



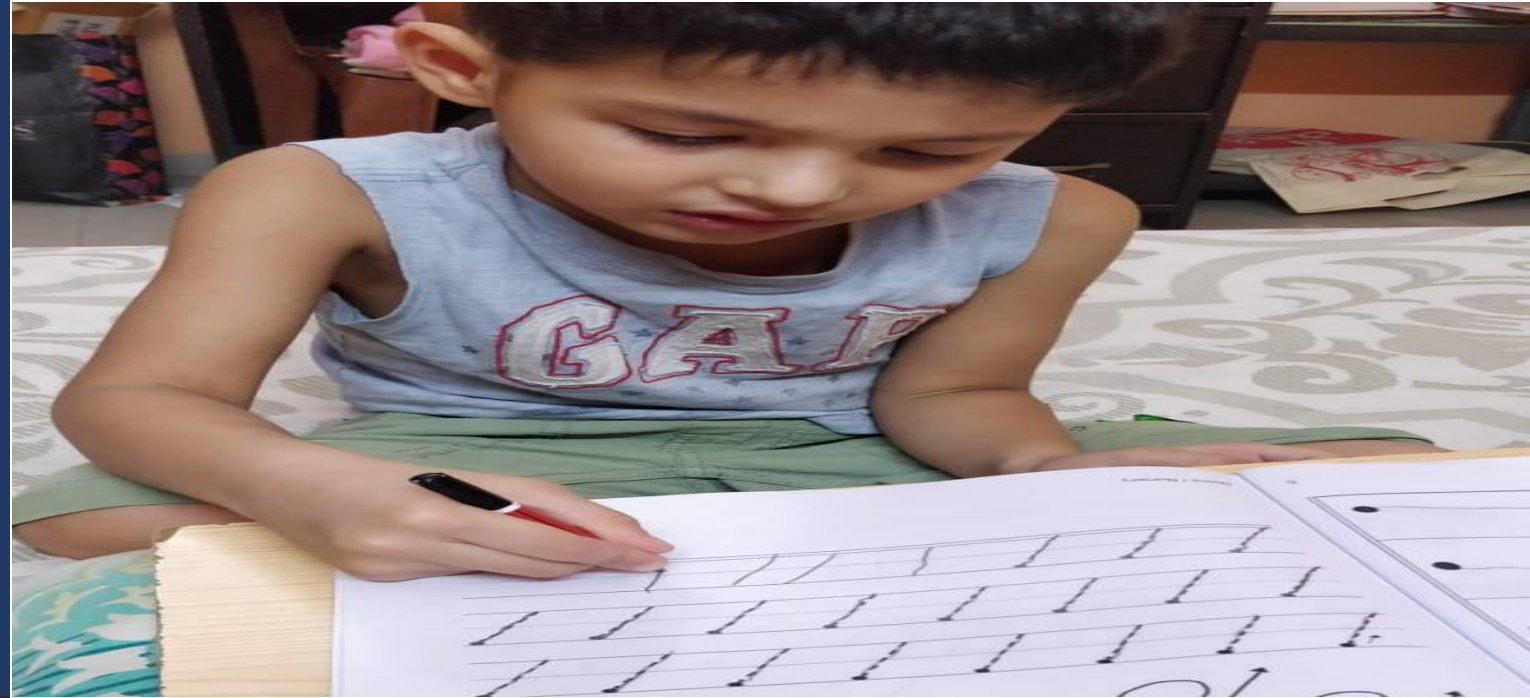

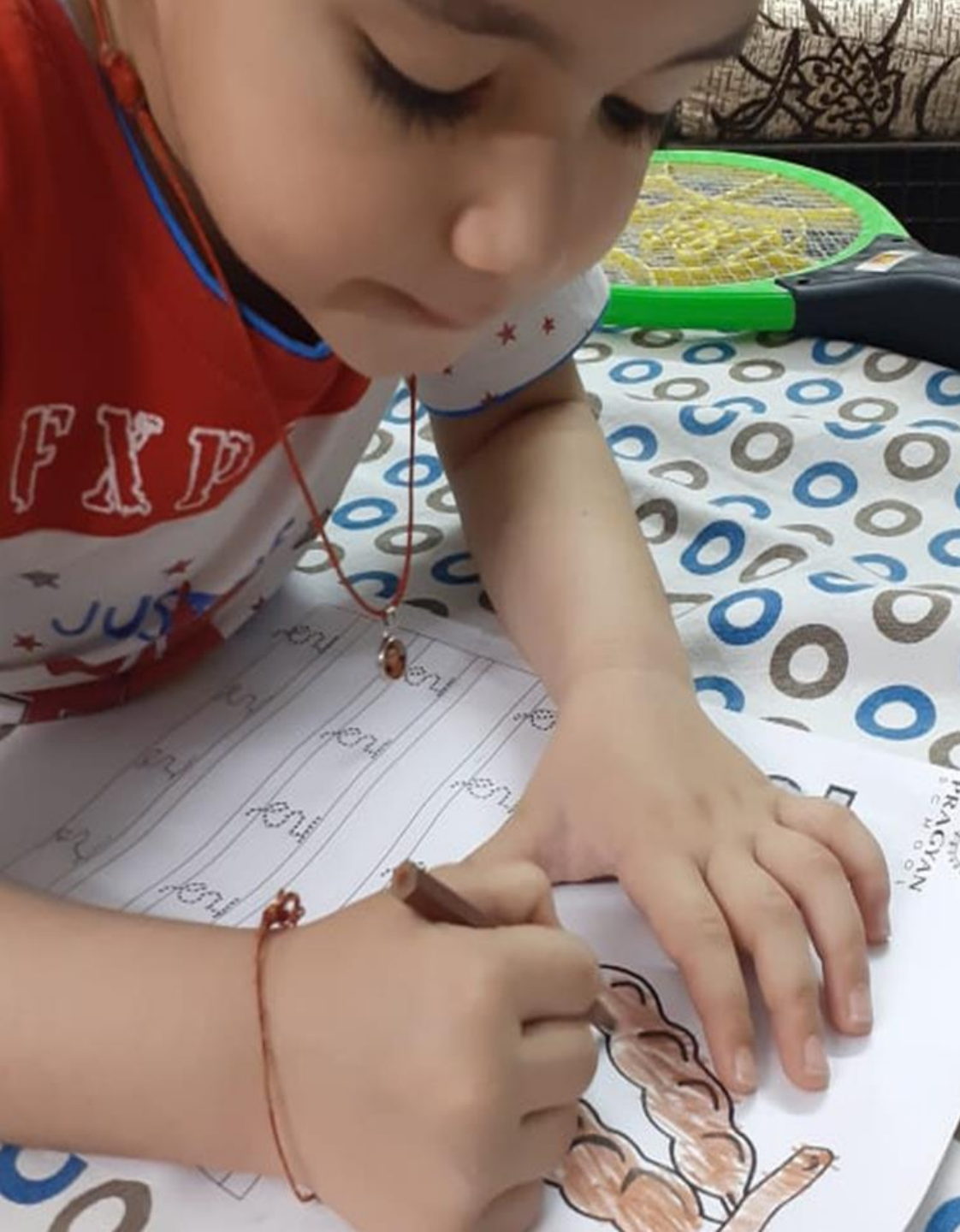

- Music- ‘Walking in the light of lord’ poem was introduced through the audio-visual session.



