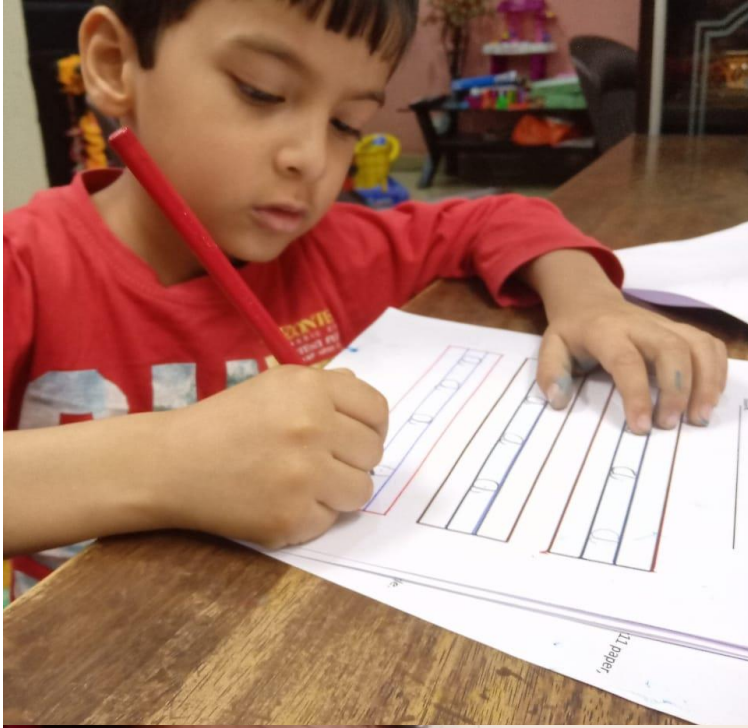

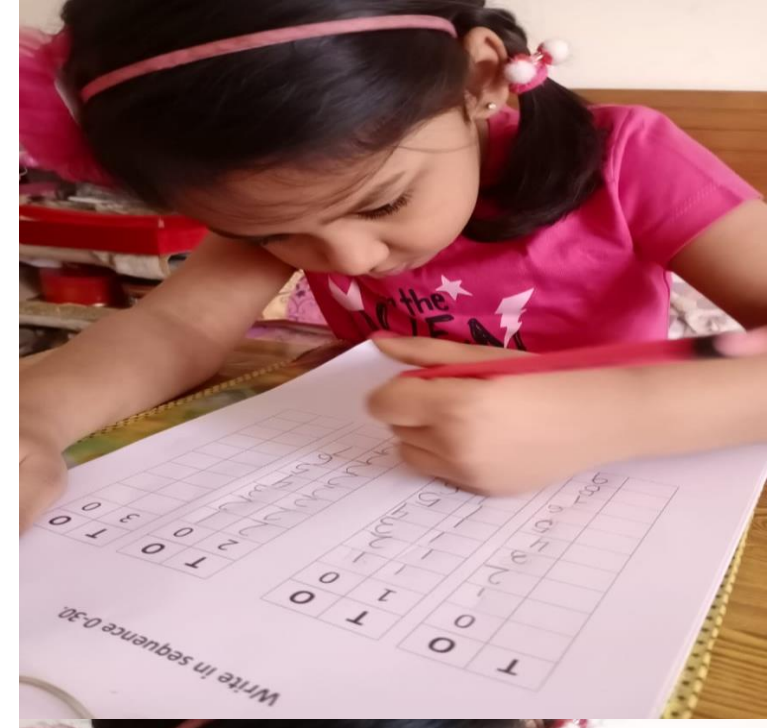
Nursery

- Maths- An activity was done by sprinkling talcum powder on a plate and writing 1 with the finger.



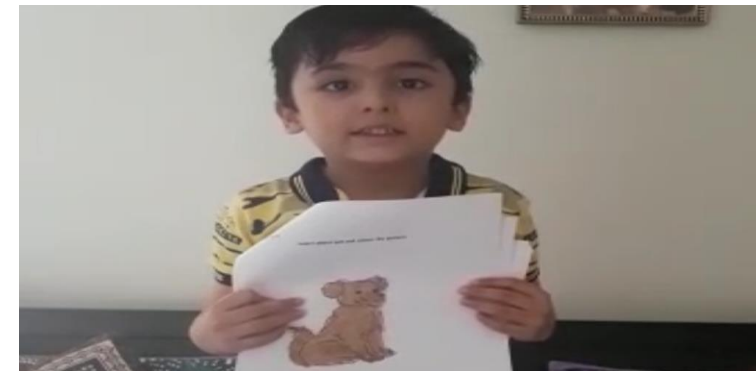
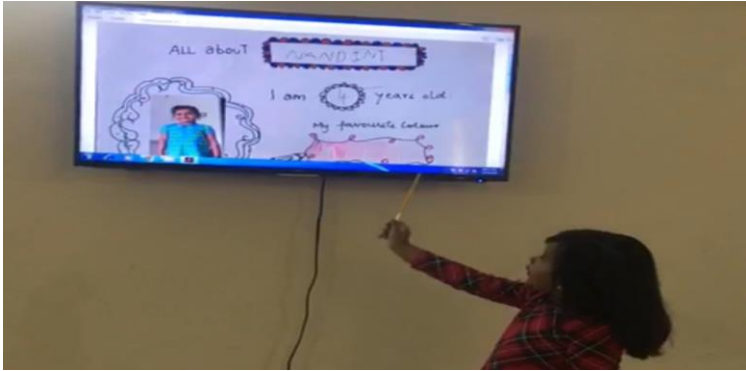

