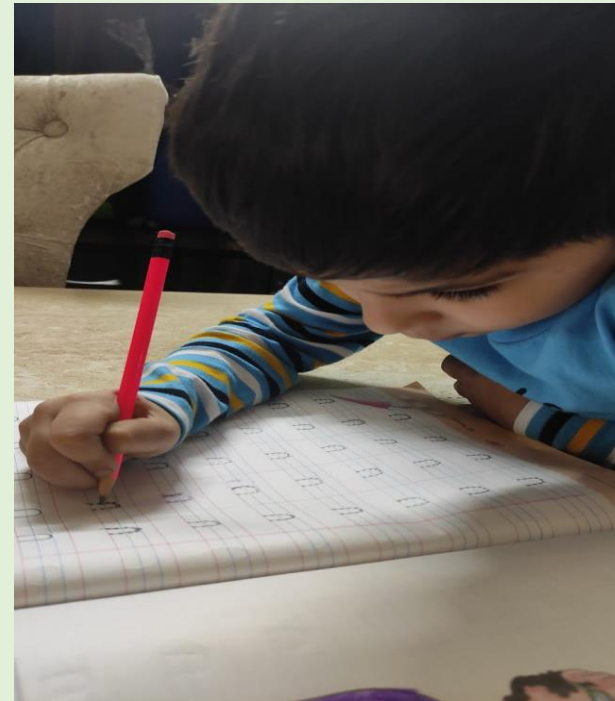

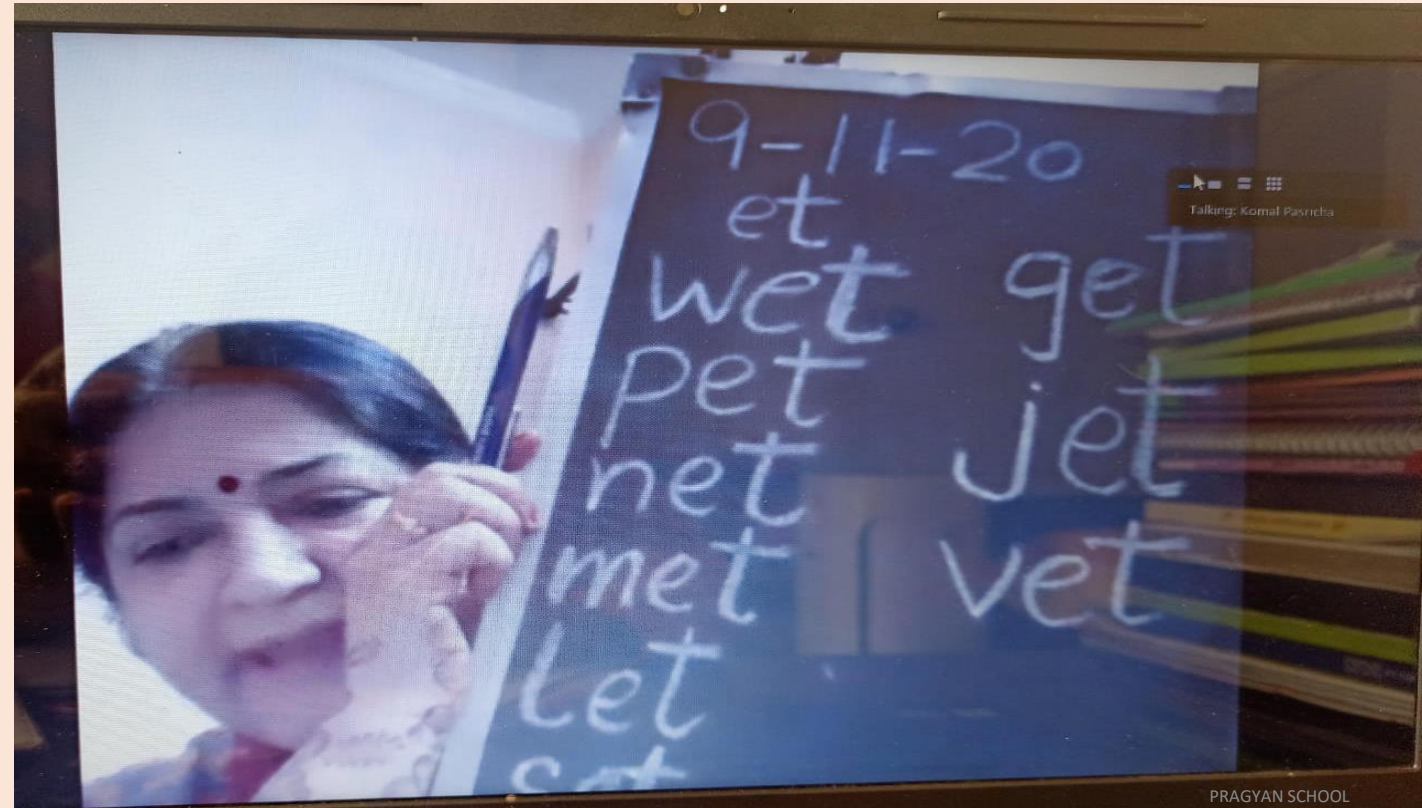


KINDERGARTEN



English - Students were taught "et" family words in English class. They practiced