NURSERY



ENGLISH

MATHS

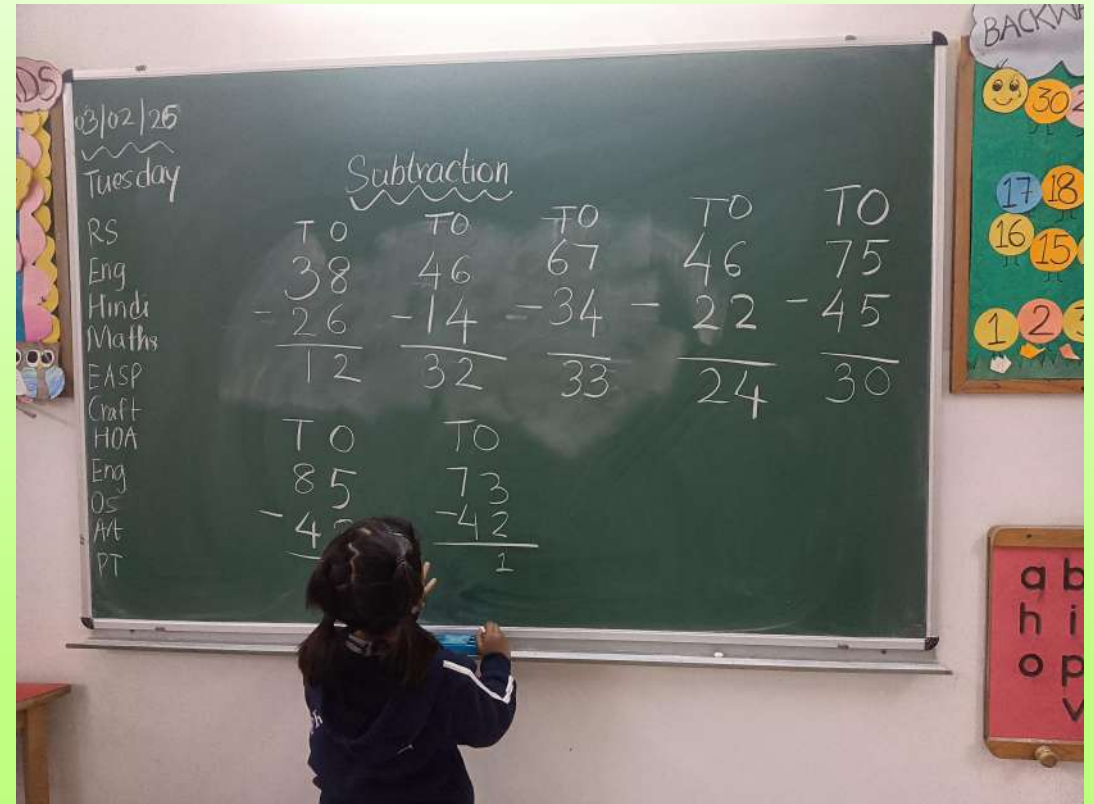
ENGLISH

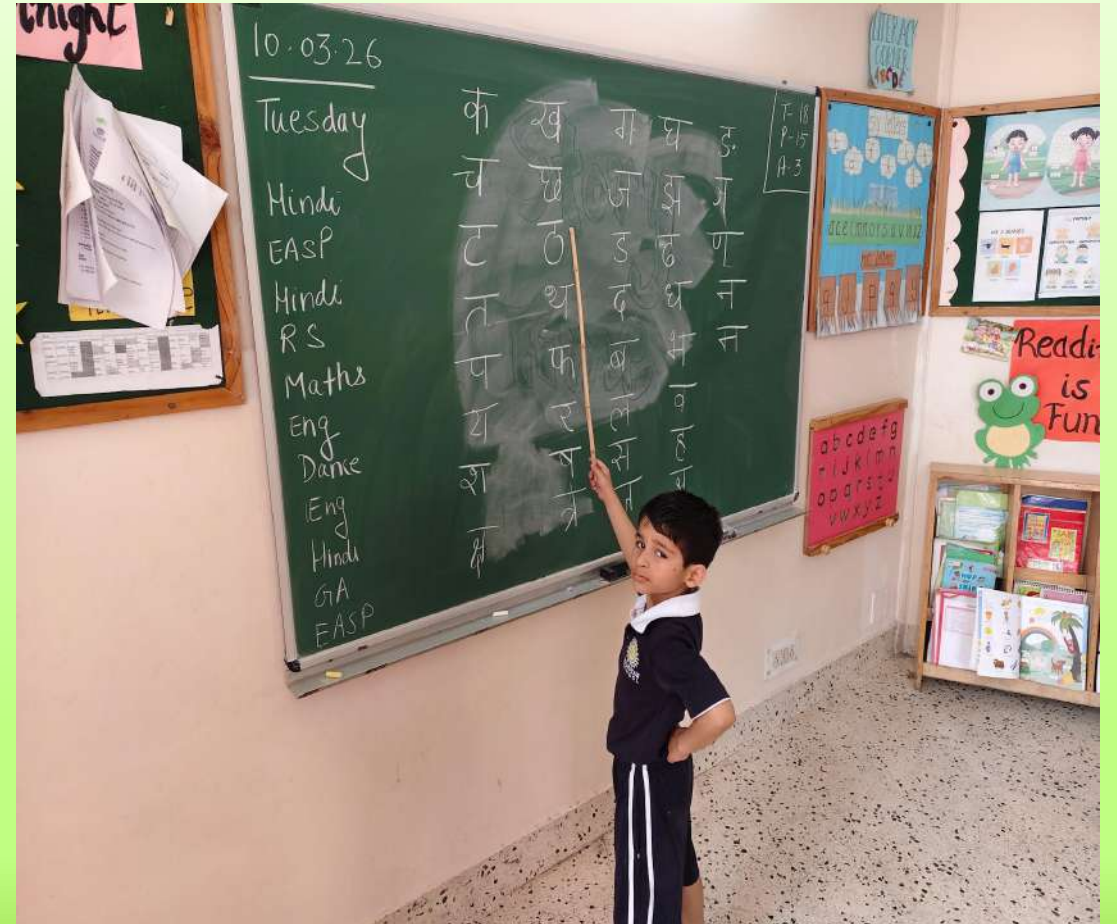
MATHS