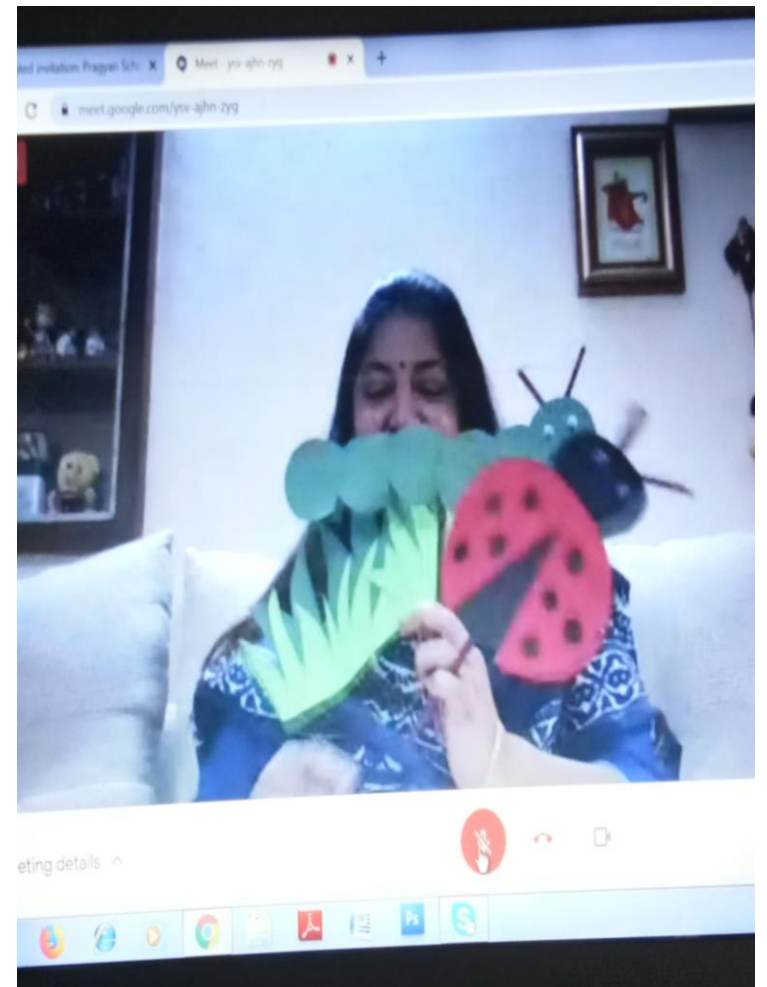
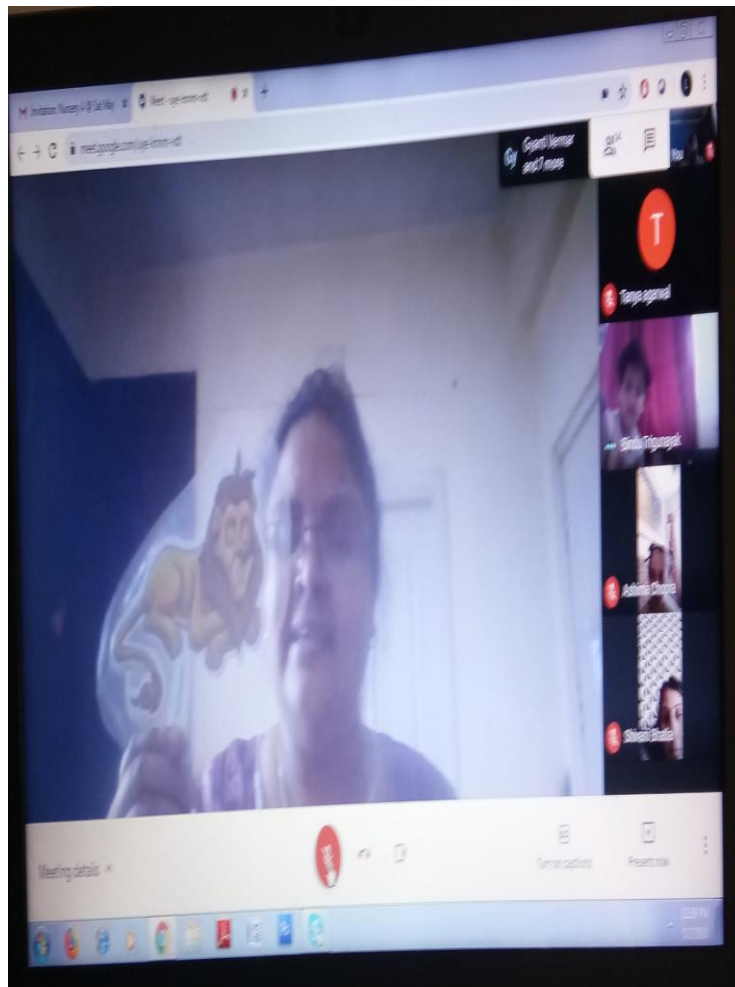
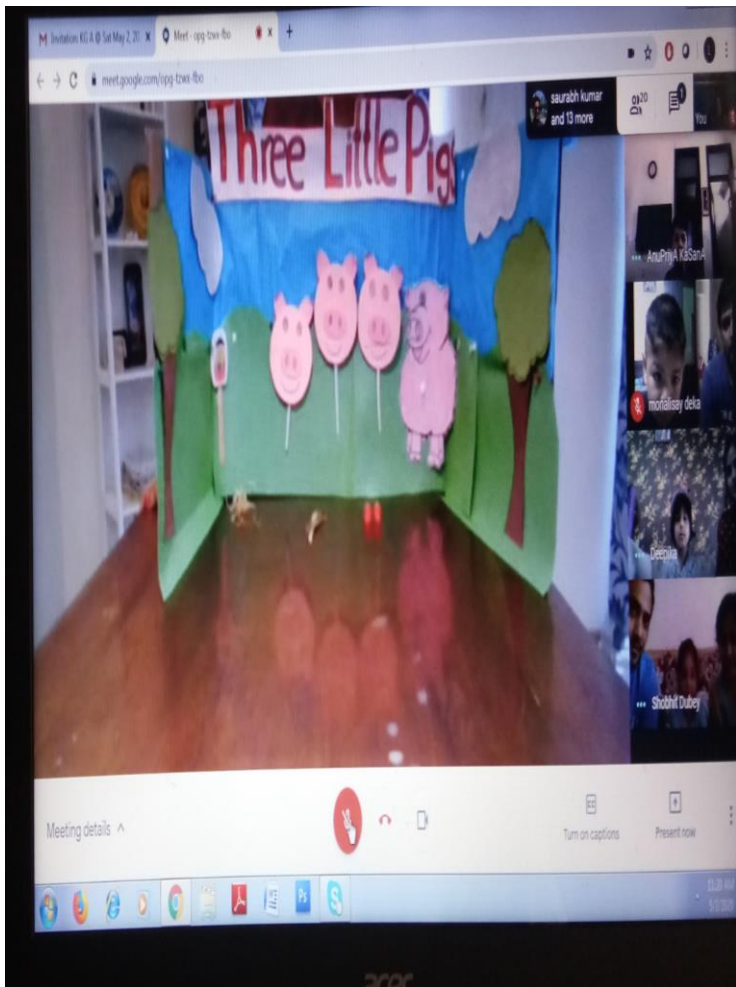
- English : Students practiced worksheets of letter 'a' by tracing them. Phonic song of letter 'a' was introduced through audio visual session.

