# NURSERY



## ENGLISH

Recapitulation of letters L,T,I,E and H was done with pictures and with help of sandpaper tracing. Letter F was introduced to them using different pictures and objects that began with letter F. They also did colouring of letter F related pictures in their Letter Book.

# MATHS

Number 4 was introduced to the students, they did counting of number 4 using different objects and practiced writing number 4 in their workbook. Pre-number concept of Heavy and Light was also introduced to the children and they enjoyed colouring the worksheet related to the topic.

Triangle shape was also introduced to them and they did tracing in their workbook.



# HINDI

Recapitulation of Vyanjan 'क', 'ख', 'ग', 'घ' was done in the class with the help of pictures. Introduction of Vyanjan 'च' was done with the help of pictures and children also did coloring and tracing of 'च' in the book.



# GENERAL AWARENESS

# KINDERGARTEN

## ENGLISH



Recap of letters o,a,c,d,e,i and j was done with pictures and two letter words ab,ad,ap,ag were introduced through flash cards. Students practiced writing two letter words in their notebook and also practiced sight words (my, and, home, the, it) with clap and jump activity.

# MATHS

Introduction of numbers from 70-80 was done with flash cards. Students wrote counting from 0-80 in their maths notebook. Students did various worksheets based on the concept of greater than, smaller than and after, before.



# HINDI

Recap of swar from अ - अः was done through flash cards. Introduction of vyanjan ब was done with the help of pictures and stories. Students practiced writing ब in their workbook and notebook.



# GENERAL AWARENESS

It is important for every child to know about their surroundings . This week the children of Kindergarten learnt about the uses and functions of different rooms in our houses like bedroom, kitchen, bathroom etc. They enjoyed colouring worksheets related to the topic.



# EVS

# YOGA (NUR & KG)

# CLASS ASSEMBLY (NUR & KG)

Morning assemblies are the best way to start the day in school life as it helps students hone their public speaking skills. It imbibes discipline, helps in increasing concentration and prepares students for their day ahead. Children of Nursery (A-C ) and Kindergarten (A-F) conducted for the first time their morning assemblies on the topic 'Home and Shelter'.





The Singular and Plural forms of nouns are important when we are talking about one and many. The concept of one and many was introduced during English class where the kids were informed how the words get changed from one to many. They were taught about adding -s & -es while writing. Based on the same a video was played where students noticed how the concept can be used in our daily conversations.





# ENVIRONMENTAL SCIENCE

Students of class 1 revised the chapter Neighbourhood during the week. They had oral discussion on the topic and were taught about other places in Neighbourhood. Students enthusiastically participated in group discussion and performed a written task based on the topic.





# Math

Children of Class 1 learnt Addition concept of single digit during their Maths class. They learnt the addition on the number line, horizontal addition and vertical addition concept. Children enjoyed learning the concept and were able to do the question given to them on their own. Videos related to the topics were also shown for better understanding.

Creative writing is not just an art form, it is a catalyst for positive change. Students of Class 2 used their imagination and practiced paragraph writing using hint words. They were explained and encouraged to write on the topic "Animal I like the most.." during their English class. Each child showcased their understanding and tried their hands on creative writing. The activity was followed up by pictorial presentation.





In continuation with the last week students of class 2 did workbook exercises related to the chapter- Time to celebrate. They also enjoyed drawing illustrations of various National symbols.





Solving word problems helps students develop perseverance. Word problems require higher level thinking skills and take students longer to solve. Students may need to think outside the box and try multiple strategies to solve the problem. Students of class 2 learnt solving word problems based on Subtraction. They practiced a few worksheets on Subtraction with regrouping. Students also revised addition and tables up to 7.



# ART & CRAFT (1&2)

Students of classes 1 and 2 were taught about primary colours where they learned about the meaning, feature, importance and use of these colours.



# INSTRUMENTAL MUSIC (1&2)



Ode to Joy is a song by Ludwig van Bethoven with a tempo of 144 BPM. It can also be used half-time at 72 BPM or double-time at 288 BPM. Children of classes 1 and 2 learned playing Xylophone and piano by following the tempo and beats pattern. They practiced playing tune of the song.

# DANCE (CLASS 2)

Dance is an art to explore your feelings. The students of class 2 started learning basic pirouettes on both feet. During the week, students practiced a few steps of a dance sequences for Prize distribution ceremony.



# PHYSICAL EDUCATION (1 & 2)

Taking part in sports is important for children as it reduces stress and enhances their mood. Sports builds healthy bones and muscles, increases fitness, improves sleep, helps them socialize. Children of class 1 and 2 enjoyed doing general exercise, stretching exercise, fun game and races.
