NURSERY

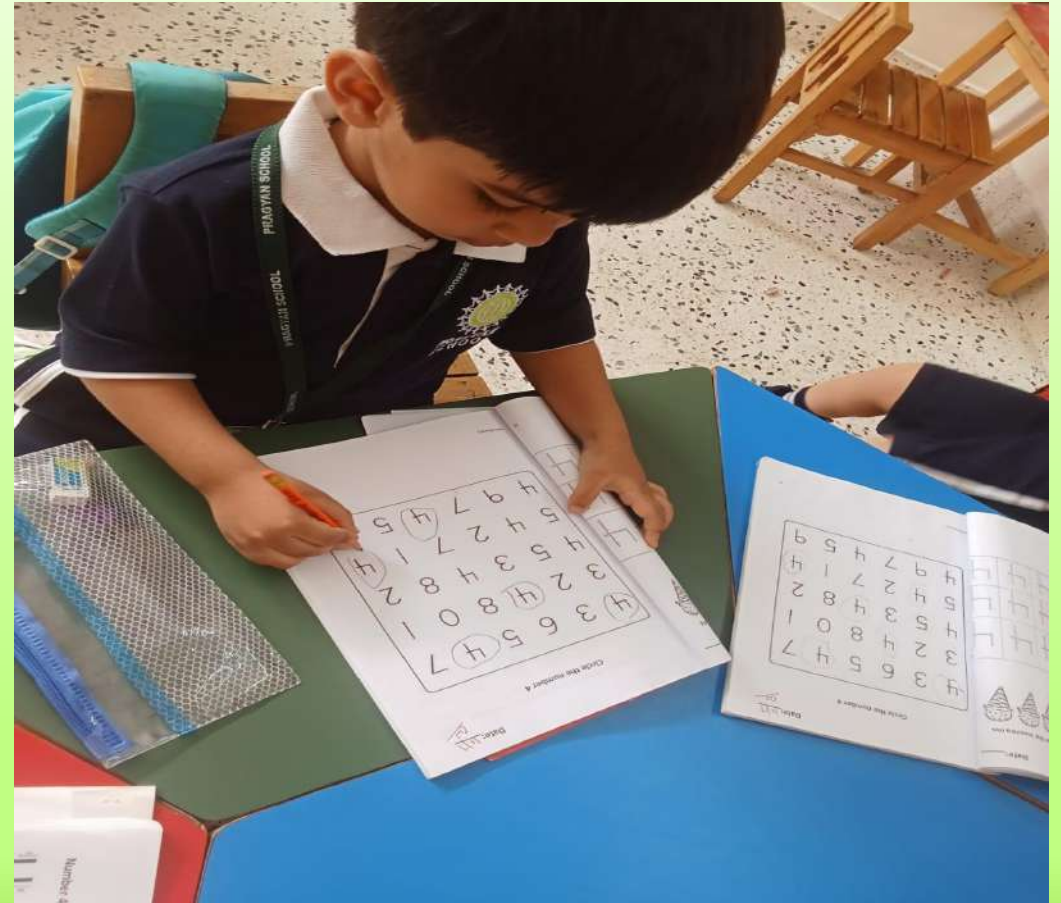


ENGLISH

Letter E was introduced to the children with the help of flashcards. Jolly phonics song of letter E was also done with the children. Students did worksheets related to the topic in their workbook.

MATHS

This week Number 4 was introduced to the nursery children using different objects and they did worksheet related to the number. They also enjoyed counting numbers orally from 1 to 15.



HINDI

Vyanjan 'घ' was introduced to the students with the help of pictures. They also enjoyed colouring 'घ' related objects in their Hindi letter book.



GENERAL AWARENESS

As part of awareness on Healthy and Unhealthy food, students were informed about different fruits and vegetables. They also enjoyed colouring the worksheets related to the topic.



CIRCLE TIME

Students of Nursery were engaged in a lively circle time discussion on fruits and vegetables. Children shared their favorite fruits and veggies, learning about different colours, shapes, and fostering a love for healthy eating and social interaction.



SCIENCE DEMONSTRATION (NURSERY)

Students of Nursery were exposed to the concept of float and sink, building on their nature walk collections. Students eagerly watched as leaves, stones, pebbles, and feathers were placed in water. They observed, predicted, and learned how objects respond to water, connecting their outdoor discoveries to scientific concepts in a fun and interactive way.