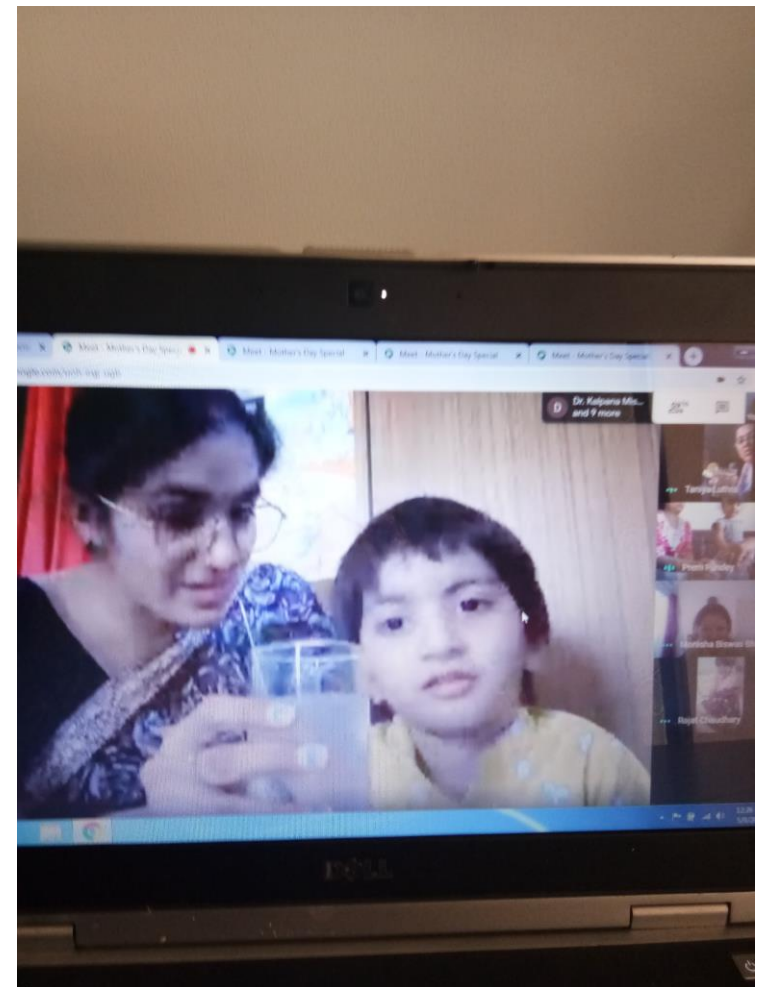
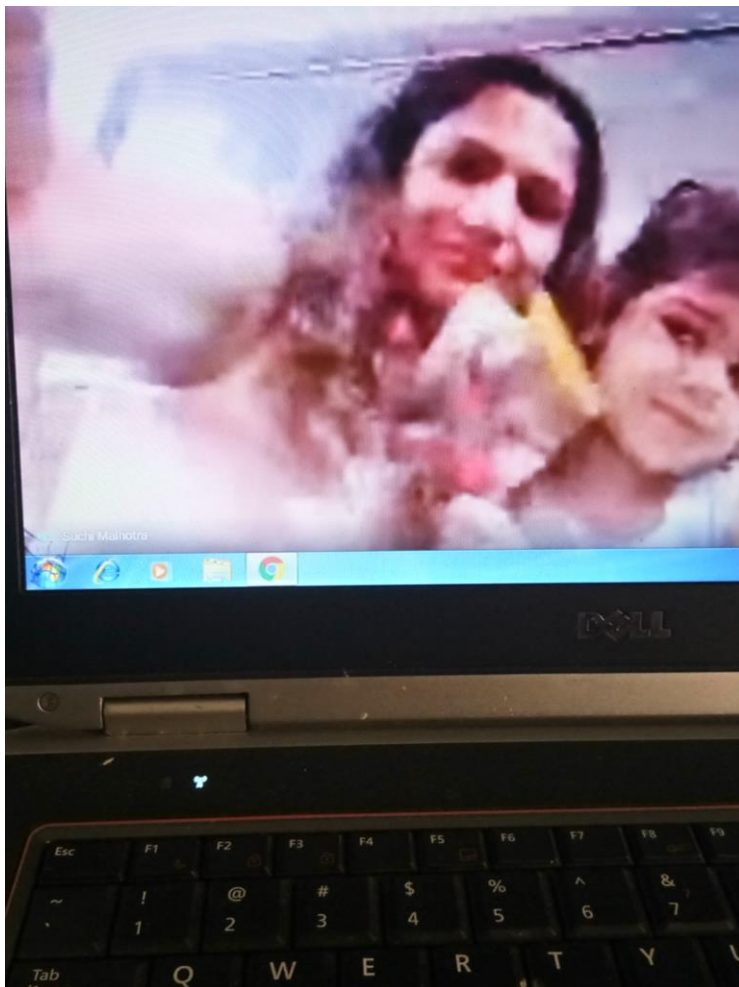
Kindergarten