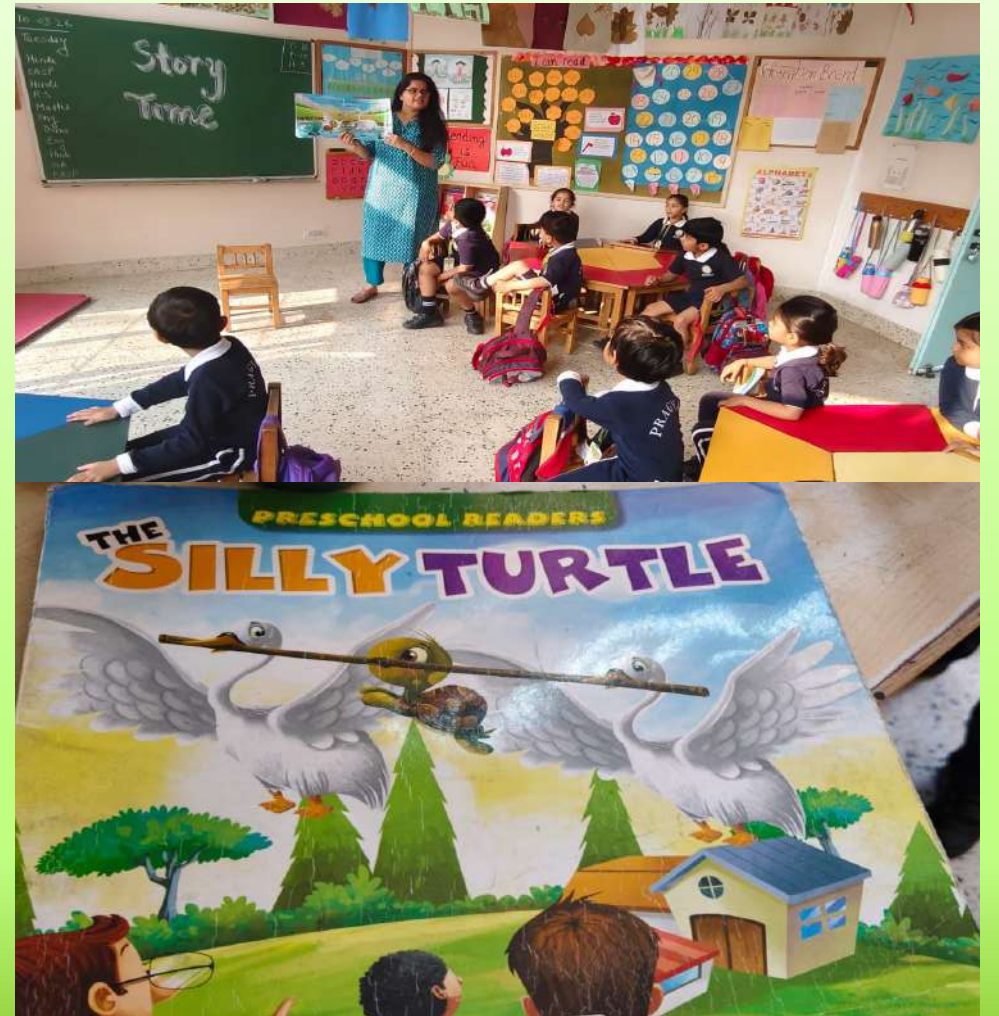
GREEN DAY

ANNUAL PRIZE DISTRIBUTION AND GRADUATION CEREMONY