writing words in their notebook. Written practice from a-z was done.

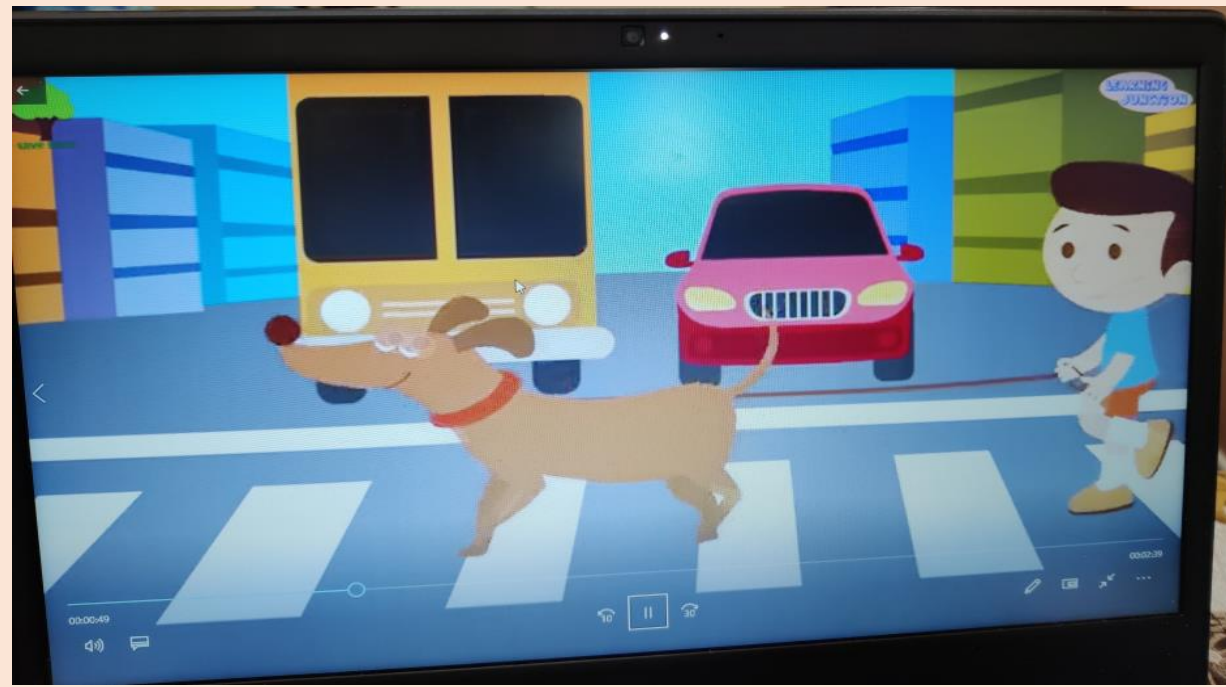
Reading Scheme - Reading practice of 'The bug' page was done.

