NURSERY



ENGLISH

This week, students learned to write slanting lines and were introduced to the letter V. They completed worksheets based on the letter V and revised previous letters. Students showed enthusiasm and participation, demonstrating their eagerness to learn.

HINDI

This week, Nursery students learned the vyanjan ऌ, understanding its pronunciation. They coloured worksheets based on this vyanjan and revised the previously taught vyanjans, reinforcing their learning and developing their Hindi language skills.



MATH

This week in Nursery, numeral 9 was introduced through engaging activities and worksheets. Students practiced writing and recognizing the number. Revision of previous numbers was also done to reinforce their understanding. The students showed enthusiasm and participated actively in the learning process, demonstrating a good grasp of the new number.



MUSIC

During music students explored Sa Re Ga Ma through interactive exercises, revising Swar Alankar. They also learned a new song demonstrating enthusiasm, participation and showcasing their understanding of rhythm and melody.



KINDERGARTEN

ENGLISH



Letter v was introduced this week along with the revision of previously done letters. Children also revised sight words and 'a' family words.

HINDI

Vyanjan ष was introduced this week. Children learnt the sound of ष along with colouring and writing practice of the same. They also practiced two letter words with the vyanjans taught so far.



YOGA

This weekend, our students enthusiastically participated in yoga classes where they learnt and practiced different asanas like Halasan, Chakrasan, and Vajrasan. The session not only improved their flexibility and concentration but also created awareness about the importance of a healthy body.





ENGLISH

This week, students did a worksheet on “th” sound and read a passage from the board. These activities helped them read more smoothly, say words more clearly, and understand the passage better. They also became more confident in recognizing sounds and using them while reading.



HINDI

This week, students learned about इ की मात्रा . They practiced reading akshara with this matra and enjoyed completing a worksheet based on it. The activity helped them understand the sounds better and boosted their confidence in reading and writing.



MATH

This week, students did a worksheet on numbers 161 to 180. They practiced before and after numbers from 161 to 180, which helped them improve number recognition and understand number order better.



GENERAL AWARENESS

This week students revised the topic of community helpers and were introduced to festivals. They completed a worksheet on festivals and had conversations about them. Students shared their views on different festivals and explained how they are celebrated.



HANDS ON ACTIVITY

During the hands-on activity, students arranged numbers in sequence and in reverse, and practiced after, before, and in-between using the number line and numbers. They also revised community helpers and completed activities.



INTER CLASS ACTIVITY

As part of Inter class activity students of Nursery, Kindergarten and Upper Kindergarten participated in the Draw and Colour on September 4, 2025, showcasing creativity by drawing and colouring various objects and scenes. The best three entries will be selected based on creativity, neatness, and presentation and the winners will soon receive the certificates of merit. The activity encouraged students to express their artistic skills and imagination, making it a fun and engaging experience.



VALUE BASED STORY

As part of a value based story session, students learned the importance of trees through the story, **The Woodcutter and the Animals**. They understood that trees are homes for animals, birds and should be preserved. The story highlighted the importance of conservation and the impact on planet earth. Students developed a sense of responsibility towards protecting trees and the creatures that depend on them.





The children revised the concept of one and many, did poem recitation that added rhythm and confidence to their learning. They were also introduced to the topic of Gender in grammar and revised workbook pages, with their progress checked through a dictation activity. An unseen passage on Dolphins was taken up to build comprehension skills, while a creative writing exercise on ‘My Class Teacher’ gave them a chance to express their thoughts beautifully in words. Along with these, they enjoyed reciting the poem of the month and explored new words of the month adding freshness to their vocabulary.