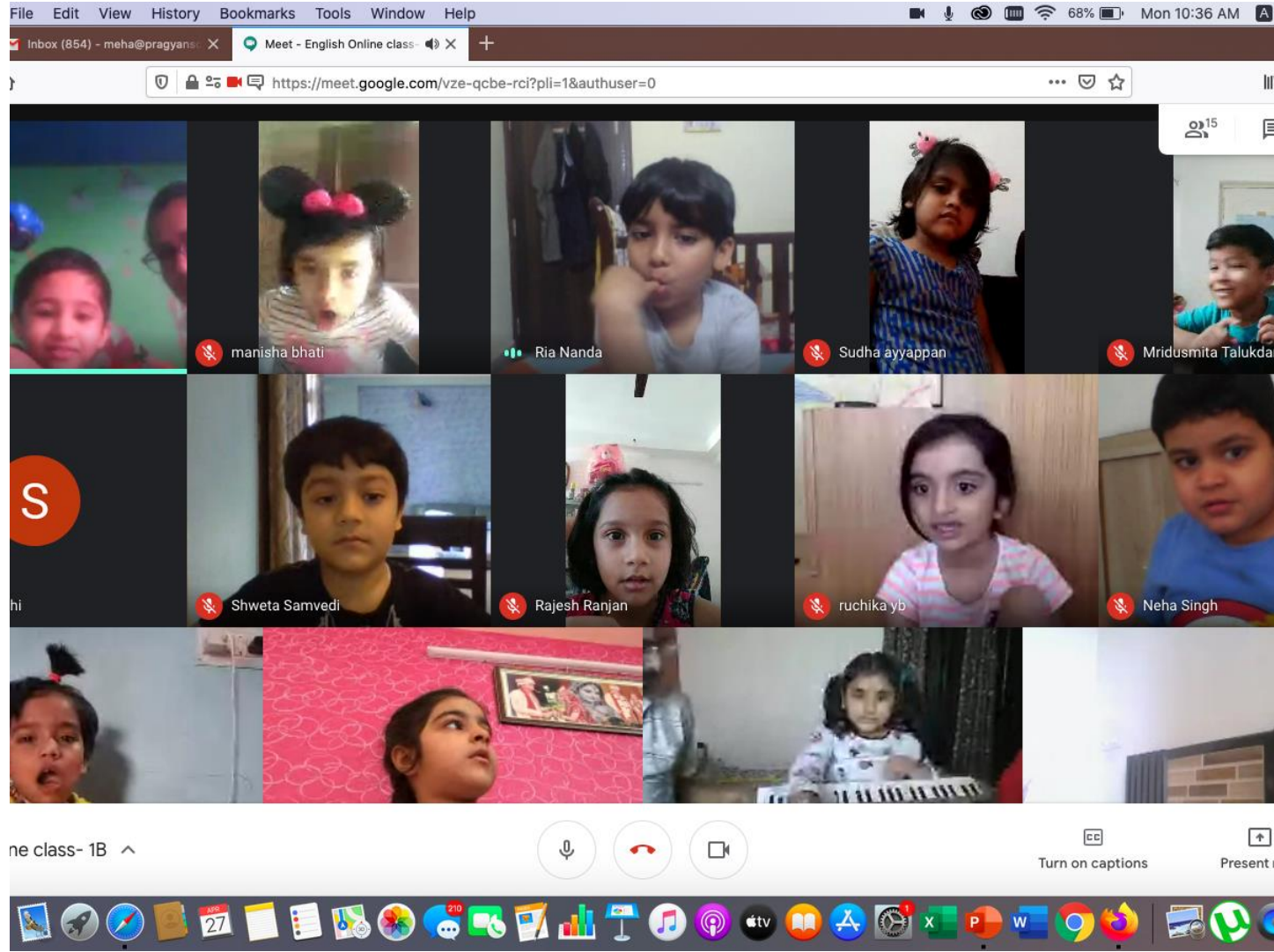
- Art & Craft- ‘ Family theme’ was done with the help of audio-visual session.

