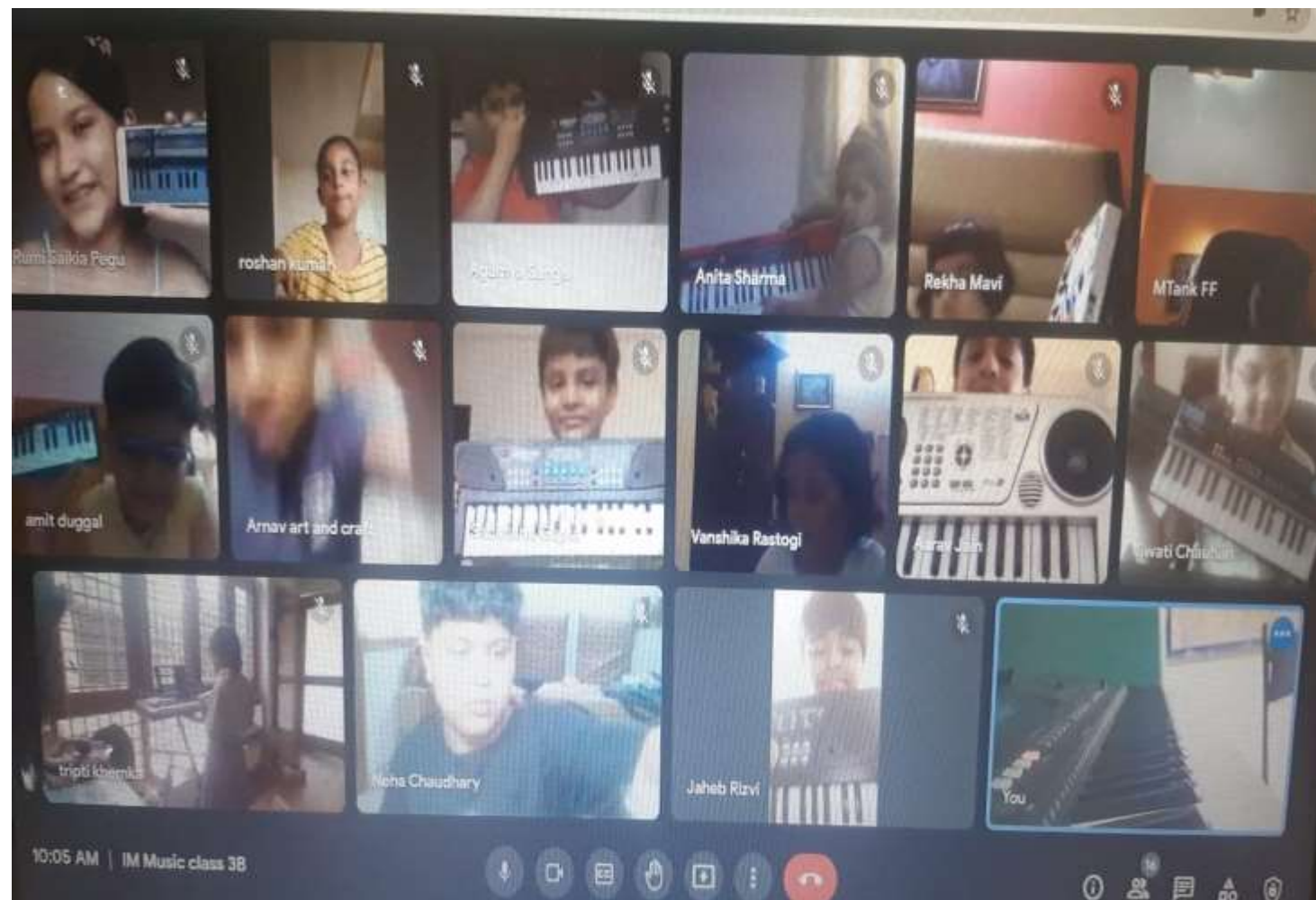
ART AND CRAFT (3- 5)

Students of classes 3 to 5 learned pattern drawings and to do blending in trees. They also learned to make hut and enjoyed using water colours in the landscape.