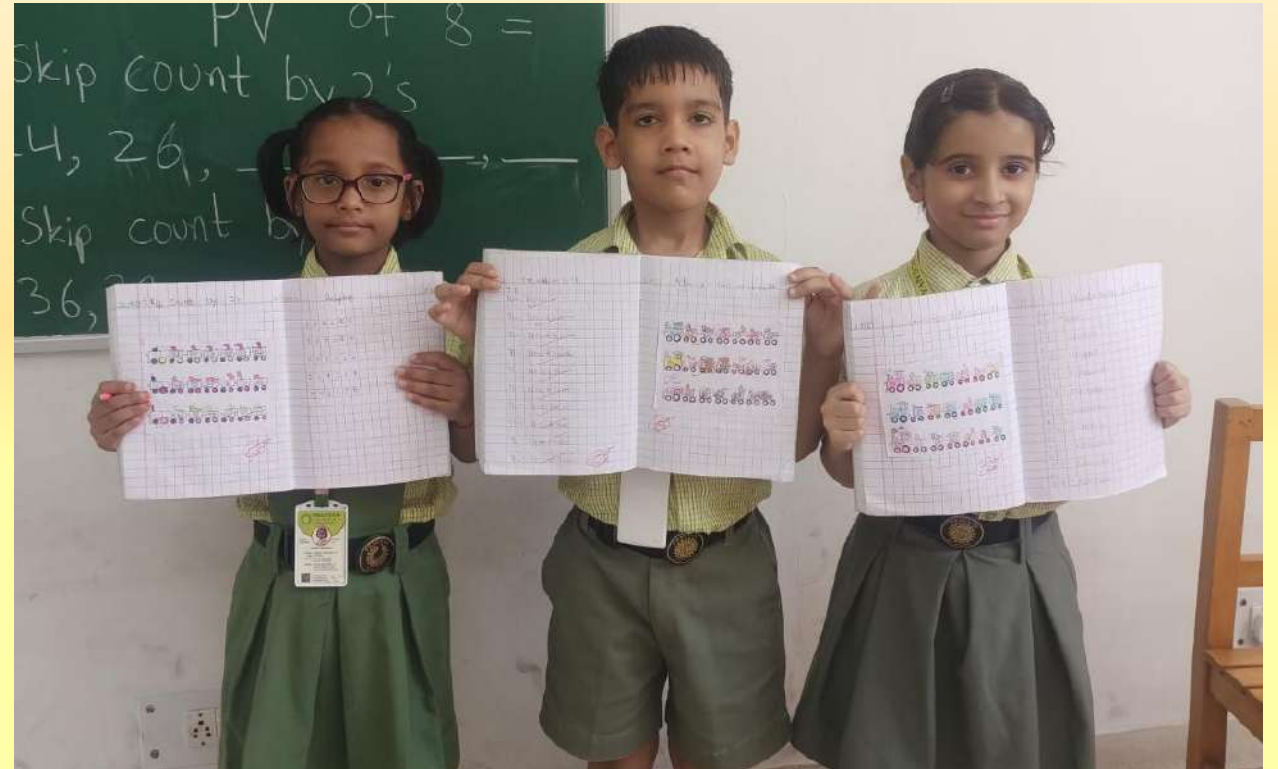
हिन्दी

पिछले सप्ताह कक्षा १ में विद्यार्थियों ने “एक/अनेक” का अभ्यास पढ़ा और लिखा। साथ ही “ओ मात्रा” का परिचय तथा मात्राखड़ी का अभ्यास कराया गया। सितंबर माह की कविता का पठन कराया गया तथा उसे लिखने का भी अभ्यास कराया गया। विद्यार्थियों ने वाक्य बनाना सीखा और “पढ़ो और लिखो” गतिविधि के माध्यम से लेखन कौशल को और बेहतर किया। इसके अतिरिक्त बच्चों ने “मैना और मकड़ी” का भी पठन किया और समझने का प्रयास किया।





The children of class 1 practiced number names from 70–79 along with tens and ones for the same range. They further learned number names from 80–89 and worked on identifying tens and ones in those numbers. Later, number names from 90–100 were also introduced and revised in class. In addition to this, students completed workbook pages as part of written practice. These exercises helped in improving their understanding of place value and number names. The children participated with interest and showed steady progress.





ENVIRONMENTAL SCIENCE

This week, the children were introduced to the chapter Religious Festivals. They explored the lesson through reading, book exercises, and notebook work based on the topic. The children enjoyed learning about different festivals celebrated in our country and how each one brings joy, unity, and togetherness. Discussions in class helped them connect festivals with their own experiences and family celebrations. Their understanding was further enhanced through oral quiz, where they expressed their learning with confidence and enthusiasm. The topic not only enhanced their knowledge but also built a sense of respect for different traditions. The students enjoyed STEM kit activity - "Healthy plate".





हिन्दी

Students of class 2 revised the new words of the month. They were introduced to adjectives and did an AIL activity where they drew the monsters of their choice and described it using different adjectives. They also did the related exercises in their notebooks and workbooks.





The students of Grade 2 have successfully read and explored the EVS chapter 'Clothes' this week. They learned about the different types of clothes we wear in various seasons, the importance of wearing clean clothes, and how clothes protect us. To enhance their learning, a fun and engaging **quiz** was also conducted, which helped the children recall and apply their knowledge from the lesson.



COMPUTER CLASS 1



The children explored the software Tux Paint and enjoyed using its fun tools to create colourful drawings on the computer. They learned to use different features like brushes, stamps and shapes, which helped them bring their imagination to life. The activity not only enhanced their creativity but also improved their mouse-handling skills and confidence in using technology. It was a joyful experience that combined learning with play in a digital way.

PHYSICAL EDUCATION

The children of Classes 1 and 2 participated in exciting fun races conducted in the playground. They enthusiastically took part in football races and showed great energy while running with the ball. The hoopla hoop race was another highlight, where children displayed balance and coordination. All the students enjoyed the activities with cheer and laughter. Such fun-filled races not only entertained the children but also helped in building team spirit and confidence.



DANCE

Dance is not just a series of steps, but an expression of emotions, a testament to discipline. Students of class 1, 2 enjoyed dance and learnt a dance sequence . They also practiced circle and dramatic elements with music.