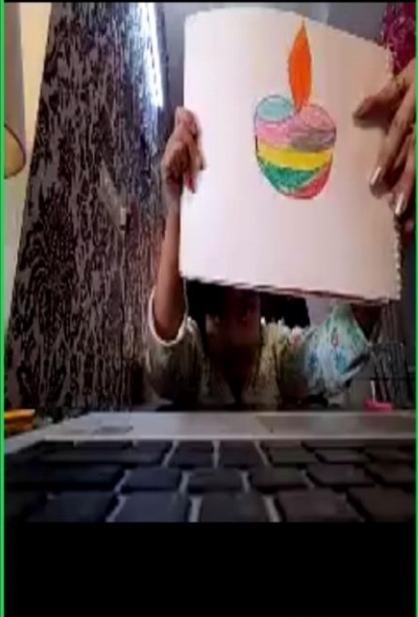

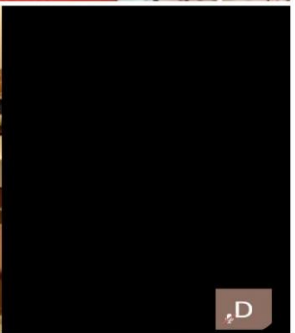
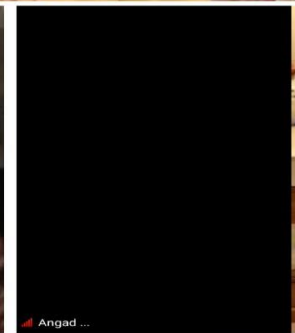

Diwali Special Assembly

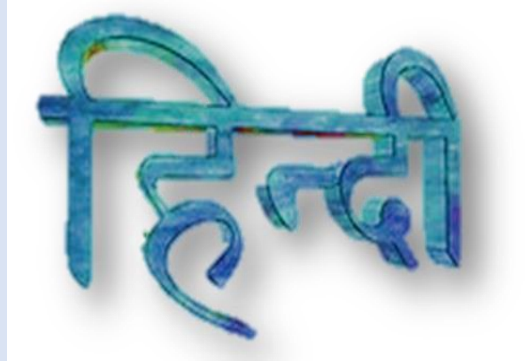

The concept of Verbs was introduced too. They continued with the reader '**Gulliver's Stories**'.

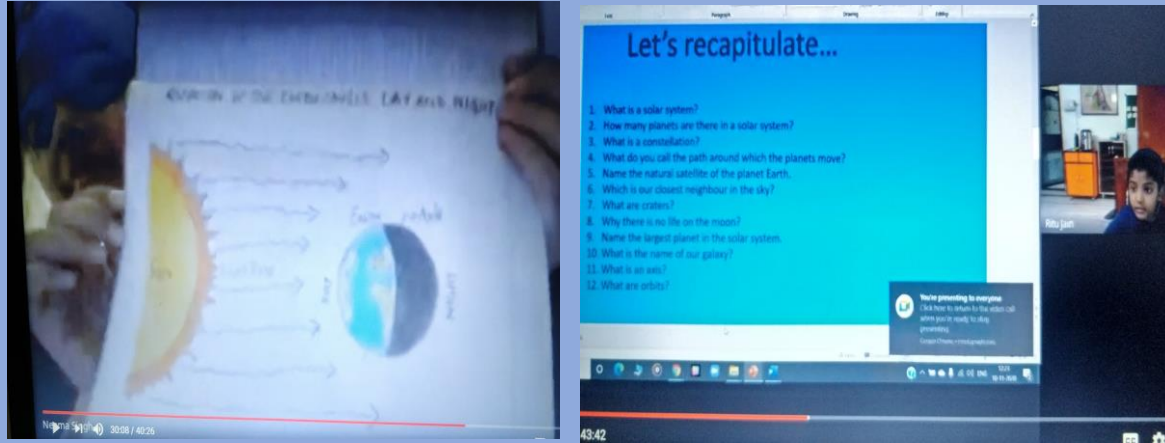

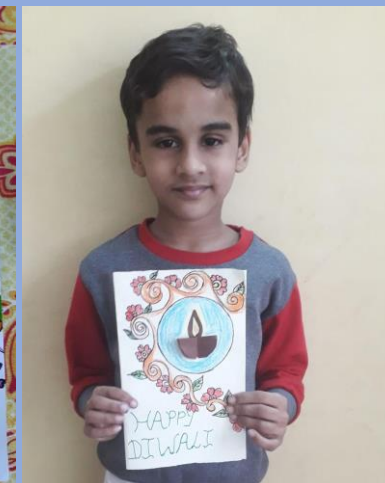

Students of **classes 3A** and **3D** learnt to make greeting cards for Diwali. They made beautiful greeting cards and enjoyed making **3-D diya** on it.