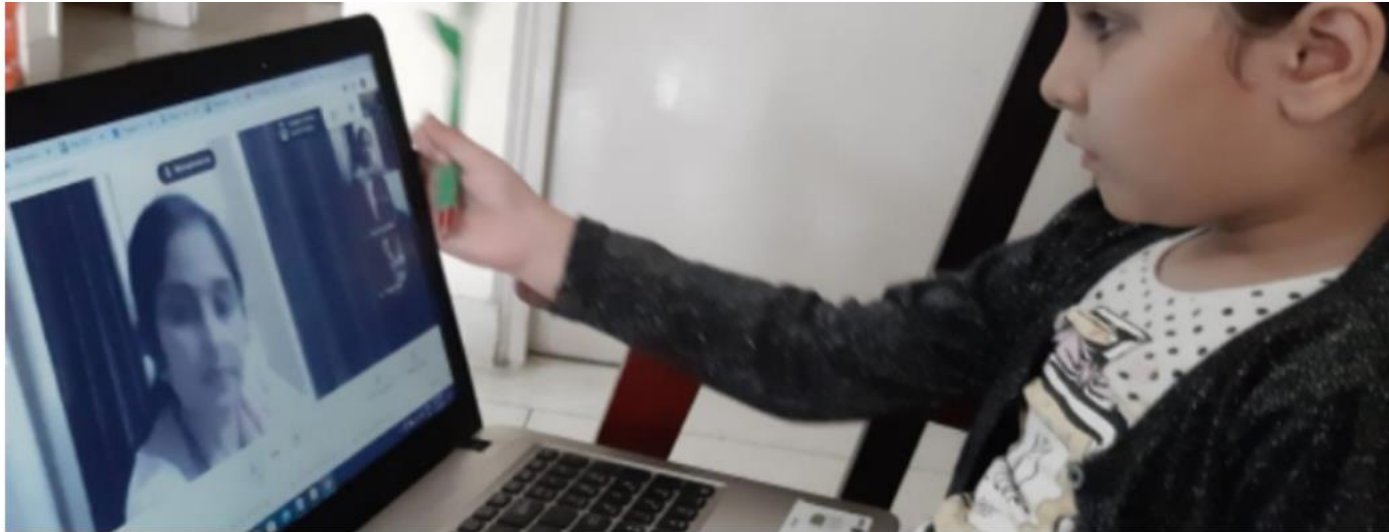
Class I

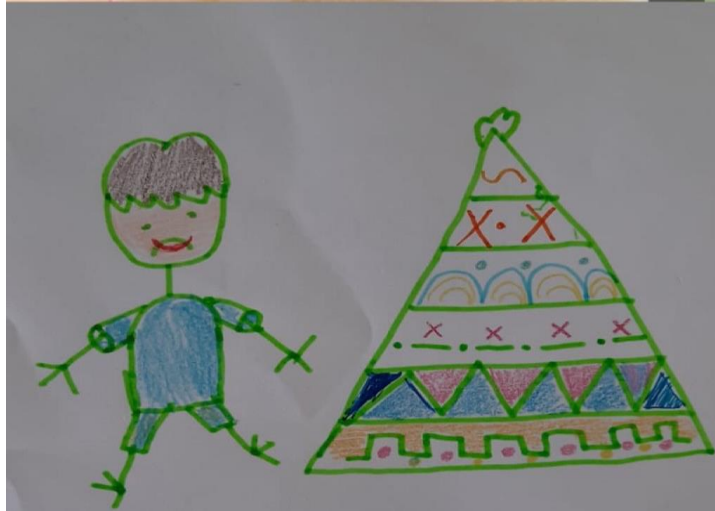
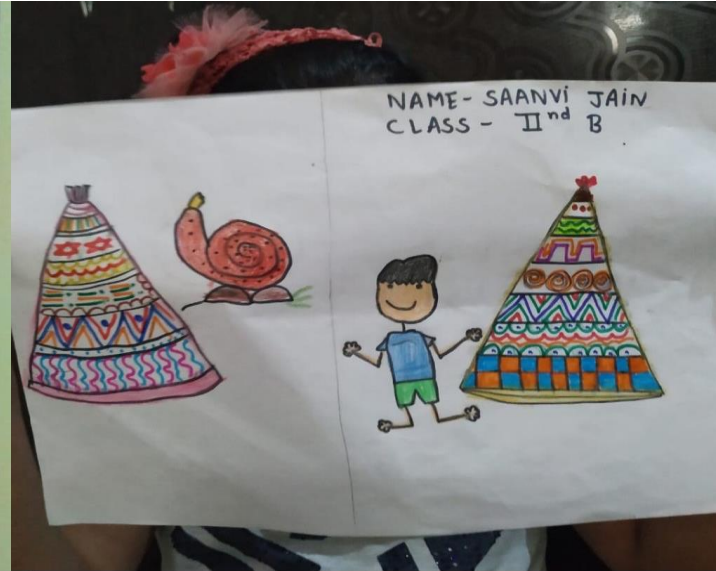
Class I

