NURSERY



ENGLISH

ENGLISH

MATHS

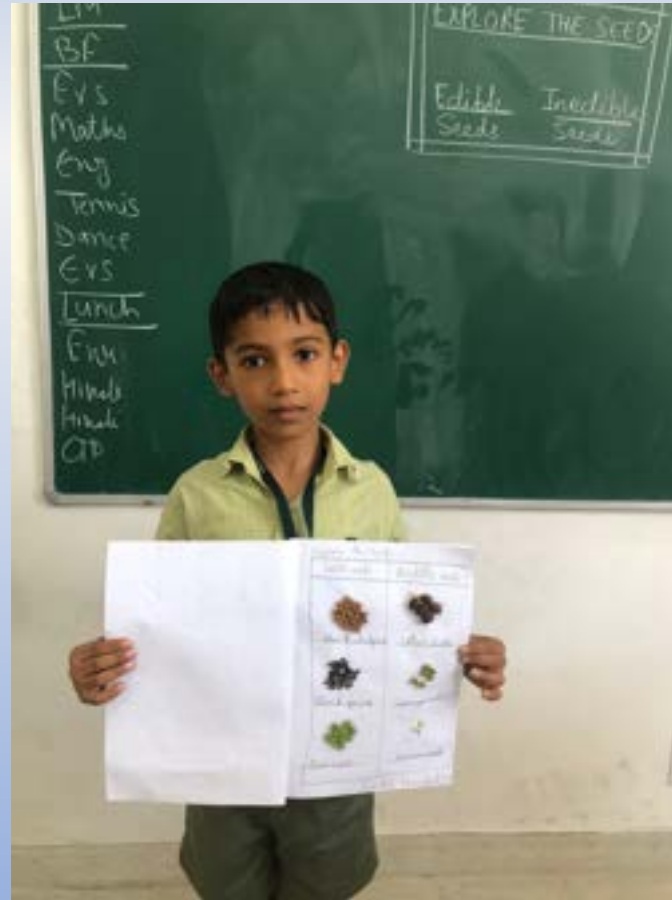