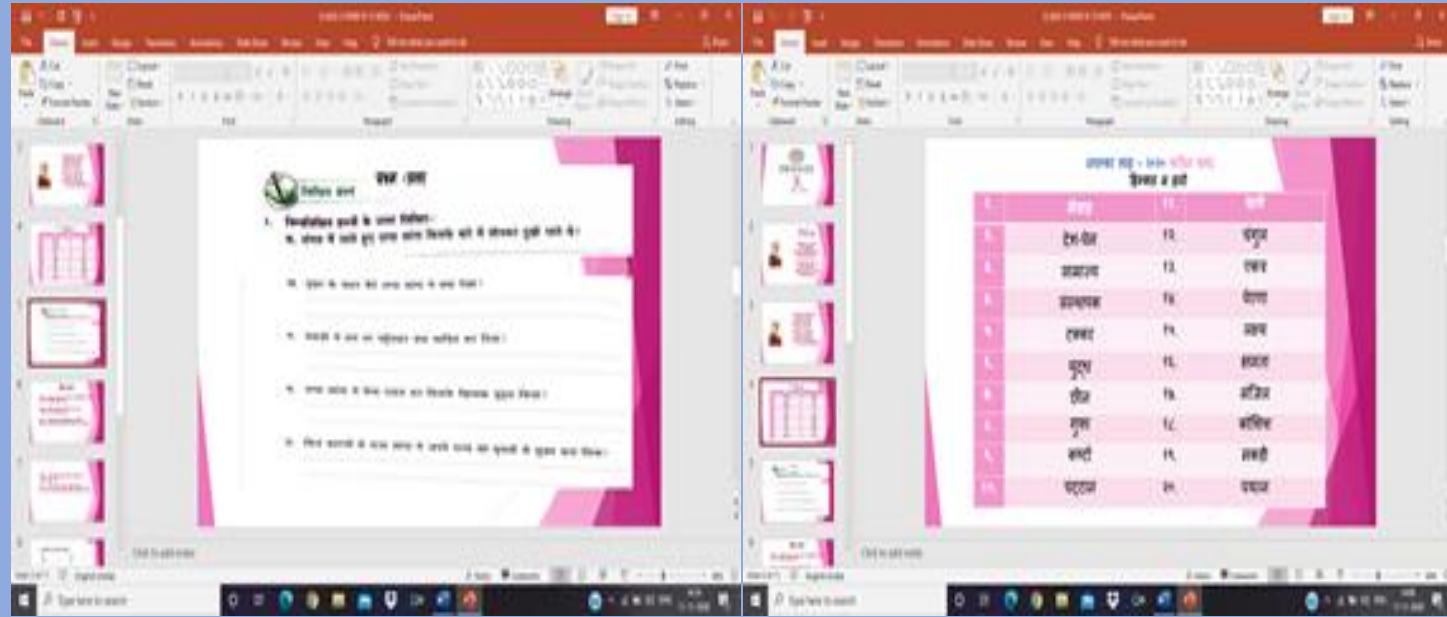

The cow *is* blue.