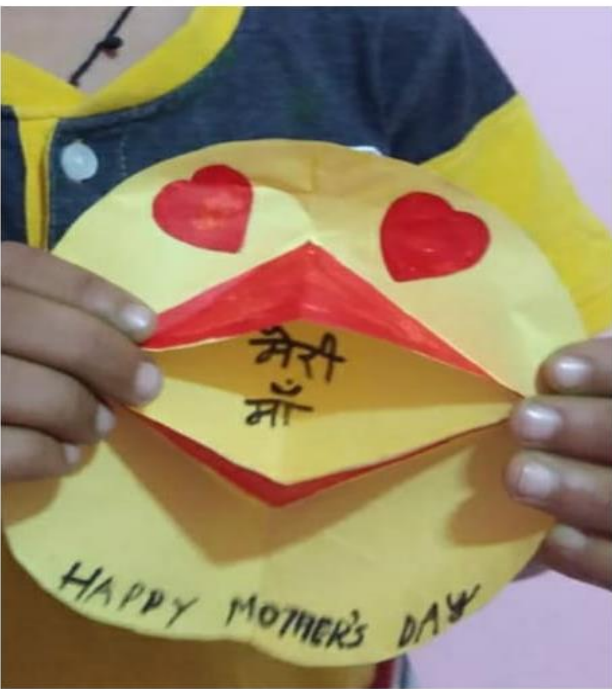
Class II

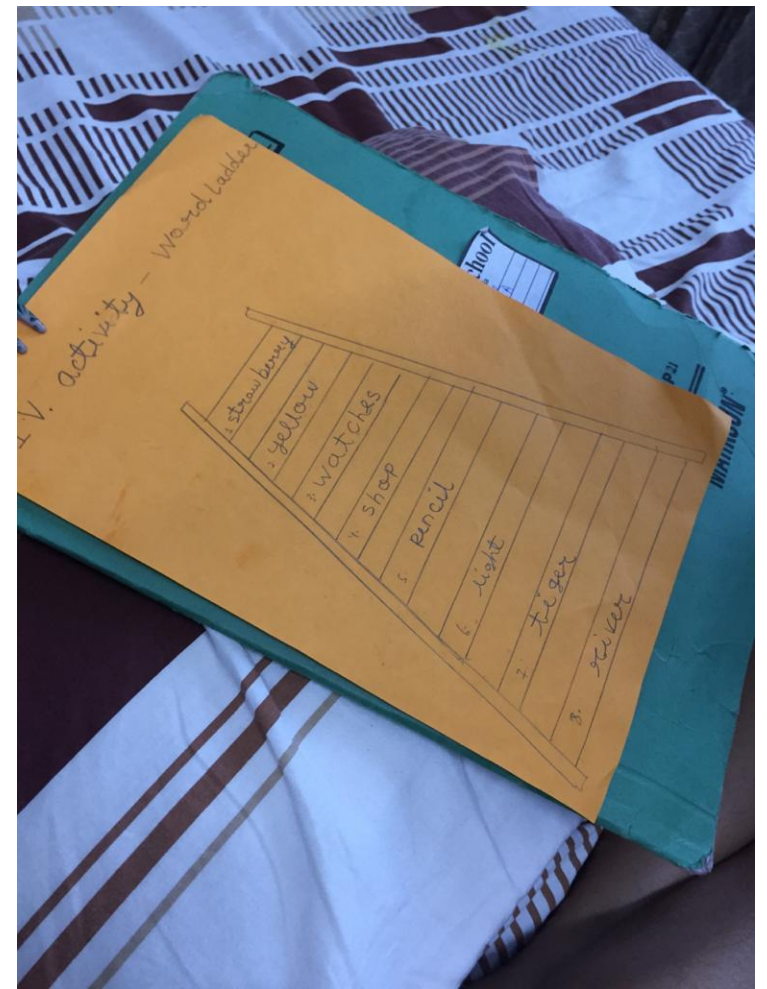