KINDERGARTEN



ENGLISH

Revision of sight words and letters 'i and l' was done during the week. Letter 't' was introduced among the children with the help of flashcards. Students did worksheets related to the topic in their workbook.

MATHS

During this week students learned about backward counting and did related worksheets in their workbook.



HINDI

Vyanjan 'ब' was introduced with the help of flash cards and students did the worksheet related to the vyanjan in their notebook.



HANDS ON ACTIVITY (KG)

During this week students learned about healthy and junk food. The students eagerly participated in sorting healthy and junk food items. Each time they picked an item, they confidently identified it as either healthy or junk, and shared a brief explanation about their choice.



SCIENCE DEMONSTRATION (KG)

As part of the Science Demonstration, students were made aware of the concept of three states of water which are solid (ice), liquid (water) and gas (water vapour). They were made aware of all the three states of water through an activity conducted in class.



SKILL BASED LEARNING (KG)

This week's activity focused on eating etiquette and table manners. Kindergarten students learned to say please and thank you, use different utensils, chew with their mouths closed, and wash their hands before meals. They also practiced correct sitting posture during the meals and being considerate of others while eating. This activity helped in enhancing important social skills and good manners, helping children to interact politely and respectfully with others. These skills are fundamental for building positive relationships and developing self-discipline.





GENERAL AWARENESS

During this week students were informed about the neighbourhood during class discussions. After discussion they understood the role of hospitals, schools and banks. They were able to do a worksheet given in the workbook related to neighbourhood and were able to recognise the picture and tick the correct word.



MATHS

During this week students learnt about place value through an activity and did related work sheets in their Maths workbook .



HINDI

Revising the topics helps students gain more confidence to attempt any related questions. To understand the learning outcome, students were given written tasks on *chitra ko pehchano aur shabdon ko pura karo* in their Hindi workbook.



HANDS ON ACTIVITY (UKG)

During this week students learnt place value through an activity. Through the use of sticks, they made a bundle of ten and the remaining were taken as ones. Students had to calculate and write the numbers in their right places.



JADUI PITARA (NUR-UKG)

As part of the foundational stage "Jadui Pitara" activity sparked excitement among students. They curiously reached into the magic box, divided into numeracy and literacy sections, and retrieved various objects like a toy, ball, animal picture, flash cards, puppets etc. For class nursery, the teacher asked questions related to the objects picked by the child, therefore fostering learning and creativity.

In Kindergarten and UKG, students spoke a few lines on the puppets they picked and tried weaving a short story.

JADUI PITARA (NUR-UKG)





Students of class 1 were introduced to the blended phonic sound like cr. They were shown a video for better understanding which includes reading of certain words with the same sound. They practiced it by doing similar kinds of exercises.