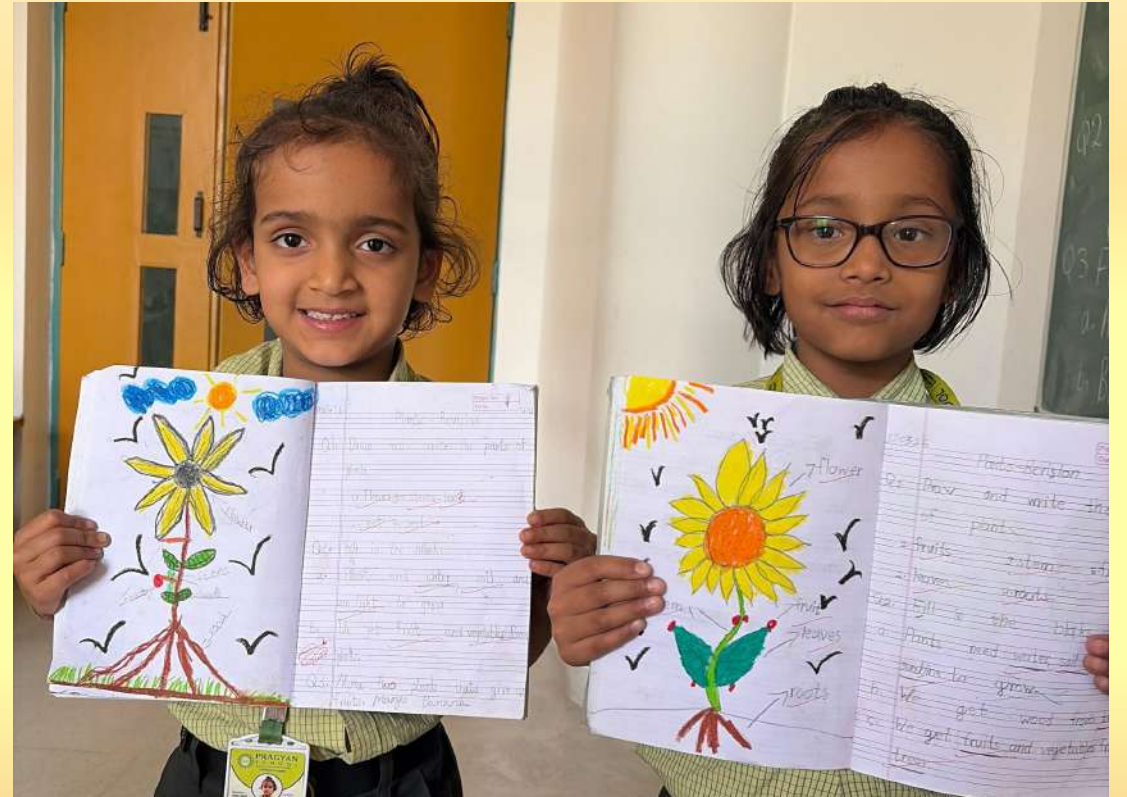

ENVIRONMENTAL SCIENCE

The children also revised the types of plants and their basic