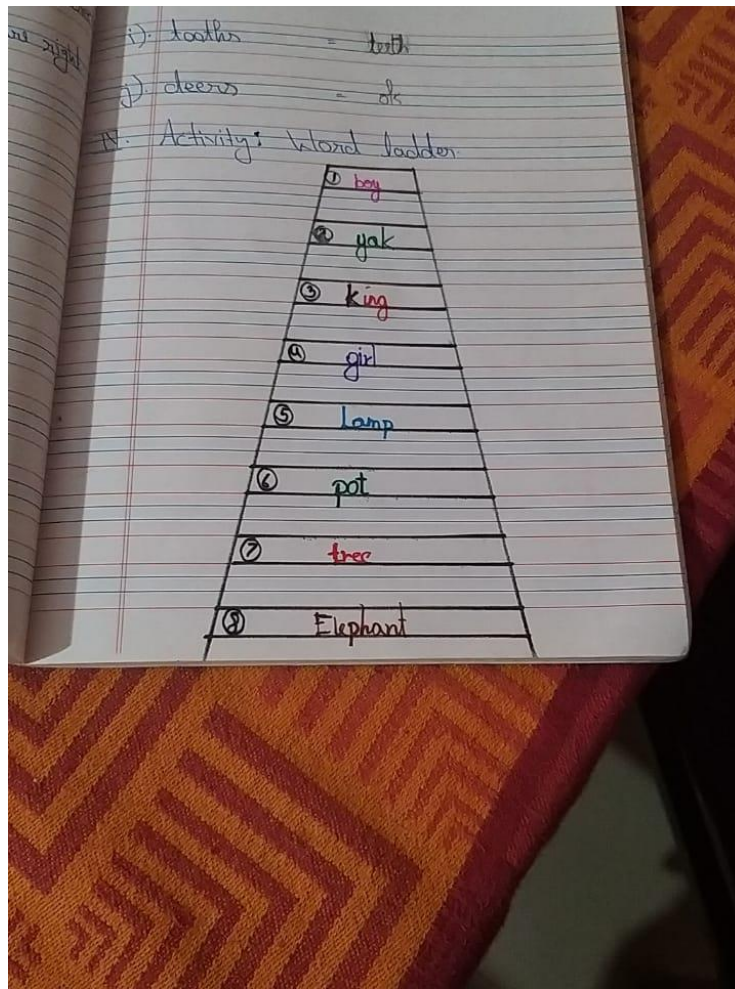
Class III