Students of Class I were introduced with 'naming words' (person and things). Each student got an opportunity to showcase an example of a 'naming word' present around them.



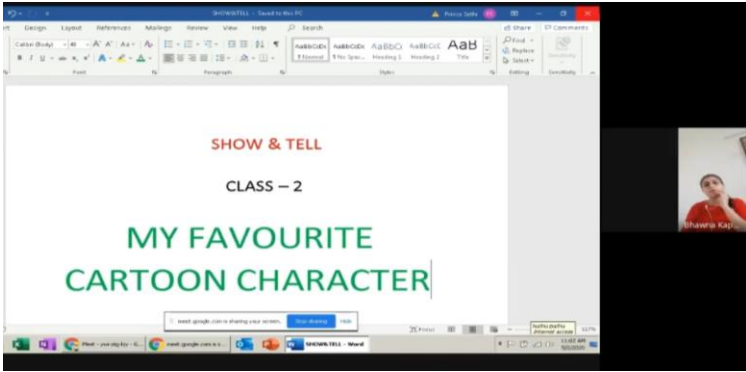

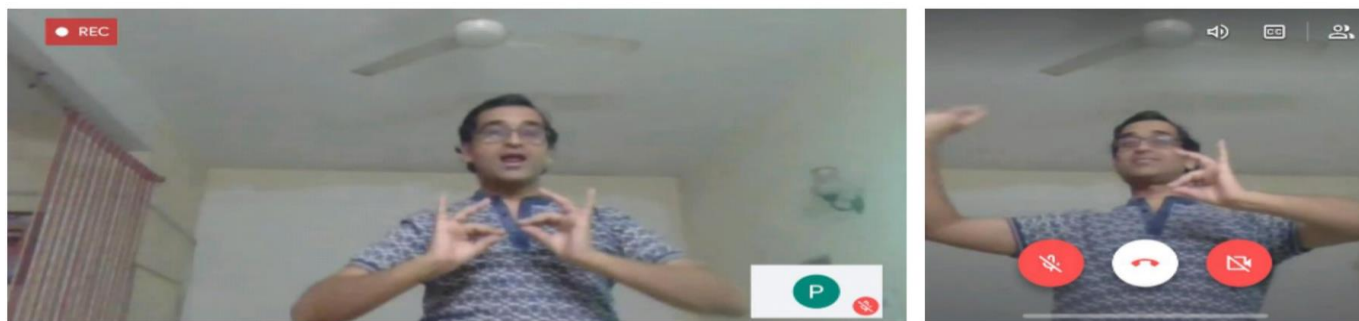
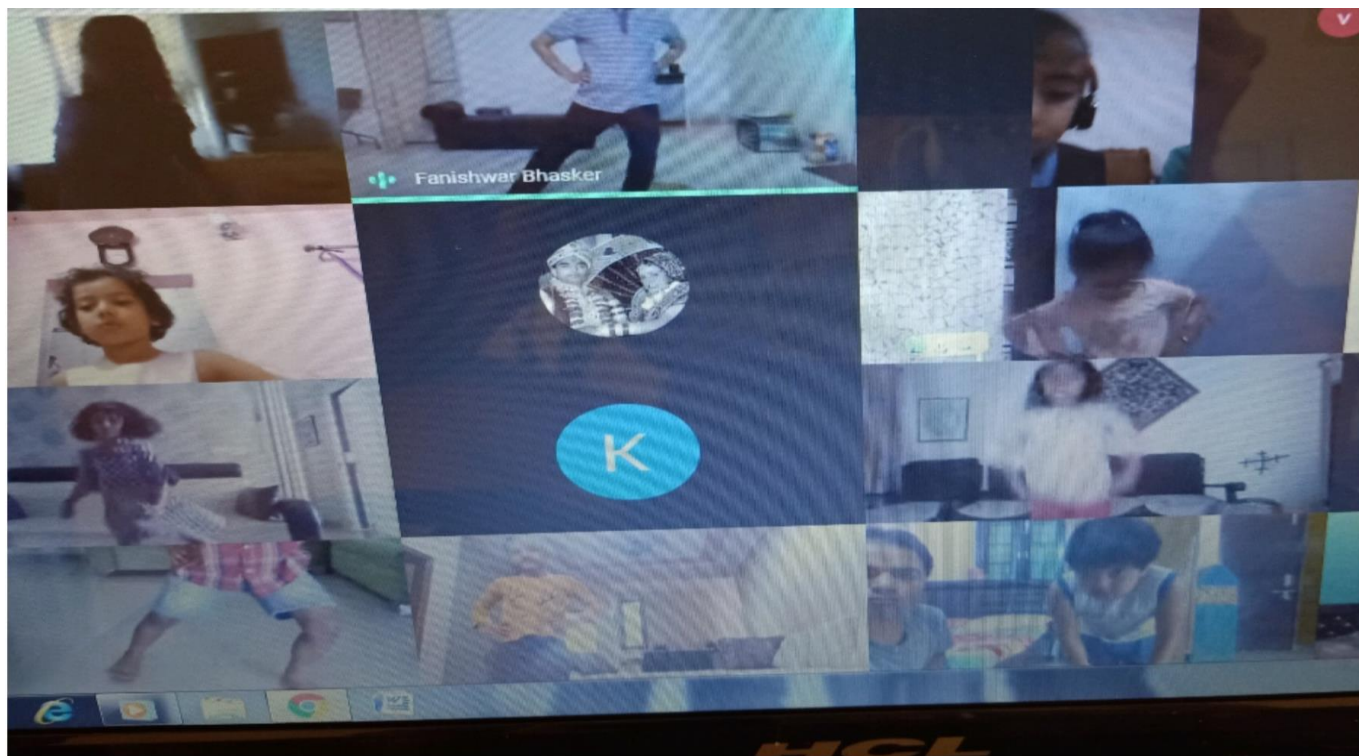