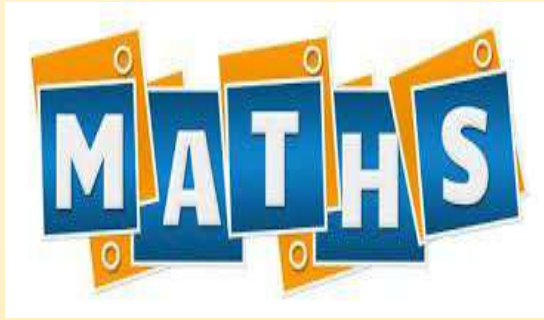




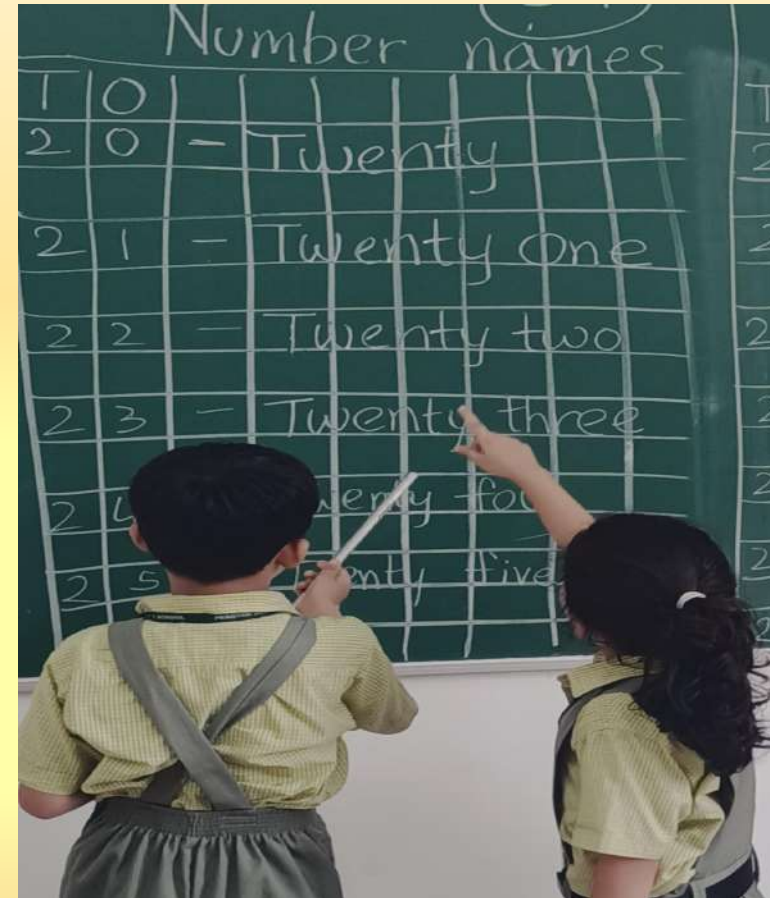
ENVIRONMENTAL SCIENCE

Children of class 1 enjoyed learning number names. They were also taught the concept of place value tens and ones till numbers from 20 - 29. PPTs and videos were shown for better understanding.

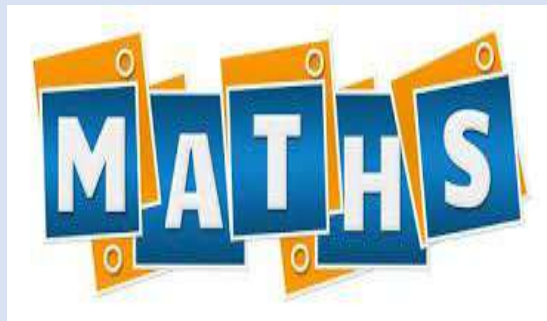
Children in Class 2 were introduced to the concept of opposite words and completed some written exercises on the topic. They also took part in an engaging activity called "Think and Act," where they acted out and responded to various words presented to them. The entire class participated enthusiastically and enjoyed this fun filled, interactive learning experience.





Festivals help to unite people from different cultures and religions in a friendly atmosphere. It is also a great chance to celebrate peace and love and spread it throughout the world. Students of class 2 read the chapter - “Time to celebrate” during their EVS class. They also enjoyed drawing their favourite festival in their EVS notebook.





While solving word problems, students may need to think outside the box and try multiple strategies to solve the problem. Students of class 2 understood solving word problems based on subtraction. They practiced a few worksheets on subtraction with regrouping along with revision of addition and tables up to 7. An ice breaking activity of solving a subtraction grid on the blackboard was conducted in the class.



INSTRUMENTAL MUSIC (1&2)



Playing a musical instrument stimulates brain activity and also fosters cognitive development and growth. In this regard, children in classes 1 and 2 revised playing Alankaar on the keyboard, thereby enhancing their musical skills and contributing to their overall brain development.

ART & CRAFT (1&2)



Students of classes 1 and 2 are preparing for their upcoming origami inter class activity. This week grade 1 students have been taught how to make a house with origami sheets and grade 2 has been taught how to make a boat with A4 size sheets.

VOCAL MUSIC (1&2)



Music provides a total brain workout. Children of classes 1 & 2 enjoyed singing 'Aao hum sab hath milaye'. They also practiced singing 'Teri hai zameen Tera aasman song'.

DANCE (1& 2)

Dance is an art to explore your feelings. The students of classes 1 & 2 started learning dance choreography for upcoming school events.



PHYSICAL EDUCATION (1 & 2)

During the physical education class children of classes 1 and 2 enjoyed playing football. They learnt basic pre-game skills also. They also practiced dribbling.