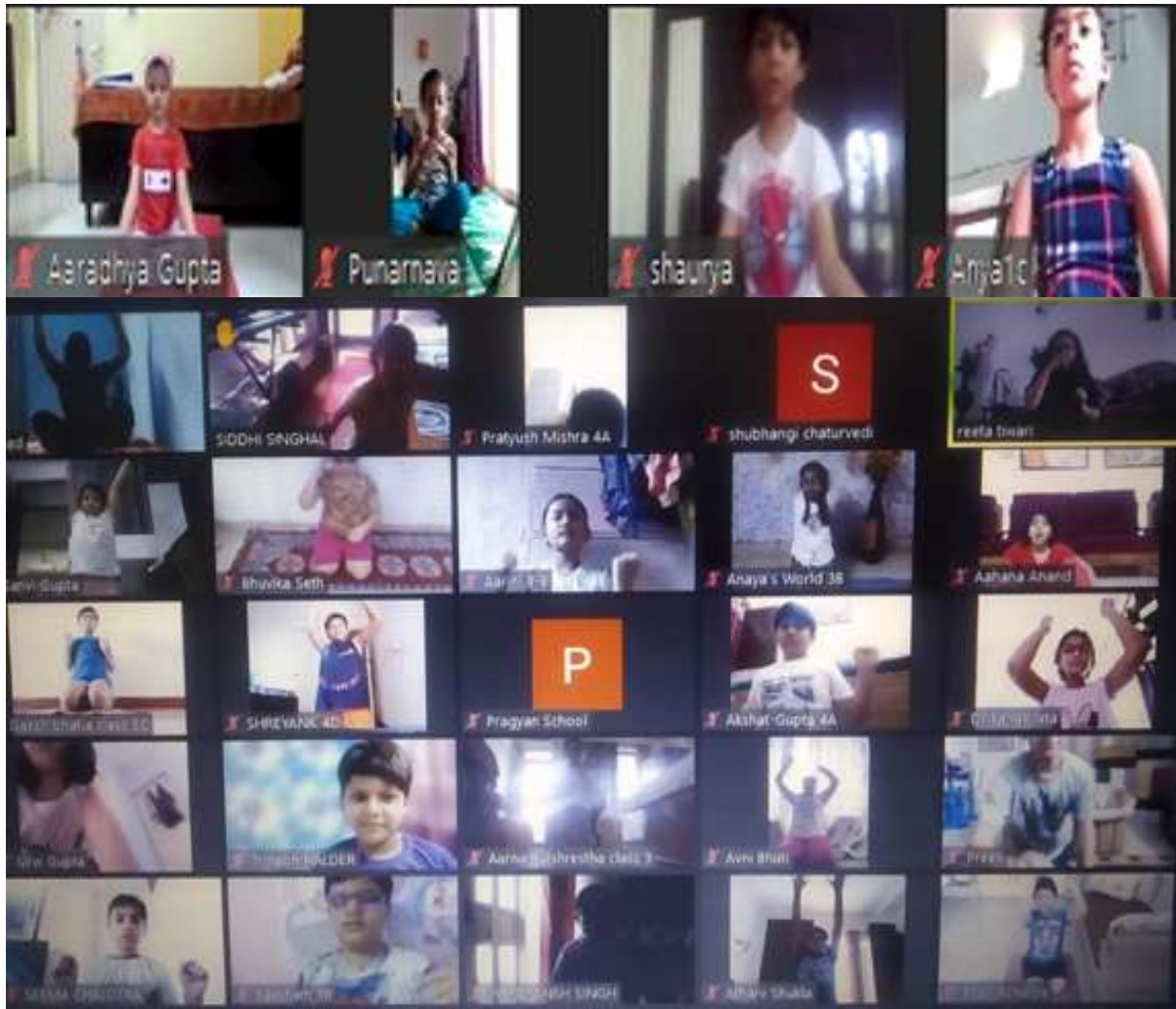
INSTRUMENTAL CLASS (3 – 5)

OPEN HOUSE SESSION:

Open House Sessions were organized for the parents of classes 1 to 5 on 1st and 2nd September 2021, to apprise everyone of the processes and procedures for reopening of schools. Mr. Ram Chand, our managing trustee and Ms. Ruchika Sharma, our principal, were present during this session. Ms. Divya Kapoor, our headmistress, gave parents the chance to get acquainted with the functioning of the physical and online classes through her presentation. She also explained the safety protocols to be administered in the school during the physical classes. It was an interactive and fruitful session where all the questions posed by the parents were answered by the principal.



Timings for Physical classes:

Timings for Classes: 8:15 am - 4:00 pm

- Students will have a complete day of school with holistic activities. The day will include academic classes, sports, co-curricular classes, library periods etc.
- No homework will be given to the students. They will be doing their worksheets during the critical periods in school.

Note: There will be reshuffling of the students to create separate online and offline sections as per the consent of the parents.