Classes I to II

With this thought, **Show and Tell** activity was organized for the students of classes I - II. They shared their views of their favorite toys and cartoon character.

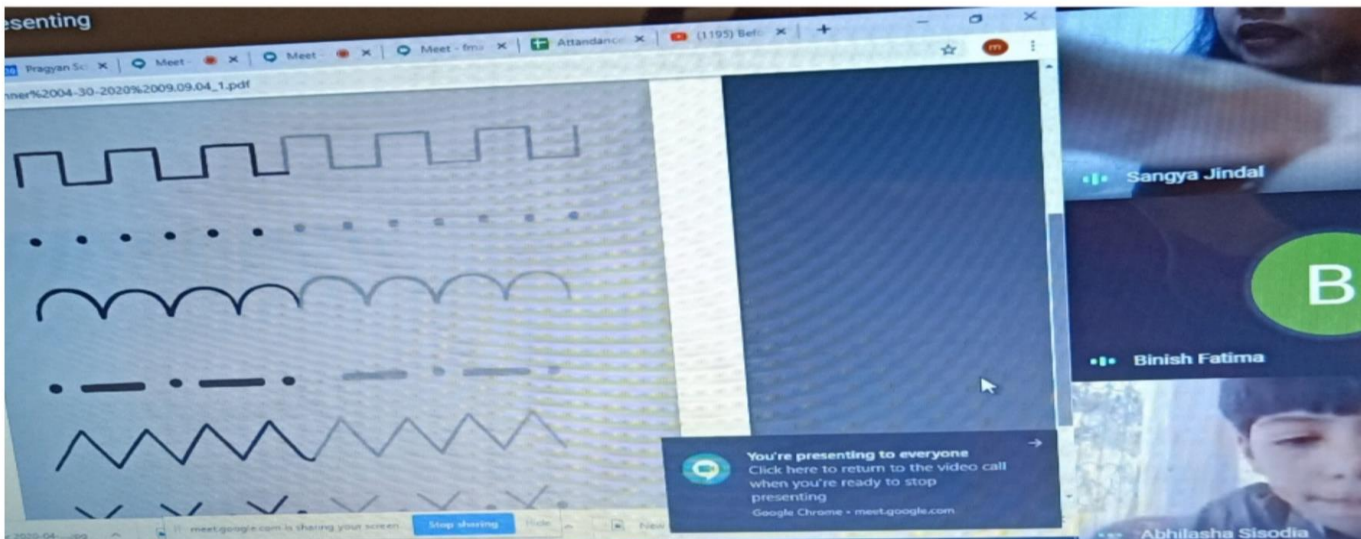
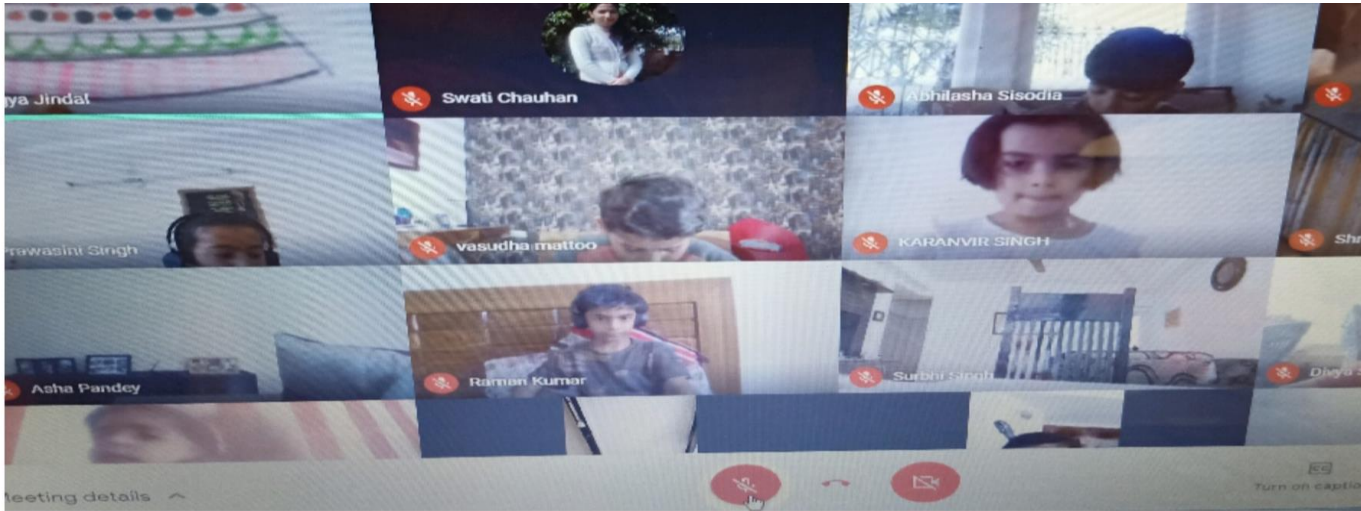




