# NURSERY

# KINDERGARTEN

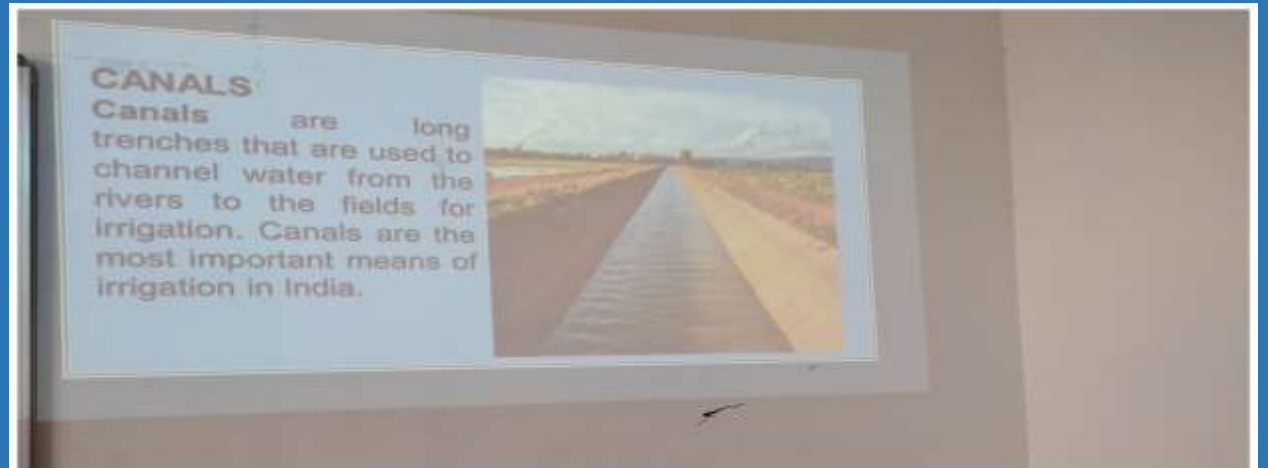