LIBRARY (1 & 2)

Storytelling is the act of telling a story using words or actions. The students learned about the 100m, 200m sprints and long jump in athletics. Furthermore, they enthusiastically participated in various drills for the development of physical fitness components.

WESTERN VOCAL CLUB



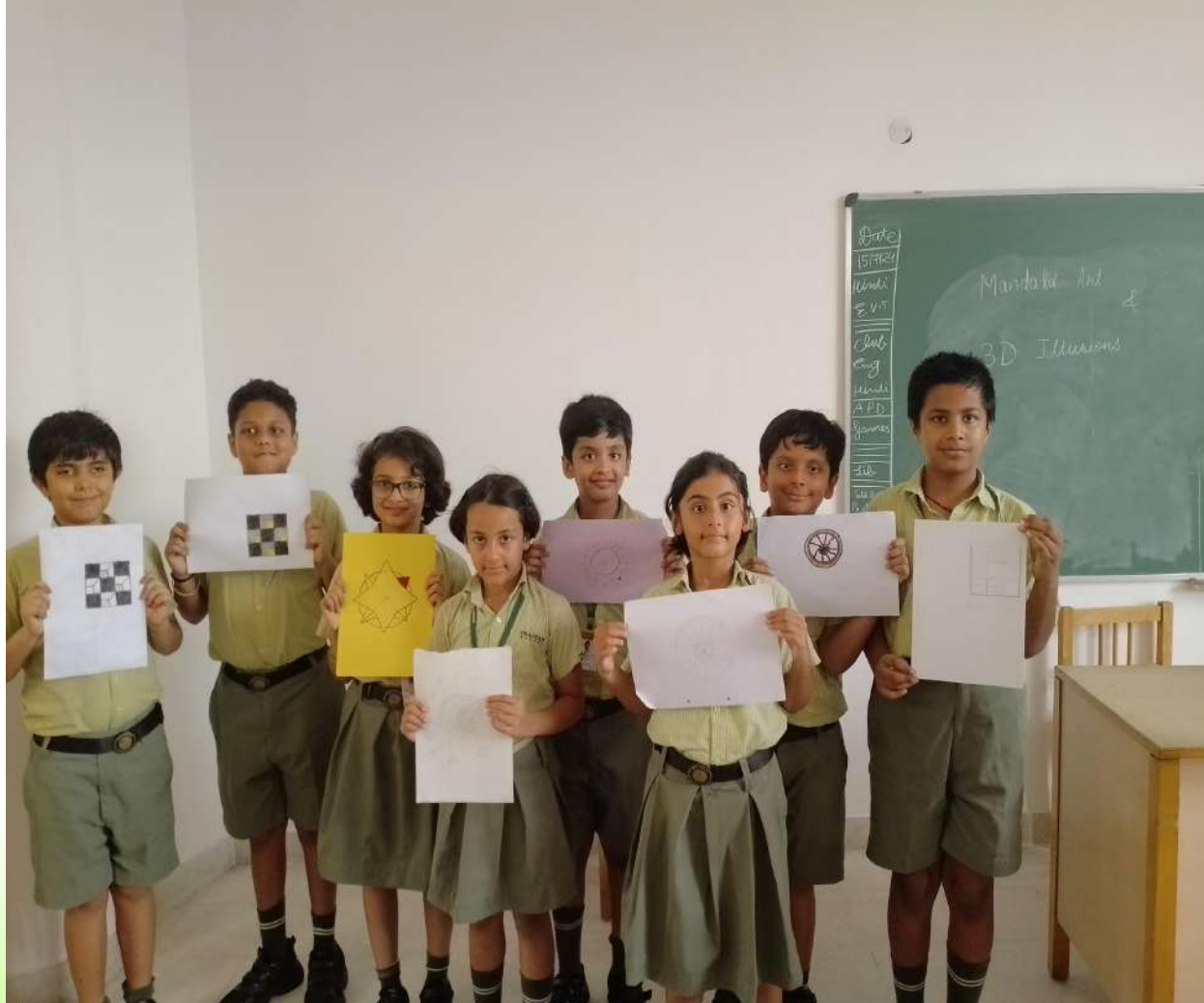