Class II

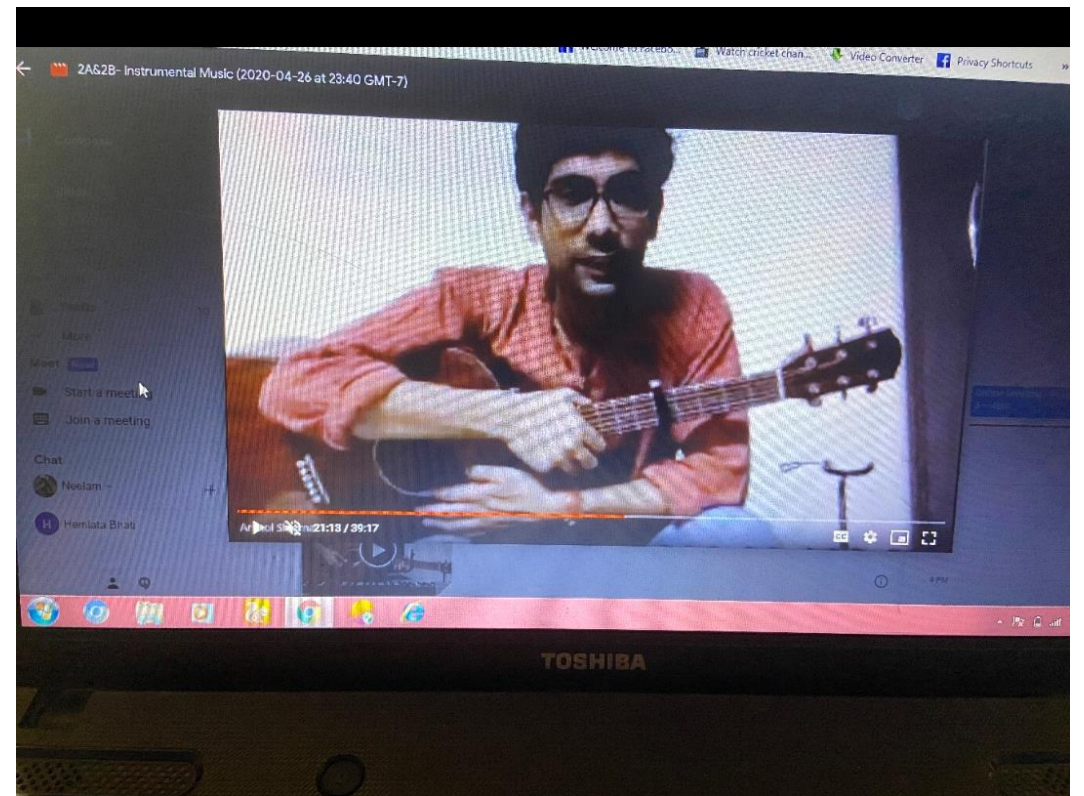
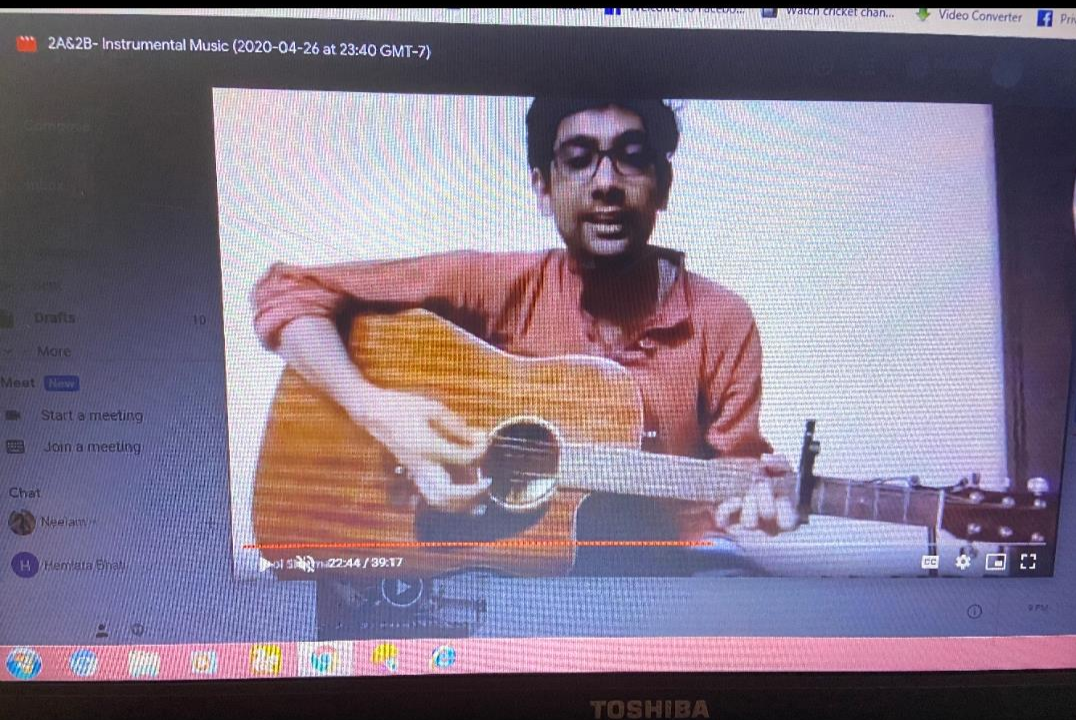