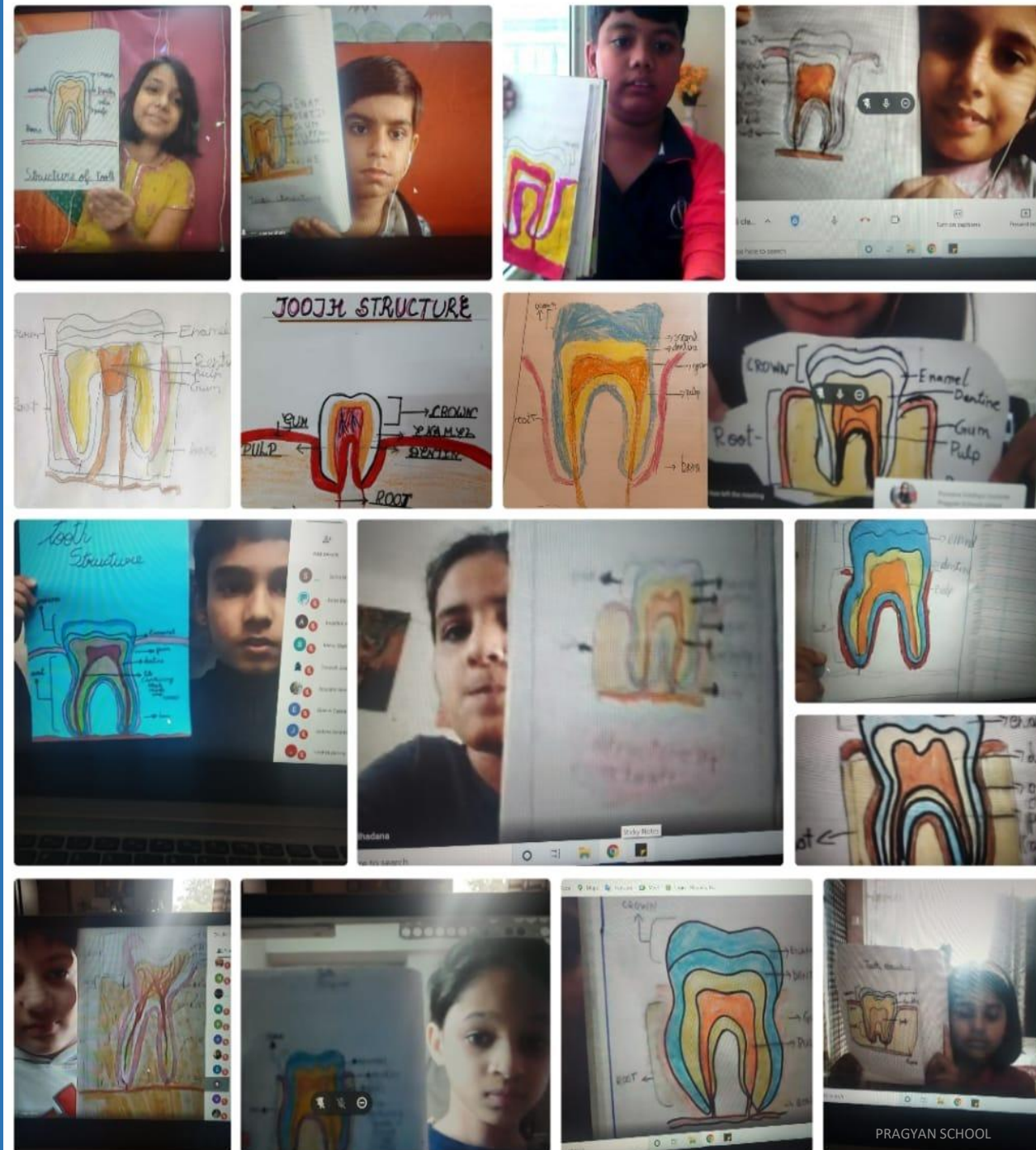