Safety protocols to be administered in classrooms:

- Class strength will be 50% of the total capacity.
- Desks will be appropriately spaced (at least 1 metre between desks)
- Seats will be marked. Displacing the furniture will be not allowed. Single desk seating arrangement will be created.
- Lockers will no longer be functional, students will carry their bag, books daily as per the time table.
- The classrooms of the school are airy and well ventilated. The windows, ventilators and doors of the rooms will remain open throughout the day.
- Chairs / tables / doors are being sanitized once a day with 'Dettol' - hospital grade disinfectant.
- All busses will be sanitized after clearing them at the end of the day.

ENGLISH DECLAMATION: INTER-CLASS ACTIVITY RESULTS

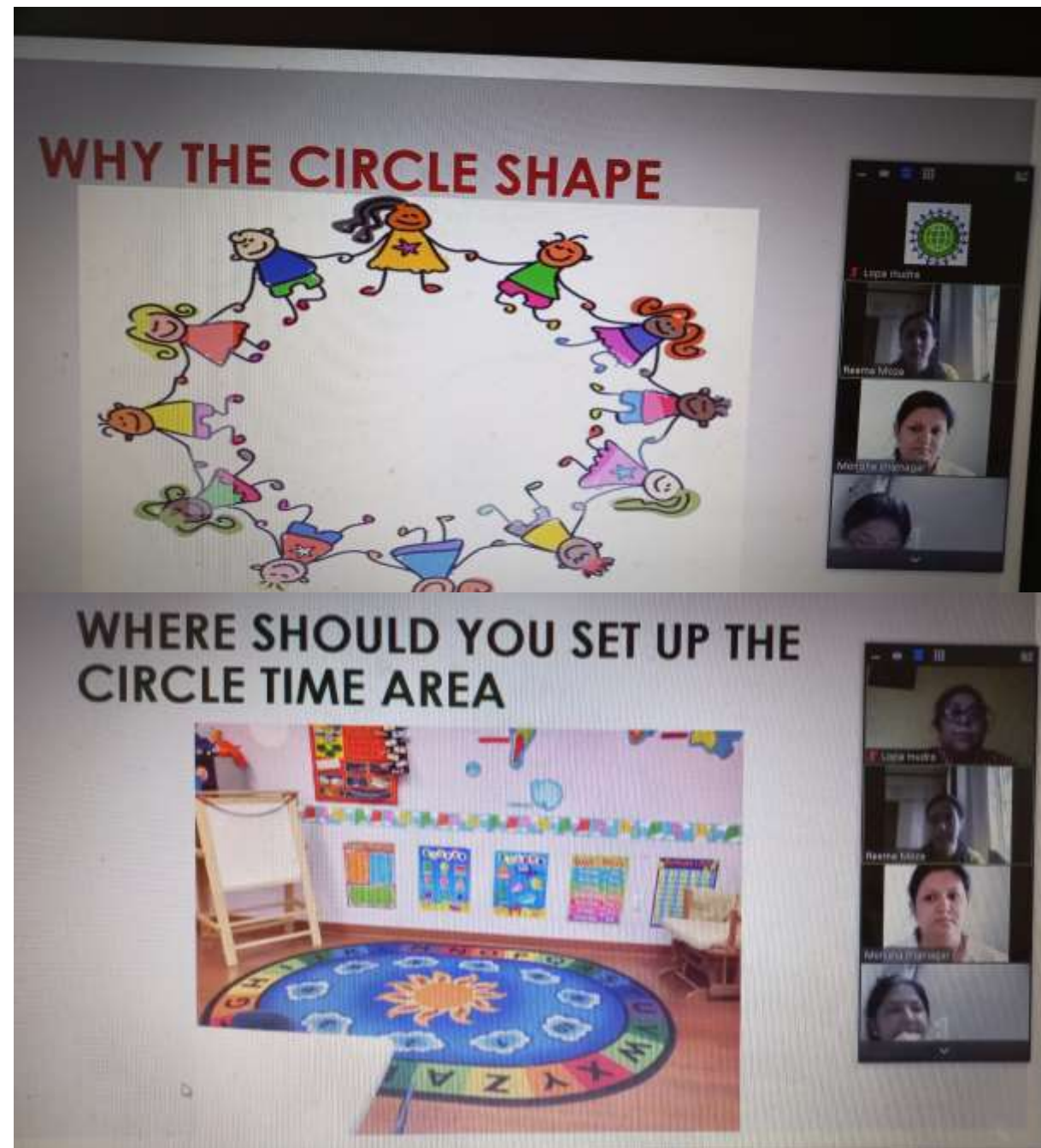
