# NURSERY



## ENGLISH

Letter A was introduced to the students with the help of picture flashcards. They also did colouring of letter A related pictures in their Letter Book and sang jolly phonic songs of letter A. As part of the Vocabulary building children took initiative to speak a line on their favourite toy that helped them to develop their oratory skills.

# MATHS

Number 5 was introduced to the students, they did counting of number 5 using different objects and practiced writing number 5 in their workbook. Pre-number concept of Long and Short was also introduced to the children and they enjoyed colouring the worksheet related to the topic.

Recapitulation of Circle, Square and Triangle was done with the help of flashcards and various shaped objects.



# ESAP

Playing games keeps children physically fit and healthy. Students of class Nursery enjoyed the Zig Zag race during games period.



# GENERAL AWARENESS

As part of general awareness the topic Food and its importance was discussed with the children. They enjoyed colouring the worksheet related to the topic.



# EVS

The topic Peacock was introduced to the children during EVS class with the help of pictures. They learnt about its different features and enjoyed colouring the worksheets related to the topic.



# ART/ CRAFT

Craft helps in developing fine motor skills. It strengthens the muscles and improves their control. Students of class Nursery enjoyed making Matki during craft class.



# KINDERGARTEN



## ENGLISH

Students of kindergarten were introduced to the letter l and t through pictures, stories and flashcards. They wrote these letters in their workbook and notebook. Introduction of new sight words (we, in and go) was done through flashcards.

# MATHS

Introduction of numbers from 80-90 was done through flashcards. Children wrote 0 to 90 in their notebooks. Children did various worksheets based on after/before and greater than, less than numbers.



# GENERAL AWARENESS

It is important to know about the food we eat. Children of Kindergarten were taught about why food is important for our health. Discussion about healthy food was done in class and the children enjoyed colouring worksheets related to the topic.



# EVS

Students of kindergarten were introduced to wild animals . Discussion about who are wild animals and where do they live were done in class. They also learnt about the Lion and its habitat through picture flash cards. Children liked colouring worksheets related to the topic.



# MUSIC (NUR & KG)

Music improves social skills, and benefits children of all ages. Students of Nursery enjoyed practicing “Jara itna Batade kahna” during music class. Students of KG enjoyed doing practice of ‘watan ke hain Diwane ‘during class.



# YOGA (NUR & KG)

Yoga is a combination of exercise and meditation. It helps us to stay physically and mentally fit. With regular practice it strengthens our mind and body. This week the students of Nursery practiced Surya Namaskar during their yoga class, whereas students of Kindergarten practiced postures related to Surya Namaskar, Vrikshasana and learnt sitting asana Padmasana, Vajrasana.



# SCIENCE DEMO

Children explore and investigate and develop an awareness of things happening around them. As part of a science demonstration, this week the children were given relevant information about Air through an object (balloon). They were taught that air is all around us, it is very important for our living.





Poetry shows us and our kids that love, life and emotions can be expressed in so many different ways. It gives them a new way to create and imagine. We started our month with the introduction of the poem of the month during English class. Students recited the poem with action, correct pronunciation and voice modulation.

During the week, students of class 1 revised the lesson Neighbourhood. The chapter was practiced by thorough discussion along with some notebook work and recapitulation task.

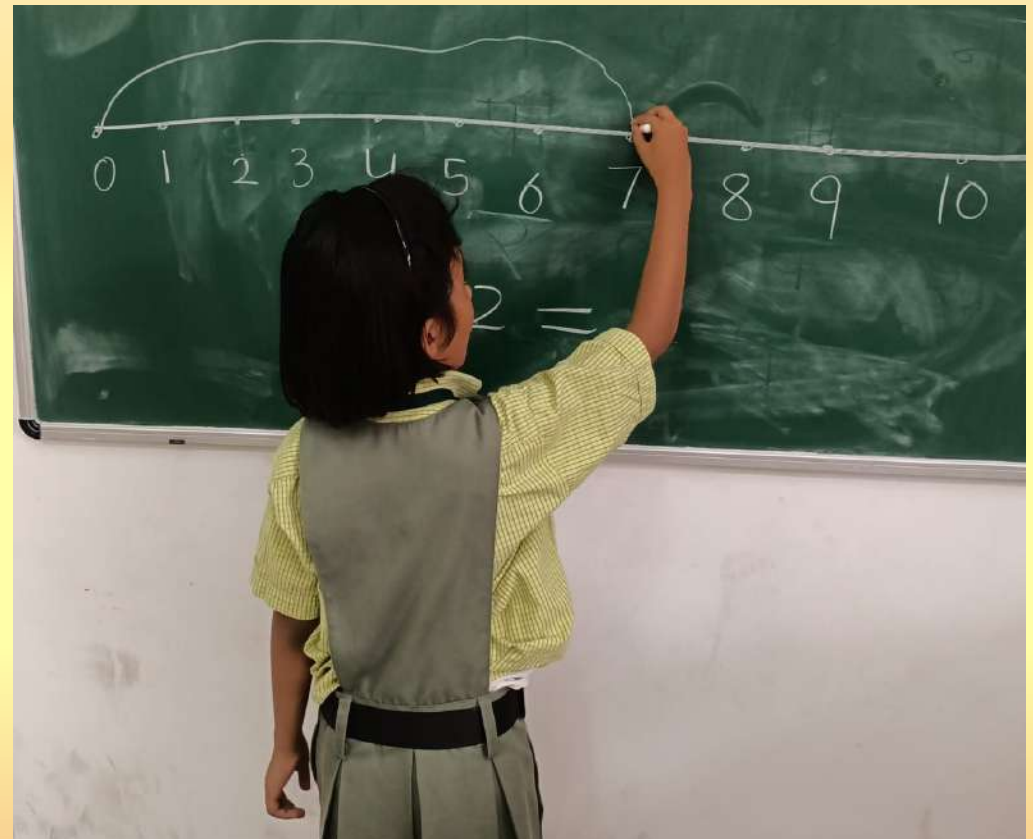




# Math

A number line is a visual representation of numbers on a straight line where the value of the numbers increases as we move from left to right. Children of class 1 learnt addition on the number line. Worksheets were given for better recapitulation.

Calculating exchange rates for spending money on holiday. Students of class 2 were introduced to the chapter: Multiplication, where they understood that multiplication is repeated addition. They also revised addition with carryover and recited tables from 2 to 7.