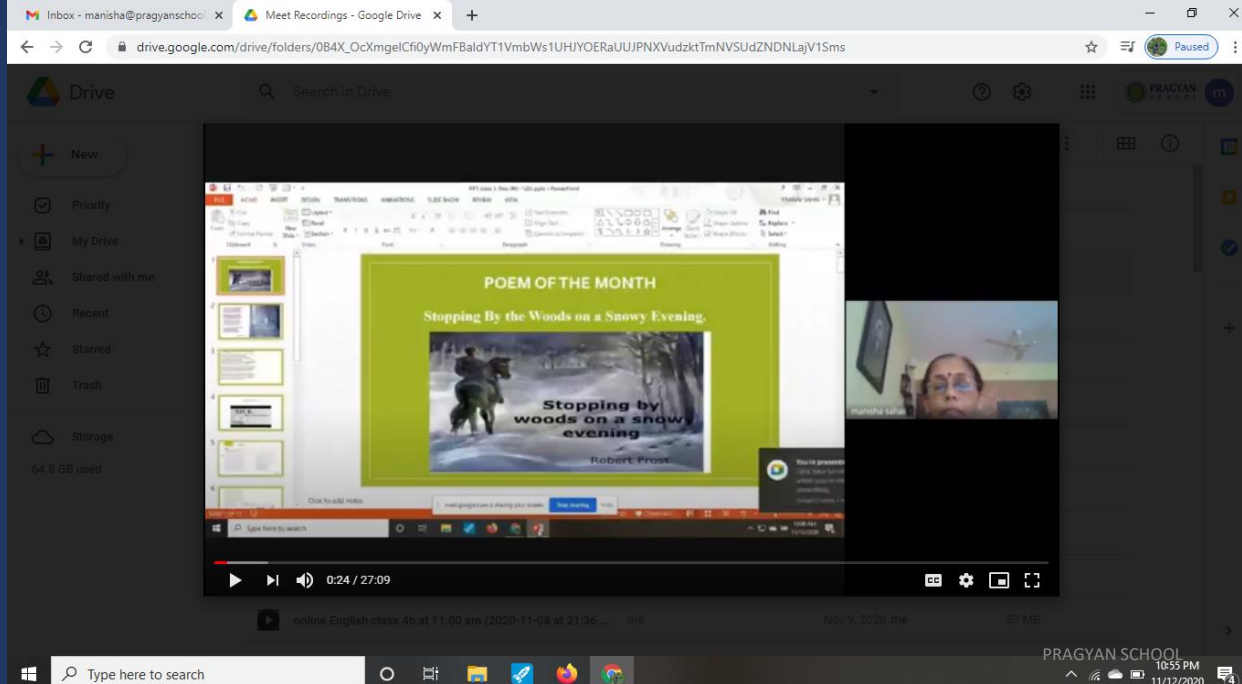
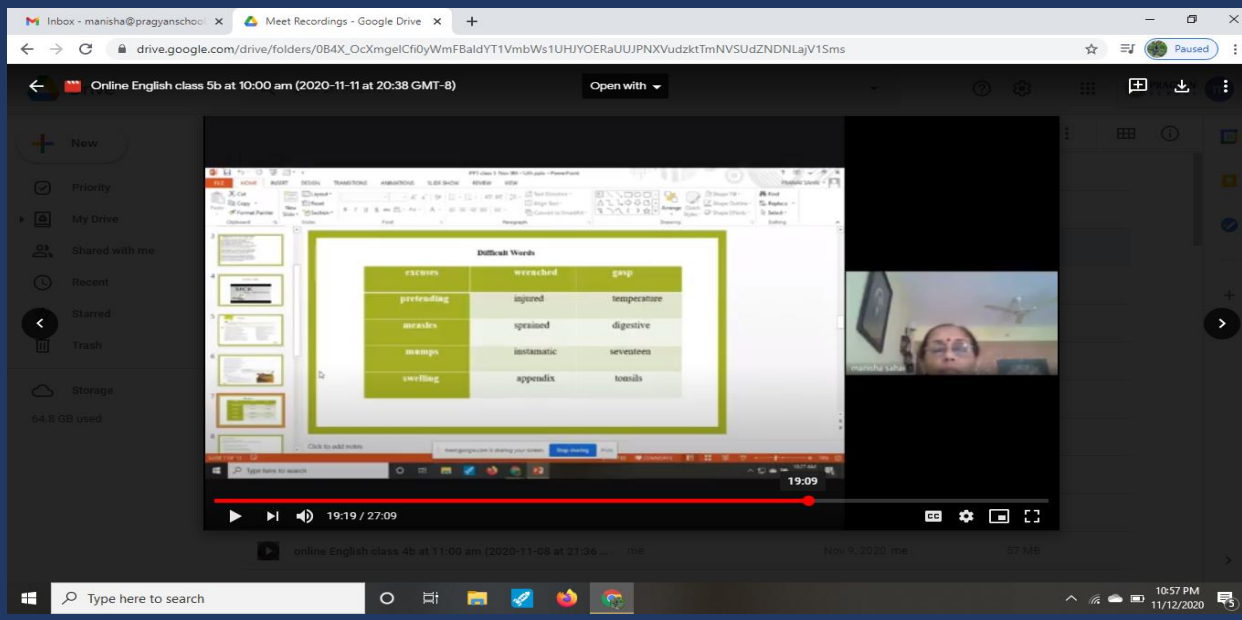