parts. Discussions, worksheets, and notebook work were conducted to reinforce the concepts. 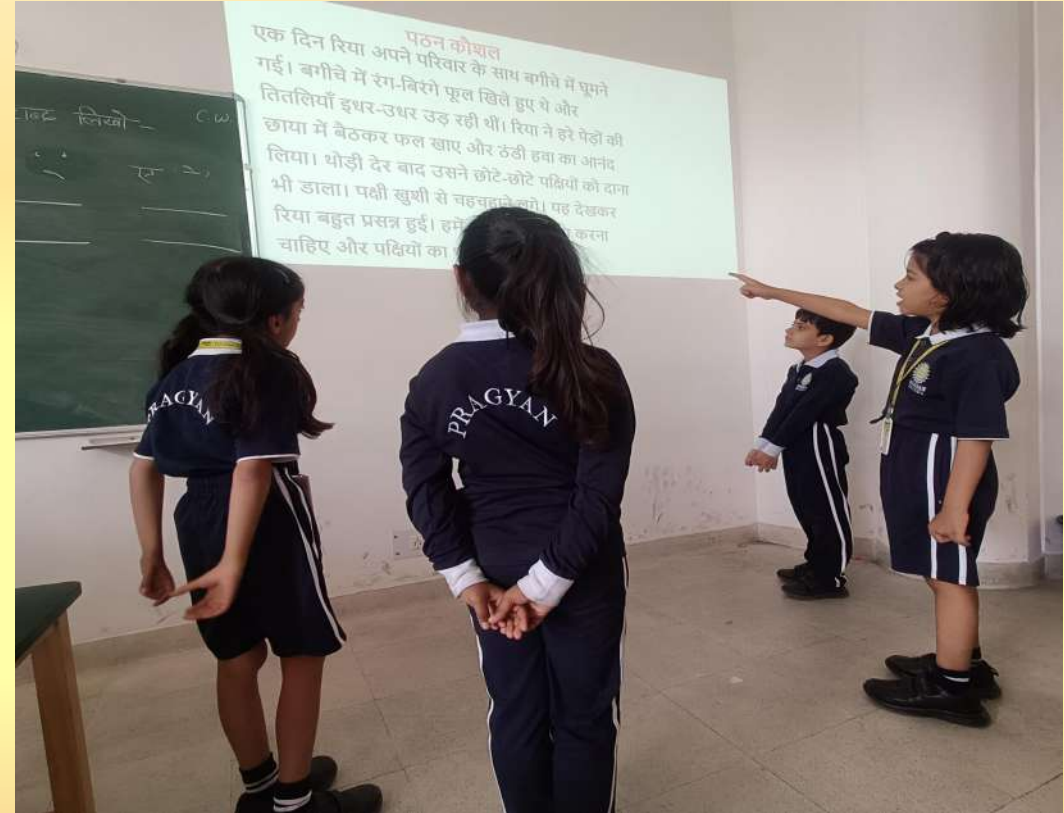