Music Class

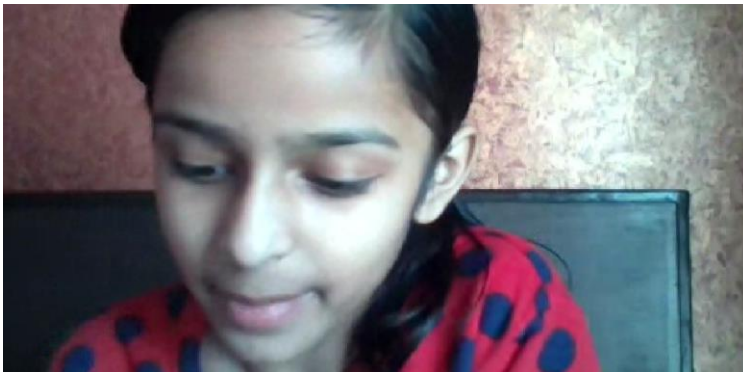

The strangest creature you'll ever find. Two eyes in front and many more behind. A living thing that is green but not a leaf. It can copy others but not a monkey.

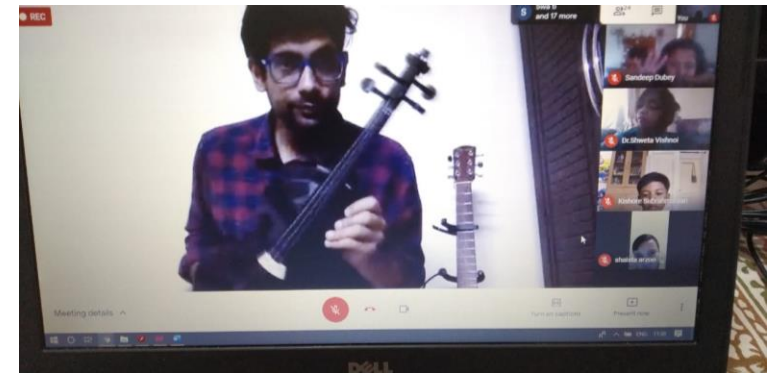

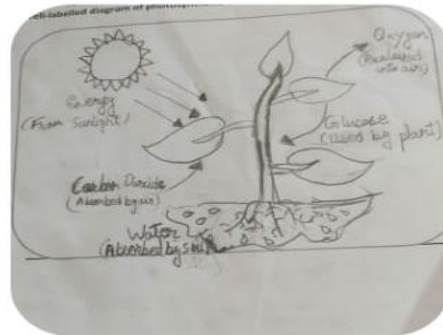
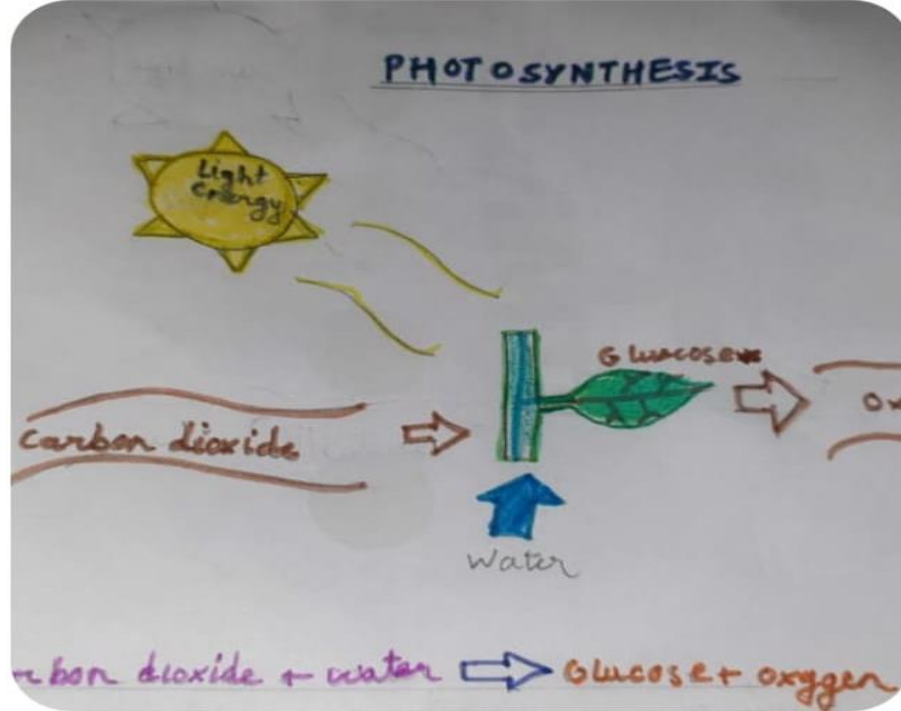