Classes III to V

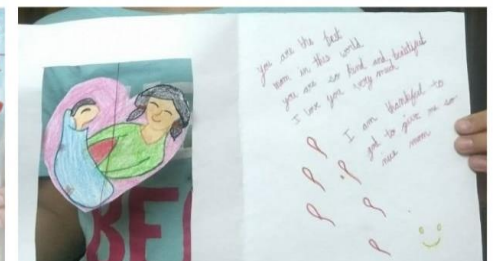

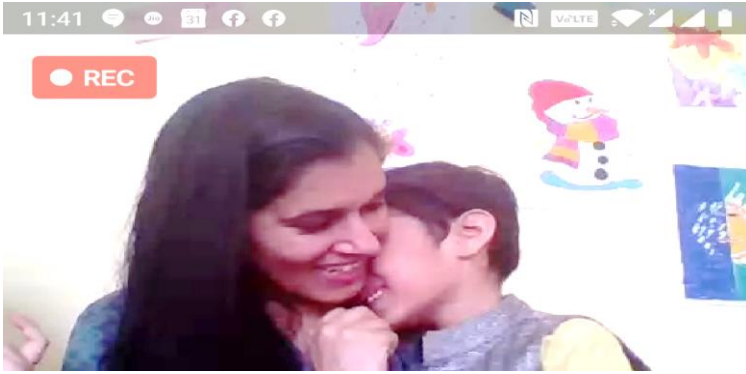

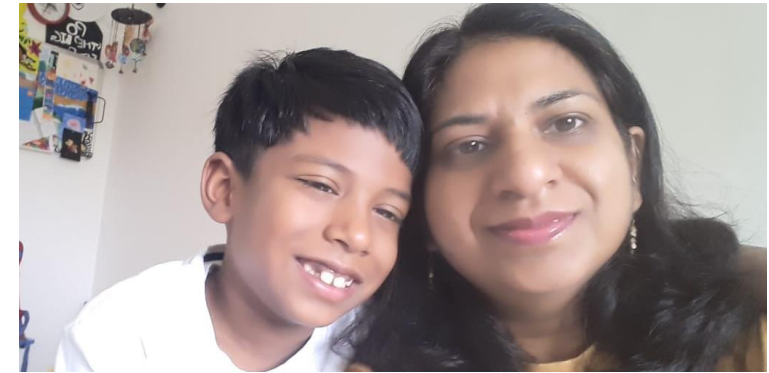
Students of classes 3 to 5 created lovely Spinning cards for their mother's on the occasion of Mother's Day. They learnt to make this card through a video which was sent to them.