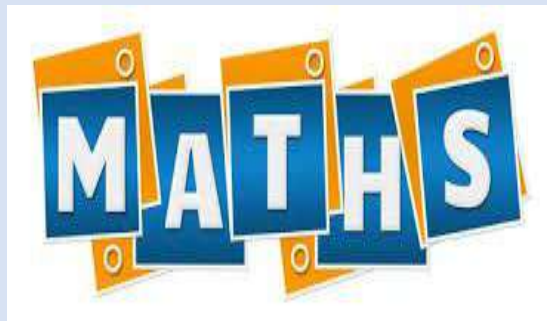

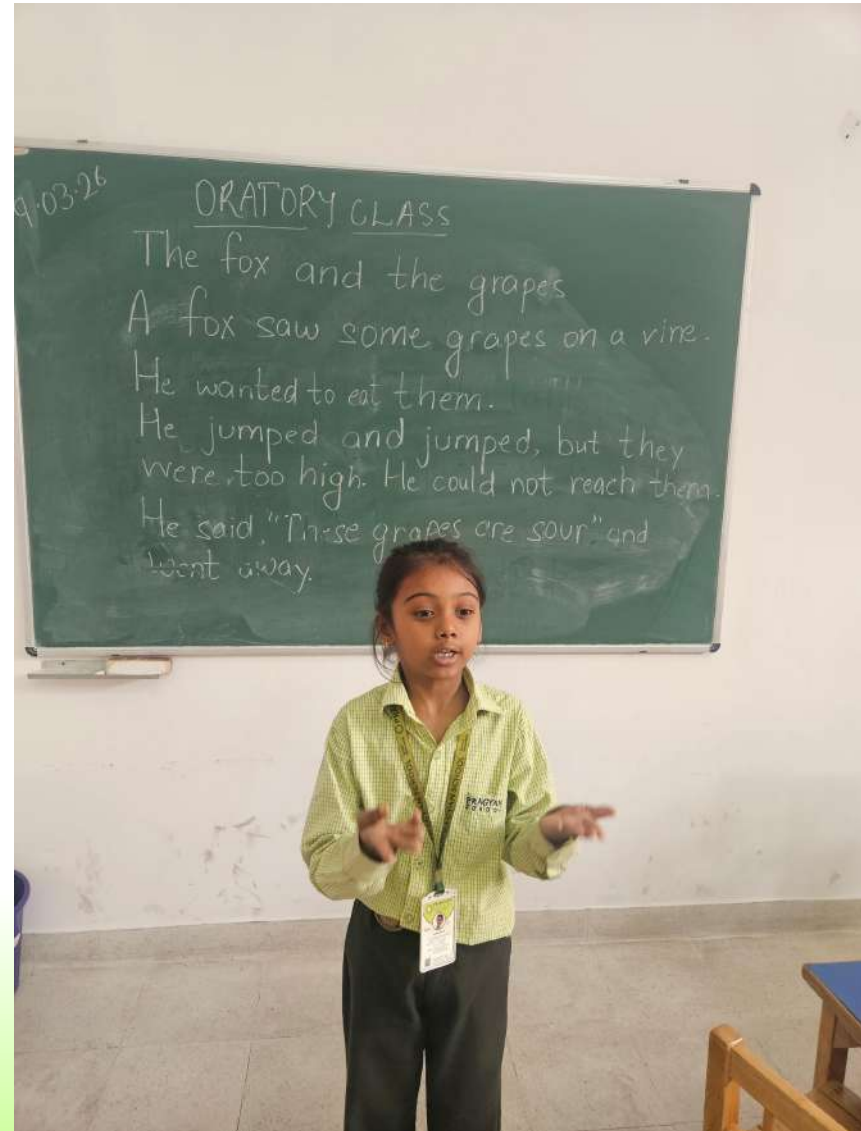
DANCE

Dance is the poetry of movement. The students of Class 1 learned various facial expressions such as anger, surprise, happiness, and sadness. Through this activity, they explored how emotions can be beautifully expressed through dance and gestures. The session helped them build confidence, creativity, and better body coordination while enjoying the rhythm of movement.



ORATORY (CLASS 1)

During the Oratory Class, the students were introduced to the story “The Fox and the Grapes.” The teacher narrated the story with proper expressions and encouraged the children to listen carefully and understand its message. The students were then guided to speak a few lines from the story, helping them build confidence and improve their speaking skills. They enjoyed repeating the lines with enthusiasm and learned the moral of the story that it is easy to dislike what we cannot get. The activity was engaging and helped the children express themselves better in front of their classmates.



PHYSICAL EDUCATION (1 & 2)

Children of Classes 1 and 2 enjoyed their Games period with great enthusiasm. They began with warm-up and stretching exercises to prepare their bodies for the activity. The children then played basketball as a recreational game, where they happily ran, passed the ball, and played together. The session helped them stay active, refreshed, and encouraged teamwork and coordination.



LIBRARY (1 & 2)

Reading helps broaden a child's perspective and guides them in the right direction. Students of class 2 visit the library to read books, they discover new words and phrases while immersing themselves in stories, characters, and a variety of emotions. Reading also nurtures critical thinking skills, helping students understand and retain information more effectively rather than simply memorizing facts.



STRETCHING SESSION



During the Yoga and Stretching session, the students practiced a few simple yoga poses along with basic stretching exercises under the teacher's guidance. They were encouraged to maintain correct posture and focus on their breathing while performing the movements. The children participated actively and enjoyed the session with great enthusiasm. The activity helped them feel relaxed, flexible, and energized.

CLASS ASSEMBLY (2E)

Class 2E conducted the morning assembly on the theme of environmental awareness. The assembly began with informative thoughts on the importance of protecting our environment. Class 3 students practiced important grammatical concepts such as tenses and synonyms to strengthen their understanding of the English language.





Students of grade 3 revised and practiced the concept of missing digits. It helped them to apply addition and subtraction together enhancing their logical thinking. They did worksheets related to the concept.





ENVIRONMENTAL SCIENCE

They also conducted an absorption test to understand how different fabrics absorb water. 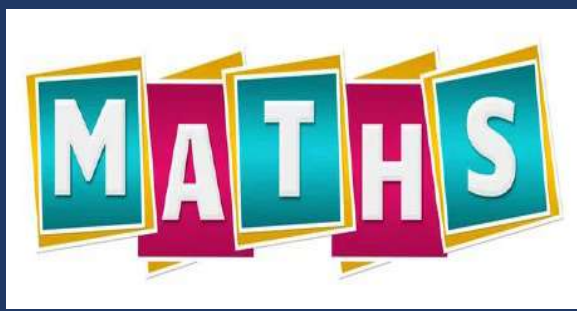




हिन्दी