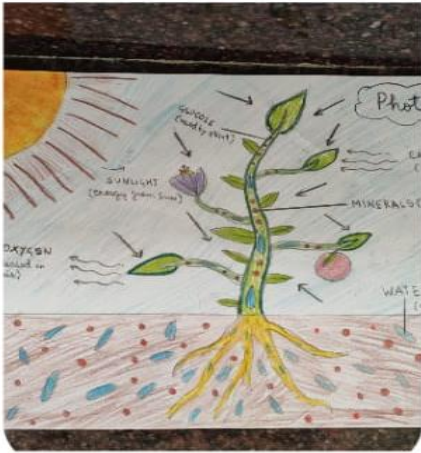
Classes III to V

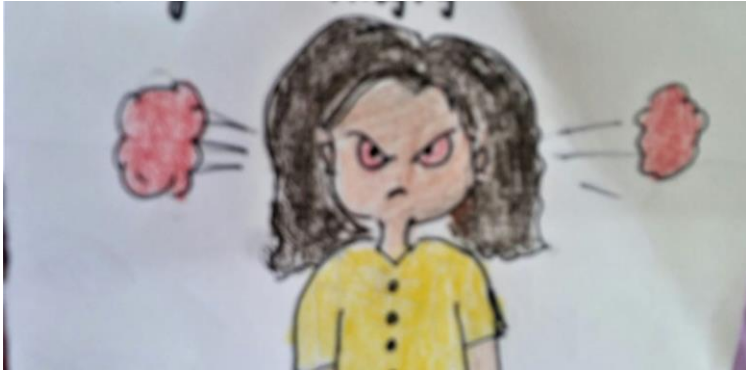
Classes III to V

Class IV

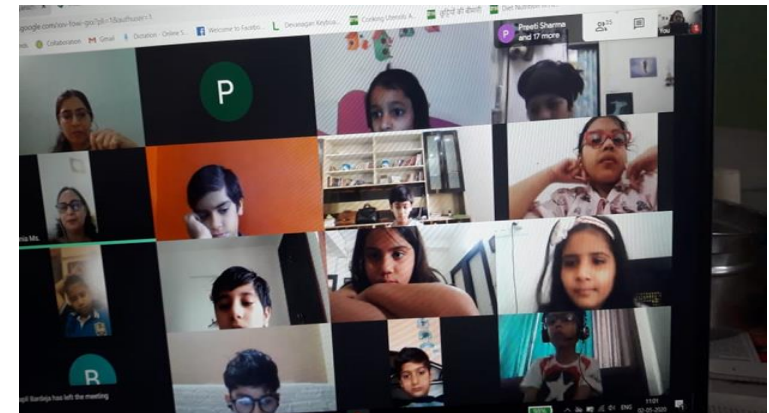
The students of class IV studied the process of photosynthesis as a part of the chapter Plants and explained it with the help of beautiful diagrams.