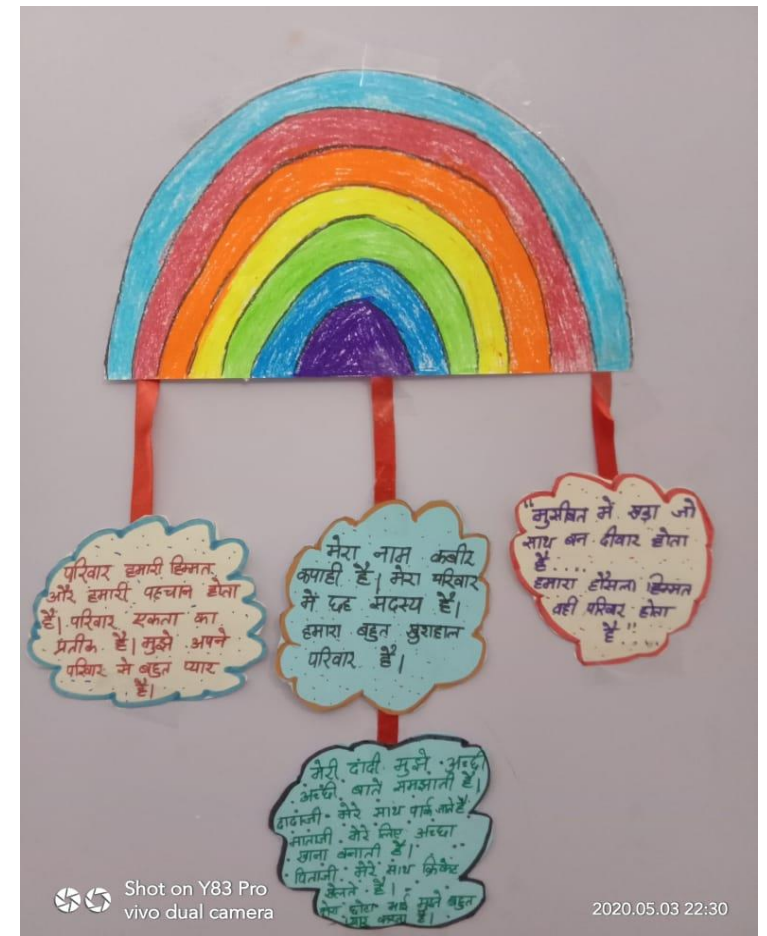
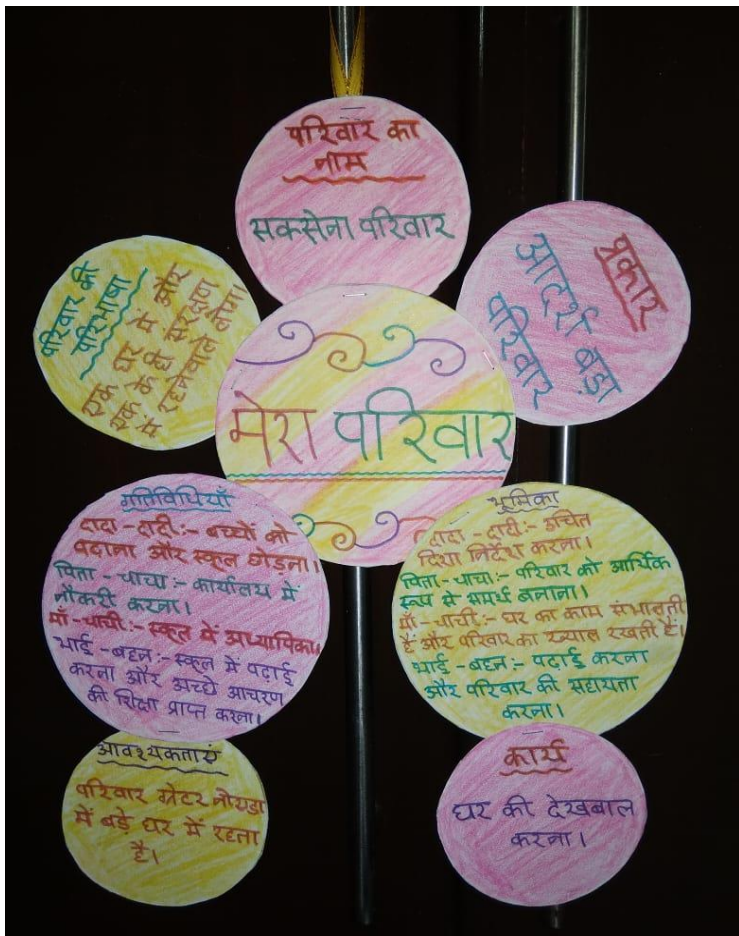




Classes III to V

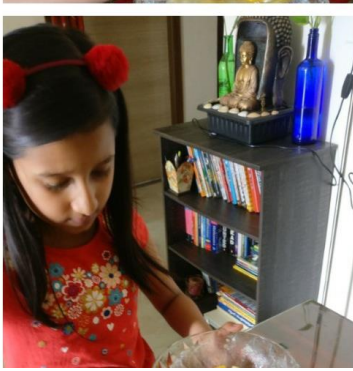
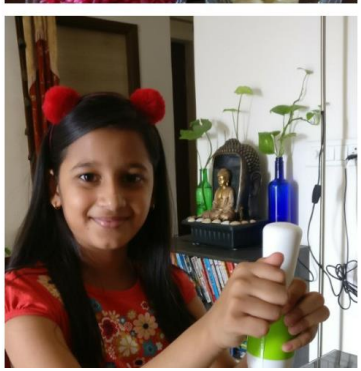




Class V
